Gamecocks Open Spring At UCF Challenge

The South Carolina women's golf team is set to open its spring schedule on Sunday at the UCF Challenge in Sorrento, Fla. The 54-hole tournament runs through Tuesday and will be contested at RedTail Golf Club.

The Lineup

After going through a competitive qualifying for this week's tournament, Harris will field the same lineup she closed out the fall with in the Landfall Tradition. Juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee, sophomore Justine Dreher and freshmen Sarah Schmelzel will look to get the Gamecocks off to a strong start this spring. Freshman Mary Fran Hillow will also be making the trip as she is set to make her collegiate debut as an individual.

History At The UCF Challenge

The Gamecocks are opening the spring season at the UCF Challenge for a third straight year. South Carolina finished tied for fifth at the event in 2011 and placed seventh last season. Former All-American Katie Burnett led the Gamecocks both years as she claimed eighth in 2011 and tied for 14th last year. Swinehart has played both years and recorded the best finish of her career in 2011 with a tie for 11th.

Breaking Down the Field

This year's UCF Challenge features 18 teams, with seven ranked in

the Golfstat Top 50. No. 9 North Carolina and No. 18 Virginia headline the tournament and are joined by No. 30 Tulane, No. 38 Texas State, No. 42 Mississippi, No. 46 Oregon State and No. 48 Missouri in the rankings. Augusta State, Coastal Carolina, College of Charleston, East Carolina, Georgia State, Kennesaw State, Louisville, Miami, South Florida and host UCF round out the field.

Recapping The 2012 UCF Challenge

South Carolina finished seventh at the 2012 UCF challenge after posting rounds of 290-299-300=889 (+25). Katie Burnett led the way with a tie for 14th finish as she shot rounds of 74-72-73=219 (+3). Samantha Swinehart and Amanda Strang tied for 38th with a three-round total of 224 (+8), while Suzie Lee and Justine Dreher tied for 43th with scores of 225 (+9). Auburn won the tournament with a total of 863 (-1).

Freshman, Smeshman

Freshman Śarah Schmelzel has been the Gamecocks' most consistent golfer this season. She was South Carolina's top finisher in its first two tournaments, including a tie for 20th showing at the NCAA Fall Preview. Schmelzel, who leads the team with a 73.90 stroke average, is No. 65 overall in the Golfstat player rankings.

A Turn For The Better

Sophomore Justine Dreher was playing some of the best golf of her career at the end of the fall and she wrapped up the four-tournament stretch with a tie for 15th showing at the weather-shortened Landfall Tradition. Dreher is currently third





Back To Form

Junior Samantha Swinehart is beginning to play the golf that earned her SEC All-Freshman Team honors in 2011. Swinehart currently ranks second on the team in stroke average (75.30) and rounds of par or better (three). Her tie for 12th finish at the Landfall Tradition is the best finish by a Gamecock this season.

Landfall Tradition Recap

The South Carolina women's golf team finished 13th at the Landfall Tradition, as the second and third rounds were canceled due to heavy overnight rain from Hurricane Sandy.

The Gamecocks played through extremely tough conditions in the second round at the Country Club of Landfall and made it through eight to 11 holes before play was suspended because of the weather. South Carolina had moved up to 10th place, but with the cancelation of the final two rounds, it finished 13th with its first-round score of 304 (+16).

Sophomore Justine Dreher finished tied for 15th with her first-round score of 73 (+3). It is the fourth top-20 finish of her career. Senior Meredith Swanson, who played as an individual, juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee and freshman Sarah Schmelzel all finished tied for 43rd with scores of 77 (+5). Freshman Chelsey Couch tied for 65th with a score of 79 (+7).

Tar Heel Invitational Recap

The Gamecocks posted a final-round 311 (+23) to wrap up the Tar Heel Invitational in a tie for 12th place at the UNC Finley Golf Course. South Carolina finished the tournament with a three-round total of 910 (+46).

Junior Samantha Swinehart led South Carolina with her second round of even-par 72 of the weekend. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart recorded her first top-20 finish of the season and fifth of her career as she tied for 12th with a three-day total of 220 (+4). The finish is the second best of her career.

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded a 6-over 78 on Sunday as she just missed out on her second consecutive top-20 finish. She closed out the tournament in a tie for 25th with a total of 223 (+7). Freshman Chelsey Couch, who played the weekend as an individual, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she tied for 47th with a total of 229 (+13) after shooting her second straight round of 75 (+3).

Junior Suzie Lee tied for 67th with a total of 234 (+18) after carding a final-round 81 (+9). Sophomore Justine Dreher shot an 8-over 80 to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 73rd with a score of 235 (+19), and senior Meredith Swanson turned in an 82 (+10) on Sunday to tie for 82nd with a score of 238 (+22).

NCAA Fall Preview Recap

South Carolina wrapped up play at the NCAA Fall Preview, posting a final-round 309 (+47) at the University of Georgia Golf Course.

Competing against one of the most elite fields in collegiate golf this season with 15 teams in the Golfstat Top 50, the Gamecocks finished 18th with a three-day total of 911 (+47). The tournament served as a preview of the 2013 NCAA Championship, as the top 10 teams from last year's championship and eight more teams with high rankings made the trip to Athens

The Gamecocks played one golfer short, as junior Suzie Lee withdrew prior to the round with an injury. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded the low round for South Carolina for the third straight day with a 2-over 74. A native of Phoenix, Ariz., Schmelzel recorded her first career top-20 finish as she tied for 20th with a total of 220 (+4).

Sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to finish the tournament in a tie for 45th with a score of 227 (+11). Junior Samantha Swinehart was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she shot a 78 (+6) to tie for 61st with a total of 230 (+14). Senior Meredith Swanson placed 79th with a score of 236 (+20) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Sunday.

Cougar Classic Recap

The South Carolina women's golf team put together its best round of the Cougar Classic, posting a final-round 294 (+6) at Yeamans Hall Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 899 (+35) as they moved six spots up the leaderboard to finish in 16th place.

After shooting only one round of par or better the first two days, Carolina finished strong, recording two rounds of even par and narrowly missing on a third 72. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel helped lead the way with her second straight 72. Junior Samantha Swinehart also carded a 72, and sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a 1-over 73.

Schmelzel proved to be the Gamecocks' most steady player at the event, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3). She climbed 12 spots up the leaderboard to finish in a tie for 30th. For the third straight day, Schmelzel did not make worse

than a bogey as she produced four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars.

Swinehart bounced back from consecutive rounds of 77 with a 72 on the final day. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart tied for 65th with a total of 226 (+10). After recording just one birdie in the first two rounds, she tallied five in the final round to go along with five bogeys and eight pars.

Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round.

Junior Suzie Lee and senior Meredith Swanson each carded a 5-over 77. Lee tied for 71st with a total of 227 (+11), and Swanson concluded the tournament in a tie for 100th with a score of 232 (+16).

Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

Busy Summer

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
