MILJANA JOCIC

5-11 • Senior-3L • Right-Handed • Novi Sad, Serbia

2009-10 (JUNIOR): Had a breakout season for South Carolina her junior year ... Named the team's Most Valuable Player ... Jovic's 28 singles victories were the most by any Gamecock in 2009-10 ... Began the fall season by winning her flight at the SEC Fall Coaches Classic in September ... Reached the finals of her draw at the Furman Fall Classic and won the backdraw

of her flight at the Wolverine Invitational ... Beginning with the Winthrop match Feb. 17, Jovic started an 11-match winning streak ... Clinched South Carolina's come-from-behind victory at Colorado with a three-set triumph on court four ... Teamed with Rita Maisak at No. 2 doubles to clinch the 1-0 lead against Alabama on March 12 and then won her singles contest in straight sets to help the Gamecocks win 4-3 ... She and Maisak won a critical doubles match at Ole Miss that clinched doubles and proved to be the difference in a 4-3 victory over the Rebels ... Won her singles match in a 4-3 win against Illinois as well ... Defeated Naoko Ueshima from Georgia twice during the spring, avenging two losses to her the previous spring ... The second time she beat her clinched South Carolina's 4-1 triumph over the Bulldogs in the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament, its first win over UGA in Athens, Ga., since 1996 ... It also marked South Carolina's first appearance in the SEC Tournament semifinals since 2002 and just the third in school history ... Played doubles primarily at the No. 2 position with Maisak, Anya Morgina and Madeleine Saari-Byström ... Her best record in doubles came with Morgina, as the two were 3-0 on court two and 2-2 at No. 3 doubles ... Named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

2008-09 (SOPHOMORE): Came back from a knee injury that shortened her freshman season to become a key contributor in the Gamecocks' lineup in both singles and doubles ... Became a fixture a No. 5 singles and No. 2 doubles during the second half of the season ... Combined with 2009 senior Gira Schofield to form a highly successful doubles team for the Gamecocks at the second spot ... The two were 17-4 together and went 14-3 at two doubles, winning their final eight matches of the season ... Snuck in the final national doubles rankings of the season at No. 72 ... It was the first time in Jovic's career she earned a national singles or doubles ranking ... She and Schofield posted a perfect 4-0 record in the NCAA Tournament in helping the Gamecocks win the doubles point each time en route to an Elite Eight appearance, the furthest the team has advanced in its history ... Earned an impressive 6-4, 6-3 over Caroline Litley in a key 5-2 win for the Gamecocks against Kentucky, a team ranked No. 14 in the nation at the time ... Became a truly fierce competitor after suffering a loss against Florida International on March 20 ... Jovic then won six of her next seven singles matches ... All six of Jovic's victories during the span came in straight sets ... Besides Kentucky, Jovic posted SEC triumphs against players from

Mississippi State, Ole Miss, LSU, Auburn and Alabama ... Named an ITA Scholar Athlete ... Earned a place on the SEC Academic Honor Roll as well.

2007-08 (FRESHMAN): One of five Gamecocks to reach 20 wins in singles play for the year ... Started her collegiate career with an impressive 14-4 fall record ... Won all three matches she played at the UVa Invitational in September ... Snagged three victories in four contests at the Wildcat Invitational in October ... Won flight B-2 at the Southern Intercollegiate Championships with four straight-set matches in which she lost a total of just six games ... Had a nine-match winning streak during the fall and won 14 of 15 during a span that extended into the spring campaign ... Reached the semifinals of the SEC Fall Coaches Classic in Auburn, Ala. ... Began the spring season winning her first five matches in straight sets against Troy, College of Charleston, Harvard, Furman and Winthrop ... Lost just 17 games during those five matches ... Picked up a strong 6-3, 6-3 triumph over Alaina Trgovich from Kentucky at No. 4 singles in her first SEC match ... Notched an 8-5 doubles record playing with Megan McGavock during every fall tournament except the SEC Fall Coaches Classic ... The pair won the B-1 flight at the Southern Intercollegiate ... Had her season cut short after losing three matches in a row in March due to a knee injury ... Underwent a minor operation in April to successfully repair it ... Named to the SEC Freshmen Academic Honor Roll.

HIGH SCHOOL: Attended the High School of Economics in Novi Sad, Serbia ... Played her first ITF Juniors event in September 2003 at the fifth Yugoslavia Junior Open ... Won three matches in the qualify draw, first against Dunja Antunovic and then was a 6-2, 6-2 winner over Katarina Vranic ... Took out Alja Zec-Peskiric 6-4, 6-1 to reach the main draw ... Suffered a first-round loss to Yulia Stupak ... Reached the main draw of the 2004 Pancevo International in Serbia and became a semifinalist ... Defeated Anastasia Poltoratskaya from Russia in the round of 32 by scores of 6-4, 6-3 ... Followed with a 6-1, 6-4 win against Maria Miziouk and then took a 6-3, 6-2 decision from Katerina Polunina in the quarters ... Lost to Olga Panova in the semifinal round ... Played in the Pancevo International in 2005 as well ... Competed at the Heveld Flanders Indoor Junior Championships in 2004 ... Played limited doubles matches on the ITF Junior Circuit ... Partnered with Katarina Milinkovic for two matches and also with Volha Duko and Ivana Milutinovic for some additional contests ... Her career-high combined ranking as a junior was No. 747 in the world ... Held a 4-4 overall record in singles matches as an ITF Juniors competitor.

DIJANA STOJIC

5-5 • Junior-2L • Right-Handed • Makarska, Croatia

2009-10 (SOPHOMORE): After a slow start to the fall campaign, Stojic went on to finish the year as one of South Carolina's most reliable points ... Posted a 21-6 record in singles after starting 1-9 through three fall tournaments ... Stojic earned second-team All-SEC Honors ... Cracked the singles rankings for the first time during the fall at No. 114 ... Ranked as high as

No. 83 in the nation during the spring before finishing 85th ... Combined with Ana Marija Zubori to form South Carolina's No. 1 doubles team the entire spring ... The duo went 16-10 overall together ... Stojic and Zubori rose as high as 14th nationally in doubles ... The two ended the year ranked No. 17, the highest final ranking in school history for a Gamecock doubles team ... The two qualified for the NCAA Doubles Championship, however, Zubori withdrew from the tournament for personal reasons following South Carolina's NCAA second-round team loss to Florida State ... Stojic and Zubori defeated teams during the spring that finished the year ranked sixth, 10th, 14th, 21st, 46th, 64th and 86th ... Stojic's 18-6 record in dual matches marked South Carolina's most dual victories ... After a win over Wake Forest on March 9, it was Stojic's 12th victory in 13 matches ... Her three-set win against Keri Wong of Clemson gave Stojic her first victory of the season against a ranked opponent, as Wong stood 65th at the time ... Scored a 6-3, 6-0 triumph versus then-No. 27 Jackie Wu from Vanderbilt in April ... Against Georgia in the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament, Stojic and Zubori clinched the doubles point with a 9-8(6) win over sixth-ranked Chelsey Gullickson and Nadja Gilchrist ... Stojic then beat Gilchrist 6-1, 6-3 in singles to put Carolina ahead 2-0 and help the Gamecocks defeat Georgia in Athens, Ga., for the first time since 1996 ... It also put the Gamecocks in the SEC Tournament semifinals for the first time since 2002 and marked just their third semifinal appearance in school history ... Stojic's performance in the SEC Tournament landed her on the SEC All-Tournament Team.

2008-09 (FRESHMAN): Was a key component who helped the Gamecocks reach the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament, the furthest the team has advanced in its history ... After sitting out the entire fall season and the first seven matches in order to gain eligibility from the NCAA, Stojic entered the Gamecocks' lineup at No. 3 singles versus Clemson on Feb. 22 ... Defeated Ina Hadziselimovic in that match 6-3, 6-2 in a 5-2 loss for the Gamecocks ... Along with 2009 senior Gira Schofield, Stojic won the most matches of any Carolina player during the NCAA run, going 3-1 in singles matches and 4-0 in doubles ... She and doubles partner Suzanna Mansour helped South Carolina win the doubles point in all four of its NCAA matches ... They entered the event with a modest 4-4 record at three doubles, but caught fire at the right time ... Stojic clinched the first-round NCAA victory against Wake Forest with a 6-2, 3-6, 6-2 win over Emilee Malvey at three singles ... Gave the Gamecocks their second

point in the match with UT by defeating second-team All-SEC player Samantha Orlin 6-2, 6-2 ... Was the second to finish against Washington in the round of 16 with a 7-5, 6-2 triumph over Lina Xu ... Trailed Xu 4-1 in the first set before coming back to win 11 of the next 14 games ... Ended the season with a heartbreaking loss to Georgia's Nadja Gilchrist in singles play in three sets ... It was the final match on court with the team score tied 3-all ... Stojic led 5-4 in the third set, but Gilchrist managed to muster just enough energy to pull out the next three games for the victory ... Began her season with a 2-4 record in singles before winning 13 of her final 15 matches ... Recovered from a 0-4 start in SEC matches to go 6-5 on the season ... Named SEC Freshman of the Week following victories against Mississippi State and Ole Miss ... Earned the first victory of her career against a ranked opponent when she defeated Mariana Muci Torres of Florida International ... Torres was No. 90 at the time ... The FIU match on March 20 started her strong finish of winning 13 of 15 matches to end her freshman year.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played Fed Cup for Bosnia-Herzegovina in 2003, 2005, 2006 and 2007 ... Owned a 10-3 record in singles matches while playing for her country in the event ... In 2006, Stojic went 5-0 for Bosnia-Herzegovina in helping her country defeat Egypt, Namibia, Botswana, Azerbaijan and Liechtenstein in Europe/Africa Group III B ... While playing on the International Tennis Federation's junior circuit, Stojic was ranked as high as No. 363 in the world in August 2002 and her best in doubles of No. 567 was in December 2002 ... As a 13-year-old, reached the championship match of the Mostar Open in September 2001 ... Survived the qualifying rounds of the BMW Junior Championships of Luxembourg, beating Maraika Biglmaier 6-1, 2-6, 6-1 to reach the main draw ... After winning her first match in the main draw, Stojic lost to Nicole Vaidisova, a current professional who has been ranked in the top 10 in the world, in the round of 16 ... In August 2002, she won three qualifying matches in straight sets at the Fischer Junior Open der Stadt Wels ... Won her opening-round match of the main draw 6-4, 4-6, 6-2 against Antonia Toth before falling to Ekaterina Bychova in the round of 16 ... Had over 50 singles victories for her career playing ITF events.

PERSONAL: Is a business major ... Born July 16, 1988, in Tuzla, Bosnia-Herzegovina ... Holds dual citizenship with Croatia and Bosnia-Herzegovina ... Prefers to use Wilson rackets ... ANYA MORGINA

5-7 • Junior-1L • Right-Handed • Cairo, Egypt

2009-10 (SOPHOMORE): Displayed a powerful game that allowed her to play in the top half of the lineup for the Gamecocks all spring ... Gave a solid performance in the fall with a 5-4 record ... Her highlight victory of the fall and season as a whole included a three-set triumph over Catherine Newman of Vanderbilt at the Furman Fall Classic in September ...

Newman entered the match ranked No. 46 nationally and played No. 1 singles for the Commodores in the spring, ending the season with a ranking of 23rd ... Morgina played the entire spring at No. 3 singles, where she posted a 15-8 record ... Held a 14-3 record after her first 17 dual matches and began the spring ranked No. 69, her highest of the year ... Won the first NCAA Tournament match of her career with a 6-1, 6-0 victory against Kayla Duncan of TCU that helped the Gamecocks come back from losing the doubles point to defeat the Horned Frogs 4-2 ... A strong performer in doubles for South Carolina as well, playing the bulk of the spring with Adriana Pereira at the No. 3 spot ... The pair went 6-4 in regular-season SEC matches at the third position ... Ended the year, however, with a different partner in Miljana Jovic, which proved to be a successful combination as well ... The two went 5-2 overall and were 3-0 at No. 2 doubles ... Listed at No. 105 in the nation in the final ITA singles rankings and appeared in every edition but one of the association's spring rankings ... Named the New Female Athlete of the Year for the entire athletics department at the annual Gamecock Gala in April.

2008-09 (FRESHMAN): Spent her freshman year in Terre Haute, Ind., playing for the Indiana State Sycamores ... Helped her team to a second-place finish in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 6-2 record ... ISU finished 8-12 overall after losing to Northern Iowa in the quarterfinals of the MVC Tournament ... Voted to the MVC All-Select Team ... Posted a 17-3 record in singles matches while going 14-6 in doubles ... Dominated the No. 2 singles slot with a 14-1 mark ... Played five matches at No. 1 singles, going 3-2 ... Partnered primarily with Sofya Lifanova for doubles, going 14-5 with her ... Morgina and Lifanova collected a 14-3 record playing the second slot ... Ranked fifth in the conference in singles winning percentage thanks to her .850 figure ... Had the highest winning percentage of any player in the league at No. 2 singles at 93.3 percent ... She and Lifanova also turned in the highest percentage of wins at the second doubles position with an 82.4 percent mark ... Morgina ranked in the top 10 in the league for conference singles winning percentage with a 7-1 record (.875) and went undefeated at No. 2 doubles with Lifanova with a 7-0 slate to lead the MVC.

HIGH SCHOOL: Ranked as high as 142nd in the world in the International Tennis Federation juniors ... Won the ITF Egypt International Championships in singles in

2007 and 2008 ... Picked up the doubles title at the 2008 Egypt championships as well with partner Natela Dzalamidze ... Claimed the 2007 Egypt doubles title with May El Wardany ... She and Petra Jurova won the doubles championship at the Damascus International Junior Tournament in Syria in July 2008 ... Won a singles title at the ITF East Africa Circuit in Burundi in November 2007 ... Won a pair of additional doubles titles on the ITF circuit with Galina Fokina and the duo made the finals of two ITA tournaments as well.

2009-10 (FRESHMAN): One of the Gamecocks' top performers as a freshman ... Won two singles matches at each fall tournament in which she appeared to finish with an 8-5 record ... Did not play singles in three of South Carolina's first five dual matches in the spring, but Pereira became a permanent fixture in the lineup after Josefin Andersson was lost for the

season with an injury ... After entering the lineup for good Feb. 24 versus College of Charleston, Pereira won her first eight matches playing at Nos. 5 and 6 singles ... Ended her freshman campaign by winning seven of her final nine matches and became the Gamecocks' regular starter at five singles ... Went 9-2 in regular-season SEC matches to tie a school record for conference victories in a season ... Her 16 dual match wins and 24 overall victories registered third on the team ... Named SEC Freshman of the Week on April 7 after helping the Gamecocks to wins over Vanderbilt and Kentucky ... Won her doubles and singles matches against both Kentucky and Georgia in the SEC Tournament to finish 4-0 in the event and help the Gamecocks defeat Georgia in Athens, Ga., for the first time since 1996 ... 2009-10 (FRESHMAN): One of the hardest workers for the Gamecocks both on the court and in the classroom ... After a 1-5 start in the fall during her first two tournaments, she ended the campaign strong by earning co-champion honors of her flight at the Wildcat Invitational by winning three straight matches to make the finals ... Play was halted at the event because

of weather problems and teams' travel arrangements ... Won four consecutive matches in the spring against Winthrop, Clemson, College of Charleston and USF ... Clinched South Carolina's win over USF, a team ranked No. 20 at the time, by overcoming a 4-1 deficit in the third set and several match points for her opponent ... Sat out six matches in a row following a loss to Alabama on March 12 because of an injury to her right arm ... Reentered the lineup against Vanderbilt on April 4 and scored a three set triumph over Hannah Blatt at No. 6 singles to clinch the match for the Gamecocks ... Won her next three matches at six singles after Vandy and finished 4-1 at the position ...
