Gamecocks Head to Palmetto Intercollegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team will open play at the Palmetto Intercollegiate on Monday in Aiken, S.C. The Gamecocks will play 36 holes on Monday and 18 on Tuesday at the historic par-70, 6,695-yard Palmetto Golf Club.

The Lineup

After finishing third at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships to open the spring, the Gamecocks will tee off in Aiken with the same lineup. Sophomore Matt NeSmith will play as the team's No. 1 golfer, followed by junior Caleb Sturgeon, junior Will Murphy, junior Blaine Woodruff and sophomore Will Starke.

What They've Done So Far

- Sophomore Matt NeSmith: Tied for 21st at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Recorded second-straight runner-up finish of the fall at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic with a total of 212 (-4), the fifth top-five finish of his career...Runner-up at the Badger Invitational with a total of 212 (-4)...Has placed in the top 10 in seven of last nine regular-season events dating back to last spring...Finished tied for fourth at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 45th at the Carpet Capital Collegiate to open the season...Leads the team with a stroke average of 72.13.
- Junior Caleb Sturgeon: Tied for 33rd at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Finished tied for 13th at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic... Won second career tournament title, claiming medalist honors at the Badger Invitational with a total of 206 (-10)...Has four career top-five finishes and 13 top-20 showings...Tied for 14th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 41st at the Carpet Capital Collegiate to open the season...Second on the team with a stroke average of 72.60...Career average of 73.05 is currently tied for the third best all-time at South Carolina.
- Junior Will Murphy: Tied for 21st at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Just missed top-20 finish at Wendy's Kiawah Classic, tying for 21st...Wrapped up Badger Invitational in a tie for 25th...Tied for sixth at the Rees Jones Invitational... Finished in a tie for 48th at the Carpet Capital Collegiate...Ranks fourth on the team with a stroke average of 73.80.
- Junior Blaine Woodruff: Just missed a top-20 finish at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships, tying for 21st...Tied for third at the Savannah Quarters Intercollegiate...Finished in a tie for 48th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 62nd at the Carpet Capital Collegiate...Has a scoring average of 75.18.
- Sophomore Will Starke: Tied for 36th at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships...Turned in second top-five finish of the season, tying for fourth at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic...Has three top-five finishes for his career...Tied for 18th at the Badger Invitational...Tied for 37th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Posted a 2-under 214 to finish in a tie for fifth at the season-opening Carpet Capital Collegiate...Ranks third on the team with a stroke average of 73.33.

History at Palmetto Intercollegiate

The Gamecocks are making their third-straight appearance at the Palmetto Intercollegiate and fifth overall. Carolina has had plenty of success at the event, finishing no worse than third in any of its previous appearances. The Gamecocks finished runner-up last season, third in 2012, first in 2004 and third in 2003. Carolina has also had an individual place in the top five each year, including Matt NeSmith's tie for third finish last year and Erik Johansen winning medalist honors in 2004.

The Older, the Better

The Gamecocks will tee off on Monday at the historic Palmetto Golf Club, which features a par-70, 6,695-yard setup. The course has been taken very good care of over the years as it was founded in 1892, earning it the distinction as the fourth oldest course in the nation.

Breaking Down the Field

The Gamecocks will face another solid field in Aiken. The 18-team field consists of five teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including South Carolina at No. 26. Virginia is the highest-ranked team at No. 7. The Cavaliers enter their first spring event with a win and a runner-up finish on their resume from the fall. Carolina will also compete against rival Clemson, the 31st-ranked team in the country. No. 36 Liberty and host USC Aiken, the ninth-ranked team in Division II, round out the top 50 teams at the event. Akron, Chattanooga, Elon, Francis Marion, Furman, Georgia Regents, Georgia State, Maryland, Nebraska, North Carolina State, Penn, Presbyterian and Wofford round out the field.

Shooting for a Top-Three Finish

The Gamecocks will be playing for their fifth-straight top-three finish at the Palmetto Golf Club. South Carolina has finished third or better in four consecutive events, including two wins. It matches last year's stretch of four consecutive top-three finishes as the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

Par-3s Not a Problem

Junior Caleb Sturgeon has been among the best in the nation on par-3 holes this season. Sturgeon currently ranks fourth nationally in par-3 scoring with an average of 2.90.

Getting Below Par

As a team, South Carolina is tied for 16th nationally in subpar strokes per round with an average of 3.40. Individually, sophomore Matt NeSmith is tied for 36th nationally with an average of 4.25 per round.

Race for the Golfstat Cup

Sophomore Matt NeSmith and junior Caleb Sturgeon are both listed in the latest standings for the Golfstat Cup, which will be awarded to the golfer with the lowest adjusted scoring average among all divisions (DI, DII, DIII, NAIA, JUCO) at the end of the season. NeSmith ranks 76th with an adjusted average of 74.51, while Sturgeon is 132nd with an adjusted average of 75.45. Western Carolina's J.T. Poston leads the way with an average of 68.93.

2013-14 Tournament Recaps

Bayou City Collegiate Championships

The 25th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team opened the spring in strong fashion by claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks fired an 8-under 280 in the final round to wrap up the event with a total of 851 (-13). Tournament host Houston claimed the team title with a total of 833 (-31), while Texas finished runner-up with a score of 841 (-23).

South Carolina has now finished third or better in four straight events, including two wins. It matches last year's stretch of four consecutive top-three finishes as the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

Juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon and sophomores Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded a 2-under 70 for the Gamecocks on Sunday, while junior Blaine Woodruff closed out the weekend with a 74 (+2).

NeSmith, Woodruff and Murphy all just missed out on a top-20 finish as they tied for 21st with totals of 215 (-1). Sturgeon tied for 33rd with a total of 216 (E), and Starke tied for 36th with a score of 217 (+1).

Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team closed out its fall schedule in dominant fashion, claiming its second-straight Wendy's Kiawah Classic title by 22 strokes at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who won last year's tournament by 20 strokes, posted a final-round 295 (+7) to finish the week with a three-round total of 864 (E) to secure their second-consecutive tournament title of the fall. It marks the first time the program has won consecutive events since winning the Turtle Bay Intercollegiate (11/4/03) and the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship (2/10/04) back-to-back during the 2003-04 season.

Four out of the five golfers in South Carolina's lineup finished the week in the top 15, with sophomore Matt NeSmith leading

the way. The North Augusta, S.C., native fired a final-round 68 (-4) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). Sophomore Will Starke (T-4th), freshman Ben Dietrich (12th) and junior Caleb Sturgeon (T-13th) also finished the week in the top 15. Junior Will Murphy just missed a top-20 finish as he tied for 21st.

Starke recorded his third career top-five showing as he shot a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish tied for fourth with a total of 216 (E).

Dietrich carded a final-round 74 (+2) to earn his first career top-20 finish with a total of 220 (+4). A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon posted a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish the event with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to conclude the week with a score of 223 (+7), missing out on his seventh career top-20 finish by a stroke. Senior Alan King, who made his Gamecock debut as an individual, finished tied for 76th with a total of 237 (+21) after shooting a final-round 85 (+13).

Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 291 (+3) to cruise to a 24-stroke victory at the Badger Invitational on Tuesday at University Ridge Golf Course.

The Gamecocks led wire-to-wire and wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 856 (-8) to pull away from the field for the win. Junior Caleb Sturgeon also captured medalist honors for the second time in his career after firing a 3-under 69 in the final round. He posted a total of 206 (-10) to become the 11th golfer in school history to win multiple tournament titles.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon now has four career top-five finishes, just one shy of breaking into the top-10 in school history. Sturgeon's closest competitor was also wearing Garnet and Black, as NeSmith carded a 73 (-1) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). NeSmith also has four top-five finishes for his career and has placed in the top 10 in six of the last seven regular-season tournaments dating back to last spring.

Sophomore Will Starke recorded his fourth career top-20 finish as he shot a final-round 72 (E) to tie for 18th with a total of 222 (+6), while junior Will Murphy finished just outside the top 20 in a tie for 25th with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Tuesday. Rounding out the lineup, freshman Ben Dietrich turned in a 77 (+5) to tie for 44th with a total of 228 (+12).

Kansas finished runner-up with a total of 880 (+16), followed by Illinois State (883), USC Upstate (+22) and Austin Peay (+27).

Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team came up short of claiming its third Rees Jones Invitational title as it shot a final-round 299 (+11) to finish in a tie for second at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks, who have never placed worse than third at the event, finished tied with South Florida with a three-round total of 887 (+23) to fall two shots shy of tournament champion Kennesaw State. The Owls captured their third Rees Jones Invitational trophy with a total of 885 (+21).

The final day proved to be the toughest, as the average score rose to 78.16 with winds gusting as high as 20 miles per hour. South Carolina fought through the conditions to place three golfers in the top 15. Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished in a tie for fourth with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Tuesday.

Junior Will Murphy carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 1-over 73 to finish in a tie for sixth with a total of 219 (+3). Junior Caleb Sturgeon posted a final-round 77 (+5) to record his second-straight top-15 finish at Haig Point with a total of 222 (+6). Sophomore Will Starke tied for 33rd with a total of 231 (+15) after turning in a 75 (+3) in the final round, while junior Blaine Woodruff shot an 80 (+8) to tie for 48th with a total of 235 (+19). Playing as an individual in his first collegiate event, freshman Ben Dietrich finished in a tie for 33rd with a total of 229 (+13) after carding an 81 (+9).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 297 (+9) at The Farm Golf Club to finish in 10th place at the Carpet Capital Collegiate. The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a three-round total of 888 (+24).

Continuing his solid play from the first two rounds, sophomore Will Starke recorded his second career top-five finish as he fired a 2-under 70 to conclude the tournament in a tie for fifth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke carded a team-best seven birdies to go with three bogeys and a double bogey. After shooting 1-over 37 on the front side, he bogeyed the 10th hole to start the back nine before playing the final eight holes at 4-under.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, who posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as he concluded the tournament in a tie for 41st with a total of 224 (+8). He recorded a pair of birdies, three bogeys and a triple bogey on the afternoon.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith turned in a 78 (+6) on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 225 (+9), while junior Will Murphy tied for 48th with a total of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 74 (+2). Rounding out the lineup, junior Blaine Woodruff shot a 77 (+5) to tie for 62nd with a total of 230 (+14).

Be on the Lookout

Sophomore Matt NeSmith, a PING Honorable Mention All-American last season, was listed among Golf World's top 50 male golfers to watch during the 2013-14 season. NeSmith recorded seven top-10 finishes a year ago.
