NOTEWORTHY

SOUTH CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- South Carolina enters its third season with head coach Scott Swanson.
- Last year's team went 18-14, the program's second winning season in the last decade and the most wins since 2008 (21).
- The Gamecocks return five letterwinners from a year ago, including two starters (senior Juliette Thévenin, sophomore Darian Dozier).
- With the departure of 11 letterwinners, South Carolina lost 97 percent of its production from last season in assists (1,346), 78.1 percent in digs (1,252) and 58.9 percent in kills (876).
- The 2012 Gamecocks improved their offensive efficiency for the second straight year, raising their hitting percentage 29 points to .255, which ranked third in the SEC.
- South Carolina returns its leader in kills (Juliette Thévenin, 453) and its second-leading blocker (Darian Dozier, 67).

Home Match Notes

- This weekend's three matches are a part of a 16-match home slate in 2013.
- South Carolina's record for most home matches in a season is 21 (1990).
- The Gamecocks are 19-12 at home in Scott Swanson's first two seasons at South Carolina.
- The 2012 squad began the year 9-0 in matches at the Volleyball Competition Facility.

(RECENT) HOME TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Gamecocks have become a familiar tournament host as they have held a home tournament every year since 2000 except for 2001 and 2005.
- Under Scott Swanson, South Carolina is 11-0 in tournaments held at home
- South Carolina's last loss at home in a tournament was a 3-0 setback against Lipscomb in the Gamecock Invitational on Sept. 11, 2010.

All-Time Records

- Through 40 years of volleyball, South Carolina holds a 724-555 (.568) record.
- The Gamecocks are 192-218 (.468) in SEC play.
- In matches played at the Volleyball Competition Facility, South Carolina is 148-76 (.661).

LEAVING HER MARK

- Senior outside hitter Juliette Thévenin returns for one last season in Garnet and Black.
- She is a preseason All-SEC selection after ranking second in SEC play in both kills per set (4.40) and points per set (4.81) last season.
- The Mont-sur-Marchinne, Belgium, native earned second-team All-SEC honors in 2012, becoming the first Gamecock to earn All-SEC honors since 2008 (Belita Salters).
- Entering the season, Thévenin is in the top 10 in four career categories in the Gamecock record book, ranking second in kills per set (3.89), fourth in points per set (4.30) and eighth in both kills (1,124) and attacks (2,903).

INSTANT IMPACT

- South Carolina added a pair of transfers to the roster in the offseason in sophomore setter Kellie McNeil (Minnesota) and junior libero Michaela Christiaansen (Pepperdine).
- McNeil, who will serve as a team captain along with seniors Juliette Thévenin and Lindsey Craft, played in 17 matches for Minnesota in 2011 and ranked second on the team in assists (32) and assists per set (6.15).
- Christiaansen played in all 64 matches during her time at Pepperdine and averaged 2.78 digs per set.
- A native of Tucson, Ariz., Christiaansen helped lead the Waves to a NCAA Regional final and a West Coast Conference title in 2011. She also played sand volleyball for the Waves, and helped the program win the 2012 AVCA National Team Championship.

ABOUT SOUTH CAROLINA STATE

- Head coach Valerie Jones is in her first season with the Lady Bulldogs.
- South Carolina State returns five starters from last year's squad that went 9-15 overall and tied for second in the Southern Division in Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference play with a 6-4 mark.
- Senior outside hitter Desire Waller, a two-time MEAC Player of the Year, returns to lead the Lady Bulldogs after leading the MEAC with 4.91 kills per set a year ago.
- The Lady Bulldogs also return senior middle blocker Alyse Lewis, who led the team in blocks (96) last season, and sophomore setter Melanie Williams, who ranked first on the team in assists (800).

Head Coach • Third Year at South Carolina

- Coached seven teams that played in the NCAA Tournament (Arizona State 1999, 2000, Minnesota 2006-10)

The 11th head coach in Gamecock Volleyball history, Scott Swanson looks to continue building the South Carolina program into a national contender entering his third season in Columbia.

Swanson guided the Gamecocks to an 18-14 record last season, the program's second winning season in the last decade. South Carolina got off to a program-best 13-0 start and improved its hitting percentage for a second straight season, ranking second in the SEC with a percentage of .255, an improvement of 29 points from the previous year. Outside hitter Juliette Thévenin garnered second-team All-SEC honors after she ranked second in SEC play with 4.40 kills per set and 4.81 points per set, becoming the first Gamecock since 2008 to receive an All-SEC award.

In Swanson's first season, the Gamecocks went 14-16 and improved its offensive efficiency and its backline defense under his guidance. The team led the SEC with a 16.78 digs average, the best mark in four years for the Gamecocks, and hit .226, a 45-point improvement from the 2011 season. Three times, South Carolina student-athletes garnered an SEC weekly award, with Thévenin picking up the first offensive listing and Paige Wheeler twice gaining the defensive certificate.

Swanson's teams have also proved themselves in the classroom, earning the Team Academic Award from the American Volleyball Coaches Association in 2011-12 and 2012-13. A total of 15 Gamecocks made the SEC Academic Honor Rolls in 2012-13, and thirteen received the honor in 2011-12. The team also claimed the department's Life Skills Team of the Year award in 2011-12, honoring the group for its academic achievements, personal development and work in the community.

Prior to his current head coaching job, Swanson spent five years on the sidelines for the Golden Gophers, helping the team to five-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and a 125-46 record. Three times, Minnesota finished second in the Big Ten behind perennial power Penn State. The 2009 team advanced to the national semifinals in the NCAA Tournament.

During his tenure in Minneapolis, Swanson helped the Golden Gophers become an elite blocking team. In five years, Minnesota never ranked lower than 35th in NCAA Division I in blocks. The 2007 team set a program record with 3.54 blocks per set. Five Golden Gophers earned All-America accolades during those five years, including 2009 first-team middle blocker and 2012 US National Team pool member Lauren Gibbemeyer.

Swanson also led the Gophers' recruiting efforts, posting three top-10 recruiting classes according to PrepVolleyball.com. The 2009 group earned top honors from the outlet.

The summer of 2009, Swanson spent time with USA Volleyball's A-2 Junior National Team, and he coached the USA Red team to a second-place showing in the 2008 USA Adult Open Championships.

Swanson brings in four years of head coaching experience to Columbia after his tenure at the University of Texas-El Paso. With a 50-61 career record, Swanson had the team on the brink of the NCAA Tournament in 2005, when the Miners went 21-10. Three player earned all-conference honors under Swanson's tutelage, including honorable mention All-American Kari Stacy. He also inked a high school All-American and saw his team improve in the classroom to a department-best 3.2 GPA in 2005.

Prior to UTEP, Swanson spent six years at his alma mater, Arizona State. He helped the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances during his time in Tempe and coached one second-team All-American and two Pac-10 All-Freshman Team players. Two of his Sun Devil players garnered Academic All-America certificates as well. Swanson started his coaching career at Mountain View (Ariz.) High School, working as an assistant with the varsity team and leading his junior varsity group to a 17-1 record. As a head coach with the Arizona East Valley Juniors club, he led a 16-1s team to a national runner-up finish and earned Cactus Region Coach of the Year honors. He also served as head coach at Camelback High School before landing the job with Arizona State, where he also played club volleyball.

A graduate of ASU, Swanson is married to the former Erin Meier. The couple has one daughter, Rylee Sue.
