### Maryland 4, Old Dominion 3

#### Maryland Notes

- With the win, Maryland improves to 37-21 on the season.
- The Terrapins are now 2-6 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- Maryland will face the winner of the South Carolina-Campbell game on Saturday at 7 p.m.
- The victory is Maryland's first NCAA Tournament win since defeating Mississippi State, 3-2, on May 28, 1970.
- The win is Maryland's first this season when trailing after eight innings. The Terrapins were 0-18 when trailing after eight heading into Friday.
- With seven strikeouts on Friday, starting pitcher Jake Stinnett set the Maryland single-season strikeouts record, pushing his total to 130.
- Left fielder Tim Lewis extended his hitting streak to 15 games with a single in the bottom of the sixth.



#### Old Dominion Notes

- With the loss, Old Dominion falls to 36-25 on the season.
- The Monarchs are now 4-15 all-time in NCAA Tournament games and 1-5 in regional games played in Columbia, S.C.
- The loss is just Old Dominion's second this season when leading after eight innings. The Monarchs entered the contest with a 30-1 record when holding the lead through eight innings.
- Old Dominion turned two double plays on Friday, pushing its season total to a school-record 67. The Monarchs ranked third nationally in double plays heading into the game.
- The Monarchs will play the loser of the South Carolina-Campbell game on Saturday in an elimination game at 1 p.m.
