### GAMECOCKS READY FOR THIRD EVENT OF THE FALL

South Carolina women's golf will travel to its third fall tournament this weekend as it gets ready to compete in the Ruth's Chris Tar Heel Invitational in Chapel Hill, N.C. This marks the 11th consecutive year the Gamecocks have played in the event, a 54-hole stroke play tournament featuring 18 of the top programs from throughout the country, including 13 that are ranked in Golfweek's top 50. Duke returns as the defending champion after edging out South Carolina by two strokes in last year's tournament.

### THE LINEUP

Senior Sarah Schmelzel, juniors Katelyn Dambaugh and Jia Xin Yang, freshman Isidora Nilsson and sophomore Ainoah Olarra will make the trip for the Gamecocks. Gaby Amos makes her Gamecock debut, traveling to compete as an individual.

### HISTORY AT THE TAR HEEL INVITATIONAL

Fresh off their win at the ANNIKA Invitational in 2014, the Gamecocks entered last year's Tar Heel Invitational ranked No. 1 in the country. South Carolina posted rounds of 287-288-289 to finish even-par, tied for second out of 18 teams. Katelyn Dambaugh and Nanna Madsen led the Gamecocks, finishing 1-under for the event, tied for fifth. Mary Fran Hillow landed just outside the top 10 with a 217 (+3). The Gamecocks received a round of 69 or better by three separate individuals.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Gamecocks opened with a stellar first-round score of 286 (-2) at the ANNIKA Intercollegiate in Reunion, Fla. before settling for ninth place in a field that included 12 of the top programs from throughout the country. Junior Katelyn Dambaugh led Carolina, finishing third overall at nine-under. She tied the low-18 (65) school record on Friday for the second time in her career and also matched the school record for low 54-hole score (207) over the weekend. Senior Sarah Schmelzel posted a career-best 54-hole score of 210 at the event, placing her in the top 10 individually as well in seventh. South Carolina was one of only three schools at the event with multiple top-10 finishers.

### HISTORIC LAST SEASON

The Gamecocks began the 2014-15 season in impressive fashion capturing the title at the ANNIKA Intercollegiate. The win helped South Carolina earned the program's first ever No. 1 ranking the following week. The Gamecocks would later earn the program's first No. 1 seed for the NCAA East Regional where they took home the title for the third time in six seasons.

advancing to their sixth-straight NCAA Championships. The team captured the school record for top-five finishes in a season, finishing with 10, capping off a streak of 15 straight top-five finishes dating back to 2013-14.

### TOP TEN PROGRAM

For the second-continuous year, the Gamecocks were ranked No. 10 in the country entering the season, cementing the program as one of the nation's elite. South Carolina finished last season ranked No. 6 after winning the NCAA East Regional and was regularly ranked in the top four throughout the season.

### RECORDS FALLING

Carolina hopes to repeat its record-breaking 2014-15 season, which saw it finish with the second-lowest team scoring average in program history. Junior Katelyn Dambaugh, along with departing-senior Mary Fran Hillow, set the new low-18 school record last season with rounds of 65. Dambaugh's 65 at the SEC Championship matched the SEC Championship record. She matched her career-best 65 at the 2015 ANNIKA Invitational and is currently on pace to break the school's career scoring average record with a mark of 73.43. Senior Sarah Schmelzel (74.52) also sits in the top five on South Carolina's career scoring average list. Her 54-hole score of 210 at the 2015 ANNIKA Invitational ranks sixth on the school's all-time list.

### WHO'S BACK

Three of the five golfers from the Gamecocks' core lineup in 2014-15, including junior Jia Xin Yang and two-time All-SEC honoree junior Katelyn Dambaugh, return. Senior Sarah Schmelzel, an SEC All-Freshman selection in 2012-13, is back as well along with sophomore Anhwa Olarra, who played in five tournaments as a freshman. Every returning player has been in the Gamecock lineup prior to 2015-16.

### SUMMER SUCCESS

A pair of Gamecocks participated in the 113th Women's North & South Amateur Championship this July. Senior Sarah Schmelzel and junior Katelyn Dambaugh represented South Carolina at the event where nine of the last 12 winners have gone on to draw paychecks as members of the LPGA Tour. Schmelzel finished +18 after three days of stoke play, one stroke away from qualifying for match play. Dambaugh advanced to the semifinals of the tournament before falling (3 and 2). She finished her week at Pineburst No. 2 course with two match-play victories and medalist honors after posting the championship's top stroke play score (+8). Her 2-under (68) in the third round of stroke play marked the field's only round under par during stroke play.

### UP NEXT FOR THE GAMECOCKS

South Carolina continues the fall season at the 14th annual Landfall Tradition, in Wilmington, N.C. The event, hosted by UNC Wilmington, takes place Fri., Oct. 23 - Sun., Oct. 25, at the Country Club of Landfall Dye Course. Eighteen teams are set to compete and include South Carolina, UNCW, North Carolina, NC State, Wake Forest, Virginia, Michigan State, Ohio State, Penn State, Purdue, Notre Dame, Alabama, Clemson, Oklahoma State, Central Florida, Kentucky and Elon. The Gamecocks finished in a tie for third in last year's event.

### Gaby Amos (Fr., Gainesville, Fla.)

**Prior to South Carolina:** Played for Buchholz High School in Gainesville, Fla...led Buchholz to four straight state tournaments...helped team qualify for state her senior year by firing a team-low 76 in the Region 1-3A golf tournament...placed fourth at 2014 Class 3A state tournament where she shot a 2-under 70 on the second day - the second-best round of the tournament...earned top-five finish at the Gainesville Junior Challenge...placed 44th of 229 at TaylorMade-adidas Golf Junior at Innisbrook this April...named the 2014 Women's Golfer of the Year by *The Gainesville Sun* after her senior year...as a junior, named to *The Gainesville Sun's* All-Area Golf First Team...finished with a 4.452 GPA at Buchholz.

**Head coach Kalen Harris on Amos:** "I'm thrilled to have Gaby representing the Gamecocks. She has an exceptional attitude, and has shown great improvement in the first month here. Gaby will do all of the things necessary to be successful, and I am eager and excited to watch her fast progression."

### Isidora Nilsson (Fr., Hilton Head, S.C.)

**Prior to South Carolina:** A native of Chile, attended Hilton Head Preparatory School in Hilton Head, S.C., and was a student at the Junior Players Golf Academy in Hilton Head...represented Chile in the South American Amateur and Junior Orange Bowl in 2013 and is currently a member of the Chilean National Team...finished 13th at the Junior Orange Bowl with rounds of 72-73-75-77...represented Chile in the 2013 Copa Los Andes in Bogota, Columbia...won the IJGT Invitational at Harbor Town and the IJGT Georgia Open...finished second at the Optimist International Tournament of Champions...owns a scoring average of 73.71 to rank 23rd in the 2015 graduate class...holds a career-low round of 68 with a best two-day tournament total of 138 (-6) on a pair of 69s...the 2012 Player of the Year on the Hurricane Junior Golf Tour.

**Head coach Kalen Harris on Nilsson:** "Isi is going to step right into our lineup. She is a very consistent ball striker and a fierce competitor. I think Isi will be an important contributor in our lineup and will only continue to get better."
