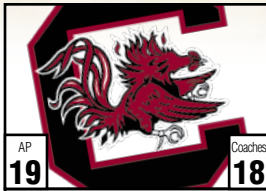

South Carolina Notables

- This is the Gamecocks' 39th season as a varsity sport, the fifth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm.
- The last four meetings between the Gamecocks and Gators have each been decided by five points or less with the teams splitting the four outcomes. Florida scored a three-point victory in 2010 and a two-point win in 2011. South Carolina responded with five-point and four-point wins to sweep the home-and-home series last season.
- The Gamecock defense has held 13 of its 18 opponents to less than 60 points, including each of the last four SEC foes, to rank third in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 47.8 points per game. South Carolina has allowed just more than 60 points just once this season.
- Senior guard Ieasia Walker scored her 1,000th career point as part of her 24-point outing against LSU (Jan. 17). She is the 28th member of that club and just the 12th to also compile at least 200 career steals. She is sixth all-time in career steals with 216, thanks to a five-swipe effort against the Lady Tigers.
- Sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch and senior guard Ieasia Walker have provided the ideal inside-outside threat combination over the last four games, during which South Carolina is 3-1. The pair of combined to score 49.1 percent of the team's 230 points during the stretch, averaging 15.5 and 14.3 points, respectively. Both rank among the SEC's top 25 scorers in league games – Welch 16th at 13.6 ppg and Walker 24th with 12.2 ppg.
- Senior forward Ashley Bruner is one of 26 Gamecocks to amass 500 career rebounds and has a chance to become just the 18th to record at least 600, needing 32 to achieve that plateau.

A South Carolina Win Would...

- Make the Gamecocks 4-2 in SEC play for the first time in five seasons under head coach Dawn Staley and the first time since the 2001-02 team opened league play at 5-1.
- Be the Gamecocks' third straight over Florida after last season's two-game sweep of the Gators.

By the Numbers

- Gamecocks averaging double-figure points this season – Aleighsa Welch (12.7) and Tiffany Mitchell (10.6)
- Gamecocks that rank among the SEC's top 20 in rebounding – Aleighsa Welch (8.3, 7th), Ashley Bruner (7.3, 10th) and Tiffany Mitchell (6.2, 18th)
- Gamecocks to score in double figures against LSU (Ieasia Walker 24, Aleighsa Welch 14, Ashley Bruner 13, Tiffany Mitchell 12) – just the third time this season and the first in SEC action that has happened

The Florida Series

The Gators lead the series 20-10, but the Gamecocks snapped a five-game skid to Florida by sweeping both games of the series last season. Both games went down to the wire, but South Carolina followed a nail-biting 49-44 win in Gainesville (Jan. 8) with a 62-58 victory at Colonial Life Arena (Feb. 12).

South Carolina is 6-8 all-time against Florida in Gainesville.

Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

With a complementary blend of youth and experience, South Carolina opened a season 10-0 for the first time since the 1981-82 team also won its first 10 contests. The Gamecocks, now 15-3, have shown they have both inside and outside offensive options and are dominant on the glass this season while the defense has dropped off very little from last season's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 effort. Two Gamecocks average double-figure points with three others netting 5.5 or more per game. South Carolina ranks eighth in the nation with a +11.2 rebounding margin and has three players ranked among the SEC's top 20 rebounders. Defensively, the Gamecocks are third in the nation in scoring defense, yielding just 47.8 points per game. South Carolina has held 13 of its 18 opponents this season under 50 points and limited six of the 18 to under 30 percent field goal shooting, including Hampton (Nov. 22), which hit just 19.3 percent (11-57) from the field for the second-lowest opponent field goal percentage of the Staley era, and Vanderbilt (Jan. 10), which shot just 26.5 percent after coming into the game with the SEC's second-highest field goal accuracy at 45.2.

Road Warriors

The Gamecocks are 191-232 (.452) all-time in games on enemy territory, including a 16-27 (.372) mark under head coach Dawn Staley.

Judging January

South Carolina is 180-179 (.501) all-time in the month of January, including a 19-21 (.475) record under fifth-year head coach Dawn Staley. The Gamecocks are 106-75 (.586) in home games during the first month of the calendar year, including a 30-55 (.352) mark at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 61-96 (.389) in January road games and 4-0 at neutral sites during the month.

Life in the League

South Carolina is 94-194 (.326) all-time in its 22nd season of SEC regular-season play. The Gamecocks are 61-84 (.421) in SEC games played in Columbia with a 33-110 record (.231) on the road. Under head coach Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks have a 30-37 (.448) SEC record, which includes a 2-12 slate in her first season at the helm. The program's 27 SEC regular-season victories in Staley's first four seasons are the best four-year mark for the program in more than a decade.

Last season's 10 wins matched the 2001-02 team for the best since joining the league for the 1991-92 season.

It was just the third time in its 21 seasons in the league that South Carolina posted at least nine conference wins. In fact, the Gamecocks have only won seven or more league games six times in their 21 seasons with three of those coming under Staley.

Overall, Staley boasts a 129-62 (.675) record in league play, including eight seasons leading her Temple teams to a 99-25 (.798) Atlantic 10 mark.

Rendering the RPI

With a 15-3 record, including six wins away from home, the Gamecocks are 24th in the NCAA RPI released this week. South Carolina is one of seven SEC schools rated among the top 40 with four others coming inside the top 85.

The Gamecocks' strength of schedule ranks in the top 30 and will continue to build over the course of the season. The Gamecocks are slated to play five teams currently ranked in the top 25 – then-No. 1/1 Stanford (Dec. 19), then-No. 12/13 Tennessee, at then-No. 13/12 Georgia (Jan. 13), home and away against No. 5/5 Kentucky (Jan. 24/ Feb. 14) and No. 20/20 Texas A&M.

Reading the Rankings

South Carolina is ranked in both national polls for the sixth-straight week. The Gamecocks dropped to No. 19 in the Associated Press Poll this week after cracking into that poll at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10. South Carolina climbed as high as No. 18 in the poll this season, the program's highest ranking since the end of the 2002-03 season. Five for Fighting

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has used the same starting lineup in every game this season, and the quintet led the way to the program's best non-conference record since 2001-02. Starters – Ieasia Walker, Sancheon White, Tiffany Mitchell, Ashley Bruner and Aleighsa Welch – account for 77.0 percent of the offense and 69.4 percent of rebounds while playing 71.7 percent of the minutes available. Each of the five averages at least 5.6 points, more than any Gamecock off the bench. Still, the four reserves available have out-scored their counterparts on the opposite bench 10 times this season, during which the Gamecocks are 9-1.

Demanding Defense

The hallmark of the Gamecocks under head coach Dawn Staley has always been defense, and this season's team is no different. Through games of Jan. 17, South Carolina's defense ranks third in the nation in points allowed per game (47.8), trailing just Connecticut (46.6) and Green Bay (47.1). The Gamecocks have allowed just one opponent

to score more than 60 points this season (Tennessee, Jan. 3) and have held 13 to 48 or fewer.

One of the more interesting facets of the Gamecocks' stifling defense is that it has not necessarily held opponents to a sub-par shooting percentage. Through Staley's tenure, opponents have shot 39.8 percent from the field (3,090-7,760). The defensive success has come from limiting opponent shot attempts entirely, especially from the 3-point line. South Carolina has attempted more total shots than its opponents every season except Staley's first (2008-09). Opponents have attempted more 3s than the Gamecocks just once as well (2009-10).

As the difference in shot attempts has increased over the course of the Staley era, so has the team's win totals, culminating in last season's 25-10 record, the program's best in more than a decade, and this season's 15-3 start.

Going Glass

Looking at South Carolina's roster of seven guards and four forwards/centers, the casual observer might think that rebounding would not be the Gamecocks' bailiwick, but South Carolina out-rebounded its opponent in all but one game (Stanford) this season, including four by more than 20 or more and six others by at least 10. The team effort has the Gamecocks ranked eighth in the nation in rebound margin at +11.2.

While rebounding is a team focus, this season has seen a surge in individual performances. In 2011-12, a Gamecock posted double-figure rebounds just seven times over 35 games. Through 18 games this season, South Carolina has amassed 16 double-digit rebound efforts, including seven from sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch. Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 20 rebounders - Aleighsa Welch (7th), Ashley Bruner (10th) and Tiffany Mitchell (18th).

Posts Up – Spurs Up

Forwards Aleighsa Welch and Ashley Bruner have been an integral part in the team's 15-3 start this season, averaging 12.7 and 9.2 points, respectively. Welch is shooting a team-best 66.7 percent from the field on the season and leads the SEC in field goal percentage in league games at 63.4.

The duo are among the league's top 10 rebounders with Welch ranking seventh at 8.3 per game and Bruner coming in 10th at 7.3. Both are especially proficient on the offensive glass, ranking first and seventh, respectively, in the league. More than half of Welch's 149 total rebounds have come on the offensive end (76), while 43.2 percent of Bruner's 132 have come on a Gamecock miss.

Walkin' on Sunshine

Senior guard Ieasia Walker has shown tremendous leadership in guiding this season's team that includes four newcomers among its nine active players to a 15-3 record. Walker showed patience through the non-conference season, stepping out of the spotlight to allow her younger teammates to find their way on offense while still providing dominant defense borne of quick hands and lightning fast reflexes.

In SEC play, however, Walker as re-asserted herself offensively raising her overall scoring average by an entire point over the last five games. With a 12.2 scoring average in league play, which ranks among the 25 best in the SEC, she has poured in 14.3 points per game over the last four outings. Walker turned up the scoring while still contributing 2.3 assists and 3.8 steals per game over the stretch.

Twice as Nice

South Carolina's Aleighsa Welch earned a spot on the 2012 SEC All-Freshman Team despite lacking a key resume bullet for forwards – a double-double. The sophomore has made up for last season's missing ingredient by amassing six through the team's first 18 games this season. After narrowly missing the mark in the season opener, Welch picked up her first career double-double two games later with a 13-point, 12-rebound effort against Savannah State (Nov. 15). She added two more at the Paradise Jam against Hampton (Nov. 22) and Florida Gulf Coast (Nov. 24) and tacked on her fourth against Drexel (Nov. 28). She made it four in five games with a 14-point/10-rebound effort at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Welch continued her balanced dominance with a 16-point, 14-rebound effort against SC State just before the holiday break.

Welch leads the team with seven double-digit rebound games this season and also paces the Gamecocks in double-figure scoring outings with 13.

Movin' On Up

South Carolina seniors Ashley Bruner and Ieasia Walker have made the most of their time in the Garnet and Black, posting and heading toward significant milestones while moving up the all-time leaderboards in several categories.

Bruner made the first move by becoming just the 26th Gamecock to pull down at least 500 career rebounds, hitting the mark as part of her seven-rebound outing at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Currently 25th on the total rebounding list with 566, she can move into the top 20 with 22 more boards, which would tie her for the 20th spot with Ilona Burgrova (2005-08). With 34 more rebounds this season, Bruner will join just 17 other Gamecocks to reach 600 career boards.

Walker joined the 1,000-point club 18 points into her 24-point performance against LSU (Jan. 17) at Carolina Coliseum. She is just the 28th Gamecock to reach the plateau and is one of just 12 in the group to pair the milestone with at least 200 career steals. Walker hit that mark with five against Western Carolina (Dec. 29). She moved into the program's top 10 in that category on the same night she scored her 1,000th point, swiping five steals from the Lady Tigers to get to 216 and climb into sixth place in school history. She needs 11 more to tie Cristina Ciocan (2000-04) in fifth place.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina's captains for this season are seniors Ieasia Walker and Ashley Bruner along with sophomore Aleighsa Welch.

Working Overtime

After Wednesday's 58-55 win over Drexel, South Carolina is 16-14 all-time in overtime games, including a 1-3 mark in double-overtime contests. Since taking the reins for the 2008-09 season, Gamecock head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 5-3 record in extended games. South Carolina played a school-record four overtime games in 2010-11, going 2-2, and in 1995-96, going 1-3.

Preseason Predictions

South Carolina was picked by both the media and league's coaches to finish in the middle of the 14-team pack in the Southeastern Conference. The media predicted the Gamecocks would take seventh place, while the coaches slotted South Carolina into sixth.

Senior guard Ieasia Walker drew preseason second-team all-conference honors from both groups. She is the team's lone returning starter and the highest returning scorer from last year's squad. Her 7.9 points per game came with 3.2 assists per outing, which combined to earn her Second-Team All-SEC honors for the second-straight year.

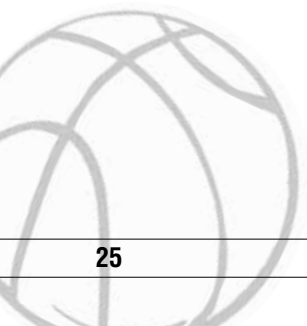
