#### South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball and the program's 24th in the SEC.
- South Carolina is in its seventh season under head coach Dawn Staley, during which the Gamecocks have gone 124-71. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16.
- All five starters from last season's NCAA Sweet 16 squad return for 2014-15 as well as the bench's top scorer and rebounder in Alaina Coates.
- The Gamecocks have won at least 25 games in each of the last three seasons, the longest stint in school history.
- This week's No. 1 ranking by the Associated Press is the first in program history.
- The Gamecocks have put three different starting lineups on the floor in as many games this season.
- In the last two games, South Carolina's bench has scored more than the opponent's complete team vs. Clemson 45-41, vs. San Diego State 53-38.
- With four Gamecocks standing at least 6-foot-4, South Carolina has scored 45.7 percent of its points in the paint – 118 of 258. Meanwhile, the Gamecocks are seventh in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 44.9 from outside the arc.
- South Carolina has assisted on 69.1 percent of its field goals so far this season, including tying the Staley-era record of 25 assists in each of the last two games. The Gamecocks' 21.7 assists per game are ninth in the nation.
- Defense is still a focal point for the Gamecocks, not allowing more than 61 points in a game this season to rank ninth in the nation in scoring defense (46.7 ppg). In fact, in the last four seasons, South Carolina has yielded 70 or more points just seven times in 105 outings. An opponent has failed to cross the 60-point barrier in 77 of the 105 contests beginning with the 2010-11 season.
- Junior Tiffany Mitchell and forward Aleighsa Welch were named to both the Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 and the Wade Watch List. South Carolina is one of four programs with two entries on both lists.

#### **Wisconsin Series Notes**

The Gamecocks and Badgers have never met in women's basketball, but Wisconsin is just one of two Big Ten Conference schools they have never played (Northwestern).

South Carolina is 21-17 all-time against the 12 other members of the Big Ten Conference. The Gamecocks have faced Penn State more than any of the other Big Ten teams with a 4-6 record against the Lady Lions. South Carolina's most recent Big Ten matchup came in the second round of the 2012 NCAA Tournament when a 72-61 win at then-No. 13 Purdue put the Gamecocks into the Sweet 16.

#### **Offshore Outings**

South Carolina is 10-6 all-time in six regularseason tournaments played outside of the contiguous United States. Under head coach Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks are 6-2 in such events, including a pair of titles in the three tournaments.

Staley's team swept three games in the 2012 Paradise Jam last season to win the Reef Division of that event. In her first season at South Carolina, she led her team to the title at the Cancun Thanksgiving Classic.

#### **Poll Presence**

This week's rankings extended South Carolina's string of Associated Press top-10 appearances to 14, the longest in program history. The previous high was 13 weeks from Jan. 22, 1980 through Dec. 16, 1980.

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was the program's first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history -Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982;

The Gamecocks opened this season with their highest preseason ranking from the organization, coming in at No. 2 to best the previous high of No. 4 heading into the 1981-82 season.

#### **Trademark TM**

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell made her name last season for her versatility – the only player to appear in the rankings for scoring, rebounding, assists and steals in SEC action. The one element of her game that she had not exploited during that All-America campaign was her 3-point shooting, unleashing that weapon judiciously, attempting just 2.2 per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

If the first three games of the season are any indication, opponents should be prepared to play the attacking guard a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is shooting 69.2 percent (9-of-13) from 3-point range – seventh in the nation – with long-range shots accounting for half of her total attempts. Her 6-of-6 effort from 3 against San Diego State (Nov. 23) was the best perfect game in program history.

#### E-I, E-I, No

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge for the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently tied for fifth with 133 in her career, matching Ilona Burgrova's (2005-08) total. Next on the list is Demetress Adams (2006-09) with 140, and the career record of 177 set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07) is also well within reach.

#### Welch Watch

Already second in school history in career offensive rebounds (350), senior forward Aleighsa Welch looks to mount an attack on other parts of the Gamecock record book before closing out her career.

#### **Power of Three**

Prior to the season, espnW ranked the top 25 college players in the nation, and a trio of Gamecocks made the list. Reigning SEC Player of the Year Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed No. 4 in the nation because "[her] greatest strength is that she doesn't really have a weakness. Shooting, penetrating, distributing, rebounding, defending and leading from her point guard spot are all part of Mitchell's resume," according to Charlie Creme. Two-time All-SEC selection Aleighsa Welch came in on the No. 7 spot for her ability to "come up with the big basket or the big rebound when the Gamecocks need it most," per Michelle Smith. 2014 SEC Freshman of the Year Alaina Coates captured the No. 25 position after a season in which she was "just scratching the surface of her potential...she could be unstoppable inside, even without a large repertoire of moves," per Mechelle Voepel.

#### Back in (Garnet and) Black

A huge reason the this season's lofty expectations is the return of all five starters among the 10 returning letterwinners. The Gamecocks return 97.6 percent of their scoring, 96.0 percent of their rebounding, 98.4 percent of their assists and 97.1 percent of their school-record shot blocking from last season's top-10 squad. Nine of the 10 returners played in at least 29 of the team's 34 games last season and contributed at least 2.0 points per game.

#### **Elite Additions**

The Gamecocks added the nation's No. 2 signing class to their core of returning letterwinners. Four of the five signees will take the court for the Gamecocks this season, led by No. 1 A'ja Wilson and No. 7 Jatarie White. Two other top-35 signees – Bianca Cuevas, Kaydra Duckett – round out the group that will contribute this season.

#### **SEC Title Talk**

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

#### **Rare Company**

As just the second sophomore ever to earn SEC Player of the Year honors from the league's coaches last season, junior Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed by the SEC coaches and media to claim the award again this season. If that prediction comes true, Mitchell would become just the seventh player to pick up the award twice in her career, joining South Carolina assistant coach Nikki McCray (1994, 1995) among others.

South Carolina's other player of the year candidate last season, Aleighsa Welch also received

#### **Ticket Boom**

After updating the Colonial Life Arena attendance top-10 list five times last season, South Carolina ranked 10th in the nation in average attendance (6,371) last season. The athletics department responded to the demand by expanding the number of reserved-seat sections available to fans. The response was so overwhelming that the sections expanded again in late October. In all, the Gamecocks have over 7,600 season-ticket holders, a significant increase from last season's 4,213.

#### Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

#### Clinev to Miss 2014-15 Season

South Carolina announced in September that the NCAA approved an initial eligibility waiver for freshman Doniyah Cliney, which allowed her to enroll in school but not compete for the Gamecocks in the 2014-15 season. The guard will focus on academics in the fall semester with an opportunity to begin practicing with the team beginning in the spring semester.

Cliney was ranked the 13th-best guard in the 2014 class and helped Malcolm X Shabazz to state titles in her final two seasons. The honorable mention all-state selection averaged 13.4 points, 3.3 assists and 5.2 rebounds as a senior. She shot 48 percent from the field, including 39 percent from 3-point range.

#### Class of 2015 Signee

Head coach Dawn Staley added one future Gamecock during the early signing period. Canada's Shay Colley signed her NLI with South Carolina on Nov. 18 and will have four years of eligibility upon enrollment.

Colley is a three-year standout for Team Canada in junior international play, representing her country in the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (silver), the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship (7th) and the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship (bronze).

# DAWN STALEY

# 7th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 296-151 record, including her 124-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14.Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
