## South Carolina Notables

- South Carolina has won six SEC games for just the eighth time in its 21 years in the league. Three of those eight times have been under head coach Dawn Staley. The most SEC games the Gamecocks have ever won is 10 in 2001-02.
- South Carolina's defense, rated second in the nation in points allowed (47.5), has held an opponent to 48 or fewer points 11 times this season, including four SEC foes – Alabama (42), Florida (44), Ole Miss (43) and Mississippi State (43). The 11 games ties the school-record mark of the 2005-06 team.
- South Carolina has had a huge scoring boon in its current three-game win streak as the Gamecocks averaged 65.0 points over stretch. The key has been efficiency of offense. South Carolina has shot 41.1 percent from the field, including 36.7 percent from 3-point range, in the last three games after entering the Vanderbilt game shooting 36.5 percent overall and 25.9 percent from long range in SEC action. The Gamecocks were scoring just 56.2 points per game in league play prior to the start of this streak.
- While turning the high-scoring duties over to her hot-shooting backcourt mates the last three games, junior Ieasia Walker has averaged 5.3 assists and 5.0 rebounds over the stretch. That rebound average is second-best on the team, and her career-high seven assists against Ole Miss moved her into the team lead in assists both overall (3.0) and per SEC outing (3.3).

## A South Carolina Win Would...

- Be the Gamecocks' fourth straight in SEC play, making it the program's longest league win streak since the 2005-06 team picked up four straight Feb. 12-23, 2006.
- Give the Gamecocks an 18-5 record on the season, the program's best since the 2001-02 team was 20-3 en route a spot in the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight.
- Be the Gamecocks' seventh SEC win of the season, making it the third time in four seasons under head coach Dawn Staley the Gamecocks have reached that mark after the program had won seven or more league games just three times in the 17 seasons prior to her arrival.

## Last Time Out

Senior guards La'Keisha Sutton and Markeshia Grant led the offense for the second-straight game, pacing the Gamecocks to a 59-43 victory over Mississippi State on Sunday afternoon. South Carolina's defense and defensive rebounding kept the Lady Bulldogs on their heels, especially in the second half when the Gamecocks 16 defensive boards into 13 fast break points. South Carolina shot a season-high 49.1 percent from the field while allowing Mississippi State to hit just 30.6 percent.

Of the current Gamecocks, junior guard Ieasia Walker has had the most scoring success against the Lady Vols, scoring 12.0 points per game over her four career outings versus Tennessee while also swiping 1.8 steals per contest. She led the team with 24 points and eight rebounds, including six on the offensive end, in last year's matchup in Columbia. Walker posted 16 points and a seven rebounds, both team highs, along with three steals in the last game in Knoxville.

### Road Warriors

South Carolina has a 185-233 (.443) all-time record on the road. The Gamecocks' best season on the road was 1979-80 when they went 11-4. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 16-24 in road games. In her 11th season as a head coach, Staley has a 78-70 road record.

The Gamecocks are 6-3 on the road so far this season, making it the first season South Carolina has won more than five true road games since the 1990-91 squad went 6-4.

### Life in the League

South Carolina is 87-189 all-time in its 21st season SEC regular-season play. The Gamecocks are 57-82 in SEC games played in Columbia with a 30-107 record on the road. The Gamecocks are 21-20 in conference play since head coach Dawn Staley's first season in the league yielded a 2-12 mark. The most SEC wins in the Staley era was last season's eight. Overall, Staley boasts a 122-57 record in league play, including eight seasons leading her Temple teams to a 99-25 Atlantic 10 mark.

### Figuring Out February

The Gamecocks are 176-136 (.564) all-time in the month of February, including a 100-38 (.725) record at home. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 8-13 in the second month of the year. The Gamecocks went 1-5 in Staley's first year at the helm (2008-09), were 3-5 in 2009-10 and posted a 4-3 record last season. The Gamecocks seven games slated for this February.

### Rating the Ranked

South Carolina is 53-190 against nationally ranked teams in its 38th season of women's basketball. The Gamecocks have collected 29 of those 52 wins in Columbia, including 11 in Colonial Life Arena.

The Gamecocks are 16-100 all-time against teams ranked in the AP top 10 with their last win over a top-10 team coming in a 71-52 decision over then-No. 6 Vanderbilt on Jan. 3, 2002, in Columbia. South Carolina was ranked No. 14 in the nation at the time.

The highest ranked team the Gamecocks have defeated in the Dawn Staley era was then-No. 14 Georgia on Feb. 25, 2010, when South Carolina left Athens with a 52-42 victory. In its basketball history, South Carolina's highest-ranked victim was a No. 3-ranked foe, and there are two of those victories, both over Auburn. The first came by a 83-76 score at home on Dec. 29, 1990. The second was a 59-47 decision over the Tigers on Feb. 27, 1993 in the final home game of the season.

In the last three seasons South Carolina has defeated a nationally ranked team eight times in 25 outings, including this year's 3-2 record.

### Yin-Yang of 3-Point Land

Head coach Dawn Staley is fond of theorizing that the thing a team does best is also the thing it does not handle well. The inverse seems to be true for the Gamecocks when it comes to 3-point shooting this season. The Gamecocks currently lead the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to hit just 20.1 percent from the arc, but they are last in the SEC in 3-point shooting, hitting just 26.2 percent from long range.

The dichotomous relationship with the arc has not hindered South Carolina's success as its strength has overcome its weakness. The Gamecocks are 13-3 this season when making more 3-pointers than their opponent. They have shot more accurately than their opponent 14 times in 22 games this season, coming out with a 11-3 record in those outings.

## Bringing the Defense

The South Carolina defense ranks second in the nation in points allowed per game (47.5) behind just Connecticut (45.1). The Gamecocks have allowed more than 55 points just five times in 22 games this season – at Vanderbilt 60 in overtime (Jan. 22), Kentucky 66 (Jan. 15), LSU 58 (Jan. 12), Drexel 58 (Dec. 28), Xavier 56 (Nov. 30) and have held 11 opponents to 48 or fewer points.

Under head coach Dawn Staley, stingy defense has been a staple of the Gamecock game plan. South Carolina has allowed just 59.3 points per game on Staley's watch, including a 47.5 average this season and a 59.6 mark in 2010-11. In the last two seasons, the Gamecocks held their opponent to 55 or fewer points in a game 31 times, including 16 of 22 games this season. In the 112 games with Staley at the helm, South Carolina has held an opponent to 55 points or fewer 39 times. In that same period, an opponent has netted 70 or more points in a game just 26 times.

## How Do They Go So Low?

One of the more interesting facets of the Gamecocks' stifling defense is that they have not necessarily held opponents to a sub-par shooting percentage. Through Staley's tenure, opponents have shot 40.8 percent from the field. South Carolina has shot 39.3 percent during that time with the Gamecocks' season field goal percentage exceeding that of its opponents just once (2009-10).

The defensive success comes from limiting opponent shot attempts entirely as South Carolina has put up more shots than its opponents every season except Staley's first (2008-09). This season alone, the Gamecocks have taken 9.7 more shots per game than their opponents. South Carolina has had fewer shot attempts than its opponent just twice this season – Kentucky (Jan. 15) and Mississippi State (Jan. 29).

## Good Hands

South Carolina is ranked 20th in the country and third in the SEC with a +5.3 turnover margin. The trio of experienced guards have helped the Gamecocks on both sides of the turnover margin. The Gamecocks have forced 20 or more turnovers in 11 of their 22 games this season while committing 20 or more turnovers only three times (29 vs. Kentucky, Jan. 15; 25 at LSU, Jan. 12; 22 vs. College of Charleston, Nov. 23). The Gamecocks are 30th in the country in fewest turnovers per game with 14.6,

the lowest average for the program since the 1983-84 team set the school record of 8.2.

## Tough to Scout

Throughout the preseason, head coach Dawn Staley talked about the versatility of her team as a key to the season's success. While she may have been speaking more about the various ways individual players could score, it has been the Gamecocks' ability to get points from various locations that has delivered the program's best opening record since Staley arrived in Columbia. Seven different players have led the team in scoring – Markeshia Grant, Ieasia Walker, Aleighsa Welch, Ashley Bruner, Tina Roy, La'Keisha Sutton and Charenee Stephens. In all, eight different Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once this season.

## Triple Play

Coming into the season, may observers felt the fate of the Gamecocks' season rested largely in the hands of its experienced backcourt – seniors Markeshia Grant and La'Keisha Sutton and junior Ieasia Walker. That has certainly been the case as between its points and assists, the trio has contributed to 61.9 percent of the team's 61.5 points per game.

Grant is leading the trio in scoring with her team-high 10.3 points per game, which ranks 24th in the SEC. Sutton is just behind with 9.9 points per game (25th) to go with her 3.0 assists per game, which is 12th in the league. Walker leads the defensive effort, ranking sixth in the SEC with 2.3 steals per game and has come on strong in recent games to lead the assist category as well, leaping into 11th in the league with 3.0 assists per game. She is seventh with a 1.2 assist-

## On the Horizon

Head coach Dawn Staley inked four players in the early signing period. Below is a brief look at each of the future Gamecocks.

- **Tiffany Davis** (Houston, Texas/Westbury Christian) is a 5-foot-8 point guard rated the 29th in the 2012 class at that position. Before transferring to Westbury Christian, she helped Westside High to the 2011 District 20-5A championship game. Davis earned all-region and first-team all-district honors as a junior, netting 16.0 points per game.
- **Asia Dozier** (Columbia, S.C./Spring Valley) is a 5-foot-11 guard who helped Spring Valley to state championships in 2009 and 2011. Rated the 34th-best guard in the 2012 class and a four-star player by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*, Dozier averaged 17.1 ppg and 3.8 apg as a junior as the Lady Vikings went 29-0. As a freshman, her 18.3 ppg and 3.8 apg earned her Class 4A Area Player of the Year honors from *The State* newspaper. Her father, Perry, and uncle Terry Dozier also played basketball for the Gamecocks.
- **Tiffany Mitchell** (Charlotte, N.C./Providence Day) is a 5-foot-10 guard who is rated among the top 50 players in the 2012 class by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*. She earned South Charlotte player of the year honors and was an *Associated Press* All-State selection after averaging 18.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 4.2 steals and 3.9 assists as a junior. She guided the Chargers to 21 straight wins in 2010-11, including the program's second-straight NCISAA state title.
- **Khadijah Sessions** (Myrtle Beach, S.C./Myrtle Beach) is a 5-foot-6 point guard rated the seventh-best in the class at her position by *ESPN Hoop/Gurlz*. The 40th-ranked player overall, she averaged 17.9 points and 5.7 assists as a junior while leading the Seahawks to their second-straight AAA state championship. A member of the all-state team, Sessions also captured all-region honors last season.

## Not So Fast

While the backcourt got all the attention leading into the season, the frontcourt has made significant contributions to the team's success as well.

The unanticipated spark of the season has been freshman forward Aleighsa Welch. Surprising head coach Dawn Staley with her consistent play and ability to absorb and apply every teaching point, the six-foot Goose Creek, S.C., product is third on the team with 8.7 points per game and leads the club in rebounding at 6.1 per contest, which ranks her 13th in the SEC. Her 60.0 percent field goal accuracy is second in the league as well. Welch's point (9.7 ppg) and rebound (6.3 rpg) numbers are slightly higher in SEC action.

While Welch has been the more recent catalyst in the frontcourt, junior Ashley Bruner had a significant hand in much of the season's early success as she spent most of the season's first month as the team's top scorer and rebounder and continues to provide solid support numbers. She accounts for 7.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per game.

## Helping Hand

With arguably the best point guard in international women's basketball history at the helm, South Carolina has been at its best when its assist numbers are highest. In the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 through present), the Gamecocks are 45-16 when handing out 10 or more assists, including a 13-1 mark this season. When missing the 10-assist plateau, South Carolina is just 15-38 overall with Staley, including a 5-23 mark in SEC action. That overall record includes this season's 4-4 ledger.

## Defense Is the Difference

How solid is the South Carolina defense this season? Just look at its performances against four of the nation's top 25 offenses.

Most recently, the Gamecocks took on the seventh-highest scoring team in the nation in then-#9/8 Kentucky (Jan. 15). South Carolina limited the high-flying Wildcat offense 15 points below its season average, allowing just 66 points when UK came in averaging 81.1 per game.

The Gamecocks limited Vanderbilt (Jan. 5) to just 55 points after the Commodores entered the game ranked ninth in the country with 80.0 points per game. South Carolina crippled the nation's top 3-point shooting team, which entered the game shooting 43.8 percent from the arc and making 6.5 3-pointers per game, allowing Vanderbilt to take just six 3-pointers in the game, making one of them. In the second meeting between the two teams, the Gamecocks were just as effective, yielding just 60 points in their overtime victory and allowing the Commodores to shoot just 17.6 percent (3-of-17) from 3-point range.

Entering its Dec. 18 game against the Gamecocks, North Carolina led the nation in scoring, pouring in 87.5 points per game. South Carolina allowed the Tar Heels just 54.9 percent of that average – 48 points – the lowest scoring output for the Tar Heels since Connecticut held them to 47 points on Jan. 9, 2010. Even with that limited offense against the Gamecocks, North Carolina still ranks among the nation's top 10 in scoring offense.

The first evidence of the stingy South Carolina defense came early in the season when the Gamecocks allowed Penn State, which is currently ranked 12th in the nation in scoring offense, just 55 points on Nov. 20. The Lady Lions have not scored lower than 65 points in any other game this season and have topped out at 103 in three games.

## Locking It Down

South Carolina has held an opponent to 48 or fewer points 11 times this season, the most since the 2005-06 squad also limited its foes to that number a school-record 11 times. South Carolina has never lost a game when holding an opponent to 48 or fewer points, which it has done in a total of 111 games (two games in the 1980-81 season were later forfeited).

## Making a Name for Herself

In December, senior guard La'Keisha Sutton etched her names among the top guards in South Carolina women's basketball history. Handing out her 300th career assist against Drexel (Dec. 28) and scoring her 1,000th career point against South Carolina State (Dec. 14), making her just the 11th Gamecock to achieve both milestones in her career. The last to hit both marks was Cristina Ciocan in 2003-04.

Sutton's 1,000th career point game just 8:40 into the 100th game of her career on a trademark drive through the lane. Her effort against South Carolina State, which ended with 12 points, made her just the 27th player in school history to score at least 1,000 points. She also became the 48th player to play in

100 career games in that outing. Her 300th assist came just in time for the Gamecocks to hold off a late rally by Drexel. After driving the lane, Sutton found Ashley Bruner on the right block for a bucket that ended a four-minute scoring drought for the Gamecocks.
