#### **Gamecocks Travel to SEC/Pac-12 Challenge**

The South Carolina women's golf team is set to tee off in the first round of the SEC/Pac-12 Challenge hosted by Tennessee on Friday, Oct. 21. The 54-hole tournament runs through Sunday at Holston Hills Country Club in Knoxville, Tenn. The course features a par-72, 6,447-yard layout.

#### This Week's Lineup

After experimenting with a different lineup at the Tar Heel Invitational, the Gamecocks are going back to their season-opening lineup for the SEC/Pac-12 Challenge. Senior Katie Burnett, juniors Meredith Swanson and Amanda Strang and sophomores Katie Rose Higgins and Samantha Swinehart will compete for Carolina during the weekend. Sophomore Suzie Lee will also tee it up as an individual.

Burnett has been Carolina's top finisher in both events this season, finishing tied for ninth in the Cougar Classic and tied for 21st in the Tar Heel Invitational. Her scoring average of 72 leads the team, followed by Swanson's stroke average of 72.67.

#### Last Time at the SEC/Pac-12 Challenge - 2010

South Carolina fought one of the toughest fields in women's college golf and treacherous playing conditions in the final round of the Pac-10/SEC Challenge, finishing 15th at the Stanford Golf Course. The Gamecocks shot 310 (+26) in the final round to finish at 912 (+60) for the week.

Katie Rose Higgins had the Gamecocks' best round of the day, shooting a 75 (+4) to end her fall season on a high note. She wrapped up her tournament in a tie for 63rd place.

Katie Burnett was the team's top finisher, but struggled in the final round with a 79 (+8), finishing with five pars and a tie for 47th place. Amanda Strang and Suzie Lee also both posted rounds of 79 to wrap up the week. Freshman Samantha Swinehart had her best round of the week, signing for a 77 (+6) that included a pair of birdies.

Fifth-ranked UCLA took the wire-to-wire victory, shooting a final-round 290 to finish at 856 (+4). No. 3 Alabama took runner-up honors at 867 (+15), and second-ranked Southern Cal finished in third place. The Trojans' Sophia Popov was the individual medalist at 207 (-6) with UCLA's Stephanie Kono in second and Auburn's Cydney Clanton taking third place.

#### **Breaking Down the Field**

This year's SEC/Pac-12 Challenge field is one of the strongest in all of college golf. The 23-team field features 14 nationally ranked squads, including seven of the top 10 in the country and No. 1 UCLA. In comparison, last year's NCAA

Championship field was made up of 24 teams, including 17 ranked squads. Ranked teams in this year's event are No. 1 UCLA, No. 2 Southern California, No. 3 LSU, No. 4 Alabama, No. 7 Arizona State, No. 9 Florida, No. 10 Georgia, No. 12 Arizona, No. 13 Arkansas, No. 14 Tennessee, No. 15 Vanderbilt, No. 16 Auburn, No. 18 California and No. 22 Stanford.

#### Tar Heel Invitational

The South Carolina women's golf team posted a final-round 294 (+6) to finish in 11th place at the Tar Heel Invitational at the UNC Finley Golf Course. The Gamecocks concluded the tournament with a three-day score of 882 (+18).

Junior Meredith Swanson bounced back from a 79 on Saturday to lead the way for South Carolina in the final round. Swanson carded an even-par 72 and finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).

Senior Katie Burnett claimed the highest finished for the Gamecocks despite a final-round 78 (+6) as she tied for 21st with a score of 219 (+3).

Sophomore Suzie Lee shaved four strokes off her second-round score to shoot 1-over 73 on Sunday. Lee's three-day score of 223 (+7) left her in a tie for 44th.

Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins carded her second-consecutive round of 74 (+2) to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 55th with a score of 225 (+9), while junior Amanda Strang recorded a 75 (+3) on Sunday to tie for 73rd with a 227 (+11)

Freshman Justine Dreher played the event as an individual and turned in a final-round 77 (+5). Dreher, whose round of 68 on Saturday was the lowest round ever by a South Carolina freshman, finished the tournament in a tie for 37th with a score of 222 (+6).

LSU claimed the team title with a three-day score of 856 (-8), followed by Alabama (860), Auburn (861), host North Carolina (862) and North Carolina State (869). Auburn's Marta Sanz fired a final-round 68 (-4) to win medalist honors by a stroke with a three-round total of 207 (-9).

#### Cougar Classic

South Carolina had three golfers post scores under par in the final round of the Cougar Classic on its way to setting the record for the lowest round in school history with a 279 (-9) at Yeamans Hall Club. The Gamecocks finished the tournament with a three-round total of 869 (+5) to claim 10th place in the 22-team field.

South Carolina's score of 279 broke the previous school record by three strokes, which was set in the second round of the 2002 Southeastern Conference Championship. It also tied for the second lowest round in Cougar Classic history. The Gamecocks' tournament total was the fourth best 54-hole total in program history.

Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins posted South Carolina's lowest score of the round with a career-best 67 (-5), tying Burnett and three former Gamecocks for the third lowest round in school history. Higgins' three-round total of 221 (+5) left her in a tie for 44th.

After posting a career-low 69 in the second round, South Carolina junior Meredith Swanson was at it again on Tuesday. Swanson fired the ninth-best round in Gamecock history with a 4-under 68. She finished the tournament in a tie for 12th with a three-day score of 214 (-2), which is tied for the 10th best 54-hole total in school history.

Senior Katie Burnett finished in the top 10 for the eighth time in her career as her final-round 74 (+2) moved her into a tie for ninth with a three-day total of 213 (-3). Burnett's 54-hole score is tied for the eighth best in program history.

South Carolina's third round under par came from junior Amanda Strang, who carded a 2-under 70 for her lowest round of the tournament. Strang recorded five birdies, 10 pars and three bogeys on the day to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 44th with a three-round score of 221 (+5).

Sophomore Samantha Swinehart turned in her best round of the event with a 74 (+2). After making three birdies in the first two rounds combined, Swinehart recorded three in the third round to go along with five bogeys and 10 pars.

#### **Burnett Among Gamecock's Best**

Senior Katie Burnett, who has not missed a lineup in her Gamecock career, is in her final season in garnet and black with her name already scattered around the South Carolina record books. Burnett's career stroke average of 74.45 is the second best all-time, while her 2009-10 stroke average of 73.58 is tied for second in school history.

Burnett's 72-hole total of 286 at the 2010 NCAA Championship ranks first all-time. Her 54-hole total of 210 is the third best score in program history, while her 36-hole score of 142 is tied for first all-time. She is also tied for first in lowest score (66), first round score (67) and second in both second round score (67) and third round score (69).
