Gamecocks Travel to Palmetto Intercollegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team is set open play in its second event of the spring as it travels to Aiken, S.C. for the 15th annual Palmetto Intercollegiate. The 54-hole event runs Monday through Tuesday at the Palmetto Golf Club, with 36 holes of competition scheduled for the first day.

This Week's Lineup

The Gamecocks will be competing with their youngest lineup of the season, as Bryan, junior Dykes Harbin and freshmen Sean Kelly, Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy will tee it up on Monday. Bryan is coming off a first-place showing at the Seahawk Invitational with a score of 209 (-7), while Sturgeon opened the spring playing the best golf of his young Gamecock career as he tied for seventh with a score of 215 (-1).

History at the Palmetto Intercollegiate

The Gamecocks are making their first appearance at the Palmetto Intercollegiate since 2004 and their third overall. Carolina has been successful in both prior experiences, finishing third in 2003 and first in 2004.

Last Time at the Palmetto Intercollegiate

Paced by the play of sophomore Eirik Johansen, who claimed his first individual collegiate title with a 9-under-par score, South Carolina clinched its third team title of the year on March 17, 2004 at the Palmetto Intercollegiate.

The Gamecocks, who entered the final round with a 12-stroke advantage

finished with a team round of 4-over-par, 288 over the last 18 holes to hold off a late charge by host USC-Aiken and win the event with a 54-hole score of 278-281-288-847.

Johansen completed the best tournament of his career by carding a third-straight round in the 60s to complete play at 0-under-par, 67-68-69-204. Joining Johansen in the event's top 10 was junior Martin Rominger, who finished alone in fourth place with his best outing of the year, a 54-hole total of 3-under-par, 70-66-74-210. The next South Carolina individual in the ield was sophomore Jake Thompson, who was part of a four-way tie for 23rd place at 72-74-72-218.

Thompson was followed by fellow junior Alex Hamilton, who tied for 27th place at 69-73-77-219. Sophomores Robert Svensson, who was among six players tied for 33rd place at 76-74-73-223, and Matt Robinson, who tied for 39th place at 72-76-76-224, while competing as an individual, rounded out the Gamecock contingent in the tournament.

Breaking Down the Field

Carolina will compete against 17 teams at the event, including in-state rival Clemson. Host USC Aiken, Akron, Augusta State, Chattanooga, College of Charleston, East Carolina, Elon, Francis Marion, Furman, Georgia Southern, Liberty, Maryland, Presbyterian, Wofford, Vanderbilt and Virginia round out the field.

About the Course

The tournament is played at the Palmetto Golf Club, which has a par-71, 6,617-yard layout. The course is recognized as



the fourth oldest golf course in the country.

Young Gun

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly has made a huge impact in just three tournaments this season. Kelly, who has been the Gamecocks' top finisher in two of his four appearances, currently is second on the team with a scoring average of 73.36. He is also tied for second on the team in rounds under par (four) and is tied for the lead for lowest 18-hole score (68).

Steadying Force

Junior Dykes Harbin has been the Gamecocks most steady player this season. Through four tournaments, Harbin is third on the team with a 73.57 scoring average. He has turned in only four rounds worse than 74 this season.

Bryan Wins Seahawk Invitational; Gamecocks Claim Third

South Carolina senior Wesley Bryan fired a final-round 70 (-2) to claim medalist honors at the Seahawk Invitational at the Country Club of Landfall. As a team, the Gamecocks shot a 4-under 284 to finish in third place with a score of 875 (+11).

Bryan became the first Gamecock to win a regular season tournament since Paul Woodbury captured the Seminole Intercollegiate on March 14, 2010. The win is the second of his career and his fourth career top-five finish.

Freshman Sean Kelly played a key role in moving Carolina up the leaderboard with a career-low 68 (-4). Kelly's three-round total of 219 (+3) was good enough for 12th place. Freshman Caleb Sturgeon, who played the tournament as an individual, posted a 73 (+1) to finished in a tie for seventh with a score of 215 (-1).

Freshman Will Murphy turned in an even-par 72 to wrap up play in a tie for 21st with a three-round score of 223 (+7). Junior Dykes Harbin and sophomore Blaine Woodruff each shot a final-round 74 for the Gamecocks. Harbin finished tied for 24th with a score of 224 (+8), while Woodruff placed 42nd with a score of 231 (+15).

Gamecock Men's Golf Takes Fifth at Bridgestone Collegiate

South Carolina posted a final-round 301 (+13) to finish in fifth place at the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate at Forest Oaks Country Club. The Gamecocks, who entered the day on top of the leaderboard, ended the tournament with a tworound score of 592 (+16), which was 10 strokes back of tournament champion Iowa State (582).

Senior Wesley Bryan and junior Dykes Harbin were Carolina's top finishers as they tied for 15th with two-round scores of 147 (+3). Bryan carded a 75 (+3) on Sunday, while Harbin turned in a 4-over 76.

Freshman Sean Kelly posted the lowest round of the

day for the Gamecocks with a 1-over 73 and ended the tournament tied for 34th with a score of 150 (+6).

Freshman Will Murphy shot a 79 (+8) on Sunday to tie for 34th with a score of 150 (+6) in his first career appearance, while sophomore Blaine Woodruff carded a 5-over 77 to tie for 72nd with a score of 156 (+12).

Gamecocks Finish Second, Kelly Third at Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 300 (+12) at the Rees Jones Signature Course at Haig Point Club to finish in second at the Rees Jones Invitational. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round score of 898 (+34).

South Carolina came up just short of winning their third title in four years at the event, finishing four strokes behind champion Kennesaw State. The Owls shot 289 (+1) on Tuesday to win their second straight Rees Jones Invitational with a score of 894 (+30).

Freshman Sean Kelly produced the best round of the day for the Gamecocks as he fired a final-round 70 (-2) to claim third place with a score of 220 (+4).

Junior Dykes Harbin turned in a 77 (+5) to give the Gamecocks a second top-10 finisher as he closed out the event with a three-round score of 222 (+6) to tie for seventh. Sophomore Blaine Woodruff carded a 76 (+4) to tie for 26th with a score of 229 (+13).

After two stellar rounds to open his Gamecock career, freshman Caleb Sturgeon struggled on Tuesday, turning in an 81(+9) to fall back to a tie for 33rd. Junior Dean Hester recorded his lowest round of the tournament with a 77 (+5) to tie for 57th with a 241 (+25).

Junior Clint Tolleson, who played the event as an individual, posted a final-round 81 (+9) and finished tied for 53rd with a score of 239 (+23).

South Carolina Finishes 11th at Mason Rudolph Championship

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly posted a 1-under 70 to lead the Gamecocks in the final round of the Mason Rudolph Championship at the Vanderbilt Legends Club South Course. South Carolina shot a final-round 288 (+4) to finish the tournament in 11th place with a three-round score of 877 (+25).

Kelly got off to a strong start as he started the day at the 10th hole and carded a birdie. The Staten Island, N.Y., native recorded his second birdie of the day on the 14th and he went on to make the turn at 34 (-2). Kelly fell back to even with back-to-back bogeys on the first and second holes but he birdied the sixth and made par the rest of the way to wrap up the round at 1-under to finish in a tie for 31st.

Sophomores Blaine Woodruff and Caulder Moore also had solid rounds for the Gamecocks with a pair of 1-over 72s. Woodruff finished in a tie for 55th, while Moore tied

Junior Dykes Harbin was the second-highest finisher for the Gamecocks, claiming a tie for 34th after a final-round 75 (+4). Senior Wesley Bryan wrapped up the event in a tie for 39th after carding a 74 (+3).

Gamecocks Tie for 11th to Open Season

South Carolina recorded a final-round 300 (+12) and tied for 11th place to wrap up play at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club to open the 2011-12 season. The Gamecocks finished the week with a team total of 890 (+26).

Junior Dykes Harbin proved to be the most consistent Gamecock during the weekend as he posted a final-round 72 (E) to finish the tournament in a tie for 21st with rounds of 73-73-72=218 (+2).

Sophomore Blaine Woodruff improved his score for the third straight day with a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 35th with rounds of 76-74-73=223 (+7).

After posting the Gamecocks' tournament low with a 3-under 69 in the second round, senior Wesley Bryan was unable to carry that momentum into the final round with a 6-over 78 to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 42nd with rounds of 78-69-78=225 (+9).

Sophomore Caulder Moore made the turn at even par but fell back on the back nine with four bogeys and a double bogey as he turned in a 77 (+5) for the round, while sophomore Logan Harrell posted an 82 (+10) for the Gamecocks. **Getting to Know the New Guys**
