Gamecocks Set for SEC Championship

The sixth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team begins postseason play this weekend at the SEC Championship. The 54-hole event will be contested Friday through Sunday on the par-70, 7,055-yard Seaside Course at Sea Island Golf Club in St. Simons Island, Ga.

Gamecocks at the SEC Championship

Carolina is making its 24th appearance at the SEC Championship and will look to win its first SEC title. The Gamecocks have finished runner-up three times, finishing one stroke back of first in 1998, eight strokes back in 2008 and two strokes back in 2013. Eric Ecker is the only Gamecock to win medalist honors at the SEC Championship as he won the rain-shortened event in 1998 with rounds of 70 and 66 in Athens, Ga. George Bryan IV came close to winning at the 2010 SEC Championship, tying for first before losing in a playoff to Georgia's Russell Henley.

Last Time at the SEC Championship

At the 2014 SEC Championship, Carolina claimed fifth place with a 54-hole total of 838 (-2), which is the lowest 54-hole SEC Championship total in school history. Alabama won its third-straight SEC title with a total of 806 (-34). Will Murphy led the Gamecocks with a tie for fifth finish with a total of 205 (-5). Matt NeSmith tied for 21st with a total of 210 (E), while Will Starke (211), Ben Dietrich (217) and Caleb Sturgeon (218) finished tied for 26th, 43rd and 51st, respectively.

SEC Championship History

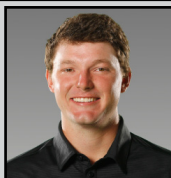
This year marks the 76th playing of the SEC Championship. Ten current SEC programs have won at least one SEC title, with Georgia leading the way with 28. Florida has won 15 titles, followed by LSU (15), Alabama (5),

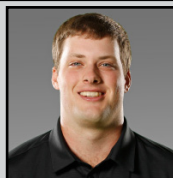

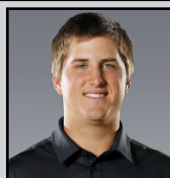

Auburn (3), Tennessee (3), Mississippi State (2), Arkansas (1), Kentucky (1) and Ole Miss (1). Georgia Tech also won an SEC Championship in 1949.

The championship is being held at Sea Island Golf Club for the 15th time. This marks the 13th time the championship has been contested on the Seaside Course.

Breaking Down the Field

The SEC continues to prove it is one of the most talented golf conferences in the country. Nine of the 14 teams are ranked in the top 50 of the latest Golfstat Relative Rankings, including five in the top 25. Vanderbilt is the highest-ranked league team at No. 5, followed by the Gamecocks (No. 6), LSU (No. 7), Auburn (No. 15), defending SEC and national champion Alabama (No. 25), Arkansas (No. 30), Georgia (No. 34), Florida (No. 37), Texas A&M (No. 39), Ole Miss (No. 51), Missouri (No. 60), Tennessee (No. 61), Kentucky (No. 68) and Mississippi State (No. 128).

Nine of the 14 league teams have won at least one tournament this season and have combined for 21 titles. The Gamecocks lead the SEC with five tournament titles, while Auburn, LSU, Georgia and Missouri have each won three tournaments. Carolina has competed against all but one SEC team this season (Mississippi State) and has a 17-4 head-to-head record against league teams heading into the weekend.

High Five

The Gamecocks have won a school-record five tournament titles this season, including three during the spring schedule. Carolina set the record by shooting a final-round 271 (-17) to capture the Hootie at Bulls Bay title on March 31 with a total of 838 (-26).

Built to Finish

Carolina has held the 36-hole lead in three tournaments this season and went on to win the tournament title each time. The Gamecocks held on to win the Bayou City Collegiate Championship on Feb. 22 by two strokes, the Palmetto Intercollegiate on March 10 by one stroke over rival Clemson and the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate on March 31 by 11 strokes.

Extending the Streak

The Gamecocks have finished in the top five in a school-record eight-straight events, with seven being top-three showings. Carolina has finished in the top five in 17 of its last 19 events dating back to last season, including eight tournament wins.

Protecting the Palmetto State

Carolina has played in three tournaments in South Carolina this season and won all three titles. The Gamecocks won the Camden Collegiate Invitational (Camden, S.C.), the Palmetto Intercollegiate (Aiken, S.C.) and the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate (Awendaw, S.C.).

Records Set to Fall

The Gamecocks are on pace to set several single-season school records. Carolina's team scoring average is currently 281.46, which is six strokes lower than the school record of 287.46 set by last year's squad. Junior Will Starke's stroke average of 69.70 is 1.65 strokes lower than the school record of 71.35 held by George Bryan IV (2009-10). Junior Matt NeSmith (2nd - 70.59), senior Caleb Sturgeon (5th - 71.85) and senior Will Murphy (6th - 71.88) also rank in the top six on the single season-season scoring average list. Starke has tied the single-season record for top-five finishes with six with the SEC Championship and at least the NCAA Regionals left on the schedule.

Three Straight a First

The Gamecocks became the first team in Carolina history to win three straight tournaments with their victory at the Palmetto Intercollegiate. Carolina won the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall and opened the spring with a win at the Bayou City Collegiate Championship before winning the Palmetto.

on the United States Palmer Cup Team. Starke currently is ranked eighth in the Team USA Palmer Cup standings. The top six golfers from the final ranking (April 17) will be among the 10 individuals selected to compete. The remaining four golfers will be selected using three committee picks and one coaches pick. Starke has finished in the top 15 in eight of nine events this season, including six top fives and a tournament win, and he won his match against Virginia's Ji Soo Park. His six top-five finishes are tied for the most in a single season in school history with Kyle Thompson (1998-99). Starke has also shot in the 60s 17 times, and his stroke average of 69.70 ranks third in the SEC and seventh nationally.

League Leaders

The Gamecocks enter the weekend ranked first in the SEC in tournament wins (5) and in team scoring average (281.46). Carolina also has four golfers in the top 20 in the SEC in scoring average, as Will Starke ranks third (69.46), Matt NeSmith ranks eighth (70.59), Caleb Sturgeon ranks 15th (71.85) and Will Murphy ranks 16th (71.88).

McDonald's 14

Gamecock head coach Bill McDonald is the winningest coach by tournament victories in school history with 14. McDonald broke the previous record of nine held by Puggy Blackmon (1995-2007) with Carolina's win at the Carpet Capital Collegiate this fall. The Gamecocks then gave McDonald his 11th tournament title with a win at the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall. Carolina opened the spring by winning the Bayou City Collegiate Championship and then won the Palmetto Intercollegiate. Carolina set the school record for wins in a season by claiming its fifth tournament title with a win at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate to close out the regular season.

Consensus Top 10

The Gamecocks have consistently been ranked in the top 25 in the golf rankings the last two seasons but they enter the SEC Championship a consensus top-10 team. Carolina is currently ranked No. 6 in the Golfstat Relative Rankings, No. 5 in the Bushnell Golfweek Coaches Poll and No. 8 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Rankings.

Gamecocks in the Golfstat Statistics Rankings

As a team South Carolina ranks third in the nation in average score (71.51) and fourth versus par (+0.17). The Gamecocks are 11th in par-3 scoring (3.13), fourth in par-4 scoring (4.05) and 14th in par-5 scoring (4.75). Carolina is tied for eighth in eagles (19) and ranks ninth in subpar strokes per round (3.57).

Individually, junior Will Starke ranks seventh nationally in scoring average (69.70), ninth versus par (-1.63), ninth in par-4 scoring (3.95), tied for first in eagles (9) and tied for sixth in subpar strokes per round (4.70). Junior Matt NeSmith ranks 20th in par-4 scoring (3.98).

Rewriting the Record Book

Seniors Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy and juniors Will Starke and Matt NeSmith continue to climb up South Carolina's career scoring average list. Starke currently ranks first all-time with an average of 71.79, while NeSmith isn't far behind in second with an average of 71.94. Sturgeon ranks fourth all-time with an average of 72.72, while Murphy is sixth with an average of 73.04.

Starke also has 11 career top-five finishes, which is tied for the third most all-time at Carolina with George Bryan IV (2006-10). NeSmith is tied for the sixth most career top-five finishes with eight.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 150 in the latest Golfweek/Amateurgolf.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 31 in the world and No. 16 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 113 in the world and No. 48 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 62, junior Will Starke is No. 74 and NeSmith is No. 85.

Roster Breakdown

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks finished ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.

2014-15 Tournament Recaps

Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate

The fifth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team played one of its best rounds of the season, firing a final-round 271 (-17) at Bulls Bay Golf Club to pull away from the field and win the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate title.

The Gamecocks claimed an 11-stroke victory with a 54-hole total of 838 (-26). The tournament title is Carolina's fifth this season, which is a school record. New Mexico finished second with a total of 849 (-15), followed by GRU Augusta (851), Virginia (852) and College of Charleston (856).

As a team, Carolina recorded just four bogeys and two double bogeys on the day while making 22 birdies. Junior Matt NeSmith won his first collegiate tournament to lead the way. A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith carded a final-round 68 (-4) to finish the round in a three-way tie for first with a total of 205 (-11). He joined New Mexico's Gavin Green and Coastal Carolina's Andrew Dorn in a playoff. All three golfers made par on 18 on the first playoff hole and went back to the 18th tee to play the hole again. Dorn was eliminated on the second playoff hole, as NeSmith and Green both made par to go to a third playoff hole. Green missed a par putt to record bogey, while NeSmith drained his par putt to claim medalist honors.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon turned in one of his best rounds of the season, posting a bogey-free 67 (-5) to finish the afternoon in a tie for fifth with a total of 209 (-7). The top-five finish is Sturgeon's second this season and sixth of his career.

Senior Will Murphy carded the low round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 6-under 66. Murphy had just one blemish on his scorecard, a bogey on the par-4 fifth. He recorded seven birdies, including four straight on holes seven through 10.

Junior Will Starke just missed a top-20 finish as he tied for 22nd with a total of 215 (-1) after shooting a final-round 70 (-2). Rounding out the lineup, sophomore Ben Dietrich shot a 75 (+3) to finish tied for 53rd with a total of 223 (+7).

Valspar Collegiate Invitational

South Carolina junior Will Starke matched the school record by firing an 8-under 63 in the final round of the Valspar Collegiate Invitational at Floridian National Golf Club to lead the seventh-ranked Gamecocks to a third-place finish.

Carolina earned its seventh-straight top-five finish by shooting a final-round 277 (-7) to wrap up the week with a 54-hole total of 841 (-11), which is the eighth lowest 54-hole total in school history. The Gamecocks finished six strokes back of tournament champion Florida State. The second-ranked Seminoles won the title with a total of 835 (-17). LSU took second with a total of 840 (-12).

Starke, who began the day tied for 41st, bogeyed the par-3 second hole, but that turned out to be his only blemish on the scorecard. During his final 16 holes, he strung together seven birdies and an eagle to get into the clubhouse with a 63 to finish tied for 11th with a total of 211 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke joins Kyle Thompson and David Seawell as the only Gamecock golfers to card a 63. Thompson posted a 63 at the 1999 NCAA East Regional, while Seawell carded a 63 at the 1996 Gator Invitational.

Junior Matt NeSmith concluded a stellar week at Floridian with a final-round 69 (-2). He closed out the tournament with a total of 210 (-3) to finish tied for sixth, his third top-10 finish this season. He now has 14 top-10 finishes in his career, which ties him with volunteer assistant and former Gamecock All-American Carl Paulson (1989-93) for sixth on Carolina's career top-10 finishes list.

Senior Will Murphy also earned a top-20 finish as he carded a final-round 72 (+1) to tie for 16th with a total of 212 (-1). Senior Caleb Sturgeon tied for 25th with a total of 215 (+2) after shooting a 73 (+2) on Tuesday. Rounding out the lineup, junior Sean Kelly tied for 50th with a total of 224 (+11) after shooting a 76 (+5).

Seminole Intercollegiate

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 281 (-7) at the Seminole Intercollegiate but came up short of winning its fourth-straight tournament, finishing third with a total of 847 (-17) at Southwood Golf Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event four strokes back of tournament champion Florida State. The second-ranked Seminoles fired a 17-under 271 on the final day of its home tournament to win with a total of 843 (-21). East Tennessee State finished runner-up with a total of 846 (-18).

Carolina junior Will Starke delivered another stellar round, carding a bogey-free 66 (-6), his eighth straight round in the 60s. A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke finished third with a total of 203 (-13), which is tied for the fifth-lowest 54-hole total in school history. The top-five finish is Starke's sixth this season, which moves him into a tie for first for the most in a single season in Carolina history. It's also his 11th career top-five finish, which is tied for the third most in school history with George Bryan IV (2006-10).

Junior Sean Kelly recorded his fourth top-20 finish this season as he turned in a final-round 74 (+2) to finish tied for 18th with a total of 213 (-3).

Junior Matt NeSmith and senior Caleb Sturgeon also carded red numbers for the Gamecocks. NeSmith shot a 2-under 70, including birdies on his final three holes, to wrap up the weekend in a tie for 23rd with a total of 214 (-2). Sturgeon carded a solid 71 (-1) to finish in 54th place with a total of 221 (+5).

Rounding out the lineup, senior Will Murphy tied for 62nd with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting a 78 (+6) on Sunday.

Palmetto Intercollegiate

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 279 (-1) to claim a one-stroke victory over rival Clemson at the Palmetto Intercollegiate at the historic Palmetto Golf Club.

The Gamecocks entered the final round with a one-shot lead and went on to win their fourth tournament title of the season with a total of 825 (-15) after Clemson (826) was unable to make up the stroke by shooting an identical 279. The four wins match the school record for most wins in a single season at Carolina. The win is also the Gamecocks' third straight tournament title, which is a school record.

Gamecock junior Will Starke also took home some hardware as he claimed medalist honors by a stroke over Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes and Clemson's Cody Proveaux with a career-low total of 201 (-9), which is tied for the second-lowest 54-hole total in school history. The win is the second of Starke's career and is also his fifth top-five finish this season, moving him into a tie for second for most top-five finishes in a single season at Carolina.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon just missed a top-10 finish as he wrapped up the week in a tie for 11th with a season-low total of 206 (-4). Sturgeon carded an even-par 70 on Tuesday to earn his third top-20 finish of the season and 17th of his career.

Junior Matt NeSmith posted a 1-over 71 to head into the clubhouse in a tie for 21st with a total of 210, while senior Will Murphy tied for 29th with a total of 213 (+3) after shooting a final-round 71. Rounding out the lineup, junior Sean Kelly turned in a 71 to finish the tournament tied for 38th with a total of 215 (-1).

Bayou City Collegiate Championship

The ninth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team claimed its third title of the season, shooting a final-round 285 (-3) to hold off Sam Houston State to win the Bayou City Collegiate Championship at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 850 (-14) to finish two strokes ahead of the Bearkats (852), who made a charge by shooting a final-round 277 (-11). Carolina has now won three tournament titles for the second consecutive season. It marks the fifth time in school history a Gamecock squad has won three tournaments in a season.

Five Gamecocks secured top-20 finishes, led by junior Will Starke. After turning in a 66 (-6) in the second round, Starke fired a bogey-free 68 (-4) on Sunday to finish tied for fifth with a total of 212 (-4), his fourth top-five showing this season.

Senior Will Murphy recorded his second top-10 finish this season as he shot a final-round 70 (-2) to tie for 10th with a total of 214 (-2). Junior Matt NeSmith carded an even-par 72 to wrap up the weekend tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1).

Junior Sean Kelly and freshman Keenan Huskey, who played as an individual, finished tied for 16th with a total of 216 (E). Kelly shot a final-round 75, while Huskey posted a 74. Rounding out the lineup, senior Caleb Sturgeon finished tied for 36th with a total of 221 (+5) after shooting a 75.

Camden Collegiate Invitational

The 10th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team fired a final-round 275 (-5) to win the inaugural Camden Collegiate Invitational by a stroke over Wofford at Camden Country Club.

The Gamecocks, who entered the day seven strokes back of Wofford, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 847 (+7) to win their second tournament of the fall. It marks the second straight year Carolina has won two tournaments in the fall. The Terriers finished with a total of 848 (+8) to claim second.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and juniors Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded rounds under par to lead the comeback. NeSmith carded the low round for the Gamecocks, shooting a 3-under 67 to finish tied for seventh with a total of 211 (+1). Sturgeon and Starke tied for fifth with a total of 210 (E) after shooting 68 and 69, respectively.

Senior Blaine Woodruff turned in a final-round 71 (+1) to tie for 26th with a total of 220 (+10), and freshman Keenan Huskey rounded out the lineup, finishing tied for 39th with a total of 223 (+13) after shooting a 73 (+3).

DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a 2-over 286 (+2) at The Golf Club of Tennessee to move one spot up the leaderboard and finish in fourth place in the DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup.

The Gamecocks, whose round was tied for the second lowest of the day, wrapped up the stroke play portion of the tournament with a 54-hole total of 859 (+7). Georgia Tech won the tournament title with a total of 848 (-4).

Junior Will Starke had a stellar tournament, finishing second with a total of 206 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-2) on Saturday. Starke came up one stroke shy of first, as Georgia's Lee McCoy won medalist honors with a total of 205 (-8).

Gamecock junior Matt NeSmith fired a bogey-free 67 (-4) to climb nine spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for fourth with a total of 209 (-4). Senior Will Murphy tied for 23rd with a total of 219 (+6) after carding a 73 (+2) on Saturday. Senior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a final-round 77 (+6) finished 45th with a total of 226 (+13), and sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 46th with a total of 227 (+14) after shooting a 77 (+6).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The 12th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team captured its first team title of the season after firing a final-round 276 (-12) at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who were three strokes off the lead heading into the round, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 848 (-16) to win its first Carpet Capital Collegiate title in 24 appearances against one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. The Gamecocks made their comeback after an incredible back nine as all five golfers in the lineup combined to shoot 10-under.

Senior Will Murphy led the charge up the leaderboard as he fired a 6-under 66, which matches his career low. A native of Columbia, S.C., Murphy finished the weekend tied for eighth with a total of 211 (-5).

Junior Will Starke was the highest Gamecock finisher, tying for fourth place with a total of 209 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-3) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith posted a final-round 68 (-4) to finish in a tie for 18th with a total of 214 (-2). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 32nd with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 73 (+1) on Sunday, while senior Caleb Sturgeon and junior Sean Kelly finished tied for 41st with a total of 219 (+3). The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 1,079 (-1), with five scores counting all three days. Georgia won with a total of 1,063 (-17).

Senior Caleb Sturgeon led the way for Carolina, recording his ninth career top-10 finish as he tied for 10th with a total of 213 (-3) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Sunday.

Junior Will Starke carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks as he turned in a 1-under 71 to finish tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1). Sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 15th with a total of 216 (E), following a round of 74 (+2) on Sunday. Junior Matt NeSmith carded a final-round 75 (+3) to finish tied for 26th with a total of 218 (+2), while senior Will Murphy and junior Sean Kelly both finished tied for 29th with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in an even-par 72, and Kelly shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday.
