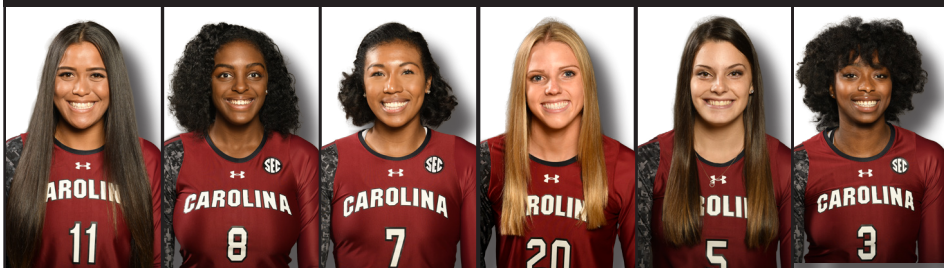

NOTEWORTHY

SCOUTING LSU

LSU stands at 7-13 overall and 2-7 in the SEC, dropping three straight matches that includes the Oct. 16 meeting with the Gamecocks. Three different players average two kills or more per set, led by outside hitter Gina Tillis (3.35). Tillis is also a stout two-way player, putting up 2.90 digs and 0.43 blocks per set, and went for 19 kills and nine digs in the previous meeting with Carolina. The Tigers as a team are one of the best in the SEC at keeping the ball alive, with a team average of 14.78 digs per set that ranks third in the conference. An achilles heel for the team has been accuracy on offense; LSU ranks 12th in hitting percentage at .185, and has hit just .152 through its first nine conference games.

SCOUTING TEXAS A&M

The defending conference champions are 12-7 with a 6-2 SEC mark. Five starters and the libero return from last season, highlighted by 2015 SEC Player of the Year Stephanie Aiple and All-SEC members Ashlie Reasor and Jazzmin Babers. Bolstering the trio is outside hitter Kiara McGee, who leads the team in points and averages 3.16 kills per set so far this season, and freshman Hollann Hans (2.84 kills, 1.58 digs per set). The duo combined for 22 of the team's 48 total kills in the first meeting between the two schools, on Oct. 14. On defense, the Aggies rank fourth in the conference in blocks per set (2.64) and are holding opponents to a .173 hitting percentage this season.

PREVIOUS MEETING (TEXAS A&M/LSU) NOTABLES

- The Gamecocks had one of their best passing performances of the season at LSU, putting up 71 digs in the match. Four different players eclipsed double-digit digs, led by Megan Kirkland's 20. It was the second-highest total of the season, behind only the 75-dig performance over five sets against Georgia Southern.
- The win at LSU snapped a five-game losing streak for Carolina in the series. The last time the Gamecocks won in Baton Rouge, current assistant coach Shonda Cole was in her freshman season.
- Koko Atoa-Williams popped up a season-high 14 digs, and added 14 kills for her second double-double of the season against the Tigers. She now has 16 for her career, ranking her 21st in program history.
- Aubrey Ezell had her best game of the conference season as well at LSU, finishing with 34 assists and 14 digs. She now has five double-doubles this season and 23 for her career, tied for the 14th most in program history.
- The Carolina middle hitters were effective all afternoon against LSU, as Jacqy Angermiller and Alicia Starr combined for 12 kills and just two errors. Starr also added eight blocks.
- Joely Cabrera finished with 11 digs at LSU, tied for a season high with the season opener at Charleston.
- Abreia Epps finished with six kills and a .364 hitting percentage at Texas A&M after entering the match in the second set. It was her most efficient night hitting in the conference season.
- Dessaa Legros' .353 hitting percentage against the Aggies was also her best of the conference season. She now has five matches this season with five or more kills and a hitting percentage above .350.
- The Aggies finished the match with a sideout percentage of 75 percent, compared to 39 percent for Carolina.

TO BE THE BEST, YOU HAVE TO BEAT THE BEST

The Gamecocks face one of the toughest conference schedules of any team in the SEC, with an 18-game slate that features two matches apiece against the top four teams in the conference - Florida, Kentucky, Missouri and Texas A&M. In the first month of the season, the Gamecocks' eight scheduled opponents currently have a combined conference record of 41-25, facing Kentucky twice and the other top three teams (Missouri, Florida, Texas A&M) once. No other team in the conference plays each of the aforementioned top four twice this season.

A 'FRESH' PERSPECTIVE

The team has received a big lift from a trio of freshman at key positions this season:

- Mikayla Shields leads the team with 2.96 kills per set, and his hitting an impressive .327 for the season despite hitting from the outside. So far this season, she has nine matches with double-digit kills and has hit over .500 seven times, and also earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors to go with tournament MVP recognition at the College of Charleston Invite and the Gamecock Invite.
- Courtney Koehler has stepped in as a setter in the team's 6-2 offense and is averaging 4.41 assists and 1.30 digs per set while playing in every set so far this season, ending as the team's top assister in six matches. On top of her setting skills, she has been a clutch server, with 10 aces and the team's best serve percentage (eight errors in 248 attempts).
- Alicia Starr had to earn her spot in the starting lineup mid-season, after being trained at an entirely different position than she played in club and high school. Since moving into a starting role, she is averaging 1.20 kills and 1.23 blocks per set and is hitting .340. She has already made her mark on the program record books as well, as her four solo blocks vs. Davidson are the second-most in the program's rally-scoring era (since 2001) and her 11 blocks vs. Kentucky are tied for the second-most in a four set match since 2001.

WHEN THE GAMECOCKS WIN...

- The team is out-hitting the opposition .303-.172, and have yet to lose this season when out-hitting opponents in a match (13-0).
- The opposition averages 1.20 aces per set, compared to 1.47 for Carolina. The Gamecocks are 8-0 when finishing a match with more aces.
- The Gamecocks average 2.59 blocks per set and have 34 solo blocks, compared to just 1.35 for opponents.
- Freshman Mikayla Shields hits .368 in wins, compared to .157 in losses. Her kills per set dips from 3.26 in wins to 1.88 in losses.

WHEN THE GAMECOCKS LOSE...

- The offense is hitting just .156 in losses with three fewer kills per set on average, and the defense is allowing opponents to hit .298. Only one of Carolina's four top attack leaders are hitting above .200 through the team's five losses.
- Serve reception has been the biggest x-factor in losses, as the Gamecocks are allowing 1.85 aces per set to opponents in the four matches, but only average 0.70 aces while holding serve.
- Opponents passing success weight heavily in matches lost by Carolina. In the five losses, Gamecocks opponents are averaging almost three digs more per set (15.65 to 12.75) and has a serve-reception percentage of .960.
- Five of South Carolina's six losses have come after dropping the first set.

COLE NAMED TO GAMECOCKS HOF

Current South Carolina assistant head coach Shonda Cole was inducted into the South Carolina Athletics Hall of Fame class of 2016 on Thursday, Oct. 20. She is the third woman from the program to make the Hall of Fame, joining Ashley Edlund-Heidtke (inducted in 2010) and Heather Larkin (inducted in 2012). Cole was the first Gamecock volleyball player to earn All-America honors, and was also a three-time All-SEC honoree. Cole still holds the program's career record for points per set, kills per set, and attacks. After an equally successful professional career, which included a stint with the U.S. national team, Cole has returned to her alma mater and is in her second season as a full-time assistant.

STANDING ROOM ONLY

It was a special atmosphere in the Carolina Volleyball Center on Sept. 4, as a crowd of 2,041 came out for the Gamecocks' match against Clemson. Against Tennessee, the team drew a crowd of 1,819 (second-most in program history). Of the top 10 home crowds on record, eight have come under head coach Scott Swanson and three have come this season alone. Currently, the Gamecocks rank 40th nationally in average attendance this season (1,185), despite the fact that two matches were rescheduled due to weather and three other matches went directly against home football games.

- Mother swam at St. John's University
- Three cousins played in Division I for softball, diving and volleyball
- Uncle is Frank Viola, MLB veteran, Cy Young winner, and three-time All-Star

COURTNEY KOEHLER

- Her brother played football at Presbyterian College
- Older sister Kerstin played volleyball at College of Charleston

DESSAA LEGROS

- Her twin sister Annayka currently plays volleyball at Coastal Carolina

EMMA LOCK

- Her uncle, Andy Lock, played football at Missouri. Currently, her cousin Drew is the Tigers' starting quarterback

MIKAYLA SHIELDS

- Her parents were track and field stars at the University of Pittsburgh.
- Her mother, Najuma, still holds the school record in the high jump, pentathlon and heptathlon. She competed for Guyana at the 1992 Olympics
- Her father, Brett, ran on the program's fastest Sprint Medley Relay team

ALICIA STARR

- Her father, Brett, played football, basketball and track at Oregon State
- Her mother, Julie, was a gymnast for the University of Vermont
- Sister Brianna is currently a senior on the UMKC volleyball team

JESSE TURNER

- Her mother, Lesli, played volleyball at Pepperdine
- Her father, Rob, played football at Eastern Michigan
- Her uncle, Roman Fortin, played in the NFL for three different teams

ALL-TIME RECORDS

- South Carolina holds a 781-606 (.562) all-time record, dating back to 1973.
- The Gamecocks joined the SEC for volleyball in 1991, and have an all-time conference record of 175-231 (.430).
- In matches in the Carolina Volleyball Center, Carolina 181-97 (.655).
- With 88 career wins, head coach Scott Swanson ranks third in program history for wins. Kim Hudson (1993-2004) is the program's wins leader, with 226.

GAMECOCKS SNAP SKID WITH WIN AT LSU

BATON ROUGE, LA. — The South Carolina volleyball team not only snapped its four-match losing streak, but earned its first win at LSU in 13 years after downing the Tigers (7-12, 2-6 SEC) in four sets, 25-19, 20-25, 25-21, 25-22. The Gamecocks (14-5, 2-5 SEC) hit .317 as a team for the match, and passed efficiently with an average of 17.8 digs per set to control the tempo.

1st Set: After tinkering with the lineup at Texas A&M Friday night, the Gamecocks went back to their tried and true look offensively and got out to a strong start. An early 6-1 run gave the Gamecocks the lead, and Jacqy Angermiller started with kills off her first four swings of the match. Carolina built a 15-10 lead at the media timeout, and offensive efficiency would be the key to the team's success for the game. Six different players finished with two or more kills in the game, and Carolina hit .484 to take the early 1-0 lead with a 25-19 win.

2nd Set: The Tigers used a pair of early blocks to curb the offensive momentum from the Gamecocks, and the home side built an 8-2 lead to force a Carolina timeout. Runs would be hard to come by for the Gamecocks as they tried to chip away at the early deficit (their largest run for the set was a 4-0 spurt at the end of the set), and LSU maintained a comfortable lead. The match went to halftime tied 1-1 after a 25-20 decision.

3rd Set: Mikayla Shields helped the Gamecocks start strong in the pivotal third set. The freshman accounted for three kills in the team's first six points and Carolina held a modest lead to start the frame. LSU closed the margin quickly, and the third set would be closely contested until a key call mid-way through. The Gamecocks got an important swing point on a challenge off a 13-all tie, as a Tiger block was called an error instead and Carolina used it to carry a 15-13 lead into the media timeout. That challenge from head coach Scott Swanson loomed large for the rest of the game. Carolina ran off an 8-1 run after the ruling to take its largest lead of the set at 21-14 and forced LSU into a final timeout. The Tigers would rally back to cut the lead to three, 24-21, but Carolina closed it out for the all-important 2-1 lead in the match.

4th Set: LSU used the blueprint that won it the second set to control the fourth game early on. The Gamecocks were able to get hands on most of the Tiger attacks in the set, but the deflections were either tooled out or could not be scooped up by the back line. LSU found itself hitting at a .517 clip and without an error through its first 14 attacks to take the early 12-6 lead. A 5-1 run for Carolina trimmed the lead to two, 13-11, but kills on four-straight possessions for the Tigers put them back ahead comfortably. Alicia Starr helped the Gamecocks stick around, pairing a block with a kill to provide Carolina with a 4-0 run to answer LSU's. After chipping away slow but sure, the set would eventually be knotted back up at 19-all, and after a LSU hitting error the Gamecocks took their first lead in the set since 2-0, with a 21-20 advantage. Dessaa Legros put the team on match point after a pair of kills made it 24-22, and Angermiller capped the win with her eighth kill of the day.

SCOTT SWANSON

Head Coach || Sixth Year at South Carolina

- Third in program history for career wins
- Coached seven NCAA tournament teams (Arizona State 1999, 2000, Minnesota 2006-10)
- Part of staff that coached eight All-Americans

The 11th head coach in Gamecock Volleyball history, Scott Swanson has his sights set on a successful 2016 season as he enters year six in Columbia. The Gamecocks will bring an exciting balance of veterans and talented youngsters into the season, with the aim of building off 2015's 13-18 campaign.

The Gamecocks faced a season of different adversities in 2015, coming from untimely injuries and a roster featuring six freshmen who all were asked to fill important roles. The team bonded through the rigors of the season, and picked up impressive wins over Tennessee, Ole Miss, and a season sweep of Arkansas. Swanson moved into third in program history for wins in a career after winning his 72nd game at South Carolina on Oct. 25.

Individually, freshman Aubrey Ezell finished with perhaps one of the best debut seasons ever by a Gamecock, finishing the season with the second-most assists ever in the program's rally-scoring era and a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team.

It would not just be the freshmen who would surprise, the team also saw breakout seasons from Dessaa Legros and Sarah Blomgren. Senior Darian Dozier capped her career in style, moving up to third in program history for career blocks and entered the top ten in hitting percentage as well. Off the court, the team volunteered over 1100 for community service, the most of any team at South Carolina.

In 2014, the Gamecocks posted a 17-14 record, which included seven SEC wins, the program's most since 2008. Libero Mikaela Christiaansen set the program record for most digs in a single season with 535, while middle blocker Darian Dozier set single-season rally scoring era school records for total blocks (141) and block assists (127). The Gamecocks also turned in another strong year in the classroom, as a league-best 12 players made the SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll.

During the 2013 season, outside hitter Juliette Thévenin became just the second Gamecock in school history to earn AVCA All-America honors as she was named honorable mention All-American. Thévenin was also a first-team AVCA All-Southeast Region and All-SEC selection as she left the program ranked in the top 10 in six career categories.

Swanson guided the Gamecocks to an 18-14 record in 2012, the program's second winning season in the last decade. South Carolina got off to a program-best 13-0 start and improved its hitting percentage for a second straight season, ranking second in the SEC with a percentage of .255, an improvement of 29 points from the previous year. Outside hitter Juliette Thévenin garnered second-team All-SEC honors after she ranked second in SEC play with 4.40 kills per set and 4.81 points per set, becoming the first Gamecock since 2008 to receive an All-SEC award.

In Swanson's first season, the Gamecocks went 14-16 and improved its offensive efficiency and its backline defense under his guidance. The team led the SEC with a 16.78 digs average, the best mark in four years for the Gamecocks, and hit .226, a 45-point improvement from the 2011 season.

Swanson's teams have also proved themselves in the classroom, earning the Team Academic Award from the American Volleyball Coaches Association in 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14. In his first five seasons, 49 student-athletes have earned a spot on the SEC Academic honor roll, including eight of the nine eligible players from 2015. The team also claimed the department's Life Skills Team of the Year award in 2011-12, honoring the group for its academic achievements, personal development and work in the community.

Prior to his current head coaching job, Swanson spent five years on the sidelines for the Golden Gophers, helping the team to five-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and a 125-46 record. Three times, Minnesota finished second in the Big Ten behind perennial power Penn State. The 2009 team advanced to the national semifinals in the NCAA Tournament.

During his tenure in Minneapolis, five Golden Gophers earned All-America accolades, including 2009 first-team middle blocker and 2012 US National Team pool member Lauren Gibbemeyer. Swanson also led the Gophers' recruiting efforts, posting three top-10 recruiting classes according to PrepVolleyball.com. The 2009 group earned top honors from the outlet.

In the summer of 2009, Swanson spent time with USA Volleyball's A-2 Junior National Team, and he coached the USA Red team to a second-place showing in the 2008 USA Adult Open Championships.

Swanson brings in four years of head coaching experience to Columbia after his tenure at the University of Texas-El Paso. With a 50-61 career record, Swanson had the team on the brink of the NCAA Tournament in 2005, when the Miners went 21-10. Three player earned all-conference honors under Swanson's tutelage, including honorable mention All-American Kari Stacy. He also inked a high school All-American and saw his team improve in the classroom to a department-best 3.2 GPA in 2005.

Prior to UTEP, Swanson spent six years at his alma mater, Arizona State. He helped the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances during his time in Tempe and coached one second-team All-American and two Pac-10 All-Freshman Team players. Two of his Sun Devil players garnered Academic All-America certificates as well.

Swanson started his coaching career at Mountain View (Ariz.) High School, working as an assistant with the varsity team and leading his junior varsity group to a 17-1 record. As a head coach with the Arizona East Valley Juniors club, he led a 16-1s team to a national runner-up finish and earned Cactus Region Coach of the Year honors. He also served as head coach at Camelback High School before landing the job with Arizona State, where he also played club volleyball.

A graduate of ASU, Swanson is married to the former Erin Meier. The couple has two daughters, Rylee Sue and Haylen Rae.
