2008 (JUNIOR): Earned first-team *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District III accolades from the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA)...Played in 29 matches, starting twice in the rotation and 23 times at libero...Played libero in 93 of the team's 111 sets...Led the team in digs on 18 occasions, tops on the team...Averaged a team-best 3.84 digs per set, ranking sixth in the Southeastern Conference and 163rd in the nation... Her 3.92 digs-per-set average in SEC play ranked eighth in the league... 13 times...Her 13 aces tied for fifth on the squad...Topped the squad with a 3.76 digs-per-set average, which ranked ninth in the SEC...She improved that to 3.87 digs per set in league action, which stood 10th in conference matches only...Compiled a 94-percent serve-reception percentage for the second-consecutive year...Tied the program record for digs in a match with 36 in the 3-2 victory over Arkansas (11/2)...That outing tied for the fourth best in league play for the season...Had five other contests with over 20 digs, with three coming in a row at Mississippi State (9/30) and at home against Tennessee (10/5) and Kentucky (10/7)...Compiled six matches where she was perfect on serve reception while getting to 10 or more...Three of those came in a four-match stretch in SEC play: at Mississippi (9/23) and Alabama (9/28) and at home versus Tennessee (10/5)...Duplicated that run at the end of the season, as she was perfect at Kentucky (11/9) and Tennessee (11/11) and at home against Alabama (11/18)...Credited with a season-high five assists at Mississippi State (9/30)...Recorded two aces on three occasions in a five-match stretch at the beginning of the year... Named to the SEC Volleyball Community Service Team...Also named to the SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll...Garnered third-team recognition from CoSIDA on their ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District III squads.


2006 (FRESHMAN): A walk-on who played in all 32 of the Gamecocks' matches and made 11 starts...Started at libero in four contests...Started the final five matches of the season...Finished fourth on the team in total digs with 214...Her 1.86 digs per set ranked fifth for the Gamecocks...Upped her digs per set average to 2.16 in conference matches...Reach double digits in the digs category eight times...Was South Carolina's second-most accurate server with a 95.2 percent figure...One of the Gamecocks' top receivers on serves as well, with a 94-percent success rate that ranked third...Had the first 10-plus-dig effort of her career in a win at Clemson (8/31) with 10... Did not miss a serve on her 10 tries versus the Tigers as well...Made her first career start the following day against Tennessee State and connected on 17-of-18 service reception attempts...Played an important role in South Carolina's 3-2 win against Auburn (9/15) by recording 11 digs and going 11for-11 and 15-for-15 on service returns and attempts... Had just one miss on the 21 balls served her way when the Gamecocks stunned then-No. 6 Florida (9/17), 3-1, to snap a 25-match losing streak to the Gators...Posted her third double-figure dig outing of the season with 10 against Alabama (10/1)...Did not miss a serve or return versus the Crimson Tide either...Had a stretch from Sept. 24 to Oct. 15 where she returned 70 serves without an error... Started 27 matches and played in 29...Played in 106 sets, fourth-most on the squad...Led the team and the Southeastern Conference and stood 52nd in NCAA Division I with a 10.57 assists-per-set average...During league action, she had a 10.75 assists-per-set average, more than 0.5 assists better than the person following her...Helped the Gamecocks to their highest team hitting percentage in over six years...Personally compiled a .253 hitting percentage herself with a 0.61 kills-per-set mark...Ranked fourth on the team with a 2.12 digs-per-frame average...Guided the team to hitting percentages north of .400 on six occasions and above .500 twice...Both of those were record-setting performances, first with a overall program-best .587 hitting percentage against South Carolina State (10/23) and a team record in an SEC match of .536 against Mississippi State (11/23)...The team put away 66 percent of her set attempts against the SCSU Bulldogs...Collected 50+ sets on seven occasions...Tallied double-doubles on eight occasions...Two of those came at the Arizona State Sheraton Invite (8/29-30), with 37 assists and a season-best 15 digs against Dayton and 52 assists and 12 digs against UNLV...Had 50 assists and a season-best four blocks in the three-set win over the College of Charleston (9/12)...Followed that with 52 helpers and 13 digs in the win over Clemson (9/12)...Had assists on 52 percent of her attempts, while matching her season-best with four blocks in the Winthrop sweep (9/13)...Named to the Carolina Challenge All-Tournament Team... Tallied 52 assists and 11 digs at Mississippi (9/26)...Made 37 assists and 12 digs in the victory over Tennessee (10/10)...Compiled 39 assists and 10 digs at Auburn (10/19)...Had a season-best 59 assists in the match at LSU (10/26)...Dished out 50 assists to go with 11 digs in the win over Mississippi (11/2)...Had a season-high seven kills, 54 assists and 12 digs at Tennessee (11/16)...Followed that with six kills and 39 assists in the sweep of Alabama (11/21).

2006-07 (UCONN): A two-time second-team AII-BIG EAST setter for the Huskies...Averaged 12.59 assists per game and 2.70 digs per game during her two years in Storrs...Totaled 89 blocks in two seasons (0.43 per game)...Ranked 46th in the nation in both 2006 and 2007 in assists per game...Left Connecticut standing fifth on the Huskies' all-time assist charts with 2,631...Her 2007 total of 1,324 was the fourth-best season in program history, while her freshman year stands sixth (1,307 assists)...Voted as UConn's team MVP as a freshman...Earned BIG EAST Rookie of the Week once (9/12/06)...Finished second on the team with a 2.96 digs-per-game average as a sophomore and third as a freshman (2.43)...One of the leading servers for the Huskies, averaging 0.36 aces per game (75 total)...Also dangerous herself in scoring, compiling a 0.73 kills-per-game average in two years with a .259 hitting percentage...During her freshman season, she ranked in the BIG EAST top 10 in both assists and service aces.



2008 (JUNIOR): Named to the 2008 American Volleyball Coaches Association All-South Region honorable mention team...Drew the starting assignment in all 30 matches while ranking as one of two players to see time in all 111 sets...Led the Gamecocks with a 3.61 kills-per-set average and with 35 aces...Ranked third in the Southeastern Conference and 76th nationally in kills per set and seventh in the league and 167th in Division I with a 0.32 service ace average...In SEC matches only, she ranked fourth with 3.57 kills per set and tied for sixth with 0.31 aces per set...Ranked third on the team with a .256 hitting percentage, good enough for 316th in the country...Ranked second on the team with a 2.82 digs-per-frame mark, which stood 13th in the league...Topped the squad with her 518 reception attempts...Finished in the top two in kills on 28 occasions, leading the squad in 17 of those matches... Also led the team eight times each in digs and blocks...Turned in 25 doubledigit kill contests and 17 10+ dig affairs...Compiled perfect serve reception percentages 11 times...Named to the all-tournament team in each of the three pre-conference tourneys in which the Gamecocks competed: the Arizona State Sheraton Invite, the Art Carmichael Classic and the Carolina Challenge...Named the MVP of the Carolina Challenge after collecting 48 kills and 36 digs in the wins over the College of Charleston, Clemson and Winthrop...Had her season high of 22 kills in the Clemson match (9/12), making six kills in the fifth set, four of those coming to either stave off or set up match point against the archrival Tigers...Also earned SEC Offensive and CVU.com National Player of the Week accolades after the Carolina Challenge...Had 20 kills in the Rhode Island victory (9/5), starting a streak of 12 consecutive contests in double figures in kills...Racked up five aces and 11 digs in the sweep of Boston College (9/5)...Hit .464 (15-2-28) in the sweep of Georgia (9/21)...Matched that output exactly in the win at Mississippi State (10/3) while adding a season-best five aces... Had 18 kills in the sweep over Tennessee (10/10)...Rebounded from two tough matches against nationallyranked foes to tally double-doubles in the next five SEC matches, starting

and ending with the matches against Auburn (10/19-11/7)...The only non-double-double in the stretch came against South Carolina State, when she set a personal best with a .522 hitting percentage on 14 kills...Made 20 kills at LSU (10/26)...Collected a career-high 21 digs to go with four blocks and 14 kills in the SEC-TV match at Tennessee (11/16)...Compiled 16 kills with a .433 hitting clip in the home win over Alabama (11/21)...Hit .429 (14-2-28) against Mississippi State (11/23)...Had 17 kills and 10 digs against No. 14 Florida (11/26)...Garnered recognition on the SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll for the second time.

2007 (SOPHOMORE): One of three Gamecocks to start all 29 matches... Sat out just one game in the 106 played...Carolina's leading attacker with 3.32 kills per game...Also topped the squad in reception attempts (667) and reception percentage (.961)...Stood fourth on the team in digs (2.37 per game)...Finished fifth with 44 total blocks...Led the team in kills on 10 occasions and in digs and blocks once each...Topped the squad with 12 double-doubles...Had double-digit kills in 17 outings, including the team's best of 26 at Georgia (10/19)...Collected 10+ digs in 14 matches...Had a five-match stretch where she was the leading attacker for the Gamecocks (10/14-10/28)... Had two five-contest streaks of double-digit kills and another skein of four...Also had double-double streaks of four and five matches... Hit over .450 in three matches: versus Binghamton (8/24), against Troy (9/7) and Appalachian State (9/8)...Named to the Gamecock Nike Invitational All-Tournament Team after hitting .393 (31-7-61) and compiling 29 digs in the three matches...Opened SEC play with a 20-kill, 19-dig performance against Auburn (9/14)...The 19 digs were her season high...Started her first run of 10+ kills with 15 at Mississippi (9/23)...Started the shorter double-double streak at Alabama with 13 kills and 12 digs...Had 15 kills in each of the final two games of the streak while adding 11 and 10 digs, respectively, against Tennessee (10/5) and Kentucky (10/7)... After just one match, started the second streak with 12 successful attacks and 12 digs at Arkansas (10/14)... Followed the Georgia high with 17 at Auburn (10/21)...Closed out that streak with 21 kills and 14 digs against Mississippi (10/26) and 17 and 10 versus the LSU Tigers (10/28)...Also had a high of five blocks, including two solos. against the Rebels...Had two aces on four occasions, including three times in the final nine...Earned SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll accolades.

2006 (FRESHMAN): Played in all but two matches for South Carolina and made 17 starts...Averaged close to one kill per game for the year...Her 0.86 blocks per game was second on the team to Belita Salters...Led the Gamecocks in blocks during SEC matches with a 1.07 average...Also increased her kills per game to 1.15 for league contests...Served up a season-high four aces in her first career match at TCU (8/25)...Became a major factor


