2008-09 Season Review

Another Top-15 Finish for Gamecocks

South Carolina hovered near the nation's top 10 most of the 2008-09 season, but settled for a final national ranking of 12th according to the GolfWorld/Nike NGCA polls and 13th according to the GolfWeek/Sagarin Ratings Index. The Gamecocks were rated 14th by GolfStat's head-to-head standings.

Through 12 tournaments, the Gamecocks posted a 290.88 stroke average, which ranks third in school history. South Carolina also captured four tournament titles on the season, tying the 1990-91 squad for the school record in tournament victories. The low round of the season came in the final round of the NCAA Southeast Regional, when a blistering 64 by senior Mark Silvers III helped South Carolina to a 269 and a tie for second place, earning a spot in the NCAA Championship.

Return to the NCAA Championship

South Carolina fought through a very difficult course setup at Inverness Club in Toledo, Ohio and battled strong winds throughout the tournament to post a 16thplace finish at the 112th NCAA Men's Golf Championship. A rough stretch of nine holes in the first round left the Gamecocks fighting their way back up the leaderboard throughout the final two rounds, and they finished with a total score of 885 (+33), 16 shots out of the top eight and a berth in the match play quarterfinals.

Mark Silvers III played his final tournament as a Gamecock and went out in style, leading the team with an 18th-place finish at 215 (+2). He posted the only sub-70 round for Carolina during the championship, carding a second-round 69. Freshman Wesley Bryan also finished strong, shooting 219 (+6) for the tournament to tie for 36th place. George Bryan IV (225), Patrick Rada (230) and Sam Braver (234) were the other finishers for South Carolina.

The Gamecocks earneed their third trip to the championship in four years on the strength of a second-place finish at the Southeast Regional at RedTail Golf Club in Sorrento, Fla.

Gamecocks Rack Up SEC Honors

Mark Silvers III was named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year for men's golf. Silvers joined junior George Bryan IV on the All-SEC Second Team, and Wesley Bryan was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team.

Silvers, a four-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll, carries a 3.909 grade point average while majoring in finance. In addition, he was named a Cleveland Golf All-America Scholar in both 2008 and 2009. Through 12 events, the senior led the team with 72.74 stroke average. His best finish came at the General Jim Hackler Invitational where he tied for third place with a 291 (+3). His low round came at the NCAA Southeast Regional, where he shot a personal-best final-round 64 (-7).

George Bryan IV earned his second All-SEC honor in three years, adding a second-team selection to his first-team honor a year ago. The junior from Chapin, S.C., finished with a 72.82 stroke average through 12 events with a low score of 65 at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate. Bryan had five top-10 finishes on the year, including a pair of runner-up showings at the Schenkel E-Z-Go Invitational (also a Carolina team victory) and the Hootie at Bulls Bay.

Wesley Bryan made an immediate impact on South Carolina golf as a freshman as he was third on the team with a 73.09 stroke average, earning a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team. Also a native of Chapin, Wesley Bryan tied with teammate Paul Woodbury for medalist honors at the Rees Jones Intercollegiate at 218 (+2), helping the Gamecocks to the team title. Bryan's last two events have been his best since the Rees Jones victory as he earned a tie for 10th place at the SEC Championship and a 14th-place tie at the Cavalier Classic.

Silvers, Bryan IV Named All-Americans

Senior Mark Silvers III and junior George Bryan IV added another honor to their ever-growing lists as they were named Honorable Mention All-Americans by the Golf Coaches' Association of America. It was the second honorable mention honor for Bryan and the first for Silvers.

South Carolina Men's Golf 2008-09 Season Review

Four Times a Champion

For only the second time in school history, a South Carolina men's team captured four tournament titles during the 2008-09 regular season. The first win came in the second tournament of the year as the Gamecocks won the Mason Rudolph Intercollegiate in Franklin, Tenn., Sept. 26-28. After a shaky outing in rough conditions at the Isleworth Intercollegiate, the Gamecocks ran away with the Rees Jones Intercollegiate title Nov. 3-4 in Daufuskie Island, S.C.

The Gamecocks then earned their biggest win of the season in taking down a strong field at the Schenkel E-Z-Go Invitational in Statesboro, Ga., March 20-22. Following a fourth-place showing at the SEC Championship, the Gamecocks won the weather-shortened Cavalier Classic in Charlottesville, Va.


Since joining the SEC in 1992, South Carolina has now won 14 team titles, including the 2007 NCAA West Regional.

Individually Incredible

The Gamecocks combined to grab 14 top-10 individual finishes in tournament play, including a twosome that tied for a tournament title. Freshman Wesley Bryan and junior Paul Woodbury shared medalist honors at the Rees Jones Intercollegiate, giving South Carolina its first individual title since George Bryan IV won the 2008 Schenkel E-Z-Go Invitational.

Junior Paul Woodbury carded a hole-in-one on the fifth hole of his second round at the Rees Jones Intercollegiate, the only one by a Gamecock during the 2008-09 season. His ace, along with a stretch of three straight birdies, left him in second place following the second round of the tournament. A strong final round would propel the native of Lake City, S.C., to a share of medalist honors along with teammate Wesley Bryan.

Endless Summer

- Wesley Bryan finished runner-up at the North and South Amateur at Pinehurst No. 2. He fell in the final match to Stanford's David Chung, 4 and 3. Bryan led a contingent of five Gamecocks in the event, including George Bryan IV, Mark Silvers III, Patrick Rada and Paul Woodbury.
- George Bryan IV finished second at the Players Amateur in Bluffton, S.C. Bryan shot 284 (-4) over the four-day event, finishing two strokes back of Alabama's Bud Cauley. Bryan was just ahead of last year's tournament winner, former Gamecock Mark Anderson.
- Wesley Bryan made it to the quarterfinals of the U.S. Amateur Public Links Championship before falling to Washington's Nick Taylor, 2 and 1.
- Wesley Bryan and George Bryan IV tied for 17th at the Porter Cup in Niagara Falls
- Paul Woodbury qualified for the U.S. Amateur Championship as the medalist in the Carthage, N.C., sectional qualifier. He was joined by Wesley Bryan and Patrick Rada at Southern Hills Country Club in Tulsa, Okla.; Rada and Bryan advanced to match play.




