FOR STARTERS

South Carolina (5-3) hosts Appalachian State (4-3) on Tuesday afternoon at Founders Park. First pitch is scheduled for 4 p.m.

The game will be broadcast live on SEC Network Plus and can be heard on the Gamecock IMG Network including flagship station, 107.5 FM, "The Game."

RANKINGS

South Carolina is ranked in all six major collegiate rankings. The Gamecocks are ranked No. 4 in the USA Today coaches poll, No. 5 in the nation by Baseball America, D1Baseball and Perfect Game No. 6 by the NCBWA and No. 13 by Collegiate Baseball.

RECAP

South Carolina went 3-2 last week with a win over Charlotte, a loss to Kansas State and a series victory over No. 25 Wright State. The Gamecocks are 5-3 on the year.

TO ARMS

The South Carolina pitching staff continues to impress as it struck out 39 batters in 27.0 innings of the Wright State series and limited the Raiders offense to just a .219 average over the weekend.

For the season, the pitching staff has a 2.38 team ERA and has allowed $\overline{26}$ runs, 19 earned, on 50 hits in 72.0 innings with 81 strikeouts to 22 walks and a .190 opposing batting average. That opposing batting average ranks second in the SEC with the ERA and strikeout total currently third best in the conference.

South Carolina's pitching staff was strong the entire opening weekend vs. UNCG as the Gamecock pitchers combined to allow just three runs, one earned, on 10 hits with 27 strikeouts in 27 innings of work. UNCG, who led the NCAA in hitting in 2016, hit just .115 with a .149 slugging percentage and a .179 on-base percentage. The three runs allowed over the weekend was the lowest total of an opening weekend since the Gamecocks allowed just two in the opening series of 2004 vs. Charleston Southern.

AT THE PLATE & ON THE FIELD

The Gamecocks are hitting .278 (73-for-263) as a team for the year with a .358 on-base percentage and a .348 slugging mark. The Gamecocks are fielding .971 for the season.

South Carolina hit .270 (27-for-100) in the Wright State series with a .360 on base percentage. South Carolina has equaled or out-hit its opponent in all eight games this season.

SUPERLATIVES

South Carolina is 5-1 on the year when scoring first in a game and 4-0 when entering the seventh inning with a lead and 5-0 when entering the ninth inning with the lead. The Gamecocks are 2-0 when scoring six or more runs and 5-2 when allowing five runs or less. South Carolina is 2-2 in games decided by three runs or less.

WELCOME BACK WIL

Junior right-hander Wil Crowe is now 2-0 on the year with a 0.79 ERA after allowing just one run on four hits in 6.1 innings with a walk and nine strikeouts in the 10-5 win over Wright State on Saturday afternoon. Crowe has 16 strikeouts to just two walks in 11.1 innings with opposing hitters .171 against him. He has allowed just one run on seven hits in his first two starts. Crowe is one of 18 SEC pitchers with two wins. He is seventh in the SEC in strikeouts and 12th in ERA.

Crowe struck out seven in five scoreless innings of work in his first appearance since April 10, 2015 in the Gamecocks' 5-1 win over UNCG on February 18. Crowe allowed just three hits and one walk to earn the victory.

WILLIAMS IS A HIT

Junior first baseman Matt Williams has hit safely in six consecutive games. Williams has played in all eight games with four starts and owns a .412 batting average (7-for-17) with a pair of runs scored and four RBI. Williams had a key two-run single in the first inning of Friday's 4-3 win over Wright State. Williams drove in four runs in the series.

START WITH CLARKE

Junior right-hander Clarke Schmidt had a no-decision after allowing three runs, all unearned, on four hits in 6.1 innings with a walk and 11 strikeouts in the 4-3 win over Wright State on Friday night. Schmidt's 11 strikeouts tied a career-high he set last year vs. Arkansas on March 18, 2016. Schmidt is 1-0 on the year with a 0.69 ERA and 14 strikeouts in 13.0 innings pitched. Opponents are hitting .146 against him. Schmidt is tied for sixth in the SEC in innings pitched, ninth in ERA and opposing batting average and tied for 10th in strikeouts.

Schmidt won on Opening Day vs. UNCG allowing just one run on three hits in 6.2 innings with two walks and three strikeouts.

DYNAMIC DESTINO

Junior designated hitter/outfielder Alex Destino is South Carolina's top run producer with a pair of home runs and a team-high nine RBI on the year. Destino is batting .323 (10-for-31) for the season with five runs scored and two doubles as well. He has a team-best .581 slugging percentage. Destino enters the week with a five-game hitting streak. He is tied for fifth in the SEC in home runs and tied for ninth in RBI.

JOHNSON BRINGS THE HEAT

Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson earned two saves this past week with 1.1 innings of work in the 5-4 win over Charlotte followed by a scoreless ninth inning in which he struck out the side in the 4-3 victory over Wright State on Friday night. Johnson has five strikeouts in 2.1 innings in his two relief appearances this year. Johnson is tied for second in the SEC in saves.

OLSON PROVIDES A SPARK

Sophomore utility player Jacob Olson cleared the bases with a three-run double in the first inning of Saturday's 10-5 win over Wright State. Olson is hitting .308 (8-for-26), third-best on the team, with a pair of doubles, four RBI and five runs scored. Olson hit his first career homer in the 5-4 victory over Charlotte.

BOWERS BRINGS IT

Senior right-hander Colie Bowers won two games this past week in relief as he picked up the win in the 5-4 victory vs. Charlotte and a win vs. Wright State in Friday's nights' 4-3 victory. Bowers has not allowed a run in four relief appearances and has eight strikeouts to one walk and just one hit allowed in 6.2 innings of work. Bowers pitched two scoreless innings in the 5-4 win over Charlotte not allowing a hit and he also did not allow a hit and walked just one in 2.1 innings of the 4-3 win over Wright State. Bowers is one of 18 SEC pitchers with two wins.

BLAIR ON BASE

Sophomore outfielder Danny Blair is South Carolina's leading hitter after two weeks of action with a .357 batting average (10-for-28). He also leads the Gamecocks with a .419 on-base percentage. Blair has reached base safely in all eight games this year.

Blair had his best series at the plate in a Gamecock uniform in his career as he went 6-for-11 (.545) to lead the Gamecocks at the plate in the UNCG series. Blair also scored a pair of runs, drove in two and stole two bags. He finished with a .545 on-base and slugging percentage as well.

HILL ON THE MOUND

Despite the loss in Sunday's 5-1 defeat to Wright State, sophomore right-hander Adam Hill was effective allowing just three runs on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Although he is 0-2 on the year, he maintains a 1.50 ERA and has 13 strikeouts to four walks in 12.0 innings. Opponents are hitting only .100 against him, ranking him third in the SEC.

STOKES IS RISING

Junior infielder Madison Stokes reached base in seven of 14 plate appearances vs. Wright State and hit .364 (4-for-11) in the series. Senior left-hander Josh Reagan has not allowed a run in four relief appearances this year. Reagan has five strikeouts in 4.1 innings with opponents batting .133 against him.

JONAH WITH A JOLT

Junior infielder Jonah Bride was South Carolina's top hitter in the Wright State series going 4-for-9 (.444) with a run scored and a pair of RBI.

GREAT SCOTT

Senior right-hander Reed Scott had a pair of appearances last week vs. Kansas State and Wright State. Scott owns a 2.25 ERA in 12.0 innings of work with nine strikeouts and opponents batting .227 against him.

Scott picked up his first save of the year going four innings in the 5-1 win. Scott allowed one run, unearned, on two hits in four innings with three strikeouts.

TJ LEADS IT OFF

Sophomore outfielder TJ Hopkins hit his first triple of the season in the 10-5 win over Wright State and 1-for-3 with two runs in the 4-3 victory over the Raiders.

Hopkins was 3-for-4 with a pair of doubles in the 7-1 season opening victory over UNCG. Hopkins also drove in a pair of runs in the victory.

THERE'S HUNTER TAYLOR

Junior catcher Hunter Taylor had a career-high three hits and scored a run in the 10-5 win over Wright State. Two of Taylor's three hits were doubles.

THAT'S TOLBERT

Sophomore infielder LT Tolbert went 2-for-3 with a RBI and a walk in the 6-5 loss to Kansas State.

ROW WITH IT

Junior infielder Justin Row has played in four games with three starts and is hitting .273 (3-for-11) with a double, two runs scored and three RBI.

WELCOME TO GAMECOCK NATION

Four Gamecocks made their debut in the weekend series vs. UNCG. Olson, junior infielder Justin Row, freshman infielder/outfielder Carlos Cortes and freshman first baseman Riley Hogan all made appearances. Also making their debut last week were right-handers Sawyer Bridges and Graham Lawson.

LOOK AT THE CROWD

South Carolina had pair of sellouts over the weekend and totaled 24,501 in attendance the first weekend for an average of 8,167 per contest at Founders Park. That is the fifth-highest series total in Founders Park history and the highest series total since the 2014 season.

SCOUTING APPALACHIAN STATE

Appalachian State heads into Tuesday's game with a 4-3 overall record. Head coach Kermit Smith is in his first season at the helm of the Mountaineers. Appalachian State is fresh off a three-game sweep over Gardner-Webb this past weekend.

Freshman infielder Calev Grubbs, a Lexington, S.C. native and a product of White Knoll HS, is the team's current leading hitter with a .346 average (9-for-26) with two doubles and five runs scored. Senior outfielder Brian Bauk is App State's leading run producer with six RBI to go along with a .318 average.

Sophomore left-hander Bobby Hampton won a midweek start last week with seven scoreless innings and just two hits allowed with nine strikeouts in a 3-1 win over VMI. Junior right-hander Reed Howell and senior right-hander Matt Brill each have saves out of the bullpen for the Mountaineers. Howell has seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings in three relief appearances and Brill has eight strikeouts in four innings in three relief appearances.

South Carolina leads the series history 13-1 including a 5-0 victory last season. In last year's game, Adam Hill struck out 11 batters his first career outing. He pitched six scoreless innings and allowed just two hits and no walks. Gene Cone went 3-for-4 with two runs, Jonah Bride was 1-for-2 with two runs as well and Marcus Mooney finished with two RBI.

WEEKEND ROTATION

Junior right-hander Clarke Schmidt, junior right-hander Wil Crowe and sophomore right-hander Adam Hill will headline the Opening Weekend rotation for the Gamecocks as announced by head coach Chad Holbrook Monday afternoon. Schmidt will start Opening Day vs. UNCG with Crowe taking the mound in Saturday's contest for the Gamecocks and Hill getting the ball for the series finale on Sunday.

This will be the second straight year that Schmidt gets the ball on Opening Day. Schmidt has been named Preseason All-America by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game and earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA last year after going 9-5 with a 3.40 ERA. He struck out 129 batters to 27 walks in 111.1 innings pitched with opponents hitting .248 against him. Schmidt's 129 strikeouts are the second-highest among returning pitchers from last season in Division I baseball.

Crowe is a Preseason All-America selection by Baseball America and returns to the mound this season after sitting out the 2016 campaign recovering from Tommy John surgery. Crowe went 8-3 and earned Freshman All-America honors in 2014 with a 2.75 ERA in 91.2 innings pitched. Opponents hit .228 against him. He also won three games in 2015 before suffering the injury that sidelined him the rest of the season.

Hill earned Freshman All-America last year after going 7-0 with a 3.53 ERA. He allowed 26 runs, all earned, on 49 hits in 66.1 innings. He had 72 strikeouts to 28 walks; opponents are batting .208 against him. That opposing batting average was fourth-best in the SEC. He was also named to the SEC All-Freshman team.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Five Gamecocks have received Preseason All-America honors this year.

Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson is a first-team selection by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game. Last season, Johnson went 3-2 with a 2.42 ERA and had nine saves. Johnson struck out 59 to just eight walks in 52.0 innings in 29 relief appearances. Eight of Johnson's nine saves were in league play, the most by any SEC pitcher. Johnson pitched on USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team over the summer.

Schmidt has been named Preseason All-America by D1Baseball, the NCBWA and Perfect Game and earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA last year after going 9-5 with a 3.40 ERA.

Crowe is a third-team Preseason All-America selection by Baseball America and returns to the mound this season after sitting out the 2016 campaign recovering from Tommy John surgery.

Junior Alex Destino earned second-team honors from the NCBWA. Destino is South Carolina's leading returning hitter as he hit .321 last season with 10 homers and 59 RBI in 60 games with 59 starts.

Senior left-hander Josh Reagan received third-team accolades from Collegiate Baseball. Reagan returns for his senior year after going 3-2 with 11 saves in 29 relief appearances. He posted a 2.08 ERA last year and struck out 50 batters in 56.1 innings. Opponents hit .172 against him.

BRAG FACTS

South Carolina won the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship in 2010 and 2011 at the College World Series. South Carolina has made 11 College World Series appearances including six times in the last 15 years. In those 11 appearances, the Gamecocks are 32-20 for a .615 winning percentage, that is sixth-best among winning percentage leaders in CWS history. South Carolina is one of three schools in the nation to have reached at least 12 NCAA Super Regionals since 2000 and has the most NCAA Super Regional appearances of the 14 SEC schools since 2000. In addition, the Gamecocks own the second-highest win total in Division I baseball since 2000 (791-332 record) and more conference wins than any SEC team since 2000 (308-198 record).

Recently, South Carolina is one of only four schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in six of the last seven years. South Carolina has ranked among the top three in the nation in total attendance for six consecutive years including a mark of 293,677 last year. South Carolina averaged a total of 7,162 fans at Founders Park in the 2016 season.

GAMECOCKS PREDICTED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE SEC EAST

South Carolina has been predicted to finish second in the SEC Eastern Division as voted by the league's 14 head coaches in the annual preseason poll announced on Thursday. Junior right-hander Tyler Johnson was a first-team Preseason All-SEC selection with junior Alex Destino garnering second-team honors.

South Carolina received four first place votes for the Eastern Division as well as two first place votes as SEC champion. South Carolina won its seventh SEC Eastern Division title last year with a 20-9 conference record.

Florida and LSU each garnered six votes for SEC Champion in the preseason poll. The Gators were predicted to win the SEC Eastern Division, while the Tigers were the favorite to win the SEC West.

Since 1996, the SEC has named a regular season champion as well as a tournament champion. Prior to 1996, the tournament champion was considered the SEC champion.

Points were compiled on a descending basis for each division. Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team, and each coach also voted for one team as an overall conference champion.

Conference play is set to begin March 17. A total of seven SEC teams qualified for NCAA Regionals in 2016, and a record four teams were selected as national seeds.

Head Coach Chad Holbrook

Chad Holbrook is in his fifth season as head coach of the South Carolina program and has spent over 20 seasons coaching college baseball including two national championship staffs with five national championship series appearances, six College World Series trips and 17 NCAA Regionals.

As head coach of the Gamecock program, South Carolina has made three NCAA Regional appearances in the last four years with two NCAA Super Regional appearances in 2013 and 2016. Under Holbrook's direction, South Carolina is one of only nine schools in the nation to host a NCAA Regional in three of the last four seasons (2013, 2014, 2016). In addition, South Carolina is one of just three schools in the SEC to finish among the top four teams in three of the last four seasons and one of four schools in the league to win at least 40 games in a single season in three of four years as well.

Holbrook's 2016 team won 46 games, the most in Holbrook's four seasons as head coach of the Garnet & Black and won the 2016 SEC Eastern Division title as Carolina made its 31st trip to the NCAA Division I Baseball Tournament and its 12th appearance in the NCAA Super Regional. The Gamecocks went 20-9 in the SEC with five sweeps in the 30-game conference slate. It marked just the fifth time Carolina reached 20 or more wins in the conference. The Gamecocks fought back from an opening round loss in the NCAA Columbia Regional to win four straight games and advance to the NCAA Super Regional. Attendance at Founders Park totaled 293,677, the third-highest mark in the country.

Right-handers Clarke Schmidt and Braden Webb earned All-America honors in 2016 with Webb also the Freshman Pitcher of the Year by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. Schmidt won nine games and struck out 129 batters, the seventh-highest total by a pitcher in school history. Webb pitched his way to unanimous Freshman All-America accolades with 10 wins, the most victories by a Gamecock in five seasons and he struck out a freshman record 128 batters in 102.0 innings pitched. Junior outfielder Gene Cone was named first-team All-SEC after leading the team with a .363 average (78-for-215) and an on-base percentage of .474, the best mark in the SEC. Schmidt was a second-team All-SEC choice. Freshman right-hander Adam Hill also picked up Freshman All-America recognition with Hill, Webb, catcher Chris Cullen and infielder LT Tolbert named to the SEC All-Freshman team, the first time in school history that the Gamecocks had four players in a single season earn that distinction.

The 2016 South Carolina pitching staff was among the best in the nation averaging 9.7 strikeouts per nine innings, second-most in the country with a WHIP of 1.21, 14th best in the nation. Carolina showcased itself on the diamond with a .978 fielding percentage, second-highest in the SEC and 12th in the country. Carolina also improved at the plate with a .291 batting average, up 34 points from the previous year to go along with a .381 on-base percentage and a .412 slugging mark.

Seven Gamecocks heard their names called in the 2016 MLB Draft including four selections in the top 10 rounds. Webb was a third round selection by the Milwaukee Brewers, junior outfielder Dom Thompson-Williams a fifth round selection by the New York Yankees, senior infielder Marcus Mooney a 10th round selection by the Atlanta Braves, Cone a 10th round selection by the New York Mets, right-handed pitcher Taylor Widener a 12th round selection by the New York Yankees, right-handed pitcher Wil Crowe a 21st round selection by the Cleveland Indians and right-handed pitcher Matt Vogel a 25th round selection by the Tampa Bay Rays.

The Gamecocks succeeded in the classroom in the 2015-16 academic year as well with South Carolina's 3.186 GPA in the spring of 2016 the highest team GPA in season in the history of the baseball program.

Holbrook is 165-81 for a winning percentage of .671 in four seasons at the helm of the Gamecock program.

He was named head baseball coach for the University of South Carolina on July 16, 2012, promoted to the top spot by athletics director Ray Tanner after four seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. Holbrook came to South Carolina in July 2008 as associate head coach. Along with his recruiting coordinator duties, he served as hitting instructor, oversaw the Gamecock offense, including base running and the short game and was the third base coach. He also worked with the outfielders. Holbrook came to the Gamecock program after serving 15 seasons as a member of the University of North Carolina coaching staff. Holbrook was the 2011 ABCA/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year after the Gamecocks won a second consecutive national championship.

A tremendous evaluator of talent, Holbrook was named the No. 10 best recruiter in all of college sports by ESPNU & ESPN The Magazine in the publication's 2011 January edition. The list was put together in conjunction with three-dozen experts who were asked the question: Who are the top 20 recruiters in college sports? Holbrook was the only baseball coach on the list.
