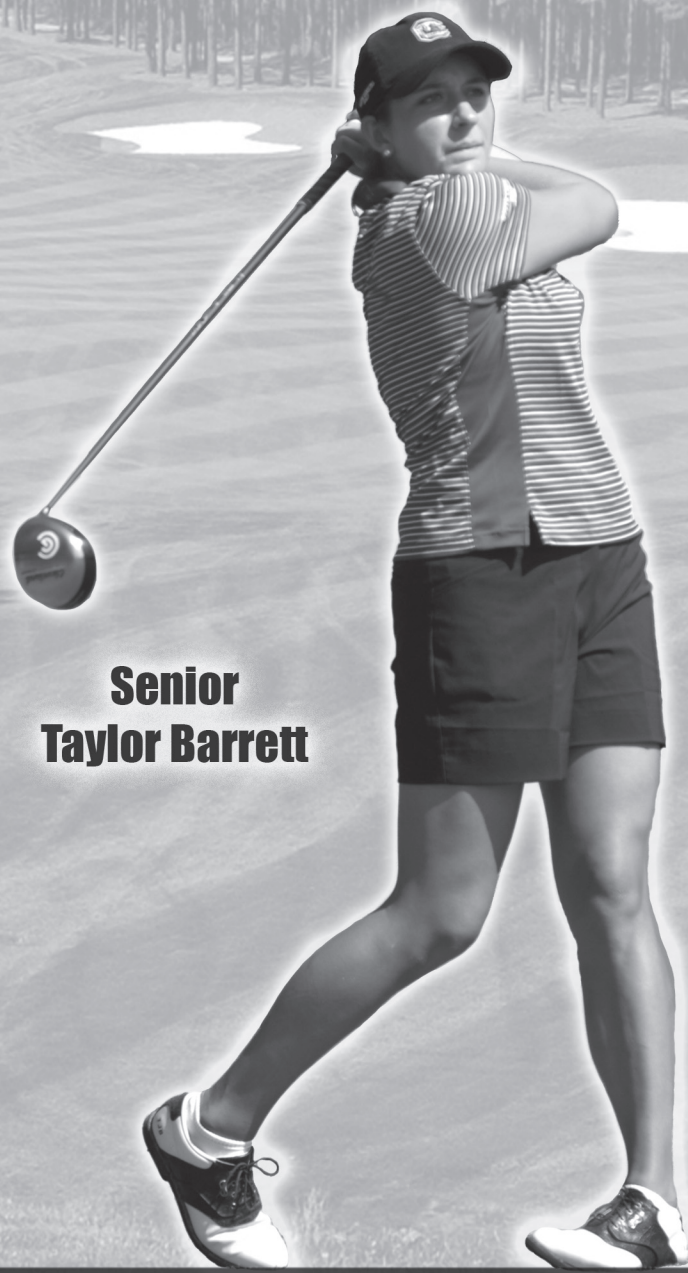

2008-09 Season Review



## Gamecocks Wrap Up Season with 11th Straight Regional Appearance

South Carolina fell just short of a second-straight NCAA Championship appearance as it finished in 12th place at the NCAA East Regional May 7-9 at the Mark Bostick Golf Course in Gainesville, Fla. The Gamecocks turned in a total score of 897 (+57) after shooting 299 (+19) in the final round, falling eight strokes short. The regional got off to a rough start with a first-round 308 that left them toward the bottom of the standings, but they responded with the low round of the day in the second round, firing a 290 (+10) to jump back into contention.

Junior Bénédicte Toumpsin - who won the 2008 East Regional - again led the Gamecocks with rounds of 79-71-71=221 (+11) to tie for 30th place. Freshman Katie Burnett, playing in her first NCAA Regional, was one stroke back of Toumpsin at 75-72-75=222 (+12).

## Toumpsin Named All-SEC Again

South Carolina junior golfer Bénédicte Toumpsin was named to the All-Southeastern Conference Second Team, the league announced in late April. It marks Toumpsin's second selection to the All-SEC team after a spot on the first team a year ago. She was also named to the league's Community Service Team.

Toumpsin finished the season ranked 11th in the SEC with a 73.90 stroke average through 10 events. The junior had six top-20 finishes on the season, including a tie for first place at the LSU Classic in March. She also had an 11th-place finish at the Cougar Classic, a tie for 19th at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate, a tie for 20th at the Central District Invitational, and a tie for 13th at the Bryan National Collegiate. Her low round of 68 came in the final round of the LSU Classic before falling in a three-way playoff for the tournament title. Her stroke average was actually better in 2009 (73.90) than it was in 2008 (74.07) when she was a first-team selection.

## Toumpsin Runner-Up; Gamecocks Ninth at SEC

Junior Bénédicte Toumpsin earned a runner-up finish at the SEC Women's Golf Championships at Cobblestone Park Golf Club, firing a final-round 73 (+2) to finish at 214 (+1) for the tournament. As a team, the Gamecocks finished ninth at 897 (+45).

Toumpsin, playing on the Gamecocks' home course, shot a final-round 73 (+2) to hang on to second place overall, improving on her third-place finish at the 2008 championship. The native of Belgium birdied her first hole, but managed three bogeys and 14 pars the rest of the way to finish at 214 (+1) for the tournament, one shot ahead

of Georgia's Mallory Hetzel and four shots back of individual tournament champion Marta Silva of Georgia.

Freshman Katie Burnett completed a successful first appearance at the SEC Championship with a final-round 74 (+3) to finish at 226 (+13) overall, tied for 32nd place. Also in a tie for 32nd was junior Corrine Carr, who was one shot better on Sunday with a 76 (+5) to finish at 226 (+13) for the weekend. Junior Taylor Barrett improved each day of the tournament, carding a 75 (+4) to finish at 233 (+20) for the tournament in 44th place.

## "Bene" Brilliant on the Bayou

Bénédicte Toumpsin put together the best 54 holes of her collegiate career at the LSU Golf Classic March 13-15 in Baton Rouge, La., tying for first place at the annual event. Her bogey-free, final-round 68 (-4) marked the best final-round score in school history as she rallied to tie for the tournament title before falling on the second hole of a three-way playoff with Virginia's Calle Nielson and Arkansas' Lucy Nunn. Toumpsin tied her career-best 18-hole round with her final-round 68 and carded three straight rounds under par for the first time in her collegiate career - 70-71-68=209 (-7).

Her tie for first marked the highest finish for a South Carolina golfer since her victory at last season's NCAA East Regional. Her score of 209 also tied for the second-lowest 54-hole total in school history, matching a pair of efforts by current LPGA star Kristy McPherson, who shot 209 at the 2002 SEC Championship and the 2003 NCAA East Regional. As a team, South Carolina shot 287 (-1) in the final round en route to a 10th-place finish. It was the first time in school history that the Gamecocks finished in red figures in the final round of a tournament.



### Youth Movement

Some of the best play for South Carolina came from its freshmen, namely Katie Burnett. The freshman from Brunswick, Ga., turned in four top-20 performances on the year, including an eighth-place showing in her first collegiate competition at the season-opening Cougar Classic Sept. 14-16. Burnett carried a stroke average of 75.27, second-best on the team, and had a 17th-place finish at the Lady Tar Heel Invite, 16th at the LSU Classic and 20th at the Bryan National Collegiate. Fellow freshman Cayci Ruppe played well later in the season, grabbing a career-best 32nd-place finish at the Bryan National Collegiate with a score of 229 (+13). Taylor Weaver, the team's other freshman, played in one tournament, the LSU Golf Classic, then qualified for the U.S. Women's Amateur later in the summer.

### Strong Out of the Gate

South Carolina sent a message early in the season that despite their lack of depth, the Gamecocks were not to be taken lightly. A seventh-place finish at the Cougar Classic served notice that South Carolina had the talent to compete with the nation's best. Freshman Katie Burnett made a statement in her initial collegiate event, firing rounds of 70-70-73=213 (-1) to grab eighth place her first time out wearing the Garnet and Black. Bénédicte Toumpsin was strong as well, finishing in 11th place after rounds of 70-72-73=215 (+2). Taylor Barrett (76-76-74=226) and Meredith Taylor (74-78-77=229) also contributed to the Gamecocks' strong showing in the season opener.

### Summer Love

The Gamecock women didn't rest on their laurels during the summer of 2009 as most all of them competed in USGA qualifiers and various other tournaments.

- Taylor Barrett and Katie Burnett qualified for the U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links Championship and advanced to the second round of match play. Barrett never trailed in her first-round victory over Briana Mao (Folsom, Calif.) and went on to win, 2-up. Burnett had a tight first-rounder with Mari Chun, a Stanford graduate, but won the ninth and 10th holes and held on to win, 2 and 1. In the stroke play portion of the event, Barrett finished in a 13-way tie for 29th place at 4-over following rounds of 74-74=148. Burnett, in her first-ever USGA Championship event, tied for 43rd place in stroke play with rounds of 77-72=149.
- Bénédicte Toumpsin advanced to the sectional round of U.S. Women's Open qualifying as she tied for fourth in the local qualifier at Pinehurst, N.C. She tied for 23rd in the sectional qualifier at Sanford, N.C., with rounds of 73-78=151 (+7), missing the cut by five shots.
- Burnett, Barrett, Corrine Carr and Taylor Weaver all played in the North & South Women's Amateur at Pinehurst No. 2. Barrett and Carr both advanced to match play with Carr making it to the third round.
- Carr and Taylor Weaver qualified for the U.S. Women's Amateur by shooting matching scores of even-par 71 at the sectional qualifier in Lexington, N.C. The U.S. Women's Amateur was held Aug. 3-9 at Old Warson Country Club in St. Louis, Mo.
