Game Notables

- Tonight's game is the Gamecocks' second of three straight against ranked opponents. South Carolina will face a ranked foe in three of its next four games with just one of those coming at home.
- The Gamecocks are 6-9 against the Wildcats in the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 to present), including just one win in seven visits to Memorial Coliseum. That one win was a decisive one, though, with then-No. 4 South Carolina overwhelming then-No. 15 Kentucky 81-58 on Feb. 20, 2014. In the last three seasons, during which both teams have ranked among the nation's top 20 for each meeting, the Gamecocks are 4-3 against the Wildcats with four of the seven games decided by single digits - three of those in South Carolina's favor.
- Four SEC players average a double-double in league play this season, and two of them will take the court tonight n.
 - South Carolina's Alaina Coates (11.7 ppg/10.7 rpg) and Kentucky's Alexis Jennings (11.3 ppg/11.0 rpg).
 - In league play, South Carolina leads the SEC in nine different stats, including those centering on offensive and defensive efficiency - scoring, field goal percentage, scoring defense and field goal percentage defense.
 - Two-time SEC Player of the Year Tiffany Mitchell has been back in stride with her all-around game in 2016, ranking among the SEC's top 15 in league play in eight of 10 primary stats (excludes offensive and defensive rebounding and minutes per game). Mitchell is top 10 in seven of the eight and misses a ranking in just rebounding and blocked shots. No other SEC player is ranked in more than six stats.
 - Besides Tiffany Mitchell, five other Gamecocks rank among the league's top 15 in at least one stat in SEC play - Bianca Cuevas (steals) Alaina Coates (points, rebounds), Tina Roy (points, 3FG %age, 3FG/ game), Khadijah Sessions (steals, 3FG/game) and A'ja Wilson (rebounds, blocks).
 - South Carolina has ramped up its defense in 2016, allowing just 50.3 points per game on 32.1 percent shooting vs. 55.8 ppg on 33.5 percent shooting in 2015.

Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

South Carolina is enjoying its most successful period in program history. The 2015 Senior Class set a four-year record with 113 wins and a .813 winning percentage. The 2016 Senior Class has a chance top that number, currently holding a record of 103-16, winning 86.6 percent of its contests. Winning consecutive SEC regular-season titles in the last two seasons, South Carolina has not finished outside the SEC's top four in four campaigns. Nationally, 64 straight AP Poll appearances is the new program record.

In the last two seasons, three Gamecocks have earned All-America honors. Seven Gamecocks have earned All-SEC selection in the last two seasons, including three members of the 2015-16 squad.

Kentucky Series Notes

In what has become a heated rivalry over the last few seasons, Kentucky leads the series 33-22, including a 20-6 edge in Lexington. The gap closes to a 9-6 Kentucky advantage in South Carolina's Dawn Staley era with the Gamecocks holding a 4-3 edge in the last three seasons, during which four of the seven games were decided by single-digit points.

The teams split their home-and-home series two of the last three seasons with the Gamecocks sweeping the regularseason meetings in 2013-14, which Kentucky avenged with a win in the 2014 SEC Tournament semifinals.

South Carolina and Kentucky were both ranked in the AP top 10 in two previous meetings in the series, both of which went the Gamecocks' way in Columbia.

Road Warriors

Overall, South Carolina is 218-243 (.473) in road games, including a 49-34 (.590) record during the Dawn Staley era. After a difficult start as the Gamecocks' mentor, Staley has guided her team to three of the program's top five road records in program history, including 2013-14's school-record winning percentage of .833 (10-2). Last season's .818 winning percentage (9-2) was second-best, while the 2012-13 team's .733 (11-4) mark is fifth in program history.

This season, South Carolina is 4-0 in road games.

Ranked Readings

The Gamecocks have 13 games on the schedule against teams currently ranked in the top 25. South Carolina opened the season with a win over No. 6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13, 88-80), following that with victories over No. 16/18 Arizona State (Nov. 27, 60-58) and No. 14/13 Duke (Dec. 6, 66-55) in non-conference action and one over No. 20/- Missouri (Jan. 10, 83-58).

After posting an 18-8 record against ranked opponents since the start of the 2013-14 season, head coach Dawn Staley has a 29-42 mark vs. the nation's best teams during her South Carolina tenure, highlighted by a 17-8 mark when the Gamecocks carry a better ranking than their opponent into the contest.

South Carolina's 10 wins against ranked foes in 2014-15 set a program record, topping the eight wins of the 1979-80 squad. Of those wins, five came against a top-10 foe.

SEC Story

Head coach Dawn Staley has steadily lifted the Gamecocks' national profile by building the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender with back-to-back regular-season titles, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her eighth season at the helm, Staley boasts a 70-43 (.619) SEC regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five only two times in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 70 wins include four seasons of double-digit league victories – 10-6 in 2012, 11-5 in 2013, an SEC-best 14-2 in 2014 and 15-1 in 2015.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 40-18 (.690) mark at home and a 30-25 (.545) slate on the road.

Fast Start

South Carolina is looking to start a season 16-0 for just the second time in program history but the second time in as many seasons. The Gamecocks rocketed through the 2014-15 season with 22 straight victories. Prior to that, a 10-0 start was the program's best and was accomplished by the 1981-82, 2012-13 and 2013-14 teams.

Poll Position

South Carolina remains at No. 2 in the nation in both polls this week, marking the 28th-straight time the Gamecocks have been ranked among the nation's top three teams. South Carolina has held a top-10 position in the Associated Press poll for 39 straight weeks and been ranked in the AP top 25 for 64 consecutive weeks (beginning Dec. 10, 2012), breaking the school record of 62 from Feb. 27, 1979 through Jan. 9, 1983.

Strength in Numbers

Based on cumulative opponent winning percentage, South Carolina currently has the 15th toughest schedule in the nation. The 26 teams the Gamecocks will face this season have a current winning percentage of .655. The SEC dominates the top 15 schedules with six entries. The Pac-12 is just behind with four.

With seven games away from Columbia so far this season, the Gamecocks are 7th in the RPI – best in the SEC ahead of Kentucky (8th) and Tennessee (10th) with Florida (21) also among the top 30. Three others – Texas A&M (32), Mississippi State (33), Missouri (41) and Georgia (46) – are in the top 50.

Be Aggressive

Led by arguably among the best frontcourts in the nation, South Carolina ranks 10th in the country in free throw attempts at 360. The Gamecocks average 24.0 free throw attempts per game, tied with No. 20 Florida for most among teams ranked in the AP Top 25. South Carolina's 237 made free throws is 25th in the nation

Diversified Assets

Head coach Dawn Staley has compiled an arsenal of offensive weapons that keeps growing throughout the season with no one Gamecock dominating the stat line, especially on offense. While nine different Gamecocks have been the team's top scorer in at least one quarter this season, no Gamecock has led the team in scoring for all four quarters of a game. A single player has topped the team in three quarters just five times – Alaina Coates (Winthrop), Tiffany Mitchell (at Clemson, at Vandy) and A'ja Wilson (vs. CSUB, Duke).

A Little Help From My Friends

Playing under one of the best point guards in U.S. women's basketball history, South Carolina has always been committed to finding the teammate with the best shot. Early this season, the Gamecocks were not as proficient in that area as they had been, assisting on 45.9 percent of their field goals (158 of 344) in nonconference action. So far in league play, South Carolina has rediscovered its roots, handing out assists on 43 of 82 made field goals (52.4 percent). In fact, the highest

scoring Gamecock in league play, Tiffany Mitchell (17.7 ppg) also leads the team in assists (3.7 apg).

Getting Back Where We Belong


The Gamecocks have steadily marched up the national standings in field goal percentage and field goal percentage defense, ranking among the country's top 15 in both. South Carolina has long been among the nation's best defensive teams, adding offensive efficiency in recent seasons. The Gamecocks finished last season ranked fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (.484) and 10th in field goal percentage defense (.349).

South Carolina is currently shooting 47.0 percent from the field (14th) and holding opponents to 33.2 percent (12th). Only three teams have shot at least 40.0 percent against the Gamecocks this season with none hitting 45.0 percent. South Carolina is 20th in the nation in points per game (78.3) and 29th in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 54.7 points per game.

Crunch Time

The Gamecocks have played three games decided by single-digit points this season, two of which they trailed at halftime but came back to win. In those outings, offense has made the difference with the Gamecocks shooting 52.0 percent from the field in the fourth quarters of those three games. Of these three opponents, only Arizona State out-shot South Carolina in the fourth quarter (.353-.313) with the Gamecocks making up the difference at the free throw line and on the glass in the waning moments of the contest.

Overall, South Carolina shoots much better in the second half (50.3 percent) than the first (43.8 percent) as opposing defenses begin to feel the effects of the Gamecocks' frontcourt and pace of play. South Carolina's offensive efficiency builds steadily throughout the game

with 19 of the 29 quarters in which the Gamecocks have shot at least 50 percent coming in the second half.

New Year, Old Tiffany

Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell is back to her All-American ways in 2016 after recovery from offseason surgery limited her efficiency in non-conference action. Still averaging double-figure points as the team's secondleading scorer in non-conference play, Mitchell was not on all-around great form through the season's first 12 games.

With the calendar now reading 2016 and SEC play in full cry, Mitchell has immediate re-inserted herself into SEC Player of the Year contention for her raw numbers as well as her impact on big games. Here's a look at how her SEC numbers compare to her non-conference production this season:

Mitchell is among the SEC's top 15 in eight of 10 primary stats, which is two more than any other player in the league, missing out on just rebounds and blocked shots. Her numbers have not grown idly either as she has taken charge of games at key moments for her team, much the way she has her last two SEC Player of the Year campaigns. Mitchell scored seven points during a key 10-3 thirdquarter run at Vanderbilt (Jan. 7) then added seven of the team's first eight points in the fourth quarter to hold off the Commodores, adding a drive and dish for a Khadijah Sessions 3-pointer and a defensive rebound in the final minute to close out the win. Against No. 20/- Missouri (Jan. 10), she hit a transition layup, a 3-pointer from the left corner and converted a steal into a layup after the Tigers had opened the third quarter on a 12-4 run.

Quarter Breakdown

Through 60 quarters this season, South Carolina has out-scored its opponent 45 times with the Gamecocks topping their foe by double digits 15 times, including a season-high differential of 26 (35-9) in the second quarter against Arkansas (Jan. 3). This season's best first-quarter advantage is 19 (26-7) against Winthrop (Dec. 13), thirdquarter margin is 22 (29-7) against Arkanas (Jan. 3) and fourth-quarter edge is 17 (27-10) vs. Hampton (Dec. 16). South Carolina has shot at least 50.0 percent (8-of-10) quarters this season with a high of 80.0 percent (8-of-10) in the third quarter against Hampton. The Gamecocks

this season, but senior guard Tina Roy owns the top spot with 15 points in the third quarter against Arkansas (Jan. 3). Senior guard Tiffany Mitchell has the highest first-quarter scoring total with nine against both CSUB (Nov. 28) and Winthrop (Dec. 13). Wilson owns the best mark in the other two quarters, turning in 11 in the second quarter against UNCG (Nov. 15) and 12 in the fourth quarter against Ohio State (Nov. 13).

Offensive Operation

Head coach Dawn Staley is often thought of as a defensive coach, but she has steadily built an efficient offensive team over the last few seasons, culminating in the 2014-15 squad's 75.9 points per game (fourth-best in program history and the first new entry in the top five since 1993-94) on 48.4 percent shooting. That group ranked 18th in the nation in scoring and fourth in field goal percentage. Here's a look at the offense's growth over the last five seasons.

SEC Active Leaders

Among the SEC's active leaders in seven statistical categories five different Gamecocks are among the top 10 in at least one. Senior Tiffany Mitchell's league-high six entries is not a surprise given the breadth of her resume, but the appearance of sophomore A'ja Wilson at No. 3 on the active blocked shots list (101), which junior Alaina Coates leads, may catch some observers off guard.

Mitchell headlines the South Carolina entries ranking second in scoring (1,587), steals (196) and field goals made (531); third in 3-pointers made (147); fourth in assists (304) and eighth in rebounding (520). She is the highest-ranking guard on the rebounding list, which includes just two other true perimeter players.

Coates is the league's active leader in blocks (152), sits third in rebounds (710) and 10th in scoring (1,010). She also has a current SEC-high 30 career doubledoubles, including eight this season.

Senior Khadijah Sessions holds sixth in steals (147) and eighth in assists (257). Senior Tina Roy is on the 3-pointers made list, coming in at fourth (128).

Great Gamecock Fans

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers. Average attendance has grown steadily over the last three seasons, culminating in this season's sell-out of the season-ticket allotment – over 11,000. Only single-game, general admission tickets remain available for purchase.

South Carolina leads the nation in average attendance at 14,424 and is the only program averaging at least 10,000 fans this season. In fact, seven of the top 10 attended games in the Division I women's basketball this

season were played at Colonial Life Arena.

Delving more deeply into the numbers, South Carolina's Colonial Life Arena's capacity of 18,000 makes it the seventh-largest women's basketball venue in the nation. South Carolina is the only one of those selling over 50 percent of their capacity as Gamecocks fans are filling Colonial Life Arena at 80.13 percent capacity, the highest of any facility seating at least 10,000 and fifth overall.

Prior to 2015-16, the Gamecocks led the nation in average attendance increase in each of the previous two seasons and paced the country in average attendance in 2014-15 at 12,293. South Carolina played in front of over 10,000 fans 15 times that season with 13 of those coming at Colonial Life Arena. The 17,156 fans that turned out for the Jan. 11 game against Kentucky were just shy of the women's basketball record of 17,712 (vs. Clemson, 11/22/02) at the facility.

U-S-A, U-S-A

USA Basketball honored two Gamecocks for their contributions to the Americans' medal count in 2015. Head coach Dawn Staley became the first person to earn Athlete of the Year and Coach of the Year honors from USA Basketball, sharing the 2015 coaching award with Sean Miller. Sophomore forward A'ja Wilson earned USA Basketball Female Athlete of the Year honors for her MVP effort at the FIBA U19 Women's World Championship.

Two other Gamecocks also represented USA Basketball last summer. Senior Tiffany Mitchell and junior Alaina Coates on the U.S. Pan Am Games silver medal team.

Highest Honors

Experts have their eye on three Gamecocks in the running for national player of the year honors – senior guard Tiffany Mitchell, junior center Alaina Coates and sophomore forward A'ja Wilson. South Carolina is in elite company with that many players in the running.

Most recently, the trio appeared on the Naismith Early Season Watch List, which included the 50 best players in the nation. South Carolina was one of three teams with three entries. The USBWA announced its 20-member watch list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which included Mitchell and Wilson, putting South Carolina among just three programs with multiple players recognized.

The Wooden Award got the streak going, announcing its 30-player watch list, which featured all the Gamecocks. South Carolina joined UConn as the only schools with three players selected.

Legacy of Leadership

South Carolina has thrived under excellent leadership from its team-selected captains the last few seasons. While some thought that area would be a question mark heading into this season, the Gamecocks selected their four returning seniors – Asia Dozier, Tiffany Mitchell,

Double-Double Trouble

The most recent addition to the Gamecocks' 1,000-point club, junior center Alaina Coates has the size and skill to take over games against any opponent and continues to grow more comfortable in that role. With an SEC-best eight double-doubles this season and best-in-the-nation .696 field goal percentage, she is among the SEC top 20 in both scoring (14th, 12.9 ppg) and rebounding (2nd, 9.3 rpg).

Coates became the 31st member of the 1,000-point club in the first 30 seconds of the win over No. 20/-Missouri (Jan. 10) but just the 13th member to also amass 700 career rebounds – a number she also reached against the Tigers.

With 30 career double-doubles, during which the Gamecocks are 29-1, she is sixth in program history in

that category, just two shy of reaching the all-time top five, which has not changed since Marsha Williams moved into the No. 2 spot in 1992-93 with 44. (The school record of 70 belongs to Sheila Foster, 1979-82.) With three straight double-doubles to open league play, Coates matched and then broke Williams' school record for double-doubles in SEC action, previously 11 now 13.

The SEC's active leader with 152 career blocks, Coates is third in South Carolina history in the category. She is just 25 shy of Lakesha Tolliver's (2004-07) career record of 177.

Hometown Hero

Sophomore forward A'ja Wilson has lived up to her billing, both this season being selected to the watch lists for the Wooden, Naismith and the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Awards and last season as the SEC Freshman of the Year, First-Team All-SEC selection and the first Gamecock freshman to earn All-America honors.

This season, Wilson has been the Gamecocks' top scorer six times and top rebounder in seven games. She leads the SEC in blocks per game (2.8) and doubledoubles (8), categories in which she ranks 20th and 18th in the nation, respectively. Wilson is also among the SEC's top five in rebounding (4th, 9.2) and field goal percentage (5th, .529), and comes in seventh in scoring (7th, 15.6).

Named SEC Player of the Week three times in the first four weeks of the season, Wilson has routinely delivered at crunch time – 12 of her 20 points against #6/10 Ohio State (Nov. 13) came in the fourth quarter, including six of the team's 10 in the final 2:35; scoring and rebounding late at UCLA (Nov. 22) put Gamecocks on top in final 3:00 of tight game; three rebounds in final 18 seconds of tie game vs. #16/18 Arizona State (Nov. 27) led to game-winning free throws with 0.6 seconds to play; 10 points in fourth quarter vs. CSU Bakersfield (Nov. 28) broke open seven-point game heading into the period; and 20 second-half points against Duke included 12 of the team's 16 in the third quarter and six in the final 1:45 of the game.

Zone Buster

Senior guard Tina Roy opened her fifth and final season with the Gamecocks in the starting lineup after great offseason and preseason work. The Kaplan, La., native struggled to get her shot on track early, though, and ceded her starting role after nine games. Roy returned from the holiday break with a renewed sense of urgency around practice, and the change has shown in games.

Roy kicked off 2016 by tying the school record for made 3s in an SEC game, burying seven against Arkansas (Jan. 3) and followed that with four at Vanderbilt (Jan. 4). Entering the season hitting 29.5 percent from 3-point range in her career, Roy is hitting 38.0 percent from behind the arc this season to rank third in the league, including an SEC-best 52.2 percent so far in conference play. Her early scoring burst in conference play has her ranked 13th in the league with 12.0 points per SEC game, which includes a league-leading 4.0 3-pointers made per game.

The Senior Sessions

Named a team captain for the second time in three seasons, senior Khadijah Sessions has had a vice-like grip on the starting point guard spot for the Gamecocks over the last three seasons. After leading the team to backto-back SEC regular-season championships and the program's first NCAA Final Four during that stretch, the Myrtle Beach, S.C., native took the challenge of expanding her offensive game to force opposing defenses to honor her as a scoring threat, especially in the halfcourt.

Sessions has delivered so far, shooting a career-best 48.4 percent from the field this season, including 53.3 percent in SEC play, during which she is 4-of-6 from 3-point range as well. She has scored at least five points 11 times through 15 games, including three doubledigit outings. In the last five games, Sessions averaged 7.4 points on 45.8 percent shooting, including 5-of-10 (.500) from 3-point range, while still averaging 2.4 assists per game and 2.0 steals.


