With expectations surrounding this season, Staley believed it was important for her team to focus on the collective instead of any individual, knowing that to thrive in pressure situations, each student-athlete may have to sacrifice a piece of herself to become one team.















### South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- Head coach Dawn Staley will recognize junior guard Tiffany Mitchell for scoring her 1,000th career point prior to today's starting lineups.
- South Carolina welcomes participants in its Active Gamecocks program to tonight's game. The program promotes physical activity in children in kindergarten through sixth grade in South Carolina, Georgia and North Carolina.
- The Gamecock defense has allowed just one team to reach 50 points (then-No. 9 Duke) in the last five games.
- Led by super-subs Alaina Coates and A'ja Wilson, the Gamecock bench has accounted for 47.2 percent of the team's scoring this season. In fact, the bench has out-scored the starters five times this season – San Diego State, vs. Wisconsin, Charlotte, Savannah State and at Hampton.
- South Carolina has made five or more 3s seven times this season, but the outside shot is still just the setup for the Gamecocks' inside game as points in the paint accounts for 52.6 percent of the team's total offense.
- Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell shot 64.5 percent from the field over the last three games, all on the road, including 64.7 percent accuracy from 3-point range.
- Senior Elem Ibiam has scored in double figures in five of the last seven games, including both games of the Subway Classic at University of Minnesota.
- Sophomore Alaina Coates has posted four double-doubles in the last six games while averaging just 21.3 minutes during that stretch.
- Four Gamecocks were named to the Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List this week with Alaina Coates and A'ja Wilson joining junior Tiffany Mitchell and Aleighsa Welch, who are also on the Wooden Award and Wade Trophy Watch Lists. No other school had four entries on the Naismith list, and South Carolina is one of four teams with two entries on the other two watch lists.

## A South Carolina Win Would...

- Be the second-straight in an SEC opener and just the third SEC-opening win of the Staley era.
- Be the Gamecocks' 25th straight at home.
- Be the Gamecocks' third straight over Auburn, which would be their longest streak of the series.

## By the Numbers

## Auburn Series History

The Tigers hold a 21-17 lead in the all-time series, but the Gamecocks won the last two meetings and are 5-3 against Auburn in the Dawn Staley era. Auburn's last win in the series was a 53-49 decision in Auburn on Jan. 19, 2012.

Last season's 72-66 win at Auburn came on Jan. 12 and courtesy of 18 points from Tiffany Mitchell. Alaina Coates' 14 first-half points helped the Gamecocks rally to tie the game at the break, and six straight points from Mitchell after the game's last media timeout stretched the Gamecocks' lead from five to 11 with 2:17 to go. The Tigers made another surge, but Khadijah Sessions hit a pair of free throws with 21 seconds to play to hold them off.

## Active Gamecocks

South Carolina welcomes the participants in the most recent segment of the Active Gamecocks program to tonight's game. Active Gamecocks promotes physical activity in children in kindergarten through sixth grade in South Carolina, Georgia and North Carolina. The students are encouraged to participate in any form of physical activity for 30 minutes per day for a two-week period. At the end of the two weeks, students and schools that participated receive tickets to predetermined Gamecock Athletics events.

Tonight's celebration recognizes the 5,900 participants from 82 schools across the region.

## Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are in the midst of unprecedented success at Colonial Life Arena, having won their last 24 games on their home court, including the facility's first perfect season in 2013-14. That 16-0 mark alone matched the previous record for win streak at the Arena, originally set Jan. 20, 2002-Jan. 9, 2003. South Carolina's last loss at Colonial Life Arena was a 50-48 decision to then-No. 14 Texas A&M on Feb. 10, 2013.

The longest home win streak in school history is 32 games, which spanned three seasons. That streak began with a win over Clemson on Dec. 10, 1977, and ended with a win over Tennessee Tech on March 4, 1980. The stretch included a perfect 11-0 record in 1978-79 at Carolina Coliseum (9-0) and the Sol Blatt P.E. Center (2-0).

Overall, South Carolina is 139-58 (.706) at Colonial Life Arena, including a 73-25 (.745) mark under head coach Dawn Staley. In the now 41-year history of the program, the Gamecocks are 384-155 (.712) in home games.

## Crowd Control

With over 8,000 season tickets issued, the Gamecocks have enjoyed unprecedented support

at Colonial Life Arena this season. South Carolina is currently third in the nation in average attendance (9,904). In fact, with just 11 games played in front of at least 10,000 fans nationally this season, the Gamecocks have three entries – more than any other team.

The Gamecocks drew 10,057 fans to their season opener against Southern Cal, the largest crowd for a home opener since the opening game at Colonial Life Arena drew 17,712.

South Carolina women's basketball has logged seven crowds of over 10,000 fans in Colonial Life Arena history, six of which have come in the last three seasons, including the first three home games this season.

## Win Any Way

As the Gamecocks' baseball coach, South Carolina athletics director Ray Tanner frequently used the saying "Win Anyway," and the women's basketball team has put its own twist on the quote. The Gamecocks have not lost a game this season, but the end has not always come by the same means.

Dawn Staley's team has won with both a high-flying offense – posting records of 3-0 when scoring 90+ points, 4-0 when scoring 80-89 points – and a more methodical one, 1-0 when scoring 70-79 points, 3-0 with scoring 60-69 points and 1-0 when scoring 50-59 points.

The Gamecocks have won both inside – 5-0 when shooting less than 33.3 percent from 3-point range, 4-0 when at least half of points come in the paint – and outside – 7-0 when shooting 33.3 percent or better from 3-point range, 8-0 when less than half of points come in the paint.

South Carolina has seen its top scorer come from both the starting lineup (6-0) and the bench (6-0).

## Diehard Defenders

While the offense has fluctuated in source and volume, the one standard for the Gamecocks – this season and throughout head coach Dawn Staley's career – has been their defense. South Carolina is third in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 47.6 points per game with no opponent scoring more than 63 points. In fact, South Carolina has not allowed more than 50 points in any of its last five games.

The Gamecocks have also built their success on the glass – another area that Staley preaches as a measure of effort as much as talent. South Carolina ranks eighth in the nation in rebounding margin, out-boards its opponents by 12.2 per game. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double-digit rebounds seven times this season, including three games by at least 20 rebounds – Clemson (+22), Savannah State (+35) and at Hampton (+27).

## Poll Presence

This week's rankings extended South Carolina's string of Associated Press top-10 appearances to 19, the longest in program history, and is the Gamecocks' sixth in the No. 1 spot. The previous high top-10 streak was 13 weeks from Jan. 22, 1980 through Dec. 16, 1980.

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was the program's first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

The Gamecocks opened this season with their highest preseason ranking from the organization, coming in at No. 2 to best the previous high of No. 4 heading into the 1981-82 season.

## Diversified Assets

South Carolina ranks sixth in the nation in field goal percentage at 49.0 percent with two Gamecocks ranked among the SEC's best in field goal percentage – the league and the NCAA

require a minimum of five made field goals per game to qualify. Only junior Tiffany Mitchell and freshman A'ja Wilson reach that mark with 5.1 and 5.3, respectively. Mitchell is 22nd in the nation (3rd in SEC) in field goal percentage at .565, while Wilson comes in at 36th (5th in SEC) at .548.

### SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks 14th in the nation with 6.1 blocked shots per game this season. The effort is a continuation of last season, during with the Gamecocks shattered the school record for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 12 blockers, led by sophomore Alaina Coates and A'ja Wilson sharing fifth place at 1.4 per game. Senior Elem Ibiam is next in line with 1.3 per game for 10th place, and senior Aleighsa Welch is just behind in 13th place at 1.2 per game.

### Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates last season, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams

have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment – the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks are second in the SEC and 51st in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 35.6 percent from outside the arc. After closing last season averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is off to a blistering 5.3 average this season, which ranks fourth in the SEC. The most 3s made per game of the Staley era is 9.2 in 2009-10.

Junior Tiffany Mitchell has been the primary long-range shooter, ranking second in the SEC with 2.3 made 3s per game and second in the country with a .538 3-point field goal percentage. But, two other Gamecocks are hitting more than one-third of their long-range attempts and must be closely guarded on the perimeter – Asia Dozier (11-of-30, .367) and Tina Roy (13-of-36, .361).

### Helping Hand

South Carolina's depth of talent has made the Gamecocks more unselfish as they rank fifth in the nation in assists per game with an SEC-best 20.0. Living up to the legend of their head coach, the Gamecocks have handed out 20 or more assists eight times this season, including a Staley-era high of 26 against NC Central. In all, South Carolina has assisted on 240 of its 361 made field goals this season (.679). Last season's team set the mark for best percentage of the Staley era at .577.

### Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be

just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has out-scored its starting teammates three times this season and has out-scored the entire opposing team four times – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23), NC Central (Dec. 1). In all, the bench has accounted for 47.2 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season.

Of the 49 double-figures games turned in so far this season, 24 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (11), Alaina Coates (6), Bianca Cuevas (3), Jatarie White (2), Asia Dozier (1) and Tina Roy (1).

### SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

## Two Grand

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell joined senior Aleighsa Welch in the 1,000-point club against Liberty (Dec. 21), making it the first time a Gamecock team has had multiple 1,000-point scorers since 2001-02 when Shaunzinski Gortman and Jocelyn Penn both reached that plateau. In program history, there have been nine seasons that featured multiple 1,000-point scorers, including three seasons that saw three Gamecocks who surpassed the benchmark.

## Trademark TM

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell established her presence on a national level based on her versatility – she was the only player to appear in the rankings for scoring, rebounding, assists and steals in SEC action. The one element of her game that she had not exploited during that All-America campaign was her 3-point shooting, unleashing that weapon judiciously with just 2.2 attempts per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

This season, the usually attacking guard has shown that opponents better be prepared to play her a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is second in the nation in 3-point percentage, hitting 53.8 percent from long range and has made 2.3 3s per game to rank second in the SEC. The outside shot has accounted for nearly half of her field goal attempts (52 3FGA, 108 FGA).

Mitchell's heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in program history. She went on to match her career high with six 3s at Hampton as well, those coming on eight attempts.

## More on Muffin

Senior forward Aleighsa Welch – nicknamed Muffin by her mother at birth – continues to be at the foundation of the Gamecocks' success. The South Carolina high school standout that first took a chance on head coach Dawn Staley's vision, the undersized post player had done everything asked to power the Gamecocks to the lofty heights achieved during her career. Always willing to do the "dirty" work that doesn't show up in the box score, Welch's energy is what drives the Gamecocks and what has prompted her teammates to vote her a team captain each of the last three seasons.

This season Welch's role has evolved from her first two seasons spent leading an undersized front line as a dynamic rebounder – she is just outside program's all-time top 10 – to this season playing often as a mid-range shooting swing player whose height can give opposing shooters fits.

While the change in position and expansion of the Gamecocks' frontline have brought her rebounding numbers down slightly (5.2 rpg this

season vs. 7.2 career average), Welch continues to provide consistency on the offensive end, shooting 58.2 percent from the field and handing out a career-best 2.2 assists per game.

## Double Trouble

One of sophomore Alaina Coates' goals this season centers around posting double-doubles, taking to heart her head coach's quip that the 6-foot-4 center is a "walking double-double." With an SEC-best six this season, the Irmo, S.C., native has already passed the halfway mark of her freshman year, during which she posted 10 double-doubles, but just three in non-conference action. With 16 career double-doubles through just 46 games, Coates is just four shy of making the Gamecocks' career top 10 in the category.

## Bang off the Bench

Just as Alaina Coates earned the unprecedented double of SEC Freshman and Co-6th Player of the Year honors last season, freshman A'ja Wilson is putting in an early bid to repeat the feat.

The 6-foot-5 Heathwood Hall product started the season opener, but has thrived off the bench in ever since, averaging 15.1 points and 6.6 rebounds during the stretch. Overall on the season, Wilson is second on the team in scoring, ranking ninth in the SEC in at 14.2 ppg, and has been the Gamecocks' top scorer a team-high six times this season. She is the only freshman to rank among the SEC's top 20 scorers and rebounders this season, adding a top-five appearance in the league's field goal percentage standings.

Wilson has earned SEC Freshman of the Week two times and was the USBWA's first ever Freshman of the Week (games Dec. 1-7).

## It's Elem-entary

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge at the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently third with 145 in her career, trailing Michelle Murray (1990-93 in second place at 148. The Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07) is also well within reach.

## Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

## Welch Watch

Already second in school history in career offensive rebounds, senior forward Aleighsa Welch looks to mount an attack on other parts of the Gamecock charts before closing out her career.

## Power of Three

Prior to the season, espnW ranked the top 25 college players in the nation, and a trio of Gamecocks made the list. Reigning SEC Player of the Year Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed No. 4 in the nation because “[her] greatest strength is that she doesn’t really have a weakness. Shooting,

penetrating, distributing, rebounding, defending and leading from her point guard spot are all part of Mitchell’s resume,” according to Charlie Creme. Two-time All-SEC selection Aleighsa Welch came in on the No. 7 spot for her ability to “come up with the big basket or the big rebound when the Gamecocks need it most,” per Michelle Smith. 2014 SEC Freshman of the Year Alaina Coates captured the No. 25 position after a season in which she was “just scratching the surface of her potential...she could be unstoppable inside, even without a large repertoire of moves,” per Mechelle Voepel.

## Cliney to Miss 2014-15 Season

South Carolina announced in September that the NCAA approved an initial eligibility waiver for freshman Doniyah Cliney, which allowed her to enroll in school but not compete for the Gamecocks in the 2014-15 season. The guard focused on academics in the fall semester and was cleared to practice with the team beginning Dec. 15.

## Class of 2015 Signee

Head coach Dawn Staley added one future Gamecock during the early signing period. Canada’s Shay Colley signed her NLI with South Carolina on Nov. 18 and will have four years of eligibility upon enrollment.

Colley is a three-year standout for Team Canada in junior international play, representing her country in the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (silver), the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship (7th) and the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship (bronze).

## Back in (Garnet and) Black

A huge reason for this season’s lofty expectations is the return of all five starters among the 10 returning letterwinners. The Gamecocks return 97.6 percent of their scoring, 96.0 percent of their rebounding, 98.4 percent of their assists and 97.1 percent of their school-record shot blocking from last season’s top-10 squad. Nine of the 10 returners played in at least 29 of the team’s 34 games last season and contributed at least 2.0 points per game.

## Elite Additions

The Gamecocks added the nation’s No. 2 signing class to their core of returning letterwinners. Four of the five signees will take the court for the Gamecocks this season, led by No. 1 A’ja Wilson and No. 7 Jatarie White. Two other top-35 signees – Bianca Cuevas, Kaydra Duckett – round out the group that will contribute this season.

# DAWN STALEY

**7th Season at South Carolina  
Virginia, 1992**

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 305-151 record, including her 130-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14. Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
