#### **Gamecocks Close Out Fall At Lanfall Tradition**

The South Carolina women's golf team will close out its fall schedule this weekend at the Landfall Tradition in Wilmington, N.C. Play begins Friday at the par-72, 6,138-yard Jack Nicklaus Course at the Country Club of Landfall. The tournament is the fourth of the fall for the Gamecocks, who are coming off a tie for 12th finish at the Tar Heel Invitational two weeks ago.

#### The Lineup

After having the same lineup in the first three tournaments, Harris will be sending out a different group for the first time this season as a result of the team's qualifier. Juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee, sophomore Justine Dreher and freshman Sarah Schmelzel will be making their fourth straight appearance for the Gamecocks, while freshman Chelsey Couch is making her first start after playing as an individual at the Tar Heel Invitational. Senior Meredith Swanson will be playing as an individual this weekend.

Swinehart is playing her best golf of the season after finishing in a tie for 12th to lead the team at the Tar Heel Invitational. She posted rounds of 72-76-72=220 (+4) for her best finish since claiming a tie for 11th at the UCF Challenge her freshman year. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart is second on the team with a stroke average of 75.11.

Couch enters the lineup for the first time this season after closing strong as an individual at the Tar Heel Invitational. She carded rounds of 79-75-75=229 (+13) to tie for 47th in her collegiate debut.

#### **History At The Landfall Tradition**

The Gamecocks are making their third straight appearance at the Landfall Tradition. South Carolina finished fourth last season, as then-senior Katie Burnett led the way with a tie for fourth showing. The Gamecocks placed 11th in their first trip to the event in 2010.

#### **Breaking Down the Field**

South Carolina will be facing yet another challenging field in Wilmington, with 12 of the 17 teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50. Third-ranked Arizona highlights the field along with No. 5 Duke, No. 11 North Carolina State, No. 14 Michigan State, No. 16 Oklahoma State, No. 18 Northwestern, No. 22 Purdue, No. 24 Notre Dame, No. 26 Iowa State, No. 27 Texas Tech, No. 32 Mississippi and No. 33 Ohio State. Florida State, UNC Greensboro, host UNC Wilmington and Wake Forest round out the field.

#### **Recapping The 2011 Landfall Tradition**

South Carolina wrapped up its fall schedule with a strong performance in the third round at the Landfall Tradition. The Gamecocks shot a 301 (+13) at the Country Club of Landfall's Jack Nicklaus Course to climb four spots to finish the event in fourth place with a score of 922 (+58). South Carolina finished 18 strokes back of tournament champion Purdue (904) and just four strokes behind second-place Auburn (918). The fourth-place showing is the Gamecocks' best this season. South Carolina senior Katie Burnett added another top five finish to her list of career accomplishments as she shot a





final-round 72 (E) to end the tournament tied for fourth with a score of 224 (+8).

Junior Amanda Strang was Carolina's next highest finisher as she shot a final-round 79 (+7) to tie for 29th with a three-day total of 233 (+17). Sophomore Samantha Swinehart posted her best round of the tournament with a 2-over 74 to tie for 34th with a score of 235 (+19). Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins and junior Meredith Swanson carded rounds of 76 (+4) and 79 (+7), respectively, to tie for 39th with a score of 236 (+20).

#### The Tougher The Better

South Carolina enters the weekend with the fourth toughest schedule in the country according to Golfweek. The Gamecocks have competed against 44 top 50 teams in three tournaments this season and will face 12 more at the Landfall Tradition.

#### Unfreshmanlike

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel has been the Gamecocks' most consistent golfer this season. She was South Carolina's top finisher in its first two tournaments, including a tie for 20th showing at the NCAA Fall Preview. Schmelzel, who leads the team with a 73.56 stroke average, has climbed to No. 45 in the Golfstat player rankings.

#### Tar Heel Invitational Recap

The Gamecocks posted a final-round 311 (+23) to wrap up the Tar Heel Invitational in a tie for 12th place at the UNC Finley Golf Course. South Carolina finished the tournament with a three-round total of 910 (+46).

Junior Samantha Swinehart led South Carolina with her second round of even-par 72 of the weekend. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart recorded her first top-20 finish of the season and fifth of her career as she tied for 12th with a three-day total of 220 (+4). The finish is the second best of her career.

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded a 6-over 78 on Sunday as she just missed out on her second consecutive top-20 finish. She closed out the tournament in a tie for 25th with a total of 223 (+7). Freshman Chelsey Couch, who played the weekend as an individual, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she tied for 47th with a total of 229 (+13) after shooting her second straight round of 75 (+3).

Junior Suzie Lee tied for 67th with a total of 234 (+18) after carding a final-round 81 (+9). Sophomore Justine Dreher shot an 8-over 80 to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 73rd with a score of 235 (+19), and senior Meredith Swanson turned in an 82 (+10) on Sunday to tie for 82nd with a score of 238 (+22).

#### **NCAA Fall Preview Recap**

South Carolina wrapped up play at the NCAA Fall Preview, posting a final-round 309 (+47) at the University of Georgia Golf Course.

Competing against one of the most elite fields in collegiate golf this season with 15 teams in the Golfstat Top 50, the Gamecocks finished 18th with a three-day total of 911 (+47). The tournament served as a preview of the 2013 NCAA Championship, as the top 10 teams from last year's championship and eight more teams with high rankings made the trip to Athens.

The Gamecocks played one golfer short, as junior Suzie Lee withdrew prior to the round with an injury. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded the low round for South Carolina for the third straight day with a 2-over 74. A native of Phoenix, Ariz., Schmelzel recorded her first career top-20 finish as she tied for 20th with a total of 220 (+4).

Sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to finish the tournament in a tie for 45th with a score of 227 (+11). Junior Samantha Swinehart was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she shot a 78 (+6) to tie for 61st with a total of 230 (+14). Senior Meredith Swanson placed 79th with a score of 236 (+20) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Sunday.

#### **Cougar Classic Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team put together its best round of the Cougar Classic, posting a final-round 294 (+6) at Yeamans Hall Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 899 (+35) as they moved six spots up the leaderboard to finish in 16th place.

After shooting only one round of par or better the first two days, Carolina finished strong, recording two rounds of even par and narrowly missing on a third 72. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel helped lead the way with her second straight 72. Junior Samantha Swinehart also carded a 72, and sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a 1-over 73.

Schmelzel proved to be the Gamecocks' most steady player at the event, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3). She climbed 12 spots up the leaderboard to finish in a tie for 30th. For the third straight day, Schmelzel did not make worse than a bogey as she produced four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars.

Swinehart bounced back from consecutive rounds of 77 with a 72 on the final day. A native of Lancaster, Ohio,

Swinehart tied for 65th with a total of 226 (+10). After recording just one birdie in the first two rounds, she tallied five in the final round to go along with five bogeys and eight pars.

Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round.

Junior Suzie Lee and senior Meredith Swanson each carded a 5-over 77. Lee tied for 71st with a total of 227 (+11), and Swanson concluded the tournament in a tie for 100th with a score of 232 (+16).

#### Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

#### **Busy Summer**

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
