
- Prior to tonight's game, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley will present senior forward A'ja Wilson with a
 ball to commemorate her 2,000th career point, which she scored against Auburn on Jan. 11. Wilson is rapidly
 approaching another milestone as she sits just 11 rebounds shy of 1,000 in her career. Upon hitting that mark, she
 will join Sheila Foster as the only Gamecocks all-time to achieve both 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.
- Sophomore point guard Tyasha Harris has six double-doubles this season, including three in SEC action over the last five games. Her 7.7 assists per SEC game are more than 2.0 ahead of the next entry on the list.
- Junior forward Alexis Jennings has elevated her offensive production over the last three games, averaging 18.6 points
 on 77.8 percent shooting (21-of-27). The effort has not stymied her rebounding at all as she pulled down 9.0 boards
 per game during the stretch.
- The Gamecock offense has been among the nation's most efficient throughout this season, shooting 50.6 percent from the field to rank third in the country. In the last two games, South Carolina shot 63.6 percent, led by A'ja Wilson and Alexis Jennings combining for 81.3 percent (26-of-32) accuracy.
- For the past few seasons, South Carolina's offense has started with the high-percentage inside game. This season 51.5
 percent of the Gamecocks' offense has come in the paint, from where 68.5 percent of their made field goals have come.

Holding Home Court

The Gamecocks are 430-156 all-time on their home court, including a 187-62 mark in Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 123-28 at home during the Dawn Staley era and has lost just three times in its last 76 home games, including undefeated home seasons in 2013-14 and 2014-15. The Gamecocks have won 35 of their last 37 SEC regular-season home games dating back to the 2012-13 season.

Ranked Readings

With a 3-3 mark this season, South Carolina is 53-48 against nationally ranked opponents under head coach Dawn Staley, although that record is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure as the Gamecocks are 38-9 versus ranked foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign. South Carolina is 17-6 against top-10 opponents during that time.

SEC Stories

Head coach Dawn Staley has built the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender with four straight regularseason titles, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her 10th SEC season at the helm, Staley boasts a 102-47 (.685) conference regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five only two times in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 102 wins include six seasons of double-digit league victories – 10 in 2012; 11 in 2013; an SEC-best 14 in 2014, 15 in 2015 and 16 in 2016; and 14 in 2017 – and account for 61.4 percent of the program's all-time 166 league wins.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 54-20 (.730) mark at home and a 48-27 (.640) slate on the road.

Staying Power

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is in her 10th season at the helm after guiding the Gamecocks into the postseason seven times in her first nine seasons in Columbia, including the 2017 National Championship and five other Sweet 16 berths.

With a .715 (409-163) winning percentage over her 18 seasons as a head coach, Staley is 23rd among active NCAA Div. I head coaches with at least 10 years of experience and is the best among SEC head coaches.

Staley is the third-longest tenured coach currently in the SEC, and her 10.8 league wins per season is best among the group. During the Gamecocks' current four-year run as SEC champion, the program averaged 14.8 conference wins per season.

With her 100th SEC regular-season victory coming against Auburn on Jan. 11, 2018, Staley became the eighth head coach all-time to record at least 100 such wins with one school.

for the Gamecocks in the poll – the fifth-longest active streak in the nation.

The Gamecocks have spent 80 straight weeks in the nation's top 10 and are one of just three teams to have stayed among the nation's top 10 every week since the start of the 2014-15 season. In the 69 polls since the start of the 2014-15 season, South Carolina has spent 59 in the top five, trailing UConn's 69 such weeks and leading Notre Dame's 57 top-five entries.

Tough Road Ahead

South Carolina's 2017-18 schedule includes 10 games against teams ranked in this week's Associated Press and/ or USA Today Coaches Poll. Seven of those games are already behind the Gamecocks, who went 3-3 in the outings.

Still up for the Gamecocks are rematches with #11/11 Missouri and #10/10 Tennessee as well as games against #1/1 UConn, at #2/2 Mississippi State and at #21/20 Georgia.

All-Around A'ja

Few players in the country are as versatile as South Carolina senior forward A'ja Wilson. Averaging 23.4 points, 10.9 rebounds and 3.4 blocks, she ranks fifth, 17th and seventh in the nation in those categories, respectively, making her the only player in the nation to be in the top 30 of all three categories.

Only seven players in the nation are among the top 50 in both scoring and rebounding, and just one other joins Wilson ranked in the top 25 of both – Megan Gustafson, Iowa (23.6 ppg/12.8 rpg).

Reading defenses more quickly than before, Wilson has also responded to her head coach's challenge to expand her skill set, improving her ball-handling to allow her to rebound and immediately start the fast break and even run the offense from the point guard position at times and developing consistency on her outside shot, of which she has hit 5-of-9 from 3-point range. The growth in her game helps both the Gamecocks, as opponents will have a more difficult time locating her for double-teaming, and Wilson's preparedness for the next step in her basketball career.

Sophomore point guard Tyasha Harris has had a brilliant 2018 so far, amassing three of her six double-doubles in the first month of the New Year while averaging 14.7 points per game on 47.8 percent field goal shooting.

Looking around the county at other guards tallying points-assists double-doubles, Harris rises to the top of the group. On the season, her six double-doubles are fourth-most in the nation. Since the turn of the New Year, she ties Ball State's Carmen Grande with three double-doubles so far. Grande's four such games in MAC play are one better than Harris' three in SEC action. No other player in the nation has multiple points-assists double-doubles in league games.

Heart of a Champion

Among A'ja Wilson's 17 games played this season are seven in which the margin was under 10 in the fourth quarter – at #15/13 Maryland (Nov. 13), vs. Rutgers (Nov. 24), vs. #6/6 Notre Dame (Nov. 26), #22/21 Texas A&M (Dec. 31), at Ole Miss (Jan. 4), at #15/15 Missouri (Jan. 8) and Auburn (Jan. 11). In those games, fans saw the senior forward step up to show why she impacts the game more than any player in the nation.

In the fourth quarter of those seven games, Wilson averaged 9.3 points on 63.2 percent shooting to go with 2.7 rebounding, 1.3 block and 1.0 assist averages.

As Texas A&M head coach Gary Blair said after the Gamecocks rallied to defeat the Aggies, "Give Miss Wilson a little bit of credit for wanting the ball at the end ... You just saw the best player in the country."

Quarter Breakdown

Through 19 games this season, South Carolina has out-scored its opponent in all but 19 quarters and has out-paced its opponent by double digits 36 times in the 76 quarters, including a season-high differential of 22 points (27-5) in the first quarter against Alabama State (Nov. 10).

South Carolina has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field 44 times in its 76 quarters of action, led by a its 81.8 (9-of-11) percent accuracy in the third quarter at Kentucky (Jan. 21).

Defensively, South Carolina has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 14 times this season with five of those quarters resulting in five or fewer points, including a program-record low of three points by Savannah State (Dec. 17) in the third quarter. An opponent has shot to 20.0 percent or less from the field in 14 quarters, including a program-record low of 5.6 percent by College of Charleston (Dec. 5) in the second quarter.

The Gamecocks are out-pacing their opponents in that space by 16.8 points per game, and their interior advantage has been at least 20 points six times, including twice with a season-high 48 – against Alabama State (Nov. 10) and Western Carolina (Nov. 30). Only three opponents have out-scored South Carolina in the paint this season – #6/6 Notre Dame (Nov. 26) 58-42, #15/15 Missouri (Jan. 7) 28-34 and #6/6 Tennessee (Jan. 14) 36-44 – which are also the Gamecocks' only losses this season.

South Carolina's starting frontcourt – whatever the combination has been (Jennings/Wilson, Jennings/Herbert Harrigan or Jennings/Grissett) has accounted for 42.9 percent of the Gamecocks' scoring this season, averaging a combined 35.3 points per game.

Blocking Scheme

30+ Points

South Carolina ranks 11th in the nation with 6.3 blocked shots per game, which is second in the SEC. While the Gamecocks have been atop this category over the last few seasons, the formula this season is slightly

different.

Instead of being dominated by two Gamecocks, nine different members of the team have recorded at least one blocked shot this season with three logging double-digit blocks.

Senior forward A'ja Wilson ranking seventh in the nation (second in the SEC) with 3.4 blocks per game.

Behind Wilson, sophomore Mikiah Herbert Harrigan is 12th in the league at 1.059 blocks per game, and junior Alexis Jennings is 13th at 1.052 per outing.

Double Dish

Preseason All-SEC Second-Team selection Tyasha Harris has heeded her head coach's challenge to expand her game not that "the novelty has worn off," and the sophomore has recorded five double-doubles this season to match the school record for points-assists double-doubles.

Harris has picked up her scoring this season, ranking 30th in the SEC with 11.6 points per game on 46.4 percent shooting. She has netted double figures in each

of the last nine games, including posting 14.1 points per SEC contest, during which she is shooting 50.0 percent.

Meanwhile, Harris continues to show great court vision and command of the offense, ranking 10th in the nation with an SEC-best 6.9 assists per game – a number that rises to 7.7 in league play. Her 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio is 10th in the nation.

Defensively, Harris has become a menace with 2.7 steals per game to rank third in the SEC.

Harris' six double-doubles is now the program single-season record for points-assists double-doubles and puts her among just three Gamecocks in the SEC era to record multiple points-assists double-doubles. Cristina Ciocan leads the group with nine in her career (4 in 2002-03, 5 in 2003-04) with Shaunzinski Gortman joining the trio with two in 1999-2000.

Just Jennings

Junior transfer Alexis Jennings has strengthened the Gamecocks' frontcourt, providing a steady, physical presence in the lane. After averaging 8.9 points and 5.4 rebounds in her two seasons at Kentucky, the powerful post has elevated her play this season, posting 12.9 points and 7.4 rebounds per game to rank second on the team and among the SEC's top 25 in both categories.

Jennings is eighth in the nation in field goal percentage (.636), and in the SEC ranks 14th in rebounding and 22nd in scoring. Both her scoring and rebounding have been on full display versus ranked opponents, against which she averages 12.3 points and 7.3 rebounds. Two of her four double-doubles so far this season have come against top-15 foes in #15/13 Maryland (Nov. 13, 12 pts/13 rebs) and #14/16 Duke (Dec. 3, 21 pts/10 rebs).

Jennings has 10 other double-figure scoring games this

season, including two 20-point outings -25 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25) and 27 at Vanderbilt (Jan. 18).

Spanning the Distance

Senior transfer Lindsey Spann brings solid experience and leadership to the Gamecocks' young roster, but the biggest impact the 1,000-point scorer from Penn State will have will likely be from 3-point range.

Claiming eighth place on the Lady Lions' career made 3s list, the 5-foot-6 guard got off to a quick start from long range – leading the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage (.550) and ranking second in the league in made 3s per gam (3.1) before missing five games due to injury. Her first field goal attempt upon her return – against #22/21 Texas A&M (Dec. 31) – was a 3.

Overall on the season, Spann is shooting 48.0 percent from 3-point range to average 11.2 points per game on 2.8 3s per game to go along with 1.7 assists per game.

Getting Some Le-way

Freshman forward LeLe Grissett spent the semester break putting in extra time in the gym, especially with assistant coach Fred Chmiel. The work is paying off just when the Gamecocks have needed it most due to injuries, as the athletic, energetic newcomer seems to have put it all together.

In the last five games, Grissett averaged 7.8 points on 62.5 percent shooting along with 6.0 rebounds per game. That stretch includes a season-best 29 minutes against #6/6 Tennessee (Jan. 14) and starts at Vanderbilt (Jan. 18) and Kentucky (Jan. 21). She posted double figures in both games that A'ja Wilson missed with an injury, including a 22-point performance at Vanderbilt on 11-of-12 shooting.

Utility Player

After two seasons coming off the bench, junior guard Doniyah Cliney has an established role in the starting lineup, and the spotlight has only amplified how much more she is prepared to contribute. Staley has marked her as a "stat stuffer" because her versatility and athleticism allow her to impact the game in so many ways. Any single number may not jump off the box score, but she will contribute to nearly all of them.

So far this season, Cliney averages 8.2 points, 3.2 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.3 steals. She has seven double-figure scoring games, including two against ranked opponents (12 vs. #6/6 Notre Dame, 16 vs. #22/21 Texas A&M), and seven games of three or more assists.

With a career-high 34 points against No. 6/6 Notre Dame (Nov. 26) following a 32-point outing at No. 15/13 Maryland (Nov. 13), A'ja Wilson became the first Gamecock to record three 30-point games against nationally ranked opponents. The most recent outing against the Fighting Irish broker her tie with Shannon Johnson, who is the only other Gamecock to record more than one such game against ranked opponents.

With just 10 such games in program history, Wilson and Kaela Davis each recorded one last season, the first new additions to the list since Feb. 15, 2996. Those two games along with Wilson's first entry this season are the only road games on the list. Davis' 37-point showing at No. 7/6 Ohio State is the highest-scoring game against a ranked opponent in program history.

Great Gamecock Fans

With over 10,000 season-ticket holders for the thirdstraight season, South Carolina continues to lead the nation in average attendance at 12,950 and is the only program drawing at least 10,000 fans per game.

The Gamecocks have posted the highest average attendance in the nation at the end of the last three seasons, averaging at least 12,000 fans in each of those seasons, during which they boast two sellouts of 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena.

Dawn Staley Head Coach

Head Coach 10th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Nine seasons later, Staley delivered on those expectations with the program's first NCAA National Championship in 2017. South Carolina has the fifth-longest streak of appearances in the Associated Press Top 25, hitting the 100-week mark on Dec. 25, 2017; and the Gamecocks boast six straight 25-win seasons, which include four SEC regular-season championships, three SEC Tournament titles, two NCAA Final Four appearances and three other Sweet 16 seasons, the program's first ever No. 1 national ranking and a school-record 34 wins in 2014-15. Staley's success has united every demographic in the state of South Carolina as the Gamecocks' fan base tripled over a span of three seasons, and three times led the nation in home attendance.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

In her 18th season as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 409-163 (.715) record, including her 237-83 (.741) slate in her 10th season at South Carolina. She has led her teams to eight 25-win seasons, a total of 14 postseason appearances and 76 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 12 in the No. 1 spot. Also a force in USA Basketball, she was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-20 after leading three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Cup, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Cup, 2007 Pan Am Games – and serving as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Cup and the 2008 and 2016 Olympic Games.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last 10 seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year, a Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist three times, SEC Coach of the Year three times and BCA Female Coach of the Year. She became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to do it.

Under Staley's leadership, four Gamecocks have collected eight All-America selections, two have picked up four SEC Player of the Year honors, two have earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition, one has been the SEC 6th Player of the Year and three were named SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 10 Gamecocks who earned All-SEC honors 21 times, including 11 first-team selections, and five Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including Alaina Coates who, as the No. 2 pick in 2017, became the highest pick in program history, and three others who earned WNBA All-Rookie Team honors.

On Staley's watch, the Gamecocks are enjoying the most sustained success in program history. After posting back-to-back 25-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 for the first time in more than 30 years, the 2014-15 team broke the school record with 34 wins. South Carolina won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's first seven seasons, culminating in the 2015-16 team recording just the second 16-0 conference record in league history. Staley's 97 SEC wins are more than any other Gamecock coach, accounting for 60.2 percent of the program's total 161 wins over its 26 seasons in the league. She has delivered the only SEC championships in program history, lifting that trophy four times in as many seasons, and she has helped the Gamecocks to six of the program's seven top-four finishes in the SEC. Off the court, Staley's Gamecocks have been active in the community and thriving in the classroom. Every student-athlete who completed her eligibility under Staley at South Carolina has graduated or is on track to graduate, and the team GPA has been over 3.0 for seven of the last eight semesters.


