Gamecocks Open Season at Pebble Beach

Coming off one of the most successful seasons in school history, the South Carolina men's golf team will look to continue the success as it opens the 2014-15 season this weekend at The Carmel Cup. The 54-hole event will be held at the historic Pebble Beach Golf Links in Pebble Beach, Calif.

The Lineup

- **Senior Will Murphy:** 72.63 stroke average in 2013-14...PING Honorable Mention All-American...T-15th at NCAA Championship...Five top-20 finishes.
- **Senior Caleb Sturgeon:** 72.89 stroke average in 2013-14...Four top-20 finishes...One tournament win.
- **Junior Matt NeSmith:** 72.26 stroke average...Seven top-20 finishes, including four top fives.
- **Junior Will Starke:** Team-best 72.20 stroke average...Seven top-20 finishes, including four top fives... One tournament win.
- **Sophomore Ben Dietrich:** 73.68 stroke average...Four top-20 finishes.
- **Junior Sean Kelly:** Did not play last season while recovering from a wrist injury.

About The Carmel Cup

In the tournament's final year, the field consists of four SEC teams and four Big 12 teams. The format is 54 holes of stroke play. Six golfers will be playing for each team, with five scores counting each round.

Breaking Down the Field

The field may only have eight teams, but those teams are among the best in the nation. The Gamecocks, who finished ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings last year, will be playing against seven teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including five in the top 20. Second-ranked Oklahoma State headlines the field after finishing runner-up to Alabama at the NCAA Championship last year. Fifth-ranked Georgia, No. 15 Oklahoma, No. 17 Vanderbilt, No. 18 Arkansas, No. 40 Texas Tech and No. 49 TCU round out the field. The Gamecocks had an 8-4 head-to-head record against these teams last season.

History of Pebble Beach

Pebble Beach Golf Links is one of the most famous golf courses in the world. It's the No. 1 ranked public course in America by Golf Digest and has hosted five U.S. Open Championships, most recently in 2010. In all Pebble Beach has hosted nine USGA championships.

A Top 25 Program

Under the guidance of head coach Bill McDonald, South Carolina was consistently listed in the top 25 in golf rankings last season. The Gamecocks ended the year ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings, No. 21 in the final regular-season Golf World/Nike Coaches Poll and No. 20 in the Golfweek Rankings.

A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks

finished ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 100 in the latest Golfweek/Amateurgolf.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 6 in the world and No. 2 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 179 in the world and No. 83 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 40, and NeSmith is No. 84.

Roster Breakdown

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.
