Gamecocks Travel to Seahawk Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team opens its spring season on Sunday with the first two rounds of the Seahawk Invitational hosted by UNC Wilmington. The tournament runs through Monday at the Country Club of Landfall's par-72, 6,946-yard Nicklaus Course in Wilmington, N.C.

This Week's Lineup

The Gamecocks will have the same lineup they closed out the fall with, as senior Wesley Bryan, junior Dykes Harbin, sophomore Blaine Woodruff, and freshmen Sean Kelly and Will Murphy are slated to play after a very competitive qualifier. Freshman Caleb Sturgeon will also play as an individual.

History at the Seahawk Invitational

The Gamecocks are making their third straight appearance and third overall at the Seahawk Invitational. Carolina has had success in both appearances at the Country Club of Landfall, finishing second in the tournament's inaugural year in 2010 and fifth last season.

Breaking Down the Field

Carolina will compete against 11 teams at the Seahawk Invitational, including three ranked in the Golfweek Top 50. No. 26 Chattanooga, No. 31 Liberty and No. 45 Wake Forest highlight the field, while host UNC Wilmington, East Carolina, Davidson, James Madison, George Mason, VCU, Old Dominion and Drexel will also compete for the title.

Last Time at the Seahawk Invitational

Carolina claimed fifth at last year's tournament with a score of 890 (+26). Then-junior Wesley Bryan tied for third to lead the way with a score of 219 (+3). Host UNC Wilmington won the event with a score of 879 (+15).

Young Gun

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly has made a huge impact in just three tournaments this season. Kelly, who has been the Gamecocks' top finisher in two of his three appearances, currently is second on the team with a scoring average of 73.50. He is also second on the team in rounds under par (three) and is tied for the lead for lowest 18-hole score (69) and lowest 54-hole score (218).

Steadying Force

Junior Dykes Harbin has been the Gamecocks most steady player this season. Through four tournaments, Harbin leads Carolina with a team-best 73.27 scoring average. He has turned in only three rounds worse than 73 this season and is the team leader in rounds of par or better with four.

Gamecock Men's Golf Takes Fifth at Bridgestone Collegiate

South Carolina posted a final-round 301 (+13) to finish in fifth place at the Bridgestone Golf Collegiate at Forest Oaks Country Club. The Gamecocks, who entered the day on top of the leaderboard, ended the tournament with a two-round score of 592 (+16), which was 10 strokes back of tournament champion Iowa State (582).

Senior Wesley Bryan and junior Dykes Harbin were Carolina's top finishers as they tied for 15th with two-round scores of





147 (+3). Bryan carded a 75 (+3) on Sunday, while Harbin turned in a 4-over 76.

Freshman Sean Kelly posted the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks with a 1-over 73 and ended the tournament tied for 34th with a score of 150 (+6).

Freshman Will Murphy shot a 79 (+8) on Sunday to tie for 34th with a score of 150 (+6) in his first career appearance, while sophomore Blaine Woodruff carded a 5-over 77 to tie for 72nd with a score of 156 (+12).

Gamecocks Finish Second, Kelly Third at Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 300 (+12) at the Rees Jones Signature Course at Haig Point Club to finish in second at the Rees Jones Invitational. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round score of 898 (+34).

South Carolina came up just short of winning their third title in four years at the event, finishing four strokes behind champion Kennesaw State. The Owls shot 289 (+1) on Tuesday to win their second straight Rees Jones Invitational with a score of 894 (+30).

Freshman Sean Kelly produced the best round of the day for the Gamecocks as he fired a final-round 70 (-2) to claim third place with a score of 220 (+4).

Junior Dykes Harbin turned in a 77 (+5) to give the Gamecocks a second top-10 finisher as he closed out the event with a three-round score of 222 (+6) to tie for seventh. Sophomore Blaine Woodruff carded a 76 (+4) to tie for 26th with a score of 229 (+13).

After two stellar rounds to open his Gamecock career, freshman Caleb Sturgeon struggled on Tuesday, turning in an 81(+9) to fall back to a tie for 33rd. Junior Dean Hester recorded his lowest round of the tournament with a 77 (+5) to tie for 57th with a 241 (+25).

Junior Clint Tolleson, who played the event as an individual, posted a final-round 81 (+9) and finished tied for 53rd with a score of 239 (+23).

South Carolina Finishes 11th at Mason Rudolph Championship

South Carolina freshman Sean Kelly posted a 1-under 70 to lead the Gamecocks in the final round of the Mason Rudolph Championship at the Vanderbilt Legends Club South Course. South Carolina shot a final-round 288 (+4) to finish the tournament in 11th place with a three-round score of 877 (+25).

Kelly got off to a strong start as he started the day at the 10th hole and carded a birdie. The Staten Island, N.Y., native recorded his second birdie of the day on the 14th and he went on to make the turn at 34 (-2). Kelly fell back to even with back-to-back bogeys on the first and second holes but he birdied the sixth and made par the rest of the way to wrap up the round at 1-under to finish in a tie for 31st.

Sophomores Blaine Woodruff and Caulder Moore also had solid rounds for the Gamecocks with a pair of 1-over 72s. Woodruff finished in a tie for 55th, while Moore tied for 51st.

Junior Dykes Harbin was the second-highest finisher for the Gamecocks, claiming a tie for 34th after a final-round 75 (+4). Senior Wesley Bryan wrapped up the event in a tie for 39th after carding a 74 (+3).

Gamecocks Tie for 11th to Open Season

South Carolina recorded a final-round 300 (+12) and tied for 11th place to wrap up play at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club to open the 2011-12 season. The Gamecocks finished the week with a team total of 890 (+26).

Junior Dykes Harbin proved to be the most consistent Gamecock during the weekend as he posted a final-round 72 (E) to finish the tournament in a tie for 21st with rounds of 73-73-72=218 (+2).

Sophomore Blaine Woodruff improved his score for the third straight day with a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 35th with rounds of 76-74-73=223 (+7).

After posting the Gamecocks' tournament low with a 3-under 69 in the second round, senior Wesley Bryan was unable to carry that momentum into the final round with a 6-over 78 to wrap up the tournament in a tie for 42nd with rounds of 78-69-78=225 (+9).

Sophomore Caulder Moore made the turn at even par but fell back on the back nine with four bogeys and a double bogey as he turned in a 77 (+5) for the round, while sophomore Logan Harrell posted an 82 (+10) for the Gamecocks.
