Thanks for your support as the Gamecocks move on to the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship! Please see below for some reminders for boosters attending Regional, Super Regional, and College World Series events.

It is NOT permissible for boosters to provide extra benefits to student-athletes and/or their family and friends.

An extra benefit is considered the receipt of any gift by a student-athlete or a student-athlete's relative or friend at a free or reduced cost, or any special arrangement that is not available to the general public and the student body as a whole.

Examples of extra benefits include, but are not limited to:

- Transportation to the competition site or transportation at the competition site (e.g., car ride, plane tickets, gas money)
- · Entertainment, such as providing tickets to games or other events in the city
- Meals, including food provided at tailgates
- · Cash gifts
- Lodging expenses

The receipt of a benefit not authorized by NCAA regulations by a student-athlete or his/her parent(s) will immediately place in jeopardy the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate athletics competition.
