A South Carolina Win Would...

- Make the Gamecocks 7-1 to start the season, the best mark since opening the 2003-04 season with an 8-1 mark.
- Be the Gamecocks' fourth on the road this season, just one shy of the program's most under head coach Dawn Staley, which is five in the 2009-10 season. South Carolina has not won more than five true road games since 1990-91.
- Be the Gamecocks' fourth straight over NC State dating back to Dec. 14, 2009, when a buzzer beater from Demetress Adams ended a five-game skid to the Wolfpack in Staley's first season.

Last Time Out

Senior Markeshia Grant got the offense going early and helped sustain it late in a 67-56 win at Xavier Wednesday night. Her career-high 18 points led four Gamecocks in double figures as freshman Aleighsa Welch added 16, including 10 from the free throw line. South Carolina shot a season-high 44.0 percent from the field and netted 21 free throws as the constant aggressor.

NC State Series Notes

The Wolfpack lead the series 18-11 but the Gamecocks have won the last three meetings, including last season's 77-63 victory in Columbia on Dec. 12. That outing was the most lop-sided of the three wins as the other two came by a a combined four points.

The last time these two teams met in Reynolds Coliseum, where the Wolfpack holds an 8-4 advantage over the Gamecocks, was the most dramatic in recent series history. The game on Jan. 14, 2009, saw five lead changes in the final minute of play with Demetress Adams striking the final blow at the buzzer to give the Gamecocks a 56-55 win, snapping a five-game losing streak to NC State.

Road Warriors

South Carolina has a 182-230 (.442) alltime record on the road. The Gamecocks' best season on the road was 1979-80 when they went 11-4. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South

Carolina is 13-21 in road games. In her 11th season as a head coach, Staley has a 75-67 road record.

The Gamecocks are 3-0 on the road so far this season, matching last season's road win total. The most true road games South Carolina has won under Staley is five, which the 2009-10 team amassed. The Gamecocks have not won more than five true road games in a season since the 1990-91 squad went 6-4.

Defense Hits High Marks

When the NCAA released its first statistical rankings for this season through games of Nov. 27, the South Carolina defense proved to be among the nation's best. The Gamecocks were fifth in the nation (first in the SEC) in scoring defense, 11th in 3-point field goal percentage defense and 20th in turnover

South Carolina has allowed more than 55 points just once in seven games this season - Xavier netted 56 on Nov. 30. Much of that low scoring may be courtesey of the Gamecocks' ability to eliminate the 3-point shot as a weapon. South Carolina has allowed just one team to shoot better than 33.3 percent from behind the arc – Illinois (1-of-2, .500). For teams attempting at least five 3s, just two have shot better than 28 percent – Presbyterian (2-of-7, .333) and

The trio of experienced guards have helped the Gamecocks on both sides of the turnover margin. The Gamecocks have forced 20 or more turnovers in five of their seven gams this season while committing 20 or more turnovers only once (vs. College of Charleston, Nov. 23).

For Starters

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has started the same five Gamecocks in each game this season and has always liked the idea of bringing an offensive weapon off the bench. That strategy seems to be working to full effect this season as 53.1 percent of the Gamecocks' scoring has come from someone not in the starting five. It is the highest percentage of bench scoring in Staley's tenure at South Carolina - in 2010-11, the bench netted 36.7 percent of the team's points; in 2009-10, it was 27.5 percent; and in her inaugural season of 2008-09 it was 29.0 percent. The delay tactic has not slowed the Gamecocks' production in the early going as they have been in the lead in all every game in the opening five minutes.

With both junior Ashley Bruner and freshman Aleighsa Welch coming off the bench, the reserves have accounted for 62.8 percent of the team's rebounding this season. Bruner has reeled in a team-best 8.3 boards per game, while Welch is second at 6.1. Junior guard Ieasia Walker actually leads the starting group on the boards as her 4.1 per contest is third-best on the team.

Tough to Scout

Throughout the preseason, head coach Dawn Staley talked about the versatility of her team as a key to the season's success. While she may have been speaking more about the various ways individual players could find to score, it's been the Gamecocks' ability to get points from various locations that has delivered the program's best opening record since 2003-04. In seven games, five different players have led the team in scoring - Ashley Bruner (2), Markeshia Grant (2), Tina Roy (1), Charenee Stephens (1) and Ieasia Walker (1). In all, eight different Gamecocks have scored at least 10 points in at least one game this season.

Helping Hand

With arguably the best point guard in international women's basketball history at the helm, South Carolina has been at its best when its assist numbers are highest. In the Dawn Staley era (2008-09 through present), the Gamecocks are 36-15 when handing out 10 or more assists, including a 4-0 mark this season. When missing the 10-assist plateau, South Carolina is just 13-35 overall with Staley, including a 4-20 mark in SEC action. That overall record includes this season's 2-1 ledger.

Triple Play

Coming into the season, may observers felt the fate of the Gamecocks' season rested largely in the hands of its experienced backcourt - seniors Markeshia Grant and La'Keisha Sutton and junior Ieasia Walker. Through the first seven games, that has certainly been the case as between their points and assists, the trio has contributed to 60.1 percent of the team's 60.6 points per game.

The trio's camaraderie on and off the floor has bred friendly competition specifically between the two seniors, designed to ultimately guide the team to its goals. After Sutton led the team with 3.6 assists per game last season, Grant has set her sights on unseating her classmate in the assist department.

Sutton is currently leading the friendly competition with 27 assists - 3.9 per game to rank 11th in the SEC. Grant has the edge in efficiency, however, with a 1.9 assist-to-turnover ratio and leads the scoring battle with 9.0 points per game, second-best average on the team.

Not So Fast

While the backcourt got all the attention leading into the season, a member of the Gamecock frontcourt leads the team in scoring as junior Ashley Bruner's 10.7 points per game includes four double-digit outings and ranks among the top 30 averages

On the Horizon

Head coach Dawn Staley inked four players in the early signing period. Below is a brief look at each of the future Gamecocks.

- Tiffany Davis (Houston, Texas/Westbury Christian) is a 5-foot-8 point guard rated the 29th in the 2012 class at that position. Before transferring to Westbury Christian, she helped Westside High to the 2011 District 20-5A championship game. Davis earned all-region and first-team all-district honors as a junior, netting 16.0 points per game.
- Asia Dozier (Columbia, S.C./Spring Valley) is a 5-foot-11 guard who helped Spring Valley to state championships in 2009 and 2011. Rated the 34th-best guard in the 2012 class and a four-star player by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz, Dozier averaged 17.1 ppg and 3.8 apg as a junior as the Lady Vikings went 29-0. As a freshman, her 18.3 ppg and 3.8 apg earned her Class 4A Area Player of the Year honors from The State newspaper. Her father, Perry, and uncle Terry Dozier also played basketball for the
- Tina Mitchell (Charlotte, N.C./Providence Day) is a 5-foot-10 guard who is rated among the top 50 players in the 2012 class by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz. She earned South Charlotte player of the year honors and was an Associated Press All-State selection after averaging 18.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 4.2 steals and 3.9 assists as a junior. She guided the Chargers to 21 straight wins in 2010-11, including the program's second-straight NCISAA state title.
- Khadijah Sessions (Myrtle Beach, S.C./ Myrtle Beach) is a 5-foot-6 point guard rated the seventh-best in the class at her position by ESPN Hoop/Gurlz. The 40thranked player overall, she averaged 17.9 points and 5.7 assists as a junior while leading the Seahawks to their secondstraight AAA state championship. A member of the all-state team, Sessions also captured all-region honors last season.

in the SEC. Additionally, she ranks 13th in the league in field goal percentage (.517).

Particularly when it comes to the assist battle in the backcourt, South Carolina's forwards will be counted on to deliver the basket at the end of those passes. The six forwards on the South Carolina roster have accounted for 44.2 percent of the team's 60.6 points per game – Bruner 10.7 ppg, Charenee Stephens 4.6 ppg, Aleighsa Welch 7.4 ppg, Elem Ibiam 3.0 ppg, Courtney Newton 1.1 and Pamela Decheva 0.0.

Deciding December

The Gamecocks are 146-76 (.658) all-time in the month of December, including an 87-22 (.798) record at home. Under head coach Dawn Staley, South Carolina is 14-6 in the final month of the year. The Gamecocks went 4-3 in Staley's first year at the helm (2008-09), were 4-2 in 2009-10 and posted a 6-1 mark last season.

Strength of Schedule

After finishing the 2010-11 campaign with the nation's 19th-toughest schedule, the Gamecocks are facing another challenging slate in 2011-12. With both the Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN

Coaches preseason polls released this week, South Carolina will play seven games against nationally ranked teams. Another five games will be against teams that also received votes in one or both polls.

Seventeen of the Gamecocks' 29 games this season will be against teams that participated in the 2011 postseason, including nine who were in the NCAA Tournament. Of the 24 opponents on the schedule, eight finished the 2010-11 season with an RPI in the top 50. Six others closed with an RPI between 51 and 100.

Watching the Gamecocks

Fans can catch up with the Gamecocks on television 12 times this season, including a pair of games on the ESPN family of networks. South Carolina will also live stream video of all of its non-televised home games for free via its official athletics website, www.GamecocksOnline.com.

The television schedule opens with four non-conference games on SportSouth, beginning with the Penn State game on Nov. 20. The station also will air games against College of Charleston (Nov. 23), Presbyterian (Nov. 27) and Furman (Dec. 11). The SEC package kicks in on Jan. 22 with the contest at Vanderbilt airing on ESPNU. Fox Sports Net will show the home game against Ole Miss (Jan. 26), and SEC Network will air the Mississippi State tilt (Jan. 29). Following the CSS broadcast of the game at Tennessee (Feb. 2), ESPN2 comes to Columbia for the Florida game (Feb. 12). The games against Georgia (Feb. 16) and at Alabama (Feb. 19) will air on FSN, and

SEC Network closes out the string with the regular-season finale against Arkansas (Feb. 26). South Carolina is 2-1 this season in live televised games.
