South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball and the program's 24th in the SEC.
- South Carolina is in its seventh season under head coach Dawn Staley, during which the Gamecocks have gone 123-71. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16.
- South Carolina is looking for its 21st-straight win at Colonial Life Arena tonight.
- With this week's ranking of No. 2, South Carolina has been in the AP top 10 for 13 straight weeks/
 polls. The Gamecocks ended the 2013-14 season ranked eighth and opened this season at No. 2. It
 matches the longest top-10 stretch for the program, originally set from Jan. 22, 1980 through Dec.
 16, 1980.
- South Carolina has not allowed a team to shoot 50.0 percent from the field since Feb. 28, 2013, (Missouri). The highest field goal percentage defense last season, during which the Gamecocks ranked fifth in the nation in the category, was .459 by North Carolina in Myrtle Beach as one of just six games that saw an opponent reach the .400 mark.
- Moving senior forward Aleighsa Welch to the wing for stretches of the game may be slowing her rebounding pace, but it has not impacted her field goal percentage or shot-blocking ability. She is shooting 75.0 percent from the field after finished 14th in the nation in the category last season (57.4) and is blocking 2.5 shots per game.
- Sophomore center Alaina Coates has two double-doubles in as many games this season.
- The Gamecocks' 99 points against Clemson Thursday night tied the Staley-era record and was the sixth 99-point game in Colonial Life Arena history. The score also generated the most lop-sided victory in the history of that rivalry with South Carolina winning by 58 points.
- South Carolina handed out a Staley-era record tying 25 assists against Clemson Thursday night,
- In a vote of student-athletes and coaches, the Gamecocks have four captains this season Asia Dozier, Elem Ibiam, Tiffany Mitchell and Aleighsa Welch.

San Diego State Series Notes

The Gamecocks have won both previous meetings with the Aztecs. Today's game is the first of the series in Columbia.

South Carolina opened the series with a 58-55 win over San Diego State on the final day of the U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam on Nov. 28, 2009. The Aztecs were ranked No. 23 in the nation, becoming the first ranked team the Gamecocks upset in the Dawn Staley era.

Last season, the two teams opened this homeand-home series being closed out today. The then-No. 19/14 Gamecocks scored an 88-54 win on Nov. 23, 2013, at Viejas Arena at Aztec Bowl. Four Gamecocks scored in double figures, led by Alaina Coates' 21 behind 5-of-6 shooting from the field and 11-of-15 accuracy from the free throw line. South Carolina shot 52.7 percent from the field but were out-rebounded 31-30.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are in the midst of unprecedented success at Colonial Life Arena, having won their last 20 games on their home court, including the first perfect season in 2013-14. That 16-0 mark alone matched the previous record for win streak at the facility, originally set Jan. 20, 2002-Jan. 9, 2003. South Carolina's last loss at Colonial Life Arena was a 50-48 decision to then-No. 14 Texas A&M on Feb. 10, 2013.

Overall, South Carolina is 135-58 (.699) at Colonial Life Arena, including a 69-25 (.734) mark under head coach Dawn Staley. In the now 41-year history of the program, the Gamecocks are 380-155 (.710) in home games.

Poll Presence

South Carolina's second week at No. 2 in the Associated Press Preseason Top 25, makes it the Gamecocks 13th-straight week in the AP top 10. The current streak matches the program's longest top-10 stretch originally set from Jan. 22, 1980 through Dec. 16, 1980.

The No. 2 ranking, originally earned in the preseason poll matches the program's all-time highest ranking and marked the best preseason rank in school history. The 1981-82 team earned the previous best marks with a preseason rank of No. 4 and spending three weeks at No. 2 (Dec. 20, 1981-Jan. 3, 1982).

Crowd Control

The Gamecocks drew 10,057 fans to their season opener against Southern Cal, the largest crowd for a home opener since the opening game at Colonial Life Arena drew 17,712.

Fans raised that number to 11,012 five nights later against Clemson, the third largest women's basketball attendance in facility history.

South Carolina women's basketball has logged six crowds of over 10,000 fans in Colonial Life Arena history, five of which have come in the last three seasons.

Reading Day Recognition

South Carolina's Read with the Gamecocks program continues this season with today's recognition of the first segment's winners. The 95 elementary schools in that participated for this segment included over 6,000 students read more than 1.4 million pages over the two-week period.

The school that turned in the most pages read for this segment was Oak Pointe Elementary in Irmo, S.C., whose students read over 147,000 pages. Individuals who read the most pages in the state were Carolina Elementary's Emily Grantham and High Hills Elementary's Jaleah Singleton.

Welch Watch

Already third in school history in career offensive rebounds (347), senior forward Aleighsa Welch looks to mount an attack on other parts of the Gamecock record book before closing out her

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge for the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently tied for fifth with 133 in her career, matching Ilona Burgrova's (2005-08) total. Next on the list is Demetress Adams (2006-09) with 140, and the career record of 177 set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07) is also well within reach.

Back in (Garnet and) Black

A huge reason the this season's lofty expectations is the return of all five starters among the 10 returning letterwinners. The Gamecocks return 97.6 percent of their scoring, 96.0 percent of their rebounding, 98.4 percent of their assists and 97.1 percent of their school-record shot blocking from last season's top-10 squad. Nine of the 10 returners played in at least 29 of the team's 34 games last season and contributed at least 2.0 points per game.

Elite Additions

The Gamecocks added the nation's No. 2 signing class to their core of returning letterwinners. Four of the five signees will take the court for the Gamecocks this season, led by No. 1 A'ja Wilson and No. 7 Jatarie White. Two other top-35 signees – Bianca Cuevas, Kaydra Duckett – round out the group that will contribute this season.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

As just the second sophomore ever to earn SEC Player of the Year honors from the league's coaches last season, junior Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed by the SEC coaches and media to claim the award again this season. If that prediction comes true, Mitchell would become just the seventh player to pick up the award twice in her career, joining South Carolina assistant coach Nikki McCray (1994, 1995) among others.

Power of Three

Prior to the season, espnW ranked the top 25 college players in the nation, and a trio of Gamecocks made the list. Reigning SEC Player of the Year Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed No. 4 in the nation because "[her] greatest strength is that she doesn't really have a weakness. Shooting, penetrating, distributing, rebounding, defending and leading from her point guard spot are all part of Mitchell's resume," according to Charlie Creme. Two-time All-SEC selection Aleighsa Welch came in on the No. 7 spot for her ability to "come up with the big basket or the big rebound when the Gamecocks need it most," per Michelle Smith. 2014 SEC Freshman of the Year Alaina Coates captured the No. 25 position despite "just scratching the surface of her potential...she could be unstoppable inside, even without a large repertoire of moves," per Mechelle Voepel.

Ticket Boom

After updating the Colonial Life Arena attendance top-10 list five times last season, South Carolina ranked 10th in the nation in average attendance (6,371) last season. The athletics department responded to the demand by expanding the number of reserved-seat sections available to fans. The response was so overwhelming that the sections expanded again in late October. In all, the Gamecocks have over 7,600 season-ticket holders, a significant increase from last season's 4,213.

Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

Cliney to Miss 2014-15 Season

South Carolina announced in September that the NCAA approved an initial eligibility waiver for freshman Doniyah Cliney, which allowed her to enroll in school but not compete for the Gamecocks in the 2014-15 season. The guard will focus on academics in the fall semester with an opportunity to begin practicing with the team beginning in the spring semester.

Cliney was ranked the 13th-best guard in the 2014 class and helped Malcolm X Shabazz to state titles in her final two seasons. The honorable mention all-state selection averaged 13.4 points, 3.3 assists and 5.2 rebounds as a senior. She shot 48 percent from the field, including 39 percent from 3-point range.

DAWN STALEY

7th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 295-151 record, including her 123-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14.Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
