The Quick Hit on 2010-11

South Carolina took their season motto of "We Rise" to heart and turned in the best season of head coach Dawn Staley's tenure and the best SEC showing in eight seasons. With an 18-15 overall record and an 8-8 mark in league play, the Gamecocks took the fifth seed in the SEC Tournament, winning a game at the event for the first time since 2006-07, and advanced to the second round of the WNIT, marking the program's first postseason appearance with Staley at the helm.

Looking back on Staley's preseason analysis of her team, the breakdown ended up turned upside down, but the result was still a net gain for the Gamecocks. Defense was key to the team's success as the Gamecocks allowed just 59.6 points per game, the fourth lowest in school history. An undersized frontcourt was offset by a team approach to rebounding that saw the Gamecocks finish sixth in the league in rebounding margin. The area Staley had been unworried about entering the season – offense – was the part of the game that most confounded the Gamecocks at times as they shot just 38.0 percent from the field on the season, including just 27.1 percent from 3-point range. Of course, that number was severely hampered by the preseason injury to senior guard Valerie Nainima, 2009-10 team's top scorer.

For the Record

In 2010-11, South Carolina hit a few high points the program had not seen in several seasons.

- Eight SEC wins were the most since 2002-03.
- Tied for fifth in the SEC standings was the best finish since 2002-03.
- A .500 winning percentage in league play was the most since the 2005-06 squad also split its games (7-7).
- 18 overall wins were the most since 2006-07.
- 62-50 victory over Ole Miss in the first round of the SEC Tournament was first win at the event since the 2007-08 season.
- Staley's eight-win improvement from her first season to her third (10 to 18) is the largest increase by a Gamecock head coach in his/her first three seasons at the helm.
- 15.5 turnovers per game were the lowest for the Gamecocks since the 1995-96 squad handed it over 15.7 times per contest.
- A .737 winning percentage at Colonial Life Arena was the third best since moving into the facility for the 2002-03 season.
- 14 home victories were the fourth most in school history.

Super Schedule

With the nation's 19th-toughest schedule, the Gamecocks took on four non-conference opponents that finished the season with an RPI in the top 30 to set the tone for a stringent SEC slate. With the unbalanced league schedule, South Carolina was one of just two schools that played three of the league's top four teams twice. Four SEC teams faced only one of the four teams multiple times. The Gamecocks went 2-4 against the league's top four – Tennessee, Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Georgia – topping Florida's 1-5 mark against the same set of foes.

Using the NCAA's final RPI ratings, the Gamecocks played 14 games against teams ranked in the top 50, recording a pair of victories (Georgia, Jan. 27; Kentucky, Feb. 10). Only three of South Carolina's 15 losses came to teams with a final RPI higher than 50 (UC Davis, 103, Nov. 28; Auburn, 84, Jan. 30; LSU, 51, Feb. 24), and the Gamecocks had 11 wins against teams totting an RPI of 51-150.

Walking on Sunshine

Sophomore guard Ieasia Walker earned second-team All-SEC honors from the league coaches and was an honorable mention selection by the Associated Press. She finished the season ranked among the SEC's top 10 in both points (13.3) and steals (2.8) per league game, turning in double-figure points in 14 of 16 SEC contests. She was third on the team in rebounding in league games and was second in assists.

Overall for the season, Walker led the team with 12.2 points and 2.4 steals per game, which ranked 17th and third, respectively, in the SEC. She netted double figures 23 times, during which the Gamecocks went 13-10, and had four 20-point games. Walker was the team's high scorer a team-high 14 times and paced the squad in assists eight times. With 20 points and 11 rebounds at Ole Miss, she recorded the program's first points-rebounds double-double by a guard since Kellindra Zachery turned in 28 points and 11 boards against NC A&T on Nov. 17, 2006.

Giving with Both Hands

Junior guard La'Keisha Sutton finished the season among the most well-rounded guards in South Carolina history. She was among the top playmakers in recent years as her 3.6 assists per game were the most by a Gamecock since Cristina Ciocan handed out 5.1 per game in 2003-04. Adding 10.2 points per game to that assist average, Sutton became just the 13th player at South Carolina to close her season with that many assists per game while also averaging double-figure points.

Sutton ranked among the SEC's elite in scoring (27th), assists (seventh), assist-to-turnover ratio (11th, 0.9) and minutes played (ninth). She scored in double figures 16 times, including three 20-point games, and led the team in points seven times. Handing out four or more assists 17 times in 33 games,

Markeshia Grant was the Gamecocks' most consistent performer in postseason action, starting with her 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in the SEC Tournament.

Sutton was the team leader in assists 26 times. Between her points and assists, she accounted for 34.4 percent of the team's total points (20.1 ppg) in SEC play.

In 2010-11, she twice dished out a career-best eight assists, including against Florida in SEC action. Coincidentally, she also netted 13 points in each of those eight-assist games (vs. Charleston Southern). Sutton was also one of four Gamecocks to turn in a perfect shooting game on the season, hitting 6-of-6 from the field against Presbyterian.

Posting Up

Statistically the most undersized team in the SEC, South Carolina still battled its way into the top half of the league in rebounding margin in league play (sixth, -0.3). South Carolina was out-rebounded just six times in conference play, and only Tennessee managed to pull down a double-digit advantage. In fact, taking out the two games against the Lady Vols, who boasted four players standing 6-foot-3 or taller, the Gamecocks had a +2.6 rebounding margin in SEC action.

Doing yeoman's work on the glass were forwards Ashley Bruner and Charenee Stephens. While rebounding was a team effort of the Gamecocks, Bruner and Stephens did a majority of the banging underneath to reel in 5.3 and 4.8 boards per game, respectively.

Bruner led the team in rebounding 13 times on the season, including three games of double-digit boards. She posted her first career double-double in the season opener, posting 17 points and 15 rebounds against then-No. 5/6 Xavier.

Stephens was the top rebounder in eight games in 2010-11, adding five games of double-digit boards. She added two double-doubles to her career total (now at seven), helping the Gamecocks to wins in both, including the WNIT first-round win over Appalachian State.

All in Good Time

Junior transfer Markeisha Grant had what has become a typical up-and-down season for guards in their first season under the watchful eyes of head coach Dawn Staley. Instead of growing frustrated with varying playing time and efforts that did not always show up in the box score, Grant committed herself to doing whatever the team needed whenever she was asked.

She first made her reputation on the defensive end, where she became the Gamecocks' spark off the bench. Grant was a key figure in the comeback victory over LSU, which the Gamecocks had not defeated since 1998. Her pressure defense led to a pair of steals and countless disruptions of the Lady Tigers' defense, and she added 12 points on 3-of-4 shooting from 3-point range as well. The game was something of a turning point, as Grant saw her minutes rise to 20+ nearly every game.

After grinding on solid numbers that helped her earn two starts down the stretch in SEC action, Grant stamped her authority on postseason play. In the four games South Carolina played in the SEC Tournament and Women's NIT combined, she averaged a team-best 12.3 points and 5.5 rebounds. She was the top rebounder in both games at the SEC Tournament, averaging 7.5 boards per outing at the event, and netted 13 of the team's 34 points in the second-round loss to Georgia.

Senior Send-Off

The Gamecocks said good-bye to a pair of outstanding seniors at the end of the 2010-11 season in forward Jewel May and guard Valerie Nainima. The two team captains both played critical roles in the team's success despite the different numbers that showed up in the box scores.

A three-year starter, May was among the Gamecocks' most reliable players, starting 87 of the team's 90 games played during her last three seasons, all while battling through a myriad of injuries. A finalist for the SEC's Brad Davis Community Service Postgraduate Scholarship and one of the 26 recipients of the NCAA's Ethnic Minority and Women's Enhancement Postgraduate Scholarships for Careers in Athletics, she earned degrees in psychology and sociology with a minor in art. A solid presence and dedicated mentor for the program's young post players, May was ninth in the SEC with 2.6 offensive rebounds per game in league play in 2010-11. She enjoyed her most productive season in the Garnet and Black as a sophomore, turning in 4.7 points and 5.1 rebounds per game.

Nainima made her mark on the South Carolina program despite spending only two seasons as a Gamecock, including 2010-11, which got off to a late start thanks to a preseason knee injury. Playing just 54 games in the Garnet and Black, Nainima ranks eighth in school history with 115 career 3-pointers made, 10th with 340 career 3-point attempts and fourth in career 3-point percentage (.338). The transfer from Long Island University earned second-team All-SEC honors as a junior behind 28 double-digit scoring games in 29 outings. Her 2.8 3-pointers per game that season were 17th-most in the nation and fourth-best in the SEC.
