Scored 28 points at the SEC Championships with fifth-place finishes in both the one-meter and three-meter events...Top six-dive score in the three-meter came against Florida State with a 323.85...Top one-meter score was in the season-opener against Virginia Tech (336.45)... 2007-08 SEASON REVIEW Men: 2-8 (0-5 SEC) Women: 4-6 (1-4 SEC)

Four Gamecock swimmers and divers advanced to the NCAA Championships with one bringing home All-America honors as South Carolina finished strong to wrap up the 2007-08 season. Freshman Taryn Zack earned an eighth-place finish in the onemeter diving event to give South Carolina its 34th All-America diving certificate. In addition, she earned Honorable Mention All-America honors in the three-meter event with an 11th-place finish.

Dominique Lendjel and Nicholas Walkotten represented South Carolina's men at the NCAA Championships, and Christy Williams swam for the Gamecock women. All three posted solid times in their respective events but fell short of qualifying for the finals and earning points.

Walkotten made his mark at the 2008 SEC Championships, breaking the school record in the 200 butterfly (1:43.83) and grabbing a second-place finish to earn Second-Team All-SEC honors. Walkotten scored a total of 35 individual points at the SEC Championships in the 200 fly, 100 fly and 100 back. In addition, the Carolina men got points from Lendjel (200 IM) and all three relay teams en route to an eighth-place finish.

In the men's diving portion, David Ovelson concluded his career by earning the bronze medal in men's diving with a third-place finish in the one-meter event. Corry Christian joined Ovelson in scoring points for the Carolina men as he finished eighth.

For the Gamecock women, Amanda Dunnigan scored in a pair of individual events at the SEC Championships with a 12th-place finish in the 400 IM and a 16th-place time in the 200 IM. South Carolina also got points from twin freshmen Claire and Christine Thompson, who combined to score eight at the SEC meet in the 1650 free and 200 free.

In the diving well, Zack turned in a fifth-place finish in both the one-meter and three-meter competitions, and Allison Barr finished seventh in the one-meter competition to score 12 points for South Carolina.

South Carolina's men posted a 2-8 regular season dual meet record with victories over Duke and Davidson, while the women finished 4-6, also winning over Duke and Davidson and adding a pair of triumphs against Clemson and Alabama.
