## NOTEWORTHY

## SCOUTING LSU

LSU has followed a disappointing 2016 season with a tremendous start to 2017. The Tigers come into the weekend at 10-3 overall 1-1 in the SEC, already surpassing their win total from last year. Along the way, the team has strong wins over High Point, UConn, Houston and a recent 3-0 win over perennial SEC power Texas A&M. Of the three losses, two came on the road to North Carolina and Baylor. 13 letter winners and five starters return from 2016, and the addition of freshman middle Taylor Bannister (3.09 kills per set) has added even more depth to the offense. Outside hitter Gina Tillis remains one of the finest six-rotation starters in the SEC, and Toni Rodriguez ranks third in kills. On defense, sophomore Jacqui Armer stand third overall in the conference at 1.41 blocks per set, and four different Tigers average two or more digs per set.

### SCOUTING TENNESSEE

The Volunteers were 1-1 in the first weekend of the conference season, and will play at No. 1 Florida Friday before coming to Carolina for a Sunday afternoon match. Tennessee is 8-3 for the year, winning four of the last five. One of the most physical teams in the country, UT ranks 12th nationally in blocks per set (2.97) and is 25th in opponent hitting percentage (.156). Those numbers are thanks in large part to the duo of Alyssa Andreno (1.36 blocks per set) and Erica Treiber (1.38), who both rank in the top 50 nationally. Also aiding the strong defense is libero Brooke Schumacher, leads the team with 4.51 digs per set (4th in the SEC). On offense, the team got a big boost with the return of sophomore standout Tessa Grubbs, who missed the first three weeks of the season due to injury but is now posting 3.25 kills per set. Kendra Turner leads the team in kills, with Treiber and Andreno close behind.

### MISSISSIPPI STATE NOTABLES

- Mikayla Shields' 20 digs are a new personal best, breaking the 19 she had against Miami (Ohio). She now has six double-doubles this season, the fifth-most in the SEC.
- Shields (20 digs) and Aubrey Ezell (21 digs) combined to be the first Gamecock duo to each get 20 digs in a
  match since Nov. 19, 2014.
- South Carolina out-blocked Mississippi State 10-2 for the night, and the Bulldogs hit just .079 in the match, the lowest by a Gamecock opponent since Gardner-Webb on Sept. 17, 2016.
- South Carolina had started the SEC season with a win on the road for the first time since 2003.
- The Gamecocks committed 18 service errors in the match, the most since Aug. 31, 2006 against Clemson.

### QUOTABLE: SCOTT SWANSON

On the win at Mississippi State

"That was not our best match, but a lot of credit to Mississippi State. I thought they served us strategically, kind of got us rattled early with some short balls. We have a lot of young players where this is their first SEC match ... we definitely could have handled that better, but thank goodness we came out of it and played pretty well at times. Thrilled to get the win, but would've loved if it wasn't quite so stressful."

#### SHIELD-BEARER

Mikayla Shields is following up a record-breaking freshman season with an even better sophomore campaign so far in 2017. The Orlando, Fla. native has upped her kills per set from 3.25 to 3.69, is hitting 23 points higher, and already surpassed her entire 2016 total for digs. Through 13 matches, she has six double-doubles, and recently set new personal bests with 26 kills against Miami (Ohio) (9/16) and 20 digs at Mississippi State (9/22).

## NOTEWORTHY

### SWANSON REACHES THE CENTURY MARK

Head coach Scott Swanson earned his 100th win at South Carolina, and 150th career win as a head coach, on Friday following the 3-2 victory at Mississippi State. Currently in his seventh season leading the program, Swanson already stands third in school history for career wins.

### **ROBINSON WITH A HISTORIC DEBUT**

In her first collegiate match, freshman middle Mikayla Robinson led the Gamecocks with 12 kills on 13 attacks against Mercer on Aug. 25, giving her a final hitting percentage of .846. That is the highest by any Gamecock with double-digit kills in a match since Lori Rowe hit .870 back on Sept. 17, 1983. Robinson and Rowe are the only Gamecocks to ever finish with a hitting percentage of .800 or better with double-digit kills.

### AN ACE FOR THE AGES

Aubrey Ezell had a career weekend at the Carolina Classic tournament (9/15-16), as the junior posted 16 aces over the team's 13 sets. In the Friday night match against Miami (Ohio), she matched her career high with six aces. Five of those six aces came in the third set alone, and pushed her past 100 for her career. Ezell is the first player in the rally-scoring era (since 2001) to eclipse 100 aces, and she is the first player to reach the century mark since Megan Hosp in 2002. Now with 114 for her career, Ezell is just two away from moving into the program's all-time top 10.

## A 'FRESH' PERSPECTIVE

The Gamecocks welcome in four freshman for the 2017 season...

- Brooke Gostomski was a multiple-time Wisconsin Volleyball Coaches Association (WVCA) All-State honoree for Muskego High School. So far this season, she has played in 11 matches and has 10 kills and 13 digs.
- Walk-on Ellie Popelka was a high school all-american for Jamestown High School in Virginia. She made the AVCA's phenom team three times, and was the Wendy's High School Heisman representative for Jamestown.
- Mikayla Robinson comes to Carolina as a top-20 recruit, and made Volleyball Magazine's Fab 50 team. Her father, Marcus, was a star football player at South Carolina and in the NFL. Robinson has started in every match so far, and ranks second on the team in kills and leads the way with 46 total blocks.
- Jess Vastine is another high school all-american, coming to Columbia from Wittman, Arizona. She finished second in kills and third in aces at the state's Division II level. Vastine earned a larger role as the non-conference season came to a close and has six starts under her belt. She is averaging 1.08 kills and 1.36 digs per set, and also has five service aces.

## FURLONG AND LOCK OVERCOME INJURIES TO PROVIDE DEPTH

Juniors Courtney Furlong and Emma Lock both entered the season as question marks, after going through major injuries last season. Lock missed most of her sophomore campaign with a shoulder injury, and Furlong suffered through a back injury during the team's winter training and had to have surgery in May. With both back in the rotation, they have immediately boosted the team both on and off the court. Lock has seen time in 12 matches, and is averaging 1.03 digs per set as a defensive specialist. Furlong has started in six matches and has been one of the team's best passers and surest blockers as a left side pin.

## WHEN THE GAMECOCKS WIN...

- The team is out-hitting the opposition .322 to .142, and committing 2.92 fewer attack errors per set.
- Tough service has helped the team; it actually has a higher service error rate in matches won (88.7 percent in wins, 92.7 percent in losses).
- Physicality at the net has been the biggest key to winning and losing. In seven wins, the team averages three blocks per set.
- The offense features the middle attackers much more in wins. Starting middles Mikayla Robinson and Claire Edwards combine for 4.57 kills and hit .404 in wins, but just 3.54 with a .171 percentage in losses.

#### WHEN THE GAMECOCKS LOSE ...

The offense is hitting just .197 in losses, and the defense is allowing opponents to hit .219. Only one of Carolina's top six hitters are above .250 through the team's five losses.

- The team is averaging just 1.82 blocks per set in losses.
- Opponents serving tough have troubled the team. In Gamecock losses, opponents' service percentage is only slightly higher than in Gamecock wins (.906 in losses, .893 in wins). The second touch has been the issue for Carolina, as the setting percentage drops from .413 in wins to just .324 in losses.

### HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE

With six home matches already in the books, four of the six now rank among the program's top 10 crowds of all time. In the latest rankings, the Gamecocks come in at No. 25 nationally for average attendance, fourth in the SEC.

### GAMECOCKS EARN AVCA ACADEMIC HONORS

The 2016 squad earned a place on AVCA Team Academic Award for the sixthstraight season. The team's 3.673 GPA for the team in the spring semester was the second-highest in program history.

### 2016-17 PROGRAM NOTABLES

- South Carolina is coming of an 18-win season in 2016, the most since 2012.
- The offense hit a combined .246 for the year, 37 points higher than 2015 and the third-highest overall in the last decade.
- Mikayla Shields finished the season with team highs in kills (341) and hitting
  percentage (.308). She is the first Gamecock since Shonda Cole in 2006 to lead
  the team in both categories, and is the first since Belita Salters in 2008 to have
  over 300 kills while also hitting above .300.
- Alicia Starr set the freshman record for blocks per set in the rally-scoring era (1.13).
- Aubrey Ezell shattered the sophomore service aces record, with 41.

## ALL-TIME RECORDS

- South Carolina holds a 793-617 (.562) all-time record, dating back to 1973.
- The Gamecocks joined the SEC for volleyball in 1991, and have an all-time conference record of 180-237 (.431).
- In matches in the Carolina Volleyball Center, Carolina 188-102 (.651).
- With 100 career wins, head coach Scott Swanson ranks third in program history.

## THE SUMMER OF SHIELDS

Sophomore Mikayla Shields expanded her skills over the summer thanks to a stint with Team U.S.A. In April, she was named to the junior national team roster, and won gold with the team at the U20 Pan American Cup in Costa Rica. She was also invited to training camp for the FIVB U20

World Championships, but did not make the 12-woman roster. Shields is the first Gamecock to earn experience on the national team since 2006, when current assistant coach Shonda Cole competed for the U.S.A. Volleyball National A2 Team in 2005 and 2006.

# SCOTT SWANSON || HEAD COACH

- Third in program history for career wins
- Coached seven NCAA tournament teams (Arizona State 1999, 2000, Minnesota 2006-10)
- Part of staff that coached eight All-Americans
- Recruited three top-10 classes to Minnesota

The 11th head coach in Gamecock Volleyball history, Scott Swanson aims to build off a strong 2016 campaign as he begins year seven with the program. The Gamecocks will lean on a young but talented core that helped the team finish last season with 18 wins, tied for the most under Swanson.

The team started 2016 with a 12-match win streak, sweeping all four of its preseason tournaments for the best start since 2012. A handful of first-year players showed early on that they would be key factors in the team's success, as freshmen Mikayla Shields, Courtney Koehler, Claire Edwards and Alicia Starr stepped in to major playing time in the non-conference.

The young Gamecocks would be challenged in the SEC, finishing 9th overall with a 6-12 record. South Carolina faced the toughest conference schedule of any SEC team, with home and away match ups with each of the top four finishers. Despite the adversity, the team picked up its first wins over a ranked team in 10 years after beating No. 21 Missouri at home, erased a 2-0 deficit to Miss. State on the road, and earned its first road win over LSU since 2003. Shields was honored with SEC All-Freshman team honors in the postseason, and also was one of just two freshmen to make the AVCA's All-Region team. In the summer, Mikayla earned a spot on the Collegiate National Team and played for Team USA at the Pan-American Cup, winning gold.

The Gamecocks faced a season of different adversities in 2015, coming from untimely injuries and a roster featuring six freshmen who all were asked to fill important roles. The team bonded through the rigors of the season, and picked up impressive wins over Tennessee, Ole Miss, and a season sweep of Arkansas. Swanson moved into third in program history for wins in a career after winning his 72nd game at South Carolina on Oct. 25. Individually, freshman Aubrey Ezell finished with perhaps one of the best debut seasons ever by a Gamecock, finishing the season with the second-most assists ever in the program's rally-scoring era and a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team.

It would not just be the freshmen who would surprise, the team also saw breakout seasons from Dessaa Legros and Sarah Blomgren. Senior Darian Dozier capped her career in style, moving up to third in program history for career blocks and entered the top ten in hitting percentage as well. Off the court, the team volunteered over 1100 for community service, the most of any team at South Carolina.

In 2014, the Gamecocks posted a 17-14 record, which included seven SEC wins, the program's most since 2008. Libero Mikaela Christiaansen set the program record for most digs in a single season with 535, while middle blocker Darian Dozier set single-season rally scoring era school records for total blocks (141) and block assists (127). The Gamecocks also turned in another strong year in the classroom, as a league-best 12 players made the SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll.

During the 2013 season, outside hitter Juliette Thévenin became just the second Gamecock in school history to earn AVCA All-America honors as she was named honorable mention All-American. Thévenin was also a first-team AVCA All-Southeast Region and All-SEC selection, leaving the program in the top 10 in six career categories.

Swanson guided the Gamecocks to an 18-14 record in 2012, the program's second winning season in the last decade. South Carolina got off to a program-best 13-0 start and improved its hitting percentage for a second straight season, ranking second in the SEC with a percentage of .255, an improvement of 29 points from the previous year. Outside hitter Juliette Thévenin garnered second-team All-SEC honors after she ranked second in SEC play with 4.40 kills per set and 4.81 points per set, becoming the first Gamecock since 2008 to receive an All-SEC award.

In Swanson's first season, the Gamecocks went 14-16 and improved its offensive efficiency and its backline defense under his guidance. The team led the SEC with a 16.78 digs average, the best mark in four years for the Gamecocks, and hit .226, a 45-point improvement from the 2011 season.

Swanson's teams have also proved themselves in the classroom, earning the Team Academic Award from the American Volleyball Coaches Association all six of his seasons at Carolina. In his six seasons, 61 student-athletes have earned a spot on the SEC Academic honor roll, including all 12 eligible players in 2016. The team also claimed the department's Life Skills Team of the Year award in 2011-12, honoring the group for its academic achievements, personal development and work in the community.

Prior to his current head coaching job, Swanson spent five years on the sidelines for the Golden Gophers, helping the team to five-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and a 125-46 record. Three times, Minnesota finished second in the Big Ten behind perennial power Penn State. The 2009 team advanced to the national semifinals in the NCAA Tournament.

During his tenure in Minneapolis, five Golden Gophers earned All-America accolades, including 2009 first-team middle blocker and 2012 US National Team pool member Lauren Gibberneyer. Swanson also led the Gophers' recruiting efforts, posting three top-10 recruiting classes according to PrepVolleyball.com. The 2009 group earned top honors from the outlet.

In the summer of 2009, Swanson spent time with USA Volleyball's A-2 Junior National Team, and he coached the USA Red team to a second-place showing in the 2008 USA Adult Open Championships.

Swanson brings in four years of head coaching experience to Columbia after his tenure at the University of Texas-El Paso. With a 50-61 career record, Swanson had the team on the brink of the NCAA Tournament in 2005, when the Miners went 21-10. Three player earned all-conference honors under Swanson's tutelage, including honorable mention All-American Kari Stacy. He also inked a high school All-American and saw his team improve in the classroom to a department-best 3.2 GPA in 2005.

Prior to UTEP, Swanson spent six years at his alma mater, Arizona State. He helped the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances during his time in Tempe and coached one second-team All-American and two Pac-10 All-Freshman Team players. Two of his Sun Devil players garnered Academic All-America certificates as well.

Swanson started his coaching career at Mountain View (Ariz.) High School, working as an assistant with the varsity team and leading his junior varsity group to a 17-1 record. As a head coach with the Arizona East Valley Juniors club, he led a 16-1s team to a national runner-up finish and earned Cactus Region Coach of the Year honors. He also served as head coach at Camelback High School before landing the job with Arizona State, where he also played club volleyball.

A graduate of ASU, Swanson is married to the former Erin Meier. The couple has two daughters, Rylee Sue and Haylen Rae.
