South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- Staley has sent four different starting lineups to the court in seven games this season. Only seniors
 Elem Ibiam and Aleigsha Welch and junior Tiffany Mitchell have been in each combination. Staley
 seemed to have settled on that trio with junior point guard Khadijah Sessions and sophomore post
 Alaina Coates, opening four games with that lineup before inserting junior co-captain Asia Dozier for
 Coates against Charlotte Thursday night.
- South Carolina is among the best set-up teams in the nation, ranking in the top five in percent of
 assisted made field goals at 70.9 percent. Among teams ranked in the AP Top 25, the Gamecocks trail
 just Oregon State's 71.6 percent.
- The Gamecocks rank eighth in the nation in field goal percentage with an SEC-best mark of .492. The accuracy is not the product of one hot hand, but instead six Gamecocks who are shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, including five of the team's top six scorers.
- South Carolina's offensive efficiency frequently stems from each Gamecock's willingness to find the best shot instead of her best shot. In addition to a high assist number fifth in the nation with an SEC-best 21.3 their sharing has resulted in no one attempting 10.0 or more field goals per game. Freshman A'ja Wilson leads the group with 9.7 FGA per game en route to her 13.7 ppg, while senior Elem Ibiam attempts just 4.3 shots per game for her 6.6 scoring average. The team's top scorer, junior Tiffany Mitchell, has scored her 14.9 points per game on just 8.6 attempts per outing.
- The Gamecocks' post players have garnered much attention this season, and rightfully so, with point in the paint accounting for 50.3 percent of South Carolina's offense. Guards who have contributed by driving to the basket have also helped ease defensive focus in the lane by shooting 38.1 percent from 3-point range 30th in the nation as 3-pointers account for 22.9 percent of this season's scoring.
- Junior Tiffany Mitchell and forward Aleighsa Welch were named to both the Wooden Award Preseason
 Top 30 and the Wade Watch List. South Carolina is one of four teams with two entries on both lists.

Duke Series Notes

The Gamecocks and Blue Devils split their previous two meetings, both taking place in the 2001-02 season. South Carolina posted a 87-81 overtime win at Cameron Indoor Stadium over then-No. 9 Duke on Nov. 25, 2001. The Blue Devils got their revenge on March 25, 2002, in the NCAA Tournament regional final in Raleigh, N.C., with a 77-68 victory that carried them into the Final Four.

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is 0-2 in her career against Duke. Both games came during her tenure at Temple. As a player at Virginia, Staley went 8-1 against the Blue Devils with a 3-1 mark in Durham.

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is facing its second ranked opponent of the season today and its first top-10 match-up. The Gamecocks are 66-216 all-time against ranked teams with a 16-39 record in the Dawn Staley era. Under Staley, South Carolina is 5-16 against ranked opponents at Colonial Life Arena, 7-12 on the road and 4-11 at neutral sites.

68-58 in Columbia on Jan. 9 before falling to then-No. 10 Tennessee on March 2. South Carolina's last road win over a top-10 team was a 64-60 decision at then-No. 8 Tennessee on Feb. 2, 2012. The highest ranked opponent South Carolina has defeated in the Staley era is then-No. 5 Kentucky, 55-50, on Jan. 24, 2013, at Colonial Life Arena.

Poll Presence

This week's rankings extended South Carolina's string of Associated Press top-10 appearances to 15, the longest in program history. The previous high was 13 weeks from Jan. 22, 1980 through Dec. 16, 1980.

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was the program's first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

The Gamecocks opened this season with their highest preseason ranking from the organization, coming in at No. 2 to best the previous high of No. 4 heading into the 1981-82 season.

SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks 12th in the nation with 6.1 blocked shots per game this season. The effort is a continuation of last season, during with the Gamecocks shattered the school record for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 10 blockers, led by senior Aleigsha Welch in third (1.6/game). Senior Elem Ibiam, sophomore Alaina Coates and freshman A'ja Wilson are all tied for fifth in the SEC at 1.3 per game.

While Coates and Ibiam have been solid shot blockers throughout their careers, the block is an art that Welch added to her resume just late last season. After recording 45 blocks in her first two seasons combined, Welch posted 47 last season, 37 of which came in the final three months of the season. Her now 103 career blocks ranks her eighth in program history with a spot in the top five just 30 blocks away.

Far Reaching

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley enjoys an embarrassment of riches with four players listed

at 6'4" or taller. Even more impressive might be the reach of the Gamecocks' top contributors, most with wingspans that exceed their height.

Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates last season, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing in on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment — the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks are second in the SEC and are 30th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 38.1 percent from outside the arc. After closing last season averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is off to a blistering 6.1 average this season, which ranks fourth in the SEC.

Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has out-scored its starting counterparts twice this season and has out-scored the entire opposing team three times as well – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23) and NC Central (Dec. 1). In all, the bench as accounted for 47.0 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season.

Of the 25 double-figures games turned in so far this season, 14 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (6), Bianca Cuevas (2), Alaina Coates (2), Jatarie White (2), Asia Dozier (1) and Tina Roy (1). The production has come with just slightly fewer minutes on the floor – 18.0 per reserve per game compared to 22.0 per starter per game.

Helping Hand

South Carolina's wealth of talent has made the Gamecocks more unselfish as they rank fifth in the nation in assists per game with an SEC-best 21.3. Living up to the legend of their head coach, the Gamecocks have handed out 20 or more assists five times this season, including a Staley-era high of 26 against NC Central. In all, South Carolina has assisted on 149 of its 210 made field goals this season (.709). Last season's team set the mark for best percentage of the Staley era at 57.7 percent.

Trademark TM

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell established her presence on a national level based on her versatility – she was the only player to appear in the rankings for scoring, rebounding, assists and steals in SEC action. The one element of her game that she had not exploited during that All-America campaign was her 3-point shooting, unleashing that weapon

judiciously with just 2.2 attempts per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

This season, the usually attacking guard has shown that opponents better be prepared to play her a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is 22nd in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 50.0 percent from long range. She has made 2.1 3s per game to rank sixth in the SEC, and the outside shot has accounted for exactly half of her field goal attempts (30 3FGA, 60 FGA).

Mitchell's heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in program history.

Welch Watch

Already second in school history in career offensive rebounds, senior forward Aleighsa Welch looks to mount an attack on other parts of the Gamecock record book before closing out her career.

Bang off the Bench

Just as Alaina Coates earned the unprecedented double of SEC Freshman and Co-6th Player of the Year honors last season, freshman A'ja Wilson is putting in an early bid to repeat the feat.

The 6-foot-5 Heathwood Hall product started the season opener, but has thrived off the bench in the last four games averaging 15.3 points and 6.8 rebounds during the stretch. Overall on the season, Wilson is the only freshman to rank among the SEC's top 20 in both scoring and rebounding – 11th with 13.7 points per game, 18th with 6.6 rebounds per game.

Handled with Care

Junior point guard Khadijah Sessions has spent the last two seasons fine-tuning her ability to run the Gamecocks the way head coach Dawn Staley would like – efficient and organized on both ends of the floor. Severn games into her junior campaign, Sessions is third in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio and is a big reason the Gamecocks are also among the top five in the country in assists per game and scoring defense.

After starting the last 15 games of last season, Sessions came off the bench in the season opener against Southern Cal, but handled the situation well and quickly went about re-establishing herself as a key stabilizing force on the floor. The Myrtle Beach native has started every game since and the Gamecocks have turned in five games of 20 or more assists, four shooting over 50.0 percent from the field and three holding an opponent to under 30.0 percent shooting.

Sessions leads the team with 26 assists – top 10 in the SEC – highlighted by her career-high eight

against NC Central, and has committed just four turnovers in her 145 minutes on the court.

E-I, E-I, No

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge for the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently fifth with 139 in her career, trailing Demetress Adams (2006-09) in fourth place at 140. The Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07) is also well within reach.

Power of Three

Prior to the season, espnW ranked the top 25 college players in the nation, and a trio of Gamecocks made the list. Reigning SEC Player of the Year Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed No. 4 in the nation because "[her] greatest strength is that she doesn't really have a weakness. Shooting, penetrating,

distributing, rebounding, defending and leading from her point guard spot are all part of Mitchell's resume," according to Charlie Creme. Two-time All-SEC selection Aleighsa Welch came in on the No. 7 spot for her ability to "come up with the big basket or the big rebound when the Gamecocks need it most," per Michelle Smith. 2014 SEC Freshman of the Year Alaina Coates captured the No. 25 position after a season in which she was "just scratching the surface of her potential...she could be unstoppable inside, even without a large repertoire of moves," per Mechelle Voepel.

Back in (Garnet and) Black

A huge reason the this season's lofty expectations is the return of all five starters among the 10 returning letterwinners. The Gamecocks return 97.6 percent of their scoring, 96.0 percent of their rebounding, 98.4 percent of their assists and 97.1 percent of their school-record shot blocking from last season's top-10 squad. Nine of the 10 returners played in at least 29 of the team's 34 games last season and contributed at least 2.0 points per game.

Elite Additions

The Gamecocks added the nation's No. 2 signing class to their core of returning letterwinners. Four of the five signees will take the court for the Gamecocks this season, led by No. 1 A'ja Wilson and No. 7 Jatarie White. Two other top-35 signees – Bianca Cuevas, Kaydra Duckett – round out the group that will contribute this season.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

Rare Company

As just the second sophomore ever to earn SEC Player of the Year honors from the league's coaches last season, junior Tiffany Mitchell was tabbed by the SEC coaches and media to claim the award again this season. If that prediction comes true, Mitchell would become just the seventh player to pick up the award twice in her career, joining South Carolina assistant coach Nikki McCray (1994, 1995) among others.

South Carolina's other player of the year candidate last season, Aleighsa Welch also received votes for the award in both preseason polls. If she can dethrone her teammate this season, it would be the first time in league history that the same school had different student-athletes win the award in consecutive seasons.

Home Grown, Nationally Known

Since her arrival for the 2008-09 season, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has been working to protect her new home state's best prospects while fielding a team that competes at a national level. Her efforts have paid huge dividends as eight of the 15 members of this year's team hail from South Carolina. Beginning with Aleighsa Welch, the first South Carolina player to sign a National Letter of Intent for Staley, the Palmetto State has frequently sent its players of the year to Columbia as Welch (2011), Asia Dozier (2012), Alaina Coates (2013), A'ja Wilson (2014) and Kaydra Duckett (2014) have each earned the title during their high school careers.

STALEY

7th Season at South Carolina Virginia, 1992

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 300-151 record, including her 128-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14.Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
