### TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina hosts Holy Cross on Sunday in a matchup that is part of the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational. The game continues a stretch of three games in five days to open the Carolina season. Sunday's contest marks the Crusaders' first game of the year. The meeting will be the second all-time between the two schools, and the first since the 1982-83 campaign.



### GAME STORYLINES

- South Carolina is in its 109th season of varsity basketball in 2016-17.
- On the sidelines, Frank Martin is joined by associate head coach Matt Figger, assistant coaches Perry Clark and Bruce Shingler, and director of operations Andy Assaley.
- South Carolina won its 16th-straight season opener on Friday night, posting an 85-76 victory over Louisiana Tech at Colonial Life Arena. It would be a game that would go down to the wire, as a late surge fueled by back-to-back transition dunks from South Carolina's Chris Silva and Sindarius Thornwell would secure the win. Carolina hit 52.6 percent from the field, and was led by Thornwell's 18 points and seven rebounds.
- Several Gamecocks made their college debuts on Friday, including freshman forward Maik Kotsar, r-sophomore guard Hassani Gravett, junior forward Ran Tut and freshman forward Khadim Gueye.
- Following Friday's win vs. La Tech, Carolina now owns an 80-29 (.733) all-time record in season openers.



## INTERVIEW POLICIES

All interview requests must be made in advance to SID Emily Miles in the South Carolina Media Relations Office. Beginning with the start of practice in October, Miles will release a weekly coach and student-athlete availability schedule to media on Mondays.

**Post-Game Interview Policy:** After each home game, the visiting coach will address the media first, followed by South Carolina student-athletes then South Carolina head coach Frank Martin. (Depending on deadline, this may be altered on a game-by-game basis).

**Road Interview Policy:** Interviews with Coach Martin and Gamecock student-athletes while on the road will be scheduled according to the home post-game media procedure.

- Be Carolina's first over a current Patriot League opponent since a 73-40 win over Navy on Nov. 21, 2003, in Columbia.
- Be the Gamecocks' 18th win in the last 21 games at Colonial Life Arena dating back to last season.

- Frank Martin is now a perfect 10-0 in season openers during his tenure as a head coach, going 5-0 at Kansas State and now 5-0 at Carolina following Friday's victory vs. La Tech.

- South Carolina returns two starters and eight letterwinners from last season's squad that posted a 25-9 overall record, matching the Carolina record for total wins.

- Those returning starters feature the only back-court in the SEC with two 1,000-point scorers, in senior guards Sindarius Thornwell and Duane Notice. The duo accounted for 24.2 points and 6.1 assists per game last season.

- Thornwell was named to the SEC All-Defensive Team last March, while Notice was named the league's Sixth Man Of the Year.

- The Gamecocks return just 49.4 percent of their scoring from a year ago, with the departure of three senior starters in Michael Carrera (14.5 ppg), Laimonas Chatkevicius (10.2 ppg) and Mindaugas Kacinas (9.9 ppg).

- The Gamecocks began the 2015-16 season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign.

- Carolina welcomes nine newcomers to the squad this season in Tommy Corchiani, Rakym Felder, Hassani Gravett, Khadim Gueye, Evan Hinson, Kory Holden, Sedee Keita, Maik Kotsar and Ran Tut.

- The Gamecocks are undefeated in exhibition contests under the direction of Frank Martin with wins over Kentucky Wesleyan (2012-13), USC Aiken (2013-14), Benedict (2014-15), Allen (2015-16) and Newberry (107-89).

## SCOUTING HOLY CROSS

- The Crusaders are led by head coach Bill Carmody in his second season. Carmody has 299 career wins entering Sunday's contest at South Carolina.

- Holy Cross won the Patriot League Tournament last season to advance to the NCAA Tournament, posting its first NCAA win since 1953.

- The Crusaders projected starting lineup for Sunday's contest features five returning letterwinners.

- Senior forward Robert Champion is the team's top returning scorer after he posted 12.0 points per game a year ago.

- Senior forward Malachi Alexander also returns, the 2016 Patriot League Tournament MVP, averaged 11.8 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game as a junior.

- In the 2016-17 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in fourth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors.

## LA TECH NOTABLES

- Sophomore guard PJ Dozier tallied a career-high with 17 points. Dozier hit 5-of-9 from the floor, including 2-of-3 from deep.

- Carolina held La Tech's leading returning scorer, Eric McCree to just eight points in 31 minutes. He was just 1-of-8 from the field. McCree averaged 16.2 points per game for the Bulldogs last season.

- Redshirt sophomore guard Hassani Gravett, freshman big man Khadim Gueye, freshman forward Maik Kotsar and junior forward Ran Tut made their Gamecock debuts. Kotsar's first career points came on the game's first basket.

- The game was the team's first regular season game on the new floor at Colonial Life Arena.

- Gravett led all bench scorers in points (7) and minutes (24).

- Redshirt junior forward Jarrell Holliman logged a new career-high with 14 minutes played. He also scored his first career points after going 2-for-2 from the field.

In home games last season South Carolina held a +10.6 scoring margin, shot 43.3 percent from the field and out-rebounded its opponents by a +6.8 margin.

## EXHIBITION RECAP

South Carolina opened its 2016-17 season with a 107-89 exhibition win over Newberry College on Nov. 6 at Colonial Life Arena. Carolina shot 50.0 percent from the field in the game en route to its offensive outburst. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all players with 34 points on 13-of-24 shooting. Thornwell recorded a double-double with 11 rebounds, which led the team. He also led the team with five assists and five blocks.

## THORNWELL NAMED TO PRESEASON SQUAD

Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the Preseason All-SEC First Team on Thursday by the league's coaches. Thornwell enters the season as the league's high scorer for active players with 1,278 career points. This marks the third-straight season that Thornwell has garnered preseason honors from the coaches, as he was named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team prior to his sophomore and junior campaigns.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**2,345** - Senior guards Duane Notice and Sindarius Thornwell have combined to score 2,345 points during their time in the Garnet and Black.

**470** - Sindarius Thornwell ranks third among active players in the SEC with 470 career rebounds.

**37.9** - Duane Notice ranks seventh in Carolina history in career three-point field goal percentage with a mark of 37.9% (153-403).

## 2016-17 SCHEDULE

South Carolina has an exciting schedule set for the 2016-17 campaign. The slate features 14 games, with 10 home contests, including one exhibition. Highlighting the non-conference portion of the schedule is the Gamecocks' participation in the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational, as well as a matchup versus Seton Hall in the Under Armour "Reunion" doubleheader at Madison Square Garden in mid-December. The Gamecocks will face eight teams that advanced to the postseason a year ago, with four of those NCAA Tournament participants, including Syracuse, which advanced to the Final Four.

## UP NEXT

South Carolina continues its stretch of three games in five days to open the 2016-17 campaign when it hosts Monmouth on Tuesday evening. The meeting matches two of the top four seeds from last season's Postseason NIT. The matchup will be broadcast on SEC Network + and will tip at 6:30 p.m. ET.

## GAMECOCKS CONCLUDE HISTORIC 2015-16 REGULAR SEASON

South Carolina concluded an historic regular season on March 5, 2015, with a 76-61 win on the road at Arkansas. That victory set the school record for regular-season wins at 24. The Gamecocks began the season 15-0, their best start since the 1933-34 campaign, and the 24 wins marked the most since the 1996-97 squad also posted 24 victories. In addition, South Carolina's 11 SEC wins marked the most since 1998, match the second-most ever by a Carolina team and marked just the fourth time that the Gamecocks had double-digit SEC wins in their 25 years in the league.

Frank Martin was named the head men's basketball coach at the University of South Carolina on March 27, 2012, becoming the 32nd head coach in the history of the South Carolina program, which enters its 109th season as a varsity sport in 2016-17. Martin owns a 187-117 (.600) overall record as a head coach, entering his 10th season overall, and a 70-63 (.526) record entering his fifth season at South Carolina.

In Martin's fourth season leading the Garnet and Black (2015-16), Carolina put together one of the top seasons in its history, matching a school record for wins with a 25-9 overall record on the year, while the Gamecocks reached double-digit SEC wins for just the fourth time since joining the league, posting an 11-7 mark in conference contests. The SEC finish was Carolina's highest since the league combined its East and West Divisions prior to the 2012 season. South Carolina began the season 15-0, its best start since the 1933-34 campaign and went on to post a school-record 24 regular-season wins.

The Gamecocks received votes or were ranked for 15 weeks in the USA Today Coaches Poll, rising to as high as 15th, and for a total of 14 weeks in the AP poll, rising to as high as 19th, during the season. Carolina advanced to postseason play for the first time since 2009, making their 12th appearance in the Postseason NIT as one of the top four seeds in the event. The Gamecocks posted a win over High Point in the opening round, before suffering a season-ending loss

to visiting Georgia Tech on March 21.

Three Gamecocks were honored with postseason awards by the SEC coaches, with senior forward Michael Carrera earning First Team All-SEC accolades, junior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the All-Defensive Team and junior guard Duane Notice was named the league's Sixth Man of the Year. Carrera went on to earn honors from several organizations following the best season of his career. Carrera, Notice and Thornwell each reached the 1,000 career-point plateau during the season as well.

Prior to his appointment in Columbia, Martin spent the previous five seasons as the head coach at Kansas State University, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament four times, including a trip to the "Elite 8," during the 2009-10 campaign when the squad won a school record 29 contests. Martin's Wildcats won at least 21 games in each of his five seasons at the helm, as the program compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) under his direction. During that time, Kansas State posted a 50-32 (.609) record in Big 12 Conference games, finishing fifth or higher in each season, with three season finishes of third or better.

A native of Miami, Fla., Martin earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Florida International in 1993. He and his wife, Anya, have three children, Brandon, Amalia and Christian.

## EXB - SOUTH CAROLINA 107, NEWBERRY 89 NOV. 6, 2016/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** - South Carolina opened its 2016-17 season with a 107-89 exhibition win over Newberry College on Sunday afternoon at Colonial Life Arena. Carolina shot 50.0 percent from the field in the game en route to its offensive outburst. Senior guard Sindarius Thornwell led all players with 34 points on 13-of-24 shooting. The Lancaster, S.C., native, recorded a double-double with 11 rebounds, which led the team. He also led the team with five assists and five blocks.

South Carolina jumped out to a 12-point lead in the first half with 11:23 left, but Newberry would keep the game competitive forcing 12 turnovers and knocking down 10 shots from deep. Thornwell led all scorers at the break with 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting. He also led the team with five rebounds. Carolina shot 51.5 percent from the field as they headed to halftime with a 53-46 lead.

The Gamecocks opened the second half on a 29-11 run, building their lead to 81-57. Thornwell (10 points) and sophomore guard PJ Dozier (nine points) helped fuel the scoring outburst with 26 of those points. Dozier finished tied for second on the team with 17 points. Senior guard Duane Notice, last season's SEC Sixth Man of the Year, also poured in 17 points. Notice was 4-for-9 from behind the arc.

Carolina's defense ramped up in the second half holding Newberry to a 42.1 field goal percentage. The Gamecocks forced 21 turnovers in the game and out-rebounded the Wolves 52-33. Newberry, who looked to run all game with a smaller lineup, would finish the game with 39 attempts from three-point range.

With the win, South Carolina remains unbeaten in five career exhibition contests under the direction of Head Coach Frank Martin.

## GAME 1 - SOUTH CAROLINA 85, LA TECH 76 NOV. 11, 2016/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** - The South Carolina men's basketball team (1-0) opened the 2016-17 regular season with an 85-76 victory over Louisiana Tech (0-1) Friday night. Four Gamecock starters were in double-figures, led by senior guard Sindarius Thornwell, who poured in 18 points. The Lancaster, S.C., native filled up the stat sheet leading the team in rebounds (7) and assists (6).

Senior guard Duane Notice (17), sophomore guard PJ Dozier (17) and sophomore forward Chris Silva (11) were the other South Carolina starters in double figures. Dozier's 17 points were a new career-high.

The Gamecocks jumped out to a 7-2 lead to start the game behind five points from Dozier. The Gamecocks extended their lead to 16-6 after Thornwell hit a 3-pointer with 12:49 left in the first half.

South Carolina's half court defense was suffocating in the first 10 minutes, as they held the Bulldogs to 29 percent shooting from the field. Louisiana Tech finished half one 11-of-29 from the field (37.9 percent).

The Bulldogs closed the gap to 18-16 with 10:24 left, but Carolina pushed the lead back to nine at 36-27 with 2:36 to play in the half after back-to-back 3s from senior guard Justin McKie and sophomore guard Hassani Gravett.

Gravett ended the first half with an exclamation point as he tipped in a Notice 3-point miss at the buzzer. Carolina led 42-31 at the break as the, Villa Rica, Ga. native's, tip-in gave the team its biggest lead of the first half at 11.

Thornwell led all scorers at halftime with nine points on 4-of-8 shooting. He also had five rebounds and three assists. Junior forward Ran Tut had a nice first half off the bench, dropping four points and tying for the team lead in rebounds with five. Notice had eight points, Dozier seven and Gravett seven to round out Carolina's scoring in the opening period. Carolina out-rebounded La Tech 22-18 in half one.

In the second half, the Bulldogs cut the deficit to seven with 14:13 left after a 3-pointer by sophomore guard Derric Jean from the right wing. La Tech's Jacobi Boykins stole the ball at half court finishing with an emphatic dunk at the other end to cut the lead to 59-54. He was whistled for a technical foul after the play. Notice missed both free throws but Silva put the Gamecocks back up by seven after a dunk on the ensuing possession off a great dish from Gravett.

La Tech's Daquan Bracy would cut the lead to four at 65-61, knocking down a 3-pointer with 7:58 left. Thornwell would answer the basket with a fast break 3 of his own from the left corner to put Carolina back up seven with 5:56 on the clock. The Bulldogs answered, but Silva increased the lead to nine with a 3-point play with 4:31 left after beating Jean to the hole for the and-one bucket.

Thornwell and Silva again halted La Tech's momentum after bringing Colonial Life Arena to its feet with two straight transition dunks, pushing the lead to 80-70 with 2:37 left, and the Gamecocks would close the nine-point win.
