With expectations surrounding this season, Staley believed it was important for her team to focus on the collective instead of any individual, knowing that to thrive in pressure situations, each student-athlete may have to sacrifice a piece of herself to become one team.















South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- Tonight's game marks the 200th women's basketball game played in Colonial Life Arena. The Gamecocks are 75-25 (.750) at the facility under head coach Dawn Staley, including the current 26-game win streak.
- In addition to honoring "We Back Pat" and the members and caregivers in the Alzheimer's Associations of the Midlands and Lowcountry tonight, the Gamecocks are wearing lime green ribbons in support of Kent State head coach Danielle O'Banion's fight against lymphoma.
- South Carolina is one of two teams in the nation ranked among the top 15 in both scoring offense (13th, 78.9 ppg) and scoring defense (2nd, 49.4 ppg). The other is UConn, which leads the nation in scoring offense (89.8 ppg) and is sixth in defense (51.2 ppg).
- The impact of Aleighsa Welch on the court and beyond the box score can not be over-estimated. The Gamecocks have been to the NCAA Tournament and improved on their win total both overall and in SEC play every year of her career. She is currently one of nine Gamecocks all-time to amass 1,000 points and 800 rebounds in her career, during which she is shooting 58.6 percent from the field, which is second-best in program history.
- Junior Tiffany Mitchell leads the SEC with 16.0 points per league game this season, shooting 50.0 percent in conference action (2nd). The reigning SEC Player of the Year has asserted herself more in the offense in conference play, leading the team with 68 field goal attempts and 2.5 assists per game.
- Freshman A'ja Wilson is making an early case for SEC Freshman of the Year, ranking 10th in the league in both scoring and ninth rebounding. She is the only freshman among the top 20 in both categories. Overall on the season, she has scored in double figures in all but three games and has four double-doubles to her credit. Her .508 field goal percentage is fifth in the SEC and fifth among freshmen nationally. She is also third in the SEC in blocks at 1.6 per game (2.0 in league play).

A South Carolina Win Would...

- Be the Gamecocks' 27th straight at home, which would tie UConn for longest active home win streak in the nation.
- Extend the school-record win streak to 19.
- Make the Gamecocks 7-0 in league play, extending the program record for best SEC start.
- Be the Gamecocks' first over Texas A&M.

Texas A&M Series History

The Gamecocks have not defeated the Aggies in three games since Texas A&M joined the SEC prior to the 2012-13 season. The losses have come by an average of 4.3 points per game, but the first and most recent contests were decided by two points each.

The last meeting – Jan. 16, 2014 – went to overtime in College Station as the Gamecocks mounted a furious rally from a 17-point halftime deficit. Aleighsa Welch (20 pts/16 rebs) and Tiffany Mitchell (19 pts/8 rebs) powered the comeback, capped by Mitchell's game-tying 3-pointer with six seconds left in regulation. Neither team scored in the first 2:21 of overtime, but the Aggies survived at the free throw line for a 67-65 victory.

The first meeting of the series came on Feb. 10, 2013, in Colonial Life Arena. With both teams ranked in the top 15, the Gamecocks nearly survived a tough shooting night (28.1 percent) to take a five-point lead with 5:15 to play. The Aggies scored the next six points to move back in front, but Khadijah Sessions hit a free throw to tie it up

Ranked Readings

South Carolina is facing its fourth ranked opponent of the season today with a 3-0 record against such foes. The Gamecocks are 68-216 all-time against ranked teams with an 18-39 record in the Dawn Staley era. Under Staley, South Carolina is 6-16 against ranked opponents at Colonial Life Arena, 8-12 on the road and 4-11 at neutral sites.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are in the midst of unprecedented success at Colonial Life Arena, having won the last 26 games on their home court, including the facility's first perfect season in 2013-14. That 16-0 mark alone matched the previous record for win streak at the Arena, originally set Jan. 20, 2002-Jan. 9, 2003. South Carolina's last loss at Colonial Life Arena was a 50-48 decision to then-No. 14 Texas A&M on Feb. 10, 2013.

The longest home win streak in school history is 32 games, which spanned three seasons. That streak began with a win over Clemson on Dec. 10, 1977, and ended with a win over Tennessee Tech on March 4, 1980. The stretch included a perfect 11-0 record in 1978-79 at Carolina Coliseum (9-0) and the Sol Blatt P.E. Center (2-0).

Overall, South Carolina is 141-58 (.709) at Colonial Life Arena, including a 75-25 (.750) mark under head coach Dawn Staley. In the now 41-year history of the program, the Gamecocks are 386-155 (.713) in home games.

Poll Prominence

South Carolina is in its eighth week as the No. 1 team in the nation in the Associated Press Poll, the third-longest stretch by a team in the last five seasons (beginning 2010-11). Only four teams have held the top spot in the AP poll during that time – Baylor (39 weeks), Connecticut (35 weeks) and Stanford (6 weeks).

In the last 10 seasons (beginning 2005-06), eight teams have occupied the AP Poll's No. 1 position. South Carolina's eight weeks in the spot is the sixth-most among that group, which is led by UConn's 85 entries. Baylor is second at 39 followed by Tennessee (16), Duke (14) and Maryland (10).

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was a South Carolina program first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

SEC Stories

Head coach Dawn Staley has steadily lifted the Gamecocks' national profile by building the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her seventh season at the helm, Staley boasts a 58-42 (.580) SEC regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five just twice in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 58 wins include three seasons of double-digit league victories – 10-6 in 2012, 11-5 in 2013 and an SEC-best 14-2 in 2014.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 31-18 (.633) mark at home and a 27-24 (.529) slate on the road.

Veterans' View

South Carolina's success this season has been built on a blend of experience and youthful talent. Freshman A'ja Wilson has led the team in scoring eight times – matching Tiffany Mitchell for team-high honors in the category – and sophomore Alaina Coates leads the way with nine entries as the team's top rebounder this season. Still, the Gamecocks' youth movement is still learning to navigate the rigors of the SEC schedule. Since the start of league play, the "old" faithful were the ones stepping up Mitchell leading the offense in three of the six league games so far and Welch leading the scoring in one and pulling down double-digit rebounds in two others.

While Coates and Wilson have seen their averages dip slightly in league play, both of the Gamecocks' player of the year candidates have

lifted their production since SEC action tipped off on Jan. 2. Mitchell's scoring average rose from 14.8 in non-conference play to and SEC-best 16.0 in league play. Welch, who annually has seemed to take purposeful step back to let younger players find their way in non-conference play, has lifted her rebounding average from 5.2 to 6.7 in SEC action, which ranks 13th in the league.

Crunch Time

South Carolina has won all five of its games this season when the margin is under 10 points in the last five minutes, and the Gamecocks have done so with their primary strengths – Tiffany Mitchell and rebounding.

In those five games – Southern Cal, vs. #22/22 Syracuse, at #9/8 Duke, #10/11 Kentucky and at Missouri – Staley trusts in Mitchell's competitive spirit, giving her the ball in late-game situations. The junior has answered the bell, averaging 3.6 points per final five minutes of those games –

double the next Gamecock on the list. Behind her fearless attacking of the rim, a majority of her points have come at the free throw line, where she has hit 12-of-14 attempts during those close-game situations. In a show of determination, the Gamecocks have also dominated the glass at crunch time, out-rebounding their opponents 6.2 to 4.4 per final five minutes, with Alaina Coates, A'ja Wilson and Aleighsa Welch grabbing the bulk of the boards.

As a team, South Carolina is shooting 40.0 percent from the field and the same percentage from 3-point range in the last five minutes of close games, while the defense has held those opponents to just 21.2 percent shooting and 18.2 percent from outside the arc in that time span. Equally impressive is the Gamecocks' 77.1 percent free throw shooting at crunch time, as South Carolina is shooting just 65.3 percent otherwise.

Win Any Way

As the Gamecocks' baseball coach a few years ago, South Carolina athletics director Ray Tanner frequently used the saying "Win Anyway," and the women's basketball team has put its own twist on the quote. The Gamecocks have not lost a game this season, but the end has not always come by the same means.

Dawn Staley's team has won with both a high-flying offense – posting records of 4-0 when scoring 90+ points, 4-0 when scoring 80-89 points – and a more methodical one, 5-0 when scoring 70-79 points, 6-0 with scoring fewer than 70.

The Gamecocks have won both inside – 8-0 when shooting less than 33.3 percent from 3-point range, 7-0 when at least half of points come in the paint – and outside – 10-0 when shooting 33.3

percent or better from 3-point range, 11-0 when less than half of points come in the paint.

South Carolina has seen its top scorer come from both the starting lineup (9-0) and the bench (8-0) – with one game a starter and reserve tied for the team high (vs. Auburn – Welch, Wilson).

Diehard Defenders

While the offense has fluctuated in source and volume, the one standard for the Gamecocks – both this season and throughout head coach Dawn Staley's career – has been their defense. South Carolina is second in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 49.4 points per game with no opponent scoring more than 63 points. In fact, South Carolina has held an opponent under 50 points 10 times in 18 games this season.

Controlled Caroms

The Gamecocks have also built their success on the glass – an area, like defense, that head coach Dawn Staley preaches as a measure of effort as much as talent. South Carolina ranks sixth in the nation in rebounding margin, out-boarding its opponents by 11.6 per game. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double-digit rebounds nine times this season, including two SEC outings. The rebounding margin has been at least 20 three times – Clemson (+22), Savannah State (+35) and at Hampton (+27).

Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has tied or out-scored its starting teammates nine times this season, including four SEC contests,

and has out-scored the entire opposing team five times – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23), NC Central (Dec. 1) and Florida (Jan. 19). In all, the bench has accounted for 47.9 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season, including 49.2 percent of the offense in SEC games.

Of the 69 double-figures games turned in this season, 34 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (15), Alaina Coates (9), Bianca Cuevas (5), Tina Roy (2), Jatarie White (2) and Asia Dozier (1).

Diversified Assets

South Carolina is often lauded for the depth of its talent, and the Gamecocks' improved offensive numbers certainly bear out those accolades – 13th in the nation at 78.8 points per game and third in the nation in field goal percentage (.488).

The embarrassment of riches has not upset South Carolina's chemistry but instead has strengthened it as each Gamecock plays for the good of the team instead of herself – a message head coach Dawn Staley often equates with USA Basketball's utopian camaraderie and ultimate success.

Two stats that best exemplify the all-for-one mentality of the team are in the assist numbers – eighth in the nation at 18.4 per game – and that

no Gamecocks is averaging more than 10 shots per game. In fact, on one of the nation's most efficient offensive teams, just two Gamecocks have made the minimum field goals required for individual ranking in field goal percentage – Tiffany Mitchell (3rd in SEC, 32nd in nation) and A'ja Wilson (5th in SEC, 65th in nation). Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates in 2013-14, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment – the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks lead the SEC and rank 42nd in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 35.5 percent from outside the arc. The percentage is not far above last season's (.347), but after closing 2013-14 averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is third in the SEC with a 5.4 average this season. The most 3s made per game of the Staley era is 9.2 in 2009-10.

Junior Tiffany Mitchell has been the primary long-range shooter, ranking second in the SEC with 2.1 made 3s per game and sixth in the country with an SEC-best .481 3-point field goal percentage. But juniors Tina Roy and Asia Dozier have lifted their long-range production in SEC action, ranking 13th in the league with 1.2 made 3s per conference game and hitting more than one-third of their attempts.

SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks 11th in the nation with 6.3 blocked shots per game. The effort is a continuation of last season, during which the Gamecocks shattered the school record for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 11 blockers, led by freshman A'ja Wilson in third at 1.6 per game – a number that jumps to 2.0 per SEC game to rank second in the league. Sophomore Alaina Coates is just behind in fifth with 1.5 per game this season. Seniors Aleighsa Welch and Elem Ibiam are next in line with Welch swatting 1.2 per game for seventh and Ibiam rejecting 1.1 per game for 11th place.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title, and the Gamecocks and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

Two Grand

Junior guard Tiffany Mitchell joined senior Aleighsa Welch in the 1,000-point club against Liberty (Dec. 21), making it the first time a Gamecock team has had multiple 1,000-point scorers since 2001-02 when Shaunzinski Gortman and Jocelyn Penn both reached that plateau. In program history, there have been nine seasons that featured multiple 1,000-point scorers, including three seasons that saw three Gamecocks who surpassed the benchmark.

More on Muffin

Senior forward Aleighsa Welch – nicknamed Muffin at birth by her mother – continues to be at the foundation of the Gamecocks' success. The South Carolina high school standout who first took a chance on head coach Dawn Staley's vision has done everything asked to power the Gamecocks to the lofty heights achieved during her career. Always willing to do the "dirty work" that doesn't show up in the box score, Welch's energy and constant communication are what drive the Gamecocks and what has prompted her teammates to vote her a team captain each of the last three seasons.

Welch's consistent effort has her ranked among the program's career top 10 in six different categories, including three rebounding totals, while also among the top-20 scorers. Among the

Gamecocks' 30 1,000-point scorers, she is one of just nine to amass at least 800 career rebounds as well. Her current career .586 field goal percentage is second in school history behind only Jocelyn Penn's school-record .593 (757-of-1277).

The expansion of the Gamecocks' frontline have brought her overall rebounding numbers down slightly (5.9 rpg this season vs. 7.2 average previous three seasons), but Welch has lifted her game in SEC play, reeling in 6.7 per conference game so far. She also continues to provide consistency on the offensive end, shooting a team-high 59.2 percent from the field and handing out 1.9 assists per game.

Trademark TM

Last season, junior guard Tiffany Mitchell established her presence on a national level based on her offensive versatility. But the All-American frequently kept one weapon in check, taking just 2.2 3-pointers per game to account for just 22.1 percent of her field goal attempts on the season.

This season, the usually attacking guard has shown that opponents better be prepared to play her a little tighter around the arc. Mitchell is sixth in the nation in 3-point accuracy, hitting 48.1 percent from long range and has made 2.1 3s per game to rank second in the SEC. The outside shot

has accounted for nearly 44.9 percent of her field goal attempts (79 3FGA, 176 FGA), and she has taken at least half her shots from outside the arc in eight games this season.

Mitchell's heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in

program history. She went on to match her career high with six 3s at Hampton as well, those coming on eight attempts.

Double Trouble

One of sophomore Alaina Coates' goals this season focuses around posting double-doubles, taking to heart her head coach's quip that the 6-foot-4 center is a "walking double-double." Ranking 46th in the nation and second in the SEC with seven this season, the Irmo, S.C., native has 17 career double-doubles through 52 games, leaving her just three shy of making the Gamecocks' career top 10 in the category.

Bang off the Bench

The Class of 2014's No. 1 recruit, A'ja Wilson drew the start in her collegiate debut, but the 6-foot-5 Heathwood Hall product has thrived off the bench ever since. Overall on the season, Wilson is second on the team in scoring, ranking 10th in the SEC in at 13.4 ppg, and has been the Gamecocks' top scorer eight times – tied for the team lead in the category. She is the only freshman to rank among the SEC's top 20 scorers and rebounders – standing 10th in points and ninth in rebounds.

Wilson is the only freshman on either then Wooden Award Midseason Top 20 or the Naismith Trophy Top 50. She has earned SEC Freshman of the Week three times and was the USBWA's first ever Freshman of the Week (games Dec. 1-7).

It's Elem-entary

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge at

the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently second with 150 in her career, trailing the Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07).

Class of 2015 Signee

Head coach Dawn Staley added one future Gamecock during the early signing period. Canada's Shay Colley signed her NLI with South Carolina on Nov. 18 and will have four years of eligibility upon enrollment.

Colley is a three-year standout for Team Canada in junior international play, representing her country in the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (silver), the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship (7th) and the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship (bronze).

DAWN STALEY

**7th Season at South Carolina
Virginia, 1992**

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 311-151 record, including her 139-71 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14. Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
