Gamecocks Head Back to Florida

The seventh-ranked South Carolina men's golf team will make its second-straight trip to Florida this week as it is set to play in the Valspar Collegiate Invitational. The field will play 36 holes on Monday and 18 on Tuesday at the par-71, 7,114-yard Floridian National Golf Club in Palm City, Fla.

About the Valspar Collegiate Invitational

The Valspar Collegiate Invitational is held at one of the premier golf clubs in America, Floridian National Golf Club, which was redesigned by world-renowned designer Tom Fazio. This marks the second year the tournament is being contested. Georgia Tech won the inaugural event last year with a total of 837 (-15). Georgia Tech's Ollie Schniederjans claimed medalist honors with a total of 201 (-12). The individual winner of the tournament receives an exemption to play in the PGA Tour's Valspar Championship.

Breaking Down the Field

The Valspar Collegiate Invitational features one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. A total of 14 teams will compete at Floridian this week, including five teams ranked in the top 10 of the latest Golfstar Relative Rankings. The Gamecocks come in at No. 7 and have recorded six-straight top-five finishes, including four wins. Top-ranked Illinois headlines the field. The Fighting Illini have won five tournaments this season. Second-ranked Florida State will look to win its third-straight event. The Seminoles, winners of four tournaments this season, are coming off a win at the Seminole Intercollegiate. Fifth-ranked Georgia Tech, No. 10 UCLA, No. 14 LSU, No. 18 South Florida, No. 19 Oklahoma State, No. 33 Houston, Texas A&M, Tennessee, Memphis, Kent State and Lamar round out the field. The Gamecocks have a 9-2 head-to-head record against teams in the field this season.

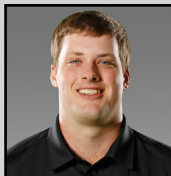

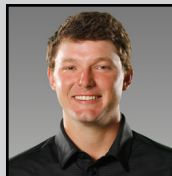

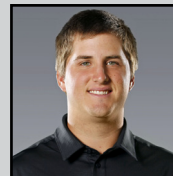

finishing third at the Seminole Intercollegiate. Starke carded rounds of 68 (-4), 69 (-3) and 66 (-6) to lead South Carolina to a third-place finish. His 54-hole total of 203 (-13) is tied for the fifth lowest 54-hole total in school history. Starke earned the honor for the third time in his career.

Going for Five

A win at the Valspar Collegiate Invitational would be Carolina's fifth this season, which would be a school record. The Gamecocks claimed a one-stroke victory over rival Clemson at the Palmetto Intercollegiate with a total of 825 (-15) on March 10 to match the school record with four wins. The 1990-91 and 2008-09 Carolina teams also recorded four tournament wins.

On Pace to Smash Records

The Gamecocks are on pace to set several single-season school records. Carolina's team scoring average is currently 282.00, which is 5.46 strokes lower than the school record of 287.46 set by last year's squad. Junior Will Starke's stroke average of 69.33 is 2.02 strokes lower than the school record of 71.35 held by George Bryan IV (2009-10). Starke has also tied the single-season record for top-five finishes with six with two regular-season tournaments, the SEC Championship and at least the NCAA Regionals left on the schedule.

Making it a Habit

The Gamecocks have finished in the top five in 15 of their last 18 tournaments dating back to last season, including seven tournament wins. Carolina has placed in the top five in six-straight events this season, including four wins. The Gamecocks matched the school record for top-five finishes in a single season last year with nine, including three wins.

Steaking into the Record Books

The Gamecocks became the first team in Carolina history to win three straight tournaments with their victory at the Palmetto Intercollegiate. Carolina won the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall and opened the spring with a win at the Bayou City Collegiate Championship before winning in Aiken this week.

Career Year

Junior Will Starke is playing some of the best golf of his career this season as he has finished in the top 15 in all seven events, including six top fives and a tournament win, and he won his match against Virginia's Ji Soo Park. His six top-five finishes are tied for the most in a single season in school history with Kyle Thompson (1998-99). Starke has also shot in the 60s in 15 of his last 17 rounds, including eight-straight rounds.

Among the SEC's Best

The Gamecocks enter the weekend ranked first in the SEC in tournament wins (4) and second in team scoring average (282.00). Carolina also two golfers in the top 10 in the SEC in scoring average, as Will Starke leads the league (69.33) and Matt NeSmith ranks fifth (71.00).

McDonald's 13

Gamecock head coach Bill McDonald is the winningest coach by tournament victories in school history with 13. McDonald broke the previous record of nine held by Puggy Blackmon (1995-2007) with Carolina's win at the Carpet Capital Collegiate this fall. The Gamecocks then gave McDonald his 11th tournament title with a win at the Camden Collegiate Invitational to close out the fall. Carolina opened the spring by winning the Bayou City Collegiate Championship and then won the Palmetto Intercollegiate this week.

A Top 25 Program

Under the guidance of head coach Bill McDonald, South Carolina has consistently been ranked in the top 25 of several polls the last two years. The Gamecocks ended last year ranked No. 14 in the final Golfstat Rankings, No. 21 in the final regular-season Golf World/Nike Coaches Poll and No. 20 in the Golfweek Rankings. Carolina is currently ranked No. 7 in the Golfstat Relative Rankings, No. 8 in the Golf Coaches Association of America Coaches Poll and No. 13 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Rankings.

Keeping it Low

Five Gamecocks currently have stroke averages in the 72s or lower. Junior Will Starke leads the way with an average of 69.33, followed by junior Matt NeSmith (71.00), senior Caleb Sturgeon (72.19), senior Will Murphy (72.33) and junior Sean Kelly (72.43). Last season Starke, NeSmith, Murphy and Sturgeon wrapped up the year with a stroke average in the 72s, which is the first time of record four golfers have done that in school history.

Gamecocks in the Golfstat Statistics Rankings

As a team South Carolina ranks third in the nation in average score (71.61) and fifth versus par (+0.31). The Gamecocks are tied for 12th in par-3 scoring (3.14), sixth in par-4 scoring (4.06) and 12th in par-5 scoring (4.75). Carolina ranks seventh in eagles (16) and 16th in subpar strokes per round (3.34).

Individually, junior Will Starke ranks sixth nationally in scoring average (69.33), seventh versus par (-1.95), fifth in par-5 scoring (4.51), tied for first in eagles (7) and tied for 15th in subpar strokes per round (3.41).

Rewriting the Record Book

Seniors Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy and juniors Will Starke and Matt NeSmith continue to climb up South Carolina's career scoring average list. Starke currently ranks first all-time with an average of 71.85, while NeSmith isn't far behind in second with an average of 72.12. Sturgeon ranks fifth all-time with an average of 72.82, while Murphy is ninth with an average of 73.19.

Starke also has 11 career top-five finishes, which is tied for the third most all-time at Carolina with George Bryan IV (2006-10). NeSmith is tied for the seventh most career top-five finishes with seven.

A Look Back at the 2013-14 Season

The 2013-14 season was a special year for the South Carolina men's golf program. The Gamecocks finished ninth at the NCAA Championship, which is the second-best finish at the national championship in program history. During the regular season, Carolina matched the school record with nine top-five finishes in 12 events, including three tournament wins. At one point during the season, the Gamecocks reeled off a school-record seven straight top-three finishes. Four Gamecocks wrapped up the season with a stroke average below 73, the first time of record that has happened in school history.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina senior Will Murphy and junior Matt NeSmith are ranked in the top 150 in the latest Golfweek/Amateur.com World Player Rankings. Murphy is No. 11 in the world and No. 4 in the U.S., while NeSmith is No. 126 in the world and No. 56 in the U.S.

In the Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings, Murphy is ranked No. 48, and NeSmith is No. 80. Junior Will Starke is ranked No. 94.

Roster Breakdown

South Carolina's roster is made up of 10 golfers, including two true freshmen, one sophomore, four juniors and three seniors. Seven of the 10 golfers are from the Palmetto state, with the other three hailing from Georgia, New York and Pennsylvania. A total of six golfers have NCAA Championship experience.

Gamecock Accolades in 2013-14

The Gamecocks received several individual and team accolades last season. Will Murphy earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors. Matt NeSmith was named to the PING All-Southeast Region Team and was a second-team All-SEC selection. Caleb Sturgeon was named a Cleveland Golf/Srixon All-America Scholar. Ben Dietrich made the SEC Community Service Team. As a team, the Gamecocks earned GCAA All-Academic Team Honors.

2014-15 Tournament Recaps Seminole Intercollegiate

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 281 (-7) at the Seminole Intercollegiate but came up short of winning its fourth-straight tournament, finishing third with a total of 847 (-17) at Southwood Golf Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event four strokes back of tournament champion Florida State. The second-ranked Seminoles fired a 17-under 271 on the final day of its home tournament to win with a total of 843 (-21). East Tennessee State finished runner-up with a total of 846 (-18).

Carolina junior Will Starke delivered another stellar round, carding a bogey-free 66 (-6), his eighth straight round in the 60s. A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke finished third with a total of 203 (-13), which is tied for the fifth-lowest 54-hole total in school history. The top-five finish is Starke's sixth this season, which moves him into a tie for first for the most in a single season in Carolina history. It's also his 11th career top-five finish, which is tied for the third most in school history with George Bryan IV (2006-10).

Junior Sean Kelly recorded his fourth top-20 finish this season as he turned in a final-round 74 (+2) to finish tied for 18th with a total of 213 (-3).

Junior Matt NeSmith and senior Caleb Sturgeon also carded red numbers for the Gamecocks. NeSmith shot a 2-under 70, including birdies on his final three holes, to wrap up the weekend in a tie for 23rd with a total of 214 (-2). Sturgeon carded a solid 71 (-1) to finish in 54th place with a total of 221 (+5).

Rounding out the lineup, senior Will Murphy tied for 62nd with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting a 78 (+6) on Sunday.

Palmetto Intercollegiate

The eighth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 279 (-1) to claim a one-stroke victory over rival Clemson at the Palmetto Intercollegiate at the historic Palmetto Golf Club.

The Gamecocks entered the final round with a one-shot lead and went on to win their fourth tournament title of the season with a total of 825 (-15) after Clemson (826) was unable to make up the stroke by shooting an identical 279. The four wins match the school record for most wins in a single season at Carolina. The win is also the Gamecocks' third straight tournament title, which is a school record.

Gamecock junior Will Starke also took home some hardware as he claimed medalist honors by a stroke over Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes and Clemson's Cody Proveaux with a career-low total of 201 (-9), which is tied for the second-lowest 54-hole total in school history. Starke fired a final-round 67 (-3) for his fifth

straight round in the 60s. He has now shot in the 60s in 12 of his last 14 rounds.

The win is the second of Starke's career and is also his fifth top-five finish this season, moving him into a tie for second for most top-five finishes in a single season at Carolina. Senior Caleb Sturgeon just missed a top-10 finish as he wrapped up the week in a tie for 11th with a season-low total of 206 (-4). Sturgeon carded an even-par 70 on Tuesday to earn his third top-20 finish of the season and 17th of his career.

Junior Matt NeSmith posted a 1-over 71 to head into the clubhouse in a tie for 21st with a total of 210, while senior Will Murphy tied for 29th with a total of 213 (+3) after shooting a final-round 71. Rounding out the lineup, junior Sean Kelly turned in a 71 to finish the tournament tied for 38th with a total of 215 (-1).

Bayou City Collegiate Championship

The ninth-ranked South Carolina men's golf team claimed its third title of the season, shooting a final-round 285 (-3) to hold off Sam Houston State to win the Bayou City Collegiate Championship at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 850 (-14) to finish two strokes ahead of the Bearcats (852), who made a charge by shooting a final-round 277 (-11). Carolina has now won three tournament titles for the second consecutive season. It marks the fifth time in school history a Gamecock squad has won three tournaments in a season.

Five Gamecocks secured top-20 finishes, led by junior Will Starke. After turning in a 66 (-6) in the second round, Starke fired a bogey-free 68 (-4) on Sunday to finish tied for fifth with a total of 212 (-4), his fourth top-five showing this season.

Senior Will Murphy recorded his second top-10 finish this season as he shot a final-round 70 (-2) to tie for 10th with a total of 214 (-2). Junior Matt NeSmith carded an even-par 72 to wrap up the weekend tied for 13th with a total of 215 (-1).

Junior Sean Kelly and freshman Keenan Huskey, who played as an individual, finished tied for 16th with a total of 216 (E). Kelly shot a final-round 75, while Huskey posted a 74. Rounding out the lineup, senior Caleb Sturgeon finished tied for 36th with a total of 221 (+5) after shooting a 75.

Camden Collegiate Invitational

The 10th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team fired a final-round 275 (-5) to win the inaugural Camden Collegiate Invitational by a stroke over Wofford at Camden Country Club.

The Gamecocks, who entered the day seven strokes back of Wofford, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 847 (+7) to win their second tournament of the fall. It marks the second straight year Carolina has won two tournaments in the fall. The Terriers finished with a total of 848 (+8) to claim second.

Senior Caleb Sturgeon and juniors Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded rounds under par to lead the comeback. NeSmith carded the low round for the Gamecocks, shooting a 3-under 67 to finish tied for seventh with a total of 211 (+1). Sturgeon and Starke tied for fifth with a total of 210 (E) after shooting 68 and 69, respectively.

Senior Blaine Woodruff turned in a final-round 71 (+1) to tie for 26th with a total of 220 (+10), and freshman Keenan Huskey rounded out the lineup, finishing tied for 39th with a total of 223 (+13) after shooting a 73 (+3).

DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a 2-over 286 (+2) at The Golf Club of Tennessee to move one spot up the leaderboard and finish in fourth place in the DICK'S Sporting Goods Collegiate Challenge Cup.

The Gamecocks, whose round was tied for the second lowest of the day, wrapped up the stroke play portion of the tournament with a 54-hole total of 859 (+7). Georgia Tech won the tournament title with a total of 848 (-4).

Junior Will Starke had a stellar tournament, finishing second with a total of 206 (-7) after shooting a 69 (-2) on Saturday. Starke came up one stroke shy of first, as Georgia's Lee McCoy won medalist honors with a total of 205 (-8).

Gamecock junior Matt NeSmith fired a bogey-free 67 (-4) to climb nine spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for fourth with a total of 209 (-4). Senior Will Murphy tied for 23rd with a total of 219 (+6) after carding a 73 (+2) on Saturday. Senior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a final-round 77 (+6) finished 45th with a total of 226 (+13), and sophomore Ben Dietrich tied for 46th with a total of 227 (+14) after shooting a 77 (+6).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The 12th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team captured its first team title of the season after firing a final-round 276 (-12) at the Carpet Capital Collegiate at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who were three strokes off the lead heading into the round, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 848 (-16) to win its first Carpet Capital Collegiate title in 24 appearances against one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. The Gamecocks made their comeback after an incredible back nine as all five golfers in the lineup combined to shoot 10-under.

Sturgeon shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday, and Kelly carded a 76 (+4).

Murphy turned in an even-par 72, and Kelly shot a 74 (+2) on Sunday.
