TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina hosts Longwood in the season opener on Saturday in a 1 p.m. afternoon matinee at Colonial Life Arena. It marks the 106th season opener in Gamecock history, and the second for head coach Frank Martin in Columbia. The Gamecocks enter this season opener having won their last 12, including 11 of those at home. The contest will not be televised, but will be broadcast via the All-Access package on GamecocksOnline.com.

CAROLINA QUICK HITS

- South Carolina is in its 106th season of basketball.
- The Gamecocks are led by Frank Martin in his second year. Matt Figger is the associate head coach, and Perry Clark and Lamont Evans are assistant coaches. Andy Assaley is in his second year as the director of operations for the Gamecocks.
- South Carolina returns seven letterwinners to its squad this season, including senior guard Brenton Williams, the team's top returning scorer from a year ago when he averaged 11.0 points per game. Also returning to the bench this season for the Garnet and Black are senior guard Bruce Ellington, who will join the team at the conclusion of the football season, sophomore forwards Michael Carrera, a 2013 SEC All-Freshman Team selection, Laimonas Chatkevicius and Mindaugas Kacinas. Sophomore guard Austin Constables and forward Brian Steele also return for Carolina.
- The Gamecocks will hold a young roster this season, welcoming seven freshmen to Columbia in forwards Demetrius Henry, Desmond Ringer, Reggie Theus Jr., and guards Duane Notice, Justin McKie, Jaylen Shaw and Sindarius Thornwell. Transfer guard Ty Johnson joined the program last January via Villanova and will be eligible to play following the first semester.
- Justin McKie, son of Gamecock great BJ McKie, was named South Carolina Mr. Basketball, and also the Gatorade South Carolina Boys' Basketball Player of the Year last spring after leading his Irmo squad to the state championship behind a 20-point, 10-rebound performance at Colonial Life Arena.
- Carolina owns a 76-29 (.723) all-time record in season openers, including a perfect 10-0 record in the last 10 seasons. The last season-opening loss for the Gamecocks came against the Ohio Valley's Tennessee Tech during the 2000-01 season, as the Golden Eagles edged the Gamecocks, 73-67. The Gamecocks earned an 82-75 overtime victory vs. UW-Milwaukee in the 2012-13 season opener.
- South Carolina returns 52.1 percent of its scoring from last season and 47.3 percent of its 3-point field goals.
- Entering the season, senior guard Brenton Williams ranks fourth all-time in the Gamecock record book in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 39.5 percent of his attempts. He paced the Gamecocks last season hitting just shy of 40 percent from beyond the arc.

INTERVIEW POLICIES

All interview requests must be made in advance to SID Emily Feeney in the South Carolina Media Relations Office. Beginning with the start of practice in October, Feeney will release a weekly coach and student-athlete availability schedule to media on Mondays.

Post-Game Interview Policy: After each home game, the visiting coach will address the media first, followed by South Carolina student-athletes then South Carolina head coach Frank Martin. (Depending on deadline, this may be altered on a game-by-game basis).

Road Interview Policy: Interviews with Coach Martin while on the road will be scheduled according to the home post-game media procedure. No student-athlete interviews are allowed until after the game once the team leaves Columbia.

All interviews are to be coordinated through the Media Relations Office. This allows the staff to arrange the interview when it best suits the student-athlete's and the reporter's schedules. Please contact the Media Relations Office in advance to make your interview requests. Media are not permitted to contact student-athletes on their own at any time.

All interviews will take place at the designated media interview site for that day as listed in the weekly availability schedule or in the Media Relations Office.

Dormitory, apartment and cell phone numbers for student-athletes will not be provided to the media. Should you need to conduct a telephone interview with a student-athlete, a call will be placed to you from the student-athlete at a mutually agreeable time.

A SOUTH CAROLINA WIN WOULD ...

- Be South Carolina's 13th-straight victory in a season opener
- Continue Frank Martin's streak of a perfect record in season openers
- Be Carolina's first win over a member of the Big South Conference since a 76-60 win vs. Presbyterian last season on Dec. 29, 2012

■ Transfer junior guard Ty Johnson will be eligible to play following the first semester after transferring from Villanova last January. In one season with the Wildcats (2011-12), Johnson averaged 3.3 points and 2.0 assists in 17.7 minutes per game.

■ South Carolina will play three of its first five contests of the regular season away from Columbia, with trips to No. 25 Baylor, Clemson and No. 8/12 Oklahoma State.

■ South Carolina's non-conference schedule features 14 games, including seven home contests. Highlighting the non-conference schedule is a holiday tournament at the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic in late December, and a mid-day contest at Baylor as part of the ESPN College Hoops Marathon in early November. South Carolina also travels to Oklahoma State in early December for the Big 12/SEC Challenge.

SCOUTING LONGWOOD

Longwood did not play an exhibition contest prior to today's season opener. The Lancers, led by first-year head coach Jayson Gee, return seven lettermen, including three starters, led by 6-4 senior guard Tristan Carey. He started 32 of 33 games last season, averaging 34.1 minutes, 15.6 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.8 assists. Carey shot 42% (189-446) from the field, 37% (81-222) on 3-point field goals and 72% (57-79) at the free throw line, adding 73 steals and 19 blocks. He led the team in points (516), scoring average, field goals, field goal attempts, 3-point field goals, 3-point attempts, 3-point percentage, steals and minutes (1,126). He was named to the 2012 Continental Tire/Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team. The other two returning starters are 6-3 senior guard David Robinson and 6-6 redshirt-junior forward Jeylani Dublin. Longwood has added eight newcomers to the program, including six freshmen. New to the team are junior-eligible transfer Tyler Akers, sophomore-eligible transfer Leron Fisher, along with first-year players Damarion Geter, Darrion Allen, Isaac Belton, Charlie Lockwood, Curtis Rowser III and Eric Shaw.

BY THE NUMBERS

12 - The 2013-14 season marks the 12th for Gamecock basketball competing in Colonial Life Arena. The men's squad won its first-ever game in the venue, a 71-66 win vs. East Tennessee State on Nov. 24, 2002.

7.2 - Sophomore forward Michael Carrera led the Gamecocks and ranked sixth in the SEC in rebounding last season with 7.2 per game. Carrera was the first freshman to lead Carolina in the category since freshman forward Mike Holmes matched redshirt-sophomore forward Dominique Archie for 5.7 rebounds per contest during the 2007-08 campaign.

6 to 1 - Rookie guard Duane Notice handled point guard duties in South Carolina's exhibition victory vs. USC Aiken last Sunday. The Woodbridge, Ontario, native dished six assists against just one turnover in the contest. He played 19 minutes before missing the final 9:54 of the contest due to cramps.

110 - Freshmen accounted for 110 of South Carolina's 200 minutes played vs. USC Aiken in exhibition action last weekend. Sophomore forward Laimonas Chatkevicius and senior guard Brenton Williams led all returners with 26 minutes each vs. the Pacers.

6 - South Carolina attempted just six 3s vs. USC Aiken in exhibition play. The fewest attempts by Carolina in a game last season was 11, in the season opener vs. UW-Milwaukee - South Carolina went 0-of-11 from beyond the arc in that contest.

23 - South Carolina's 2013 recruiting class was ranked No. 23 in the nation according to ESPN.com.

Carolina hits the road early next week, traveling to No. 25 Baylor for a 3 p.m. ET matchup on Tuesday as part of ESPN's College Hoops Marathon. The contest will be televised on ESPN.

SEC TOURNAMENT

Fresh off hosting the 2013 Final Four, the Georgia Dome will be the site for the 2014 SEC Tournament, March 12-16 in Atlanta. The Georgia Dome first hosted the tourney in 1995 and the 2014 event will mark the 11th time the venue has hosted the league's postseason tournament. The winner of the 13-game tournament receives the SEC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular-season conference finish.

South Carolina head coach Frank Martin has a very experienced staff with him on the sideline this season. Perry Clark joins the team as an assistant coach with over 30 years of college coaching experience, including stops as the head coach at Tulane, Miami (Fla.) and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Former assistant Matt Figger was promoted to associate head coach during the offseason, and Lamont Evans returns for his second season as an assistant on Martin's staff in Columbia.

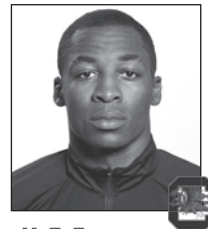

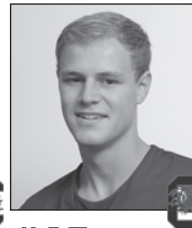

**EXHIB. - SOUTH CAROLINA 84, USC AIKEN 72
NOV. 3, 2012/COLONIAL LIFE ARENA**

COLUMBIA, S.C. - In South Carolina's only exhibition game before opening up the season on Nov. 9, the Gamecocks used a pair of first half runs fueled by its defense to take hold a 17-point first-lead before ultimately defeating USC Aiken 84-72. Sophomore guard Michael Carrera led the Gamecocks with 14 points, while sophomore forward Laimonas Chatkevicius added a double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds.

South Carolina jumped out to a quick 5-1 lead just over two minutes into the game after a jumper from freshman guard Duane Notice. The Pacers though tied it up a minute and a half later on a bucket from senior guard Jesse Seilern and pushed the lead to 9-7 after a 3-pointer from Seilern at the 15:03 mark.

From that point on, the Gamecocks picked up their pressure on the defensive end that resulted in a 10-1 run that was capped off by Carrera turning over Aiken's DeVontae Wright in the backcourt and taking the ball the length of the court for a two-handed dunk.

Wright came back and connected on a 3 on the right side to end a two and half minute drought that saw the Pacers forced into six missed attempts.

Wright's basket was the last for the Pacers for almost seven minutes. After a pair of free throws from the senior guard cut the game to two at the 9:30 mark, South Carolina went on a 16-1 run that started with a dunk from Chatkevicius. Over two minutes later, Notice found Carrera open on the left side as the sophomore marksman drained the triple to push the lead to nine.

Five free throws and buckets from Notice and fellow freshman Demetrius Henry pushed the lead to 33-16. During the near four and a half minute stretch, the Gamecocks forced the Pacers into 12 missed field goal attempts.

With under a minute remaining in the half, Thornwell turned over Aiken, flipped the ball to Notice who found Carrera on the end in transition for an easy dunk, but Seilern's third 3 of the half for the Pacers with five seconds left made it a 17-point game.

After holding USC Aiken to 21 percent shooting in the first half, the Pacers caught fire midway through the second half. With a 62-47 South Carolina lead at the second media timeout at 11:49, USC Aiken went 6-of-10 from the floor to go with four free throws in less than four minutes. After Chatkevicius added a free throw for Carolina at 9:54, the Pacers went on a 13-0 run in under two minutes, highlighted by three-straight 3-pointers from senior guard Ronald Zimmerman. Senior forward Paul Larsen's layup with eight minutes remaining cut the lead to three at 65-62.

The defensive intensity picked back up for the Gamecocks as they went on a 16-2 run over the next 5-plus minutes, primarily at the free-throw line to put the game away.

The run was keyed by senior guard Brenton Williams who hit a big 3 for the Gamecocks to push the lead back up to six with under seven minutes remaining.

To go with Carrera's 14 and Chatkevicius' 10, Thornwell and Williams were also in double figures with 12 and 10 points, respectively. Aiken's Seilern led all scores with 18.
