## South Carolina Notables

- This is the Gamecocks' 39th season as a varsity sport, the fifth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm.
- The Gamecock defense has held 10 of its 14 opponents to less than 50 points to rank fourth in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 47.5 points per game. The Gamecocks allowed then-\#1/1 Stanford (Dec. 21) to score just 53 points after the Cardinal entered the game averaging 78.6 per contest.
- Senior guard Ieasia Walker swiped five steals against Western Carolina (Dec. 29) to become just the 13th Gamecock to amass at least 200 in her career. The three-year starter is also on track to reach the 1,000 -point plateau this season, needing just 45 points to reach the mark.
- South Carolina has found success by limiting its opponents offensive opportunities. While allowing foes to shot 34.2 percent from the field, the Gamecocks are taking 8.6 more shots per game than their opponents. That effort is helped by a +3.4 turnover margin and the fact that South Carolina ranks 13th in the nation in turnovers per game (13.8).

## The Mississippi State Series

The Bulldogs hold a 16-11 edge in the series, but have not defeated the Gamecocks since Feb. 11, 2010. South Carolina scored a 69-43 win at Colonial Life Arena on Jan. 29, 2012. That followed the Gamecocks' first win in Starkville, a 60-53 decision on Feb. 13, 2011, since the 2005-06 season.

Mississippi State holds a 9-3 record against the Gamecocks in Starkville, while South Carolina has an 8-5 edge on its homecourt.

## Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

With a complementary blend of youth and experience, South Carolina opened a season 10-0 for the first time since the 1981-82 team also won its first 10 contests. The Gamecocks, now 12-2, have shown they have both inside and outside offensive options and are dominant on the glass this season while the defense has dropped off very little from last season's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 effort. Two Gamecocks average double-figure points with three others netting 5.5 or more points per game. South Carolina ranks eighth in the nation with a +12.4 rebounding margin and has three players ranked among the SEC's top 20 rebounders. Defensively, the Gamecocks are fourth in the nation in scoring defense, yielding just 47.5 points per game. South Carolina has held 10 of its 14 opponents this season under 50 points and limited five of the 14 to under 30 percent field goal shooting, including Hampton which hit just 19.3 percent (11-57) from the field for the second-lowest opponent field goal percentage of the Staley era.

## Road Warriors

The Gamecocks are 190-231 (.451) all-time in games on enemy territory, including a 15-26 mark under head coach Dawn Staley. Those numbers improve when factoring in just non-conference outings. Since 1983-84 when South Carolina first joined a conference for women's basketball, the Gamecocks are 7263 (.533) in regular-season non-conference outings. Staley's four seasons account for an 8-7 mark in that subset of games.

## Judging January

South Carolina is 177-178 (.499) all-time in the month of January, including a 16-20 (.444) record under fifth-year head coach Dawn Staley. The Gamecocks are 104-75 (.581) in home games during the first month of the calendar year, including a 29-55 (.345) mark at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 60-95 (.387) in January road games and 4-0 at neutral sites during the month.

## Reading the Rankings

South Carolina is ranked in both national polls for the fourth-straight week. The Gamecocks climbed to No. 18 in the Associated Press Poll this week after finally cracking into that ranking at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10. It is the program's highest AP rank since the end of the 2002-03 season. The Gamecocks moved up a spot to No. 15 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

The Gamecocks were receiving votes in both polls right out of the gate, finally breaking into the coaches poll at No. 24 on Nov. 26 behind a 7-0 record. South Carolina moved up to No. 21 the following week before climbing to No. 18 in the Dec. 10 poll. The Gamecocks have risen one spot in each of the last three polls. The AP voters added the Gamecocks to their top 25 at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10 before lifting them to No. 21 the following week. Following a strong showing against No. 1/1 Stanford, the AP voters bumped South Carolina up two spots, and the Gamecocks climbed one more this week.

## Rendering the RPI

With a 12-2 record, including five wins away from home, the Gamecocks are among the nation's top 40 in RPI (varies depending on the organization). South Carolina is one of seven SEC schools ranked in the top 40 in RPI.

The Gamecocks' strength of schedule ranks in the top 60 and should continue to build over the course of the season. The Gamecocks are slated to play six teams currently ranked in the top 25. Beginning Dec. 19 against then-No. 1/1 Stanford, the matchups with ranked foes include road games at Georgia (10/11) and Arkansas (23/-), home and road games against Kentucky (6/6) and home games against Tennessee (12/13) and Texas A\&M (24/22).

## Five for Fighting

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has used the same starting lineup in every game this season, and the quintet has led the way to the program's best non-conference record since 2001-02. Starters Ieasia Walker, Sancheon White, Tiffany Mitchell, Ashley Bruner and Aleighsa Welch - account for 75.0 percent of the offense and 67.7 percent of rebounds while playing 69.4 percent of the minutes available. Each of the five averages at least 5.9 points per game, more than any Gamecock off the bench. Still, the four reserves available have outscored their counterparts on the opposite bench eight times this season,

Looking at South Carolina's roster of seven guards and four forwards/centers, the casual observer might think that rebounding would not be the Gamecocks' bailiwick, but South Carolina has outrebounded all but one of its 13 opponents this season (Stanford), including four by more 20 or more. The team effort has the Gamecocks ranked eighth in the nation in rebound margin at +12.4 . In comparison.

While rebounding is a team focus, this season has seen a surge in individual performances. In 2011-12, a Gamecock posted double-figure rebounds just seven times over 35 games. Through just 14 games this season, South Carolina has amassed 14 double-digit rebound efforts, including seven from sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch, who is second in the SEC led in the category.

## Posts Up - Spurs Up

For the first time in the Dawn Staley era, two of the team's top three scorers are post players. Forwards Aleighsa Welch and Ashley Bruner have been an integral part in the team's 12-2 start this season, averaging 11.9 and 9.4 points, respectively. Welch is shooting a team-best 66.3 percent from the field, although she is nine field goals shy of the minimum required to be ranked in the SEC.

The duo are among the league's top 10 rebounders with Welch ranking fourth at 8.9 per game and Bruner coming in 10th at 7.1. Both are especially proficient on the offensive glass, ranking first and

sixth, respectively, in the league. More than half of Welch's 125 total rebounds have come on the offensive end (65), while 49.0 percent of Bruner's have come on a Gamecock miss. Welch has the third-highest single-game rebound total in the SEC this season with her career-high 15 against Drexel.

## Twice as Nice

South Carolina's Aleighsa Welch earned a spot on the 2012 SEC All-Freshman Team despite lacking a key resume bullet for forwards - a double-double. The sophomore has made up for last season's missing ingredient by amassing six through the team's first 14 games this season. She is tied for the SEC lead and ranks 26th in the nation in that category. After narrowly missing the mark in the season opener, Welch picked up her first career double-double two games laster with a 13 -point, 12 -rebound effort against Savannah State (Nov. 15). She added two more at the Paradise Jam against Hampton (Nov. 22) and Florida Gulf Coast (Nov. 24) and tacked on her fourth against Drexel (Nov. 28). She made it four in five games with a 14 -point/10-rebound effort at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Welch continued her balanced dominance with a 16 -point, 14 -rebound effort against SC State just before the holiday break.

Welch leads the team and is second in the SEC with seven double-digit rebound games this season and also paces the Gamecocks in double-figure scoring outings with nine.

## Jane of All Trades

Senior guard Ieasia Walker's ability to adapt her game to the needs of her team has been a key factor in the team's success in her four seasons in the Garnet and Black. After coming off the bench most of her freshman year, the guard's offense exploded in 2010-11 as the team's predicted offensive weapons faltered. Walker more than doubled her scoring output to a team-high 12.2 points per game, including 13.3 points per SEC contest. As a junior, the point guard shifted her focus to conducting the team, both offensively and defensively. While her scoring average dropped to 7.9 points in 2011-12, her overall productivity did not. Walker led the team with 3.2 assists per game, which helped the team generate another 6.9 points per game. In all, her offensive prowess generated 25.4 percent of the team's 61.2 points per game.

This season, Walker has shown her versatility, adding another component to her on-court effort - leadership. With six underclassmen on the roster, Walker has shown patience through the non-conference season, stepping out of the spotlight to allow her younger teammates to find their way. Still, the senior has scored in double figures six times, paced the team in assists eight times and ranks 10th in the SEC in steals per game (2.4). Her ability to read the team's needs, has yielded a box score that has two post players and a freshman guard among the team's top three scorers so far this season - a first in the Dawn Staley era.

## Movin' On Up

South Carolina seniors Ashley Bruner and Ieasia Walker have made the most of their time in the Garnet and Black, posting and heading toward significant milestones while moving up the all-time leaderboards in several categories.

Bruner made the first move by becoming just the 26th Gamecock to pull down at least 500 career rebounds, hitting the mark as part of her seven-rebound outing at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Currently 25th on the total rebounding list with 534, she can move into the top 20 with 54 more boards, which would tie her for the 20th spot with Ilona Burgrova (2005-08). With 66 more rebounds this season, Bruner will join just 17 other Gamecocks to reach 600 career boards.

Walker became just the 13th Gamecock to amass at least 200 career steals with her five against Western Carolina (Dec. 29). Currently with 201 steals, she needs just 11 more to join Shaunzinksi Gortman (1999-2002) and Sharon Rivers (1980-83) in the all-time top 10. With 955 career points, Walker is on track to join the Gamecocks' 1,000 -point club as the 28th member, only 11 of whom have also posted at least 200 steals.

## Working Overtime

After Wednesday's 58-55 win over Drexel, South Carolina is 16-14 all-time in overtime games, including a 1-3 mark in double-overtime contests. Since taking the reins for the 2008-09 season, Gamecock head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 5-3 record in extended games. South Carolina played a schoolrecord four overtime games in 2010-11, going 2-2, and in 1995-96, going 1-3.

## Preseason Predictions

South Carolina was picked by both the media and league's coaches to finish in the middle of the 14 -team pack in the Southeastern Conference. The media predicted the Gamecocks would take seventh place, while the coaches slotted South Carolina into sixth.

Senior guard Ieasia Walker drew preseason second-team all-conference honors from both groups. She is the team's lone returning starter and the highest returning scorer from last year's squad. Her 7.9 points per game came with 3.2 assists per outing, which combined to earn her Second-Team All-SEC honors for the second-straight year.

## Quick Re-Take

South Carolina put together its best season in a decade last season, reaching the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 for the first time since 2001-02 and making the program's first ever appearance in the SEC Tournament semifinals. The team's 25 victories tied for the most during the program's time in the SEC, matching that of the 2001-02 team, which advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

The Gamecocks found success behind a steady dose of stifling defense, ranked fourth in the nation, and a diversified offense. South Carolina allowed more than 55 points just 12 times in 25 games and held five nationally ranked opponents to that mark or lower. Seven different Gamecocks led the team in scoring, and eight scored in double figures at least once. South Carolina's 14-2 start earned the program's first national ranking since the end of the 2002-03 season, and the Gamecocks finished the season ranked No. 25 by the Associated Press. The team posted the most SEC wins since the 2001-02 squad also had 10 . Signature league wins included the program's first sweeps of Vanderbilt and Florida and its first win over Tennessee in Knoxville.
