



2014 Florida Football Postgame Notes

South Carolina 23, Florida 20 (Overtime)

November 15, 2014

Team Notes

- South Carolina QB Dylan Thompson scored the game-winning touchdown on a four-yard run in the first OT.
- Florida fell to 4-3 all-time in overtime games.
- UF had its overtime winning streak snapped at four games.
- 2014 marks the first season in program history where the Gators have played multiple overtime games.
- Saturday's contest was the first in the Florida-South Carolina series to go to overtime.
- The Orange and Blue has forced six Gamecock turnovers since 2011, including one today.
- After allowing 136 yards in the first quarter, UF yielded 165 in the final four periods (2nd – 31; 3rd – 42; 4th – 67; OT – 25).

Individual Notes

- Treon Harris rushed for 111 yards, marking the first time a UF quarterback has rushed for more than 100 yards since Jeff Driskel had 177 at Vanderbilt on Oct. 13, 2012.
- Demarcus Robinson scored his fifth career touchdown (all this season) on an 11-yard pass from Harris with 24 seconds remaining in the first half.
- The touchdown pass was the fourth of Harris' career, and his first since the Missouri game on Oct. 18.
- Matt Jones scored on a 1-yard touchdown run in the third quarter, marking his sixth rushing score of the season.
- Jones' total of six rushing touchdowns is the most in a season by a Gator since Mike Gillislee had 10 in 2012.
- Antonio Morrison recorded a career-high 16 tackles, marking his second game with 15+ stops this year (also: 15 vs. Georgia, Nov. 1).
- Jabari Gorman forced and recovered a fumble in the third quarter, marking the fifth time this season (and second in as many weeks) that a Gator has both caused and recovered a fumble in a game (also: Caleb Brantley vs. Eastern Michigan, Keanu Neal at Alabama, Jalen Tabor at Tennessee, Vernon Hargreaves at Vanderbilt).
- Jonathan Bullard sacked Carolina QB Dylan Thompson in the third quarter, marking his first solo sack since Sept. 28, 2013, at Kentucky.
- Francisco Velez opened the scoring for Florida when he converted a 35-yard field goal in the second quarter.
