Gamecocks End Regular Season at Augusta Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team will look to close out the regular season in strong fashion this weekend at the Augusta Invitational. The 54-hole event runs Saturday through Sunday at the par-72, 7,142-yard Forest Hills Golf Club in Augusta, Ga.

The Lineup

South Carolina head coach Bill McDonald will be sticking with the same five golfers who have led the Gamecocks to three tournament wins and a runner-up finish last week at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate. Junior Caleb Sturgeon will occupy the No. 1 spot this week, followed by sophomore Will Starke, sophomore Matt NeSmith, junior Will Murphy and freshman Ben Dietrich.

What They've Done So Far

- Junior Caleb Sturgeon: Played in all eight tournaments...Has recorded four top-20 finishes, including a win at the Badger Invitational with a total of 206 (-10)...Tied for third on the team with a stroke average of 73.09...Has produced nine rounds of par or better...Career stroke average of 73.14 currently ranks fifth all-time at South Carolina.

- Sophomore Will Starke: Played in all eight tournaments...Won first collegiate title at Seahawk Intercollegiate with a total of 137 (-7)...Tied for the team lead with four top-five finishes, which is tied for the fifth most all-time in a single season at South Carolina...Ranks second on the team with a stroke average of 72.30...Second on the squad with 11 rounds of par or better.

- Sophomore Matt NeSmith: Played in all eight tournaments...Tied for the team lead with four top-five finishes, which is tied for the fifth most in a single season at South Carolina...Has placed in the top 10 in eight of last 12 regular-season events dating back to last spring...Leads the team with a 71.96 stroke average, which ranks third all-time for a single season in school history...Ranks first on the team in rounds of par or better with 12.

- Junior Will Murphy: Played in all eight tournaments...Has three top-20 finishes, including a fourth-place finish at the Seahawk Intercollegiate...Tied for third on the team with a stroke average of 73.09...Ranks third on the team with 10 rounds of par or better.

- Freshman Ben Dietrich: Played in five team tournaments and on individual event...Has three top-20 finishes in team events this season, including a career-best tie for 10th showing at the Seahawk Intercollegiate...Ranks fifth on the team with a 74.00 stroke average...Produced four rounds of par or better.

History at Augusta Invitational

The Gamecocks are making their 10th appearance all-time, including their fifth straight, at the Augusta Invitational. South Carolina's best finish at the event was a runner-up showing in 2010 with a score of 833 (-31), which is the fourth best 54-hole total in school history. The Gamecocks shot a school and tournament record 266 (-22) in the second round that year. South Carolina's best individual finish at the event came in 2007 when Georgia Bryan IV tied for second with a total of 210 (-6).

Last Time at the Augusta Invitational: April 6-7, 2013

South Carolina finished fifth at last year's Augusta Invitational with a total of 872 (+8), finishing ahead of eight teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50. Matt NeSmith was the Gamecocks' top individual finisher as he tied for eighth with a total of 214 (-2), including

an open-round 67 (-5).

Breaking Down the Field

This weekend's field is one of the strongest the Gamecocks have faced this season. Twelve out of the 15 teams are ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including South Carolina at No. 23. Three teams are in the top 10, with UCF leading the way at No. 7. The Knights have won three tournaments on the season and have finished no worse than fifth in eight events. Eighth-ranked Houston and No. 9 Illinois, the 2013 NCAA Championship runner-up, round out the top-10 teams. Thirteenth-ranked Virginia Tech, No. 19 Texas, No. 22 New Mexico, No. 27 Baylor, No. 28 Clemson, No. 42 Purdue, No. 43 Tennessee and No. 46 TCU make up the rest of the top 50 teams. Host GRU Augusta, Coastal Carolina and USC Aiken, the No. 3 team in Division II, round out the field.

Going for Four and Eight

The Gamecocks will be looking to win their fourth tournament title of the season and earn their eighth-straight finish of third or better this week at the Augusta Invitational. A fourth win would tie the school record for wins in a season, matching the 1990-91 and 2008-09 teams. The Gamecocks are just the fourth team to win three tournaments in a season, joining the 1981-82, 2003-04 and 2008-09 squads. An eighth-straight top-three finish would add to the school record for the best stretch in school history. The Gamecocks set the record with a seventh-straight top-three finish with a runner-up finish at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate.

Among the Best in the World

South Carolina sophomore Matt NeSmith and juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon are ranked in the top 100 in the latest Golfweek/Amateurgolf.com World Player Rankings. NeSmith is No. 50 in the world rankings and No. 27 in the U.S. rankings. Murphy comes in at No. 64 in the world and No. 35 in the U.S., while Sturgeon is ranked No. 77 in the world and No. 44 in the U.S.

Starke Earns SEC Golfer of the Week Honor

South Carolina sophomore Will Starke was named SEC Golfer of the Week (March 19) after winning medalist honors and leading the Gamecocks to the team title at the Seahawk Intercollegiate. His total of 137 (-7) is the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history, and it included an opening-round 64, which is tied for the third lowest round in school history. As a team, the Gamecocks score of 560 (-16) is the third best 36-hole total in school history.

Par-3s Not a Problem

Junior Caleb Sturgeon and sophomore Will Starke have been among the best in the nation on par-3 holes this season. Both are currently tied for 19th nationally in par-3 scoring with an average of 3.03. As a team, South Carolina is ranked 16th with an average of 3.15.

Getting Below Par

As a team, South Carolina is 10th nationally in subpar strokes per round with an average of 3.53.

Race for the Golfstat Cup

Sophomore Matt NeSmith, sophomore Will Starke and juniors Caleb Sturgeon and Will Murphy are listed in the latest standings for the Golfstat Cup, which will be awarded to the golfer with the lowest adjusted scoring average among all divisions (DI, DII, DIII, NAIA, JUCO) at the end of the season. NeSmith ranks 58th with an adjusted average of 73.91, while Starke is 92nd with an adjusted average of 74.59. Sturgeon and Murphy are tied for 230th with an average of 76.17. Georgia's Joey Garber leads the way with an average of 70.24.

2013-14 Tournament Recaps

Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate

The 24th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team made a run at winning its fourth tournament title of the season at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate but it came up just short, finishing runner-up despite shooting a final-round 276 (-12) at Bulls Bay Golf Club.

The Gamecocks concluded the event with a total of 855 (-9), just three strokes back of Auburn for the title. The second-place finish marks the seventh-straight finish of third or better for South Carolina, which is the longest stretch of top-three finishes in school history.

Four of the five Gamecocks wrapped up the event with top-20 finishes, with sophomore Will Starke leading the way. After collecting his first collegiate win a week ago, Starke continued his stellar play in Awendaw on his way to a seventh-place finish, his fifth top-10 finish this season. His final-round 68 kept him firmly in the top 10 with a total of 212 (-4).

Junior Will Murphy and freshman Ben Dietrich tied for 11th with a total of 214 (-2), which is a season low for Murphy and a career-low for Dietrich. Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his 15th career top-20 finish as he tied for 20th with a total of 217 (+1). Rounding out the lineup, junior Caleb Sturgeon turned in a 75 (+3) on Tuesday to finish the event in a tie for 49th with a total of 226 (+10).

Seahawk Intercollegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team won its third tournament title of the season by 19 strokes after the final round of the Seahawk Intercollegiate was canceled due to inclement weather at the Country Club of Landfall.

The Gamecocks finished the event with a two-round total of 560 (-16), which is the third-best 36-hole total in school history.

Sophomore Will Starke also brought home some hardware as he claimed its first collegiate title with a total of 137 (-7), including a career-low 64 in the opening round on Sunday. Starke's total is the fifth-lowest 36-hole total in school history.

The remainder of the Gamecocks in the lineup recorded top-20 finishes. Sophomore Matt NeSmith earned his sixth career top-five finish, claiming third with a total of 139 (-5). Junior Will Murphy also placed in the top-five, finishing fourth with a total of 140 (-4). Freshman Ben Dietrich tied for 10th with a total of 144 (E), while junior Caleb Sturgeon tied for 18th with a score of 146 (+2).

Bayou City Collegiate Championships

The 25th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team opened the spring in strong fashion by claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships at the Golf Club of Houston.

The Gamecocks fired an 8-under 280 in the final round to wrap up the event with a total of 851 (-13). Tournament host Houston claimed the team title with a total of 833 (-31), while Texas finished runner-up with a score of 841 (-23).

South Carolina has now finished third or better in four straight events, including two wins. It matches last year's stretch of four consecutive top-three finishes as the most by a Gamecock team since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

Juniors Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon and sophomores Matt NeSmith and Will Starke all carded a 2-under 70 for the Gamecocks on Sunday, while junior Blaine Woodruff closed out the weekend with a 74 (+2).

NeSmith, Woodruff and Murphy all just missed out on a top-20 finish as they tied for 21st with totals of 215 (-1). Sturgeon tied for 33rd with a total of 216 (E), and Starke tied for 36th with a score of 217 (+1).

Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team closed out its fall schedule in dominant fashion, claiming its second-straight Wendy's Kiawah Classic title by 22 strokes at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who won last year's tournament by 20 strokes, posted a final-round 295 (+7) to finish the week with a three-round total of 864 (E) to secure their second-consecutive tournament title of the fall.

Four out of the five golfers in South Carolina's lineup finished the week in the top 15, with sophomore Matt NeSmith leading the way. The North Augusta, S.C., native fired a final-round 68 (-4) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). Sophomore Will Starke (T-4th), freshman Ben Dietrich (12th) and junior Caleb Sturgeon (T-13th) also finished the week in the top 15. Junior Will Murphy just missed a top-20 finish as he tied for 21st.

Starke recorded his third career top-five showing as he shot a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish tied for fourth with a total of 216 (E).

Dietrich carded a final-round 74 (+2) to earn his first career top-20 finish with a total of 220 (+4). A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon posted a 77 (+5) on Tuesday to finish the event with a total of 221 (+5). Murphy turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to conclude the week with a score of 223 (+7), missing out on his seventh career top-20 finish by a stroke.

Badger Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 291 (+3) to cruise to a 24-stroke victory at the Badger Invitational on Tuesday at University Ridge Golf Course.

The Gamecocks led wire-to-wire and wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 856 (-8) to pull away from the field for the win. Junior Caleb Sturgeon also captured medalist honors for the second time in his career after firing a 3-under 69 in the final round. He posted a total of 206 (-10) to become the 11th golfer in school history to win multiple tournament titles.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon now has four career top-five finishes, just one shy of breaking into the top-10 in school history. Sturgeon's closest competitor was also wearing Garnet and Black, as NeSmith carded a 73 (+1) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). NeSmith also has four top-five finishes for his career and has placed in the top 10 in six of the last seven regular-season tournaments dating back to last spring.

Sophomore Will Starke recorded his fourth career top-20 finish as he shot a final-round 72 (E) to tie for 18th with a total of 222 (+6), while junior Will Murphy finished just outside the top 20 in a tie for 25th with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Tuesday. Rounding out the lineup, freshman Ben Dietrich turned in a 77 (+5) to tie for 44th with a total of 228 (+12). Kansas finished runner-up with a total of 880 (+16), followed by Illinois State (883), USC Upstate (+22) and Austin Peay (+27).

Rees Jones Invitational

The South Carolina men's golf team came up short of claiming its third Rees Jones Invitational title as it shot a final-round 299 (+11) to finish in a tie for second at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks, who have never placed worse than third at the event, finished tied with South Florida with a three-round total of 887 (+23) to fall two shots shy of tournament champion Kennesaw State. The Owls captured their third Rees Jones Invitational trophy with a total of 885 (+21).

The final day proved to be the toughest, as the average score rose to 78.16 with winds gusting as high as 20 miles per hour. South Carolina fought through the conditions to place three golfers in the top 15. Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished in a tie for fourth with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Tuesday.

Junior Will Murphy carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 1-over 73 to finish in a tie for sixth with a total of 219 (+3). Junior Caleb Sturgeon posted a final-round 77 (+5) to record his second-straight top-15 finish at Haig Point with a total of 222 (+6). Sophomore Will Starke tied for 33rd with a total of 231 (+15) after turning in a 75 (+3) in the final round, while junior Blaine Woodruff shot an 80 (+8) to tie for 48th with a total of 235 (+19).

Carpet Capital Collegiate

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 297 (+9) at The Farm Golf Club to finish in 10th place at the Carpet Capital Collegiate. The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a three-round total of 888 (+24).

Continuing his solid play from the first two rounds, sophomore Will Starke recorded his second career top-five finish as he fired a 2-under 70 to conclude the tournament in a tie for fifth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke carded a team-best seven birdies to go with three bogeys and a double bogey. After shooting 1-over 37 on the front side, he bogeyed the 10th hole to start the back nine before playing the final eight holes at 4-under.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, who posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as he concluded the tournament in a tie for 41st with a total of 224 (+8). He recorded a pair of birdies, three bogeys and a triple bogey on the afternoon.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith turned in a 78 (+6) on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 225 (+9), while junior Will Murphy tied for 48th with a total of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 74 (+2). Rounding out the lineup, junior Blaine Woodruff shot a 77 (+5) to tie for 62nd with a total of 230 (+14).
