## SCOUTING SOUTH CAROLINA

South Carolina (14-4, 0-0 SEC) - The Gamecocks are off to one of the best starts in program history, owning 14 wins heading into SEC play including a huge win last weekend over previously undefeated and third-ranked Arizona State. The momentum from the first win did not carry over for the rest of the tournament however, as they fell to Minnesota and Ball State in the remaining two games. Freshman Kaylea Snaer has had a great start to her career so far, batting .370 with a team-leading 20 hits and 16 RBI. Junior Sarah Mooney also owns 16 RBI, helped by a team-leading six home runs. Senior Ashlyn Masters leads the team with a .385 average including five doubles and two triples. In the circle, junior Julie Sarratt and freshman Nickie Blue have split time nearly evenly, with Sarratt owning a 1.24 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 50.2 innings pitched.

## SERIES HISTORY

Alabama owns a 35-16 all-time record against South Carolina, having faced the Gamecocks every year except 2007. In last season's series, the Tide swept the Gamecocks in Columbia, S.C., in three very tight games, winning 6-4, 5-3 and 7-6. Over that series, Kaila Hunt went 6-10 (.600) while Jaclyn Traina drove in a team-leading five RBI thanks in part to home runs in each of the final two games. Alabama has won the past 12 meetings, with South Carolina's last win in the series coming on April 11, 2009. South Carolina's last win in Tuscaloosa was on April 17, 2004.

## LAST TIME OUT: ALABAMA GOES 4-1 AT EASTON CRIMSON CLASSIC

Last weekend, Alabama hosted the Easton Crimson Classic, going 4-1 against Purdue, Houston and No. 9 Florida State. On Friday, Feb. 28, the Tide grabbed a pair of wins, defeating Purdue, 7-3, and Houston, 114. Jaclyn Traina and Leslie Jury each threw over 130 pitches in their starting efforts but the offense backed them up, hitting .333 as a team with three players earning three hits each. On Saturday, March 1, Alabama opened the day with its first ranked victory, defeating the ninth-ranked Seminoles, 1-0, in a pitchers' duel. A fifth-inning solo homer by Kaila Hunt made all the difference as the Tide held on for the tight one-run victory. After the pitchers' duel, the Alabama offense exploded against Houston in the nightcap, defeating the Cougars 12-1 in five innings with six of the starting nine on offense earning at least one hit. In a rematch against Florida State on Sunday, March 2, three Tide errors in the fourth inning led to an early deficit which proved to large to overcome as they eventually fell, 5-1.

## AROUND THE SEC

Heading into conference play this weekend, eight of the league's 13 teams are hitting above .300 as a team, led by Georgia at .350 , though the Bulldogs have the second fewest at-bats in the league. Undefeated Florida leads the leage in runs scored (181), RBI (169) and home runs (30) while Alabama and Texas A\&M are tied at the top in hits with 188 , just one ahead of the Gators. LSU's speed has them at the top of the league in stolen bases with 56 , having only been caught four times. In the pitching department, Mississippi State leads the SEC with a stunning 0.64 team ERA, holding opposing batters to a .132 average while striking out 181 over 143.0 innings pitched. Individually, Alabama's Haylie McCleney leads the league with a slash line of .542/.663/.932 while Florida's Lauren Haeger has blasted an SEC-leading nine home runs. Tennessee's Ellen Renfroe is the wins leader in the circle with 10 and ranks second with 85 strikeouts and 65.1 innings pitched.

## OPENING STRONG AGAINST THE SEC

Traditionally, Alabama has had plenty of success on the opening weekend of SEC play, holding an all-time record of 45-10. Over the past 17 seasons, Alabama's only series loss was last year at Tennessee, dropping two of the three games. The Tide has never been swept on its opening conference weekend and has swept its opponent 10 out of 17 times. At home, Alabama is 29-3 and has swept its opponent seven out of 10 times. Alabama and South Carolina have never met on the opening weekend of SEC play. The Tide's most common opponent on opening weekend has been Arkansas, with the teams meeting six times since 1997.

## HUNTING FOR THE CAREER HOME RUN RECORD

Senior infielder Kaila Hunt has been a consistent source of power in the Alabama lineup over the past three seasons, and now she has a chance to etch her name at the top of the Tide record books. She currently has 51 career home runs, only 10 shy of breaking Kelly Kretschman's (1998-01) career record of 60 . The Evans, Ga., native is averaging just over 15 home runs per season, blasting a career-best 21 in the Tide's championship 2012 season. Hunt blasted her 50th career home run against Purdue on Feb. 28, becoming just the fourth player in Alabama history to surpass 50 career home runs, joining Kretschman, Charlotte Morgan (58, 2007-10) and Amanda Locke (54, 2008-12) in the prestigious club.

## ALABAMA SOFTBALL RANKED NO. 11 IN BOTH WEEK FOUR POLLS

A 4-1 weekend at the Easton Crimson Classic, including a win over ninth-ranked Florida State, helped Alabama hold on to its No. 11 ranking in the week four polls, released Tuesday. For the second-straight week, Alabama is ranked No. 11 in the USA Today/NFCA Poll, with no new teams entering or falling out of the top ten. Florida is a near-unanimous No. 1 pick, earning 30 of the 32 possible first-place votes. Oregon slides into the No. 2 spot ahead of Tennessee, who suffered its first loss of the season last weekend. Arizona State made the biggest slide, as a three-loss weekend dropped them from No. 3 to No. 10. In the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, Alabama fell one spot from No. 10 last week to No. 11 this week. The Seminoles, who also went 4-1 last weekend in Tuscaloosa, jumped from No. 11 to No. 9. The Gators and the Lady Vols remain atop the rankings for the third-straight week. Besides Alabama, nine other SEC teams are ranked in both polls: Florida (1/1), Tennessee (2/3), Kentucky (8/10), Texas A\&M (13/16), Missouri (15/18), Georgia (18/19) and LSU (24/23). Auburn and Mississippi State are also receiving votes in both polls.

## PATRICK MURPHY EARNS 800TH WIN AT ALABAMA

With Saturday's win over Virginia Tech, Head Coach Patrick Murphy eclipsed the 800 -win plateau as the University of Alabama's head coach. He is the 15th active Division-I head coach with at least 800 wins at their current school, while Murphy and Arizona's Mike Candrea are the only coaches among those 15 averaging over 50 wins per season. Over his Alabama career, Murphy owns a 801-216 (.788) record, while he is 829-236 (.778) all-time as a head coach, including 15-plus years at Alabama and one at Northwestern Missouri State.

## ALABAMA PLACES THIRD IN PRESEASON SEC POLL

Alabama was chosen to finish third in the Southeastern Conference by a vote of the conference's 13 head coaches in the annual preseason poll. Defending SEC champion Florida is the preseason favorite, followed by 2013 national runner-up Tennessee. The Gators earned 10 out of a possible 13 first-place votes after earning a national-best 58 wins in 2013 and winning its fourth SEC title. The Lady Vols, chosen No. 1 in the preseason NFCA/USA Today poll, earned two first-place votes while the Crimson Tide earned one first-place vote. The top eight programs in the SEC poll are all ranked in the preseason NFCA/USA Today Top 25, with Arkansas and Auburn also receiving votes. Points for the SEC poll were awarded on a 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12 basis and coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.

## KAILA HUNT NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Alabama senior Kaila Hunt was selected as one of 30 Division-I senior softball players on the initial candidate list for the 2014 Senior CLASS Award. The CLASS award, an acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, celebrates student-athletes that excel on and off the field. Hunt is one of 13 on the list with a cumulative GPA higher than 3.5, one of nine to earn NFCA All-America honors in 2013 and just one of four to earn CoSIDA Capital One Academic All-America honors in 2013. Last season, she became just the sixth player in Alabama history to earn NFCA All-American and CoSIDA Academic All-American honors in the same season.

## HUNT, TRAINA AND MCCLENEY NAMED TO USA SOFTBALL POY TOP 50 WATCH LIST

Alabama softball boasts three representatives, tied for the most of any school, on the Top 50 Watch List for the 2014 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Award, announced Wednesday. Kaila Hunt, Jackie Traina and Haylie McCleney, all Top 25 finalists last season, represent the Crimson Tide on the prestigious list. Alabama is the only Southeastern Conference member with three honorees, as Arizona State and Oregon are the only other schools in the nation to have three on the list. The SEC is the most-represented conference, with seven member schools placing at least one on the list.

## THREE NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-SEC TEAM

Alabama is well-represented on the preseason All-SEC team, as Kaila Hunt, Haylie McCleney and Jackie Traina all were voted to the list. Alabama and Georgia lead the conference with three representatives each, followed closely by Auburn, Florida and Tennessee with two each. This is Traina's third-straight apperance on the preseason All-SEC team and Hunt's second-straight. All three were also on the Top 50 Watch List for the USA Softball Player of the Year.

## PATRICK MURPHY INDUCTED INTO NFCA HALL OF FAME

Alabama head coach Patrick Murphy was recognized for a career of excellence as the National Fastpitch Coaches Association inducted him into the NFCA Hall of Fame this past December. Murphy owns over 800 wins as a head coach, including 15 years at Alabama and one at Northwest Missouri State during the 1995 season. Murphy arrived at the Capstone in the program's inagural 1997 season as an assistant coach before being promoted to the head coach prior to the 1999 season. Murphy has guided the Crimson Tide to the NCAA Tournament every season since 1999, including eight Women's College World Series appearances and a national championship in 2012. The Alabama coaching staff has been named the South Region Coaching Staff of the Year eight times, including National Coaching Staff of the Year honors in 2012. Under Murphy, Alabama has garnered 89 All-American Honors, 73 All-South Regin honors and 14 Academic All-American honors.

## STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Alabama will face 16 teams this season that made the 2013 NCAA Tournament. Nine of those 16 teams are out-of-conference while the remaining seven are SEC opponents. Out-of-conference opponents that qualified for the 2013 NCAA Tournament include Northwestern State, Arizona, Virginia Tech, UAB, Houston, Mississippi Valley State, South Alabama, Georgia Southern and North Carolina. Prior to the 2014 season, Alabama is a combined 54-10 all-time against these opponents.

SEC opponents in 2014 that made the 2013 postseason include South Carolina, Florida, LSU, Arkansas, Mississippi State, Georgia and Missouri. Potential matchups in the SEC Tournament against 2013 postseason teams include Texas A\&M, Tennessee or Kentucky. The SEC sent a NCAA-record 11 teams to the postseason in 2013.

## 2013 RECAP

Alabama ended the 2013 season with a 45-15 (13-11 SEC) record, finishing third in the SEC West Division and seventh overall. The Tide made their 15th-straight appearance in the NCAA Touranment, sweeping the Tuscaloosa Regional round before falling in two games to the eventual national runner-up Tennessee in the Knoxville Super Regional round. Four players earned NFCA All-America honors (Kayla Braud, Kaila Hunt, Haylie McCleney and Jackie Traina) and Alabama finished the season ranked No. 10 in both the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and the USA Today/NFCA poll.

## NEXT TIME OUT: VS. MISSISSIPPI VALLEY STATE, AT OLE MISS

On Tuesday, March 11, Alabama will play a midweek game against the Mississippi Valley State Devilettes, which is set for a 6 p.m. CT first pitch. The following weekend, Alabama hits the road for a three-game series in Oxford, Miss., against the Ole Miss Rebels.


## PATRICK MURPHY

Northern Iowa, 1988

In today's world of collegiate athletics, few can claim to have been at a program since the beginning. Not many can say they were there at the origin of a program, having been present from the very inception to where it stands today. And certainly nobody can claim to have brought a program further, and in shorter time, than Crimson Tide head softball coach Patrick Murphy, entering his 16th season as the program's leader in 2014.

From a humble start to a national championship, Murphy has taken Alabama to the top of the college softball world. Beginning with his days as an assistant in the very first years of the Alabama softball program, Murphy has emerged as the face of a team that has grown under his leadership to become one of the most consistently successful programs in the nation.

The accomplishments are there for everyone to see. A 2012 National Championship, eight Women's College World Series berths, four SEC titles and 15 straight NCAA Tournament bids are only a few of the team honors that Murphy has brought to Tuscaloosa during his tenure.

The individual honors are equally as impressive. Tide players have earned All-America honors 89 times under Murphy's watch. He has tutored 81 All-SEC performers and 73 NFCA All-Region honorees. His teams have been just as successful in the classroom, with 14 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans and 157 SEC AllAcademic selections.

Even more impressively, Murphy has led the program to a surge of popularity among Tide fans. Alabama has become a regular atop the nation's attendance standings, with an ever-growing group of loyal fans who fill the stands at Rhoads Stadium throughout the season. The 2008 campaign was a sellout, setting a new benchmark in season tickets sold with more than 1,200 allocated to loyal fans. During the 2009 season, Alabama broke the single-season attendance record formerly held by Fresno State. Then, in 2010, a record total of 80,690 fans were part of the atmosphere in Tuscaloosa followed by 68,110 that took in the Tide in 2011. The previous two seasons have seen attendance top the 90,000 mark, with 91,541 fans in 2012 and 93,332 in 2013.
