## **GAMECOCKS CONTINUE EARLY SEASON ON THE ROAD**

After competing against its first SEC competition of the season at Tennessee last week, South Carolina will return to the road this week as the squad heads to Greenville, N.C., to face East Carolina at Minges Natatorium. It marks a return trip to his alma mater for Head Coach McGee Moody.

## **SERIES HISTORY**

The Gamecock men's swimming and diving team is 6-2 all-time in dual meets against the Pirates while the women's team is a perfect 3-0.

## LAST TIME VS. EAST CAROLINA

On Jan. 28, 2012, the Gamecock women defeated Vanderbilt, 187-122, and East Carolina, 180.5-140.5, while the South Carolina men topped East Carolina 186-152. South Carolina won nine of the first 11 events before taking exhibition times in the last nine events to conclude the two-day dual meet at the Blatt P.E. Center/Carolina Natatorium.

# **SCOUTING EAST CAROLINA**

Both the East Carolina men and women are 1-0 on the year in dual meets after easily defeating Davidson on Oct. 12. The two teams combined to win 29 of 32 events. For the men, Senior Attila Kiraly (100 and 200 backstroke, 200 IM) posted three victories. Juniors Charlsie Lincoln (100 and 200 breaststroke) and Danielle Morrin (200 butterfly and 200 IM) both won a pair of events on the women's side, while junior Rokas Cepulis (100 and 200 breaststroke) and freshman Adam Dear (100 and 200 freestyle) did the same for the men.

In their first competition of the season, both Pirate squads finished second at the All-North Carolina Invitational as NC State won both the men's and women's competitions.

#### NATIONALLY RANKED

After some standout performances at No. 8 Tennessee, the South Carolina men's swimming and diving team is ranked No. 25 in the first College Swimming Coaches Association of America Division I Team Rankings of the 2013-14 season.

## DIVING TO THE TOP OF THE SEC

In back-to-back weeks, South Carolina has had one its divers named SEC Diver of the week after junior Cole Miller won the honor this week after Miller producing big results at Tennessee. He claimed the 3-meter board title with 409.28 points, his second consecutive week scoring over 400 points in that event. The junior finished second on the 1-meter board with 328.65 points, falling to former SEC platform champion Mauricio Robles by 0.15 points after the final dive. His mark on the 3-meter at Tennessee currently leads the conference, while his total of 365.02 on the 1-meter against College of Charleston is second.

A week prior, junior Patricia Kranz was named SEC Female Diver of the Week (10/15)

after winning the three-meter springboard at the dual meet against College of Charleston. She earned the honor after placing first in the three-meter and taking second in the one-meter board. Her mark of 369.23 points was just shy of a career mark in the event. She finished with 303.52 points in the one-meter. Her score in the three-meter currently ranks first in the SEC, while her one-meter score ranks second in the conference.

#### YOUTH MOVEMENT

At Tennessee, redshirt freshman Kevin Leithold and true freshman Sam Lynch produced nationally ranked teams en-route to wins. Leithold posted the nation's 12th ranked time in the 100 freestyle as he won the event at 44.61. The redshirt freshman also claimed the win in the 100 breaststroke with the 23rd ranked time of 56.27. Lynch posted the 18th fastest time in the 100 butterfly as he won the event in 48.98.

## TRANSFERRING IMPACT

Since transferring from Louisville, Victoria Mitchell has made an immediate impact on the women's team as she's won four events in two dual meets. Individually, the junior won the 200 and 800 freestyles two weeks ago at College of Charleston, before capturing 1000 freestyle and the 200 IM last week at Tennessee.

#### **WORKING TOGETHER**

Until last year, the Gamecocks haven't had a relay team invited to the NCAA Championships since the 800 freestyle relay team qualified in 2007. That team finished 11th in the event to earn All-America honors. Last year's 800 freestyle relay team of Gerard Rodriguez, Michael Flach, Marwan El Kamash and Alex Fitton entered the meet with the 19th fastest time in the country of 6:23.99, which is a school record. The team posted a time of 6:24.54 to place 15th at the Championships and earn All-America honors. Rodriguez, Flach and El Kamash are all back this season.

#### LEADER OF THE PACK

Senior Michael Flach had a stellar return to collegiate swimming after redshirting two seasons ago to focus on the U.S. Olympic Trials. A native of Annandale, Va., Flach recorded a team-high 12 first place finishes during the regular season. He won silver in the 500 freestyle at the SEC Championships with a school-record time of 4:15.32 and finished fourth in both the 200 freestyle and 200 butterfly. On the national scene, he currently has the seventh fastest time in the country in the 500 freestyle (4:15.32) and the 10th fastest time in the 200 butterfly (1:43.42). Flach put together a performance to remember at the Virginia Tech Invitational in November, posting the then-nation's fastest marks in the 500 freestyle (4:18.38) and the 200 butterfly (1:45.51) on his way to earning Counsilman Hunsaker National Swimmer Of The Week and SEC Male Swimmer of the Week honors. He recorded a time of 1:44.70 in the 200 butterfly at the NCAA Championships, missing the finals by 0:00.48.

## MOODY REACHES CENTURY MARK

The Gamecock women's victory over Alabama on Feb. 2, 2013 gave South Carolina head coach McGee Moody his 100th career victory (men and women combined). Moody, who is in his seventh season in Columbia, has compiled 62 wins with the Gamecocks. Prior to South Carolina, he led William & Mary to 38 wins in three seasons. Overall, Moody has a 100-96-1 record.

## THE BIGGER THE STAGE, THE BETTER

Senior Amanda Rutqvist has proven time and time again that her best performances come during the biggest meets of the season. Rutqvist earned All-America honors in both the 100 breaststroke and 200 breaststroke at the 2011 NCAA Championships as a freshman. Earlier that year she became the first Gamecock women's swimmer to win a SEC title by claiming first in the 200 breaststroke with a then-SEC record of 2:08.56. She won silver in the 200 breaststroke at the 2012 SEC Championships and later earned her third career All-America honor at the NCAA Championships with an 11th-place finish in the 200 breaststroke.

# **AWARD-WINNING DEBUT**

Sophomore Marwan El Kamash earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors last season after an impressive collegiate debut against Texas A&M and North Carolina. A native of Alexandria, Egypt, El Kamash helped lead the Gamecocks to a 160-140 victory over Texas A&M on Saturday in a tri meet with the Aggies and North Carolina, turning in four top-five performances. El Kamash won the 500-yard freestyle in 4:31.27. He took runner-up honors in the 1000-yard freestyle with a time of 9:21.21. He swam the leadoff leg of the 400-yard freestyle relay and helped the team to second-place finish in 3:02.05. El Kamash also placed fifth overall in the 100-yard freestyle in 46.45.

## **SENIOR LEADERS**

Senior Amanda Rutqvist and Rachael Schaffer have been leaders of the women's team since arriving in Columbia, and 2012-13 will be no different.

Rutqvist, who is the Gamecocks' top breaststroker, earned her third All-America honor in 2012 by finishing 15th in the 200 breaststroke at the NCAA Championships. She is the school record holder in both the 100 and 200 breaststroke with times of 1:00.20 and 2:07.86, respectively.

Schaffer is one of the Gamecocks top all-around swimmers and narrowly missed earning her first All-America honor in 2012, finishing 17th in the 400 IM at the NCAA Championships.

## THE TRADITION CONTINUES

South Carolina head diving coach Todd Sherritt has produced a long line of SEC Champions and All-Americans during his 21-year tenure in Columbia, and juniors Cole Miller and Patricia Kranz look to keep the tradition alive this season.

Kranz won bronze on the one-meter springboard at the SEC Championships last season. Miller looks to build on one of the best freshman campaigns in the conference. A SEC All-Freshman Team selection in 2012, Miller finished fifth on the three-meter springboard and 10th on the platform.
