### TODAY'S GAME

South Carolina concludes the non-conference portion of its regular season when it travels to face Memphis on Friday at FedExForum. The meeting marks the 25th all-time between the two schools, and just the second regular season meeting since the 1990-91 campaign. South Carolina looks for its first-ever road win in the series against the Tigers on Friday night.

### GAME STORYLINES

- South Carolina is in its 109th season of varsity basketball in 2016-17.
- On the sidelines, Frank Martin is joined by associate head coach Matt Figger, assistant coaches Perry Clark and Bruce Shingler, and director of operations Andy Assaley.
- The Gamecocks are receiving votes in this week's AP poll and are 25th in the USA Today Coaches Poll after a loss to Clemson last week. The Gamecocks have risen to as high as 15th in the AP poll this season, which was the highest rank for Carolina since the Gamecocks were ranked 14th in the final poll of the 1997-98 campaign. The Gamecocks high mark in the Coaches poll this season was at No. 15.
- Carolina rebounded from a two-point loss to Clemson with a 28-point victory over instate foe Lander on Tuesday at Colonial Life Arena. Rookie guard Rakym Felder erupted for a season high 20 points, hitting six baskets, including a 5-of-7 effort from 3-point range. Fellow freshman, Maik Kotsar, notched his first career double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds in the winning effort. The Gamecocks hit 51.5% from the floor, converting on a season high 35-of-68 shot attempts in the game.
- Sophomore guard PJ Dozier snapped a streak of five-straight games scoring 20 or more points when he tallied 15 vs. Lander on Tuesday. His stretch of five straight over 20 marked the longest streak of its kind since mid-season during the 2009-10 campaign when Devan Downey hit 20 or more in nine consecutive games.

South Carolina ranks **third** nationally in field goal percentage defense (games through Dec. 27), allowing opponents to hit just 35.2% from the floor this season. That mark leads the SEC as well.

## A SOUTH CAROLINA WIN WOULD ...

- Be Carolina's second straight in the series, after Memphis won the previous eight games dating back to a 63-48 Tiger win in Memphis on Feb. 11, 1989.
- Be the 198th of Frank Martin's head coaching career.
- Be the Gamecocks' first ever road win in the series.
- Be the Gamecocks' first over a current member of the American Conference since a 77-68 road win at South Florida just two weeks ago on Dec. 17.

- Memphis head coach Tubby Smith, a former assistant coach at South Carolina who was part of the 1989 NCAA Tournament team, will be facing South Carolina for the 31st time in his head coaching career. The majority of those past matchups came while he was the head coach at Kentucky from 1997-2007.

- The Gamecocks currently rank 31st in the NCAA RPI (games through Dec. 27), which is fourth in the SEC behind Florida (fifth), Kentucky (ninth) and Arkansas (23rd).

- South Carolina currently ranks first in the country (NCAA stats games through Dec. 27) in 3-point field goal percentage defense, as opponents are hitting just 26.4 percent (58-220) from beyond the arc this season.

- The Gamecocks are 0-8 all-time in games played in Memphis vs. the Tigers. The last away meeting in the series was a 60-52 Memphis win on Jan. 26, 1991.

- South Carolina suffered a loss to intrastate rival Clemson on Dec. 21 at Colonial Life Arena despite a career high 26 points from sophomore guard PJ Dozier. Dozier recorded at least 20 points in five straight games. Sophomore forward Chris Silva recorded a career high 14 as well, but Clemson connected on 41 percent of its attempts from the floor, and was 5-of-6 from the free throw line in the final minute to close the two-point victory.

- Carolina hit just 35.5 percent from the floor vs. the Tigers, which was the Gamecocks' second-lowest percentage of the season.

- The Gamecocks rebounded from their first loss of the season with an 11-point road win at USF on Dec. 17. Trailing by six at halftime, the duo of senior guard Duane Notice and sophomore guard PJ Dozier recorded 28 of Carolina's 46 second-half points to help the Gamecocks earn the road win. Carolina committed a season low seven turnovers in the contest, forcing 17 by the Bulls, and collecting nine steals and posting 16 points off of turnovers.

- Rookie guard Rakym Felder had one of his top performances of the season at USF, scoring a season high 11 points, hitting three 3s, dishing five assists and playing a season high 26 minutes.

- South Carolina suffered its first loss of the season on Dec. 12 in a 67-64 decision to Seton Hall at Madison Square Garden in the Under Armour Reunion. Carolina held the Pirates to just

34.5% from the floor, but Seton Hall was solid at the free throw line, hitting 26-of-36 attempts on the night, while also holding a 49-35 upperhand on the boards in the win.

- For his play vs. Vermont and FIU, Dozier was named the Dec. 5, SEC Player of the Week.

- The Gamecocks were credited for 18 assists in the win over Vermont, with senior guard Sindarius Thornwell matching his career high with nine.

- The Gamecocks jumped in to the national rankings on Nov. 28 for the first time this season after posting wins over two ranked opponents the previous week in No. 25/24 Michigan and No. 18/16 Syracuse. The Gamecocks checked in at No. 20 in the Associated Press poll and No. 23 in the Coaches Poll.

- South Carolina returns two starters and eight letterwinners from last season's squad that posted a 25-9 overall record, matching the Carolina record for total wins.

- Those returning starters feature the only backcourt in the SEC with two 1,000-point scorers, in senior guards Sindarius Thornwell and Duane Notice. The duo accounted for 24.2 points and 6.1 assists per game last season.

## SCOUTING MEMPHIS



- The Tigers are led by head coach Tubby Smith in his first season. Smith, a former assistant coach at South Carolina who was part of the 1989 NCAA Tournament team, will be facing South Carolina for the 31st time in his head coaching career. The majority of those past matchups came while he was the head coach at Kentucky from 1997-2007.

- The Tigers are 9-4 this season, which includes an 0-1 mark in American games after suffering a loss to visiting SMU on Tuesday evening.
- Sophomore forward Detric Lawson paces the team with 20.7 points and 10.8 rebounds per game. He leads the American in points per outing, while his rebounds per game rank second.
- Lawson's brother, KJ, adds 14.3 points and 8.8 rebounds per game from the guard position.
- Markel Crawford (13.5) and Jeremiah Martin (10.4) also contribute double-figure points per game.
- The Tigers rank sixth nationally in assist to turnover ratio (1.68), 14th in assists per game (18.5) and 18th in blocked shots per game (5.8), behind Detric Lawson's 2.8 blocks per outing (15th nationally).
- The Tigers are 7-2 in homes games this season with losses to Ole Miss and Monmouth.

## DOZIER NUMBERS

South Carolina sophomore guard PJ Dozier has tallied double-digit points in nine games this season, including in seven straight, scoring at least 15 points each game during the stretch. His field goal percentage of 47.3 percent (71-150) is nearly 10 percentage points higher than last season's number of 38.1 percent (91-239) during his rookie campaign. Most notably is his accuracy from beyond the arc. Dozier connected on 10-of-47 attempts last season (21.3%), and has already surpassed his mark of made 3s just 12 games into this season, hitting 21-of-47 attempts at 44.7 percent. He is also making a mark on the defensive end, leading the team and the SEC with 30 steals, 2.5 per game, which ranks 13th nationally.

## MEMPHIS SERIES

Memphis leads the all-time series vs. South Carolina, 18-6, which includes an 8-0 upperhand in games played in Memphis. Friday's meeting marks the first time the Gamecocks have faced the Tigers at the Forum, and will be the first meeting in Memphis between the two squads since the 1990-91 season. ## THE DEFENSE

South Carolina is making headlines this season for its tenacious defense, which has held seven of 11 opponents to below 40% from the floor. The Gamecocks have ranked among the top 25 in the nation in field goal percentage defense at the conclusion of the last two seasons - 13th in 2014-15 when opponents hit 38.7%, and 25th in 2015-16 when opponents hit 39.7% - while Carolina currently ranks third nationally (opponent field goal percent of 35.2%) in the category this season.

## 2016-17 SCHEDULE

South Carolina has an exciting schedule set for the 2016-17 campaign. The slate features 14 games, with 10 home contests, including one exhibition. Highlighting the non-conference portion of the schedule is the Gamecocks' participation in the Brooklyn Hoops Holiday Invitational, as well as a matchup versus Seton Hall in the Under Armour "Reunion" double-header at Madison Square Garden in mid-December. The Gamecocks will face eight teams that advanced to the postseason a year ago, with four of those NCAA Tournament participants, including Syracuse, which advanced to the Final Four.

Frank Martin was named the head men's basketball coach at the University of South Carolina on March 27, 2012, becoming the 32nd head coach in the history of the South Carolina program, which enters its 109th season as a varsity sport in 2016-17. Martin owns a 187-117 (.600) overall record as a head coach, entering his 10th season overall, and a 70-63 (.526) record entering his fifth season at South Carolina.

In Martin's fourth season leading the Garnet and Black (2015-16), Carolina put together one of the top seasons in its history, matching a school record for wins with a 25-9 overall record on the year, while the Gamecocks reached double-digit SEC wins for just the fourth time since joining the league, posting an 11-7 mark in conference contests. The SEC finish was Carolina's highest since the league combined its East and West Divisions prior to the 2012 season. South Carolina began the season 15-0, its best start since the 1933-34 campaign and went on to post a school-record 24 regular-season wins.

The Gamecocks received votes or were ranked for 15 weeks in the USA Today Coaches Poll, rising to as high as 15th, and for a total of 14 weeks in the AP poll, rising to as high as 19th, during the season. Carolina advanced to postseason play for the first time since 2009, making their 12th appearance in the Postseason NIT as one of the top four seeds in the event. The Gamecocks posted a win over High Point in the opening round, before suffering a season-ending loss to visiting Georgia Tech on March 21.

Three Gamecocks were honored with postseason awards by the SEC coaches, with senior forward Michael Carrera earning First Team All-SEC accolades, junior guard Sindarius Thornwell was named to the All-Defensive Team and junior guard Duane Notice was named the league's Sixth Man of the Year. Carrera went on to earn honors from several organizations following the best season of his career. Carrera, Notice and Thornwell each reached the 1,000 career-point plateau during the season as well.

Prior to his appointment in Columbia, Martin spent the previous five seasons as the head coach at Kansas State University, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament four times, including a trip to the "Elite 8," during the 2009-10 campaign when the squad won a school record 29 contests. Martin's Wildcats won at least 21 games in each of his five seasons at the helm, as the program compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) under his direction. During that time, Kansas State posted a 50-32 (.609) record in Big 12 Conference games, finishing fifth or higher in each season, with three season finishes of third or better.

A native of Miami, Fla., Martin earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Florida International in 1993. He and his wife, Anya, have three children, Brandon, Amalia and Christian.

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** - South Carolina (10-2) posted a 90-62 victory versus instate foe Lander (3-7) Tuesday night at Colonial Life Arena. Freshman Rakym Felder led the team with a career-high 20 points after going 5-for-7 from the 3-point line.

The Bearcats scored the game's first hoop, but Carolina went on an 11-0 run to take an 11-2 lead with 15:32 left in the opening half. Freshman Maik Kotsar had six of the team's first 11 points.

The Gamecocks pushed the run to 19-0 after a pair of Notice free throws with 12:56 remaining. A jumper by freshman Sedee Keita improved the run to 29-1, as Carolina led 29-3 with 9:48 to go in the first half. The Gamecocks' defense held Lander to 1-of-15 shooting in the first 10 minutes.

The Bearcats ended their 0-for-14 field goal draught, as Carolina was up 36-7 at the under eight media timeout. Felder hit back-to-back 3s to extend the lead to 50-14 with 1:49 on the clock. The Brooklyn, N.Y. native, then hit another 3 with 44 seconds left, as the Gamecocks led 53-16 at halftime.

Carolina shot 20-for-32 (63 percent) in the opening half, including 7-for-11 from 3. The Gamecocks held Lander to just 17 percent (5-for-30) shooting from the field and had a 25-14 edge in the rebound column. Felder led the way with 15 points, as he was 4-of-4 from behind the arc in the first half. Nine different players scored in half one for Carolina.

After the break, Felder hit his fifth 3-pointer with 12:19 to go in the game, as Carolina jumped out to its biggest lead of the night, 73-33.

Kotsar posted his first career double-double, snagging his 10th rebound and scoring his 10th point on the ensuing possession with 9:16 to go and the Gamecocks in control up 77-43.

South Carolina remained up by 30 the rest of the way, before a late Lander 3 with 18 seconds left in the game to make it 90-62.

PJ Dozier (15), Duane Notice (13) and Kotsar (10) joined Felder in double-figures. Chris Silva tied Kotsar for the team lead with 11 rebounds and Carolina tied a season-high with 18 assists on the night.
