**DALTON, Ga.** – The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 294 (+6) to wrap up the Carpet Capital Collegiate in a tie for 11th place at The Farm Golf Club.

The Gamecocks finished the weekend with a three-round total of 886 (+22). Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith both finished in the top 20 to lead Carolina, tying for 14th and 19th place, respectively.

Harbin posted the low round of the Gamecocks on Sunday, shooting an even-par 72 to take his three-round total to 216 (E). The top-20 finish is the fifth of his career. A native of Augusta, Ga., Harbin recorded five birdies, five bogeys and eight pars on the day.

One of three newcomers on the South Carolina roster this season, NeSmith made a stellar debut as he closed out the weekend with a 3-over 75. The North Augusta, S.C., native tallied two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars to finish with a three-round score of 219 (+3).

Sophomore Sean Kelly produced his best round of the tournament, shooting a 1-over 73 as he finished in a tie for 68th with a score of 230 (+14).

Junior Caulder Moore turned in a 3-over 75 on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 224 (+8), while sophomore Caleb Sturgeon posted a 2-over 74 to tie for 66th with a total of 229 (+13).

Defending national champion Texas shot a final-round 292 (+4) to hold on to win the tournament with a total of 851 (-13). Georgia finished second with a score of 856 (-8), followed by Alabama (865), LSU (871) and Clemson (871).

Texas' Brandon Stone claimed medalist honors after shooting an even-par 72. He concluded the tournament with a total of 204 (-12).

**DAUFUSKIE ISLAND, S.C.** – The South Carolina men's golf team carded a final-round 305 (+17) to finish in third place at the Rees Jones Invitational at Haig Point Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 896 (+32), finishing two strokes behind second-place East Carolina (894). Liberty won the tournament with a total of 870 (+6), which is one stroke off the tournament record.

With winds picking up throughout the day, Tuesday proved to be the toughest round for the field, as the scoring average shot up to 78.14 for the round. The Gamecocks toughed out the conditions and had a strong presence at the top of the leaderboard with five golfers finishing in the top 15.

Senior Dykes Harbin led the way for South Carolina as he recorded a final-round 77 (+5) to finish sixth with a total of 221 (+5). The finish is the best of his career and his second career top-10 showing.

Freshman Matt NeSmith bounced back from his second-round 78 to post a solid round of even-par 72 on Tuesday. A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith earned his first career top-10 finish as he tied for seventh place with a total of 223 (+7).

Senior Dean Hester, who played as an individual, finished in a tie for 13th with a score of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 73 (+1).

Sophomores Will Murphy and Caleb Sturgeon tied for 15th with totals of 227 (+11). Murphy closed out the tournament with a 76 (+4), and Sturgeon carded an 80 (+8).

Sophomore Sean Kelly shot an 82 (+10) on the afternoon to finish 42nd with a score of 235 (+19).

Liberty's Niklas Lindstrom won medalist honors after firing a 2-under 70 in the final round. Lindstrom claimed a six-shot victory with a total of 213 (-3), the second lowest 54-hole score in tournament history.

Charlotte finished placed fourth with a score of 906 (+42), and Winthrop rounded out the top five with a total of 909 (+45). Two-time defending champion Kennesaw State took eighth with a score of 921 (+57).

**DULUTH, Ga.** - South Carolina senior Dykes Harbin continued to play the best golf of his career as he shot a final-round 72 (+1) to win the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic at Berkeley Hills Country Club.

Harbin claimed a two-stroke victory over Chattanooga's Steven Fox, Winthrop's Kamito Hirai and Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes with a three-round total of 210 (-3), which ties a career low. As a team, the Gamecocks posted the sixth best score of the day with a 10-over 294 on their way to finishing in a tie for seventh place with a total of 889 (+37).

A native of Augusta, Ga., Harbin put himself in position to win his first career tournament on Monday by opening with a career-low 66 in the first round. He then held onto the lead with consecutive rounds of 72 (+1). Both Fox and Hirai made a charge at Harbin on Tuesday, as they each shot a 3-under 68. They both made it to 2-under late in their rounds but were unable to pull any closer, as Harbin was 1-under in his final four holes, including a birdie on the par-4 18th to seal the win.

Through three tournaments this season, Harbin has now finished first, sixth and tied for 14th and leads the team with a 71.89 stroke average.

Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon was the next highest finisher for the Gamecocks as he tied for 31st with a total of 225 (+12). Sturgeon carded a final-round 74 (+3), which included two birdies, five bogeys and 11 pars.

Sophomore Will Murphy posted the second lowest score of the day for South Carolina with a 2-over 73. His round consisted of three birdies, five bogeys and 10 pars. Murphy finished the tournament in a tie for 35th with a score of 226 (+13).

Senior Dean Hester tied for 50th with a total of 229 (+16) after shooting a final-round 75 (+4), while freshman Matt NeSmith shot a 78 (+7) to finished tied for 67th with a score of 233 (+20).

Georgia Southern won the team title with rounds of 283-286-290=859 (+7). Host Georgia State finished second with a score of 866 (+14), followed by Mercer (874), Chattanooga (881) and Winthrop (885).

**KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C.** - With its first tournament title in three years on the line, the South Carolina men's golf team left no doubt about which team was going to come out on top as it posted a final-round 284 (E) to cruise to a 20-stroke victory in the Wendy's Kiawah Classic at Turtle Point Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who had four golfers finish in the top 20, wrapped up the tournament with a three-round total of 859 (+7) to capture their first title since winning the Rees Jones Invitational on Oct. 6, 2009. South Carolina was also represented in the medalist trophy presentation, as sophomore Caleb Sturgeon claimed his first career tournament title following his second round of 68 (-3) of the week.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon finished the tournament with a career-low 54-hole total of 210 (-3). His closest competitor happened to be wearing garnet and black as well, with freshman Will Starke finishing two strokes back in second place after carding a career-low 69 (-2).

**HUMBLE, Texas** – The South Carolina men's golf team made one last charge up the leaderboard, posting a final-round 291 (+3) on its way to claiming third place at the Bayou City Collegiate Championships at Redstone Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who moved three spots up the standings with the third lowest round of the day, wrapped up the weekend with a total of 871 (+7). South Carolina has now finished first and third in its last two tournaments, making it the program's best two-tournament stretch since finishing tied for first and first at the Mason Rudolph Championship and the Rees Jones Invitational in back-to-back events in the fall of 2009.

Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon fired a 3-under 69 to lead the Gamecocks' move up the leaderboard. Sturgeon, who won medalist honors at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic to close out the fall, earned his second straight top-10 finish as he moved 19 spots up the standings to tie for eighth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon made it through his round with just one blemish on his scorecard, a bogey on the par-4 18th. He was stellar the rest of the way, making four birdies and 13 pars.

Sophomore Will Murphy came close to carding his third straight round of par or better on the weekend but he fell one stroke short, turning in a 1-over 73 to conclude one of the best tournaments of his collegiate career. Murphy finished the weekend in a tie for eighth along with Sturgeon with a total of 214 (-2), which is his best collegiate finish when competing at a team event. He finished second two weeks ago at the Savannah Quarters Individual, a non-team event. Murphy recorded a birdie, two bogeys and 15 pars on the day.

Senior Dykes Harbin and freshman Matt NeSmith tied for 31st and 39th, respectively. Harbin turned in a 4-over 76 on Sunday to close out the weekend with a total of 221 (+5), while NeSmith shot a 1-over 73 to take his final total to 222 (+6). Rounding out the lineup, freshman Will Starke carded a 77 (+5) on Sunday to finished tied for 71st with a total of 232 (+16).

Third-ranked Texas pulled away to win the tournament with a total of 842 (-22). The Longhorns shot a 5-under 283 in the final round. Tournament host Houston finished second with a score of 863 (-1), followed by the Gamecocks, Louisiana Tech (874), Chattanooga (875) and Baylor (875). Texas' Brandon Stone won medalist honors with a total of 207 (-9) after shooting a 5-under 67 on Sunday.

**DADE CITY, Fla.** - The South Carolina men's golf team erased a three-shot third-round deficit to tie North Carolina State in the final few holes at the USF Invitational, but it wasn't enough as a late birdie pushed the Wolfpack past the Gamecocks to claim the title at Lake Jovita Golf and Country Club.

South Carolina was tied with North Carolina State at 3-under par with just one player each left on the golf course. Gamecock senior Dykes Harbin, who was 2-under on the back nine through six holes, recorded par on his final three holes to finish the day with a solid 1-under 71. The Wolfpack's Albin Choi made par on the 16th and 18th holes, but it was his birdie at the par-4 17th that lifted North Carolina State to victory.

The Gamecocks closed out the tournament in second place with a three-round total of 861 (-3), while the Wolfpack finished with a total of 860 (-4). South Carolina has now finished first, third and second in its last three tournaments.

Four Gamecocks wrapped up the week in the top 20 led by Harbin, who finished tied for second with a total of 211 (-5). The finish is Harbin's fifth in the top 20 this season and second in the top five. NeSmith earned his third top-10 finish of the season with a final-round 71 (-1). NeSmith closed out the week with a career-best total of 216 (E). On the afternoon, the North Augusta, S.C., native recorded six birdies, five bogeys and seven pars.

Sophomore Caleb Sturgeon posted a 1-over 73 on Tuesday to finish the event in a tie for 14th with a total of 217. Sturgeon, who now has four top-20 finishes on the season, carded four birdies, five bogeys and nine pars on the afternoon.

Continuing his success to begin the spring, sophomore Will Murphy earned his second straight top-20 finish in a team event by tying for 19th with a total of 219 (+3) after shooting a final-round 76 (+4). Rounding out the lineup for the Gamecocks, junior Caulder Moore shot a 79 (+7) to finish the week in a tie for 41st with a total of 226 (+10).

Choi also won medalist honors with a total of 208 (-8). Sixteenth-ranked Florida State finished third with a score of 863 (-1), with South Florida (873) and Virginia (881) rounding out the top five.

**AIKEN, S.C.** – The South Carolina men's golf team was in contention throughout the final round at the Palmetto Intercollegiate but it came up just short down the stretch to finish runner-up for the second straight week with a total of 863 (+23).

The Gamecocks, who posted a 293 (+13) on Tuesday, finished seven strokes back of tournament champion Augusta State. The Jaguars turned in a final-round 282 (+2) to come back from four strokes down and win the title with a total of 856 (+16). South Carolina has now finished first, third, second and second in its last four tournaments. It marks the first time the Gamecocks have recorded four straight top-three finishes since finishing third or better in six straight events during the spring schedule of 1999.

**AUGUSTA, Ga. –** The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 289 (+1) to capture fifth place at the Insperty Augusta State Invitational at Forest Hills Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who now have six top-five finishes this season, wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 872 (+8) as they finished nine shots back of tournament champion Texas (863). **ST. SIMONS ISLAND, Ga. –** The South Carolina men's golf team made a stellar run at the program's first SEC title but it came up just short, finishing runner-up by two strokes to second-ranked Alabama at the 2013 SEC Championship with a total of 850 (+10) at Sea Island Golf Club.

The Gamecocks, who shot a final-round 295 (+15), entered the day with a three-shot lead over the Crimson Tide, but Alabama posted a 290 (+10) to win the title with a 54-hole total of 848 (+8).

With just one group left on the course, the teams entered the final three holes tied at 8-over par. Carolina sophomore Caleb Sturgeon triple bogeyed the 16th but bounced back to make par on the 17th and a birdie on No. 18 to give the Gamecocks a chance. However, Alabama's Corey Whitsett finished with a birdie, a par and a bogey to secure the title for the Crimson Tide.

Sturgeon played one of the best tournaments of his career as he carded a final-round 73 (+3) to finish runner-up in the individual standings with a total of 205 (-5), which was three strokes back of Arkansas' Sebastian Cappelen (202). His total is the second lowest 54-hole SEC Championship score in school history, ranking behind only George Bryan IV's total of 204 at the 2010 event.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon recorded two birdies and three bogeys on the front nine to make the turn at 1-over. He got his round back to even par with a birdie on the par-3 12th but gave the stroke back on the next hole with a bogey on No. 13. After two consecutive pars, he triple bogeyed the par-4 16th before recording par on the 17th and birdie on No. 18 to conclude the afternoon at 3-over.

**COLUMBUS, Ohio** – The 20th-ranked South Carolina men's golf team punched its ticket to the NCAA Championship as it tied for second place at the NCAA Columbus Regional at the Ohio State University Golf Club.

The Gamecocks posted a final-round 288 (+4) to wrap up the week in a tie with Auburn with a total of 872 (+20), earning their first championship trip since 2009 and the program's 17th all-time. Carolina fell two strokes shy of regional champion New Mexico. The top-seeded Lobos finished first with a total of 870 (+18). This year's NCAA Championship will be held May 28 through June 2 at the Capital City Club in Atlanta, Ga.

NeSmith, the SEC Freshman of the Year, made a charge up the leaderboard to lead the way on Saturday. The North Augusta, S.C., native fired a 3-under 68 to climb 14 spots to finish in a tie for second with a total of 214 (+1). NeSmith now has seven top-10 finishes on the season, which moves him into a tie with Erik Johansen, Kyle Thompson and David Seawell for the second most in a single season in school history. He trails only Fred Wadsworth, who recorded nine top-10 finishes in the 1983-84 season. New Mexico's James Erkenbeck won medalist honors with a total of 210 (-3).

Freshman Will Starke also played a key role in getting the Gamecocks to Atlanta as he finished in a tie for ninth with a total of 217 (+4). He posted a final-round 76 (+5) that included one birdie, four bogeys and a double bogey.

Harbin and sophomore Caleb Sturgeon saved their best round of the week for last as they both carded a 1-over 72 on Saturday. Harbin finished the tournament in a tie for 43rd with a total of 225 (+12), while Sturgeon tied for 25th with a total of 222 (+9).

Sophomore Sean Kelly turned in a final-round 77 (+6) to conclude the event in a tie for 48th with a total of 226 (+13). Kelly recorded one birdie, five bogeys and a double bogey on the afternoon.

# 2007 NCAA East Regional Champions

## South Carolina finishes 44-under-par to set course record en route to program's first regional title

**GREENVILLE, N.C.** – Behind a record-breaking performance, the South Carolina men's golf team claimed a two-stroke victory over UCLA to win the 2007 NCAA West Regional at Karsten Golf Course (Par 72, 7,057 yards) in Tempe, Ariz. The Gamecocks recorded a three-round score of 820 to finish 44 strokes under par and set a course record.

"The guys were focused all week and nothing fazed them," South Carolina associate head coach Bill McDonald said. "I kept talking about winning the tournament, not so much advancing (to the NCAA finals). I wanted them to taste victory. I felt like we were good enough to win earlier in the season. We had some opportunities and didn't get it done. I am proud of the effort they gave."

South Carolina entered the final round one stroke behind regional leader and No. 4 UCLA. The Gamecocks shot 10-under par (278) as a team Saturday to beat the Bruins, who were seven under (281). No. 10 Southern California and No. 18 Arizona State, the regional host, shared third place with a final score of 824 (-40). Fellow Southeastern Conference team Vanderbilt caught fire on Saturday, finishing the third round at 21 under to surge into fifth place.

It was the first regional title for the Gamecocks, who reached the top 10 in three of the previous four NCAA Regionals. In 1999, South Carolina fell just shy of the East Regional title, finishing second in Barrington, R.I., despite Kyle Thompson's individual victory at the event.

The Gamecocks, who entered the tournament as the No. 11 seed, held a slight lead on UCLA for most of the final day, and freshman George Bryan IV's strong finish secured the win. The last player on the course for South Carolina, Bryan eagled No. 17 and sank a 40-foot putt for birdie on No. 18. The Chapin, S.C., product tied for 10th individually with a three-day total of 68-67-69=204 (-12). His tournament total of 204 tied him for fourth place in school history for a three-round individual score and was the best individual performance ever by a Gamecock in regional play. Bryan's 10th-place finish was the best by a Carolina golfer since Thompson won the 2001 NCAA West Regional in Corvallis, Ore.

Sophomore Florian Fritsch and junior Mark Anderson tied for 16th on the individual leader board after posting three-day totals of 206 (-10), which tied for the eighth-best three-round effort in school history. Anderson closed with a 70 (-2) on the final 18 holes, while Fritsch carded a 71 (-1) Saturday.

Sophomore Mark Silvers III fired a final round 69, and junior Warren Thomas posted a 70 on the final 18 holes. Silvers and Thomas both tied for 43rd with a three-day total score of 211 (-5).

"I noticed early on that both teams (South Carolina and UCLA) seemed tight," McDonald said. "It really helped us that Mark Silvers got off to such a good start. He made a couple of birdies early and made the turn at 32 (four under par). I think when our guys started to see the board and that we had a lead, that really helped. We got a burst of energy on the back nine knowing we had a chance to win."

Carolina opened with a round of 273 on Thursday before

shooting 269 on Friday. Those scores are among the five lowest rounds in school history. The team victory was the first for South Carolina since capturing the title at the 2005 Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate (Oct. 15-16). In 2007, the Gamecocks' previous best performance was fourth place on three occasions.

"I told the team in a meeting a little while ago that this will mean more to them as the years go by," McDonald said of winning the title. "It will really mean a lot. To me, it gives our program validity. Instead of just talking about what we want to do, we went out and did it. It will really help from a recruiting and coaching standpoint. The more they win, the more they will believe and expect to play this way. That will develop tradition and have a long-lasting effect."

## Mark Anderson

**2005 - Third Team • 2008 - Honorable Mention**

Mark Anderson put All-American bookends on his career, earning GCAA PING All-America honorable mention status as a senior after picking up third-team honors from the organization as a freshman. In his final season in the Garnet and Black, Anderson turned in seven top-20 finishes, reaching the status in six of the seven tournaments in the spring, to grab a spot on the All-SEC first team for the second time in his career. As a freshman, he also earned first-team all-conference honors and was named the league's Freshman of the Year.

## George Bryan IV

**2007, 2009 - Honorable Mention • 2010 - Third Team**

George Bryan IV joins David Seawell (1994-96) and Kyle Thompson (1999-2001) as the only three-time All-Americans in South Carolina annals. He earned a selection to the PING All-America Third Team in 2010 after being named an Honorable Mention selection in 2007 and 2009. Bryan wrapped up his career this season as one of the most prolific golfers in South Carolina history. His career scoring average of 72.37 stands atop the record books, as does his average of 71.35 for the 2009-10 season. Ranked 39th in the nation in the final Golfweek/Sagarin release, he tied for medalist honors twice during his senior season - including the SEC Championship - falling in playoffs on both occasions. The native of Chapin, S.C., earned four top-five finishes and eight top-20 showings in 11 events this season. For his career, he posted 17 career top-10 finishes in 46 tournaments, ranking fourth in school history.



## Michael Christie

**1992 - Honorable Mention**

Michael Christie was an all-SEC selection and an honorable mention All-American in 1992. He had seven top-10 finishes in tournament play, including a third-place finish at the 1991 Metro Conference Championship. After a successful collegiate career, Christie completed his degree in retailing and participated in the PGA qualifying school.

## Eric Ecker

**1998, 1999 - Honorable Mention**

Eric Ecker was named honorable mention All-America in both his sophomore and junior seasons. As a sophomore he captured the 1998 SEC Championship with a two-day score of eight-under. He participated in every South Carolina tournament in his four years at the school and ranked as one of USC's all-time bests in terms of low tournament score and single-round low.







## Webb Heintzelman

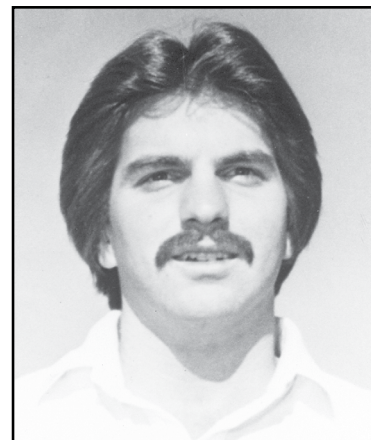
**1984 - Honorable Mention**

A 1984 graduate of South Carolina, Webb Heintzelman earned All-American honors his senior year. While playing for the Gamecocks, Heintzelman claimed the 1984 Tar Heel Invitational crown and established a new course record with a round of 65.

## Mike Holland

**1978 - Honorable Mention**

A 1978 graduate, Mike Holland earned All-America honors his final season. Holland won the S.C. Amateur in 1976, finished ninth in the NCAAs in 1978 and played five years on the PGA Tour. Holland teamed with Vance Heafner to win the Walt Disney Team Championship in 1981, and, in 1982, finished second in the St. Jude Memphis Classic.



## Jeff Hull

**1989 - Honorable Mention**

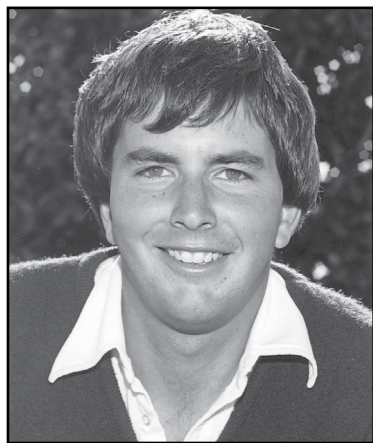
Jeff Hull earned All-America honors in 1989 as a senior. Hull finished 13th in the 1989 NCAAs. He was also named an All-American Scholar and played in the United States Amateur Championship.

## Eirik Johansen

**2003, 2006 - Honorable Mention**

Eirik Johansen earned honorable mention All-America honors as a freshman and again as a senior. Johansen shined during his first season as a Gamecock, leading the team with a 72.53 stroke average. He went on to become a three-time first-team All-SEC selection after playing in every tournament South Carolina entered during his career. Johansen concluded his career with 20 top-10 finishes.





## Steve Liebler

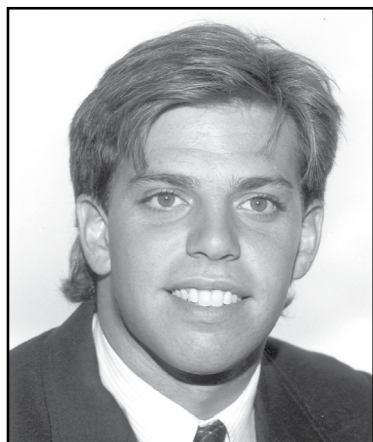
**1980, 1981 - Honorable Mention**

A 1981 graduate, Steve Liebler was a two-time All-American in 1980 and 1981. Liebler claimed four top-10 finishes during his career. He captured the Eastern Amateur in 1981 and won the 1979 Guilford College Intercollegiate Tournament. After five years on the professional golf tour, he returned to his alma mater as head coach. The Virginia native coached USC to six NCAA Championship tournaments in his tenure.

## Matt NeSmith

**2013 - Honorable Mention**

Matt NeSmith earned PING Honorable Mention All-America honors in 2013. A native of North Augusta, S.C., NeSmith turned in one of the most decorated freshman seasons in school history. On top of the All-American honor, he was also named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Year and earned a spot on the PING All-Southeast Region Team. He led South Carolina to a runner-up finish at the SEC Championship and a tie for second showing at the NCAA Columbus Regional, which secured the program's first NCAA Championship berth since 2009. He recorded seven top-10 finishes this season, tying for the second most all-time in a single season at South Carolina. He also led the Gamecocks in scoring with a stroke average of 72.64, which is the second lowest average for a freshman in school history. NeSmith was South Carolina's top finisher at the NCAA Championship as he tied for 38th after firing a final-round 66 (-4), matching the lowest NCAA Championship score in school history.



## Carl Paulson

**1993 - Honorable Mention**

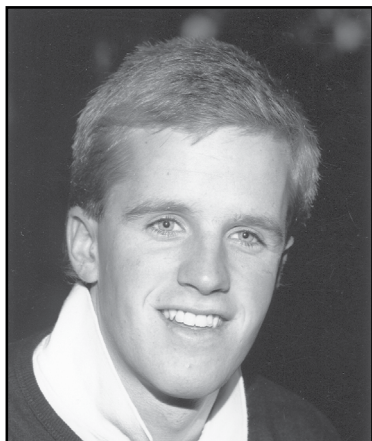
Carl Paulson earned All-America honors in 1993. As a Gamecock, Paulson compiled four individual medalist honors, more than anyone ever to wear the garnet and black. He was the Metro Conference Champion in 1991 and was named SEC Player of the Year in 1993. Paulson won the 1995 PGA Tour Qualifying School. Paulson is currently playing professionally.

## Allen Powers

**1968 - Honorable Mention**

In 1968, Allen Powers was named to the All-America team and finished in the NCAA top five. A 1968 graduate of USC, Powers won the Carolinas' Four-Ball Tournament four times and captured the S.C. Amateur in 1982. Powers' other collegiate victories included the 1967 South Carolina Intercollegiate and the 1968 Palmetto Intercollegiate.





## Brett Quigley

**1991 - Honorable Mention**

A 1991 graduate, Quigley earned honorable mention All-America honors in his senior season. Quigley also garnered Academic All-America laurels and made first team All-Metro Conference that season. He was second in the 1989 Metro Conference Tournament and posted a 72.9 stroke average his senior year. The Barrington, R.I., native is currently having a successful professional career, including a top-20 finish on the PGA's money list in 2006.

## David Seawell

**1994 - Second Team • 1995, 1996 - Honorable Mention**

David Seawell was named second-team All-America as a sophomore. He won the Carpet Capital Collegiate in 1994 and led the nation in stroke average at one time. Seawell tied for fourth in the NCAA East Regional and qualified as an individual for the NCAA Finals. He qualified for the NCAA Championships in Columbus, Ohio, as a junior, en route to honorable mention All-America honors.



## Mark Silvers III

**2009 - Honorable Mention**

Mark Silvers III earned Honorable Mention All-America status his senior season at South Carolina with a team-best 72.74 stroke average and an 18th-place finish at the NCAA Championship. He recorded four top-10 and eight top-20 showings, the most impressive of which was a tie for 10th at the NCAA Southeast Regional. He fired a final-round 64 to vault the Gamecocks up the leaderboard and into the NCAA Championship. Silvers was also named the 2009 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

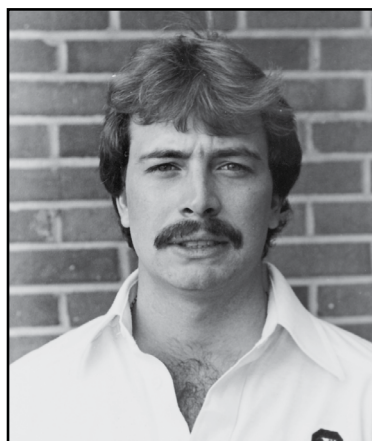
## Kyle Thompson

**1999 - Second Team • 2000, 2001 - Honorable Mention**

Kyle Thompson was named an All-American three times (1999, 2000, 2001). In 1999, he captured individual championships in both the Seminole Classic and the NCAA East Regional, where he set a school record of 63 in the final round. After winning the 2001 NCAA West Regional, Thompson broke Carl Paulson's school record for most individual titles with five. He is the only golfer in the history of the NCAA to win two different regionals. Thompson earned his PGA Tour card for 2008.







## David Tolley

### *1984 - Honorable Mention*

David Tolley earned All-America honors in 1984 and graduated from South Carolina the same year. Tolley gained national recognition while at South Carolina by playing in the 1983 Masters Tournament. Tolley shot a 77-74 at The Masters, missing the cut by only four shots. He was runner-up in the 1982 U.S. Amateur before losing to Jay Sigel.

## Fred Wadsworth

### *1984 - Second Team*

Fred Wadsworth was named to the 1984 All-America squad. As a senior, Wadsworth placed ninth at the NCAA Championships. He collected victories at the Imperial Lakes Invitational and the South Carolina Invitational. In 1986, Wadsworth joined the PGA Tour and captured the Southern Open Championship. He was the last Monday qualifier to win on the PGA Tour for 24 years until Arjun Atwal captured the 2010 Wyndham Championship.



## Rick Williams

### *1990 - Honorable Mention*

Rick Williams was named to the 1988 All-America and All-Metro squads. Williams earned All-Metro honors again in 1990 by capturing the conference individual title. He finished his collegiate career with a 44th-place showing at the 1990 NCAA East Regional.

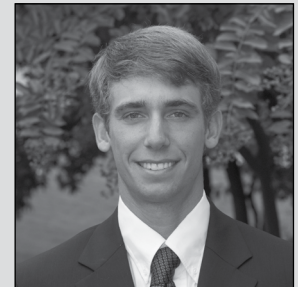
