HAVE YOU HERD?

This will be the third time men's soccer has hosted a ranked team at Hoops Family Field, which opened in 2013. Last season, the Herd held No. 7 Charlotte to a scoreless draw. The first match against a ranked team was a 3-1 overtime loss to No. 25 New Mexico in 2013. Marshall last beat a ranked team in 2014, topping No. 15 New Mexico 2-1 on the road.

TAIBI TOPS HERD SCORERS

Freshman defender/midfielder Chris Taibi (Wantagh, N.Y.), scored his team-leading third goal Saturday at No. 24 FIU. The goal was Taibi's first of the season from open play, with the previous two coming from free kicks.

KLUEH NOTCHES FIRST ASSIST

Senior defender Austin Klueh (Loveland, Ohio) earned his first Herd assist Saturday on Taibi's goal. Klueh scored his first Herd goal last season in a 4-0 win against Asbury.

SCOUTING THE GAMECOCKS

The Gamecocks ranked No. 19 in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) polls after earning wins at home last week against No. 8 Elon and No. 7 New Mexico. South Carolina also ranked No. 9 in the NCAA's first RPI report, released on Monday. South Carolina has three players with three or more goals. Danny Deakin leads the squad with six, while Jeffrey Torda and Kevin Walker each have three. Koty Millard and Ryan Arambula are the team's leaders in assists, with three each.

THE GRAY AREA

"Coach Berson has a really young team, too. They were leaking a lot of goals early, but they've got that fixed right now. Coach Berson is a very good coach. He will have them ready to play, but we've done well against South Carolina if you look at our record in years past, so we're looking forward to the challenge."

VETERANS MEMORIAL CUP CO-CHAMPS

The Herd hosted No. 24 Bowling Green, Robert Morris and Evansville for the Veterans Memorial Cup last Friday and Sunday. Marshall won its home opener 3-1

against Robert Morris on Friday. On Sunday, the Herd snapped its four-game winning streak with a 1-0 loss to Evansville.

Each team won and lost one game, which meant goal differential decided the champions. Marshall and Bowling Green both had a goal differential of +1, which made the two sides co-champions.

STRONG IN C-USA OPENERS

Marshall is 4-1 in its last five Conference USA opening matches, with the lone loss coming to No. 25 New Mexico in 2013.

BEST FOUR GAME START SINCE 2010

With its 1-0 win last Friday against Duquesne and 2-1 OT win against Liberty Tuesday, the Herd improved to 3-1-0, with three straight wins.

Marshall's 3-1-0 start is the best start the team has had since 2010, when the Herd had an equal mark.

NEWCOMERS MAKE THE DIFFERENCE

Two newcomers have scored both of Marshall's goals in 2015. Freshman Chris Taibi (Wantagh, N.Y.) and junior transfer Rimario Gordon (Kingston, Jamaica), scored the winners against Detroit and Duquesne and Liberty, respectively.

EDGINTON NAMED A SENIOR CLASS CANDIDATE

Senior defender/midfielder Nick Edginton (Wellington, New Zealand), is one of 30 NCAA Division I men's soccer players that has been named a candidate for the Senior CLASS award.

To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

TAIBI MAKES BIG DEBUT

Freshman defender Chris Taibi (Wantagh, N.Y.) scored the Herd's first goal of the season – the winner in overtime against Detroit in the 96th minute – which came in only his second appearance and first start.

The goal came from a free kick delivery by senior Jack Hopkins (Birmingham, Ala.), which Taibi headed in from five yards out.

REINING STANDS TALL IN FIRST WIN

Sophomore goalkeeper Dominik Reining (Frankfurt, Germany) made a big impact on Sunday's win at Detroit. Reining made eight saves, including six in the second half en route to a shutout.

During the first 12 minutes of the second half, Reining was forced into making four saves. He also stayed strong in the late stages of the game, making two crucial saves on Detroit's Tommy Bowman in the 87th and 88th minutes.

AN IMPRESSIVE PRESEASON

The Herd hosted three exhibition games at home in a one week span to prepare for the regular season. Marshall won all three contests, conceding no goals.

The Herd defeated High Point (the lone Division I team on the preseason schedule) 1-0 on Aug. 17. Daniel Jodah scored the Herd's goal. Against Salem International on Aug. 20, the Herd won 2-0 with goals from seniors Nick Edginton and Ryan Forde. In the final tune-up, the Herd beat Division II runner-up University of Charleston 4-0, behind two goals from Rimario Gordon and one each from Jodah and senior Jack Hopkins.

RETURNING FIREPOWER

Marshall returns its top goal scorer (junior Daniel Jodah, five) and two top assists leaders (Jack Hopkins and Christian Kershaw each had four).

The team returns players that scored 19 out of Marshall's 20 total goals and set up 16 out of 18 assists.

JODAH EARNS PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Junior MF/F Daniel Jodah was named to the preseason All-Conference USA team.

Jodah, a junior, led the 2014 Thundering Herd with five goals and 10 points.

A versatile player who can line up as a striker or attacking midfielder, Jodah has shown plenty of attacking flair since arriving at Marshall. During his freshman season in 2013, Jodah led the Herd in assists, with four.

SIZEABLE INCOMING CLASS

The Herd welcomes 11 new players to its squad. That group includes eight freshmen and three junior transfers.

GRAY CLIMBING WINS LIST

Herd coach Bob Gray enters his 21st season with Marshall and his 39th overall. Gray's 431 career wins rank third among active coaches and places him at 10th on the NCAA all-time wins list.

PRESEASON C-USA RANKINGS

Conference USA coaches have selected Marshall to finish eighth in the C-USA preseason poll.

RETURN TO C-USA TOURNAMENT

Last season, Marshall advanced to the Conference USA Tournament for the first time since 2011.

The Herd lost 1-0 to UAB in the quarterfinals.

SEDOR IS HERD'S FIRST PLAYER FROM "THE LAST FRONTIER"

Freshman forward Jack Sedor has the distinction of being the first player in the men's soccer program from the state of Alaska.

Sedor, who is from Anchorage, won the Gatorade State Player of the Year Award in both his junior and senior seasons.

About Veterans Memorial Soccer Complex

The main entrance plaza, at the corner of Fifth and 26th, is done in sections like that of a soccer ball. A sign similar to the one at the corner of Fifth and 20th - next to the Marshall Recreation Center graces the plaza along with plantings.

The site was the home of the Veterans Memorial Field House for more than six decades. The Herd’s aged former basketball home had fallen into disrepair - but the memorial panel to veterans that graced the side of the old arena was preserved and hangs at the main entrance of the soccer stadium off Fifth Avenue.

The main entrance to the 1,006-seat stadium includes a brick plaza.

The facility features a glass-door entrance from the field into the equipment room. Also, the men’s and women’s teams have their own locker rooms, training rooms and lounges. There also are visiting team and officials’ locker rooms.

The Herd head coaches and assistant coaches also have their own office space and conference room.

Atop the stadium sits a large pressbox area that will accommodate TV, radio and print outlets.

Throughout the soccer building, walls are highlighted by sections of Kelly green, and rows of textured block bring definition to the walls.

The project, in excess of \$8 million, is one of the products of the ongoing Vision Campaign for Marshall University Athletics.
