## Gamecocks Close Out Regular Season At PING ASU Invitational

South Carolina will play in its eighth and final tournament of the regular season this weekend at the PING ASU Invitational. The 54-hole event runs Friday through Sunday at the par-72, 6,223-yard ASU Karsten Golf Course in Tempe, Ariz.

#### The Lineup

The Gamecocks will compete with their fourth different lineup of the spring as they look to nail down a lineup for the SEC Championship. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel will occupy the No. 1 spot and will be joined by junior Suzie Lee, sophomore Justine Dreher, freshman Mary Fran Hillow and senior Meredith Swanson. Junior Samantha Swinehart will also play this weekend as an individual.

#### What They've Done So Far

- Freshman Sarah Schmelzel: Making her eighth appearance this season... Leads the team with a stroke average of 74.74, which ranks fifth among freshmen in the SEC...On pace to break South Carolina's school record for scoring average by a freshman...Has turned in a team-high seven rounds of par or better... Finished in the top 20 twice, including a third-place showing at the Bryan National Collegiate that earned her SEC Freshman of the Week honors.
- Junior Suzie Lee: Has a stroke average of 75.78, which ranks third on the team...Playing in her eighth tournament this season...Had a season-best tie for 17th showing at the Darius Rucker Intercollegiate.
- Sophomore Justine Dreher: Making her eighth tournament lineup this season...Second on the team with a stroke average of 75.58... Leads team with two top-20 finishes, a tie for 15th showing at the Landfall Tradition and a tie for 12th finish at the UCF Challenge.
- Freshman Mary Fran Hillow: Making her fourth straight tournament appearance for the Gamecocks...Has put together a scoring average of 76.67...Finished tied for 18th as an individual at the UCF Challenge, her first collegiate tournament.
- Senior Meredith Swanson: Making her sixth tournament appearance this season...Has a stroke average of 79.08...Produced a season-best tie for 43rd showing at the Landfall Tradition.
- Junior Samantha Swinehart: Playing in her eighth tournament of the season and third as an individual...Has a stroke average of 76.47, which ranks fourth on the team...Turned in four rounds of par or better...Tied for 12th at the Tar Heel Invitational.

#### **History At The PING ASU Invitational**

South Carolina is making its first-ever appearance at the event.

#### **Breaking Down the Field**

This week's field will have a western flavor, as No. 2 Duke, No. 3 Alabama and the 44th-ranked Gamecocks will be the only teams from the East at the tournament. The 17-team field features 15 teams ranked in the Golfstat Top 50, including 11 in the top 25. Top-ranked Southern California highlights the field and will be joined by No. 7 Arizona, No. 14 Arizona State (host), No. 40 California, Colorado, No. 36 Oregon, No. 15 Stanford, No. 21 Texas, No. 25 Texas A&M, TCU, No. 16 UC Davis, No. 11 UCLA, No. 37 UNLV and No. 9 Washington. The Gamecocks have competed against 10 teams in the field at least once this season and have a 3-14 head-to-head record against those

#### **Schmelzel Receives SEC Honor**

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel was named SEC Freshman Golfer of the Week after recording her first career top-five finish with a third-place showing at the Bryan National Collegiate in Greensboro, N.C. She posted rounds of 71-73-71 for a total of 215 (-1), which matches the second-lowest 54-hole total for a freshman in school history. Schmelzel lowered her season average to a team-best 74.74, which ranks 24th overall and fifth among freshmen in the SEC. She is on pace to break Katie Burnett's school record for scoring average by a freshman of 75.27, which was set in 2009.

#### **Bryan National Collegiate Recap**

South Carolina freshman Sarah Schmelzel fired her second 71 (-1) of the weekend on her way to claiming third place at the Bryan National Collegiate at the Bryan Park Golf and Enrichment Center. As a team, the Gamecocks posted a final-round 296 (+8) to finish in eighth place with a total of 893 (+29).

Schmelzel wrapped up the weekend with a 54-hole total of 215 (-1), which matches the second-lowest 54-hole total for a freshman in school history. Junior Suzie Lee was the next highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as she finished in a tie for 40th with a total of 225 (+9). Sophomore Justine Dreher posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday to conclude the tournament in a tie for 44th with a total of 226 (+10).

Freshman Chelsey Couch turned in the second lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks as she shot a 74 (+2). Couch finished the weekend in a tie for 56th with a total of 229 (+13). Freshman Mary Fran Hillow shot a 77 (+5) to finish the tournament in a tie for 75th with a total of 237 (+21). Junior Samantha Swinehart, who played as an individual, carded an 81 (+9) to finish in a tie for 50th with a total of 228 (+12).

#### **Darius Rucker Intercollegiate Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team posted its lowest round of the weekend, shooting a 302 (+18) on Sunday to finish in 11th place at the second annual Darius Rucker Intercollegiate at Long Cove Club. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 921 (+69), improving their score each day.

Junior Suzie Lee led South Carolina with a tie for 17th finish, the fourth top-20 showing of her career. Lee carded a solid round of 2-over 73 to close out the week with a total of 223 (+10). Sophomore Justine Dreher climbed 11 spots up the leaderboard to finish tied for 39th after carding a 74 (+3) on Sunday. Dreher closed out the week with a 54-hole total of 229 (+16).

Freshman Mary Fran Hillow posted a 76 (+5) to finish the weekend in a tie for 54th with a total of 234 (+21). Freshman Sarah Schmelzel tied for 64th with a total of 238 (+25) after turning in a final-round 79 (+8). Freshman Chelsey Couch, who played the weekend as an individual, shot an 84 (+13) and tied for 67th with a total of 239 (+26). Senior Meredith Swanson carded an 84 (+13) and finished 74th with a total of 245 (+32). Junior Samantha Swinehart, who also played as an individual, wrapped up the event in 78th with a total of 251 (+38) after shooting an 83 (+12).

#### **UCF Challenge Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team posted a final-round 293 (+5) to finish in seventh place in the UCF Challenge at RedTail Golf Club. The Gamecocks wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 883 (+19), which was one stroke shy of cracking the top 10 in school history.

South Carolina had two golfers finish in the top 20, as sophomore Justine Dreher matched her career best with a tie for 12th finish and freshman Mary Fran Hillow tied for 18th in her first collegiate appearance. Dreher carded a 2-over 74 in the final round to close out the event with a career-best total of 218 (+2). Hillow, who played as an individual and did not count toward the team score, continued her steady play with a 1-over 73. A native of Orlando, Fla., Hillow turned in a 54-hole total of 219 (+3).

Junior Samantha Swinehart narrowly missed a top 20 finish as she shot a 74 (+2) to tie for 21st with a total of 221 (+5). On the afternoon, Swinehart tallied two birdies, two bogeys, a double bogey and 13 pars. Junior Suzie Lee had the best round of the day for the Gamecocks as she turned in an even-par 72, recording three birdies, a bogey, a double bogey and 13 pars. Lee finished the tournament tied for 36th with a total of 224 (+8). Freshman Chelsey Couch also tied for 36th after shooting a final-round 73 (+1) that included three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars. Rounding out the lineup for South Carolina, freshman Sarah Schmelzel shot a 77 (+5) to finish tied for 54th with a score of 228 (+12).

#### **Landfall Tradition Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team finished 13th at the Landfall Tradition, as the second and third rounds were canceled due to heavy overnight rain from Hurricane Sandy.

The Gamecocks played through extremely tough conditions in the second round at the Country Club of Landfall and made it through eight to 11 holes before play was suspended because of the weather. South Carolina had moved up to 10th place, but with the cancelation of the final two rounds, it finished 13th with its first-round score of 304 (+16).

Sophomore Justine Dreher finished tied for 15th with her first-round score of 73 (+3). It is the fourth top-20 finish of her career.

Senior Meredith Swanson, who played as an individual, juniors Samantha Swinehart and Suzie Lee and freshman Sarah Schmelzel all finished tied for 43rd with scores of 77 (+5). Freshman Chelsey Couch tied for 65th with a score of 79 (+7).

#### **Tar Heel Invitational Recap**

The Gamecocks posted a final-round 311 (+23) to wrap up the Tar Heel Invitational in a tie for 12th place at the UNC Finley Golf Course. South Carolina finished the tournament with a three-round total of 910 (+46).

Junior Samantha Swinehart led South Carolina with her second round of even-par 72 of the weekend. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart recorded her first top-20 finish of the season and fifth of her career as she tied for 12th with a three-day total of 220 (+4). Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded a 6-over 78 on Sunday as she just missed out on her second consecutive top-20 finish. She closed out the tournament in a tie for 25th with a total of 223 (+7). Freshman Chelsey Couch, who played the weekend as an individual, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she tied for 47th with a total of 229 (+13) after shooting her second straight round of 75 (+3). Junior Suzie Lee tied for 67th with a total of 234 (+18) after carding a final-round 81 (+9).

#### **NCAA Fall Preview Recap**

South Carolina wrapped up play at the NCAA Fall Preview, posting a final-round 309 (+47) at the University of Georgia Golf Course. Competing against one of the most elite fields in collegiate golf this season with 15 teams in the Golfstat Top 50, the Gamecocks finished 18th with a three-day total of 911 (+47).

Freshman Sarah Schmelzel carded the low round for South Carolina for the third straight day with a 2-over 74. A native of Phoenix, Ariz., Schmelzel recorded her first career top-20 finish as she tied for 20th with a total of 220 (+4).

Sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a final-round 76 (+4) to finish the tournament in a tie for 45th with a score of 227 (+11). Junior Samantha Swinehart was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as she shot a 78 (+6) to tie for 61st with a total of 230 (+14). Senior Meredith Swanson placed 79th with a score of 236 (+20) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Sunday.

#### **Cougar Classic Recap**

The South Carolina women's golf team put together its best round of the Cougar Classic, posting a final-round 294 (+6) at Yeamans Hall Club. The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 899 (+35) as they moved six spots up the leaderboard to finish in 16th place. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel helped lead the way with her second straight 72. Junior Samantha Swinehart also carded a 72, and sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a 1-over 73.

Schmelzel proved to be the Gamecocks' most steady player at the event, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3). She climbed 12 spots up the leaderboard to finish in a tie for 30th. Swinehart bounced back from consecutive rounds of 77 with a 72 on the final day. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart tied for 65th with a total of 226 (+10). Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round.

#### Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

#### **Busy Summer**

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
