Gamecocks Travel To NCAA Fall Preview

The South Carolina women's golf team will face one of its toughest tests of the season this weekend when it opens play on Friday at the NCAA Fall Preview in Athens, Ga. The 54-hole event runs through Sunday at the par-72, 6,335-yard University of Georgia Golf Course. The tournament serves as a preview to the 2013 NCAA Championship, which will be held at the UGA Golf Course May 21-24.

The Lineup

South Carolina will head to Athens with the same lineup it had to open the season. Senior Meredith Swanson, juniors Suzie Lee and Samantha Swinehart, sophomore Justine Dreher and freshman Sarah Schmelzel are slated to tee off on Friday. Schmelzel enters the weekend leading the team in scoring average (73.00) after finishing in a tie for 30th in her collegiate debut at the Cougar Classic.

History At The UGA Golf Course

South Carolina will look to continue its long history of success at the UGA Golf Course this weekend. In 2002, the Gamecocks claimed the program's first and only SEC Championship in Athens with a school-record three-day total of 861. Kristy McPherson's 209 (-7) led the way and earned her medalist honors for the second straight season. In 2008, Benedicte Toumpsin won medalist honors at the NCAA East Regional in Athens. The Gamecocks also played in the 1993 NCAA Championship at the UGA Golf Course and finished 12th, which is the third best championship finish in school history.

The Gamecocks finished fifth at the UGA Golf Course in last season's Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic.

Breaking Down the Field

With a field featuring 18 teams, including 15 ranked in the top 50 in the latest Golfstat rankings, the Gamecocks will get an early indication of where they stack up against the best teams in the country. The field consists of defending national champion Alabama, along with SEC opponents Auburn, Georgia, LSU, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt. Duke, North Carolina and Virginia will represent the ACC, and California, Southern California and UCLA make up the PAC-12 contingent. Denver, Oklahoma, Purdue and Tulane round out the field.

Recapping The 2012 Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic

The South Carolina women's golf team shot a final-round 298 (+10) to finish in fifth place at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic at the University of Georgia Golf Course.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the tournament with a three-day total of 875 (+11), giving Carolina its best finish at the Liz Murphey Classic since a fourth-place showing at the event in 2002.

Senior Katie Burnett continued her steady play from the first two rounds by posting an even-par 72 to lead the Gamecocks on Sunday. Burnett claimed fifth place with a score of 212 (-4), which is the eighth-lowest 54-hole score in school history. She recorded four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars for the round and she recorded 11 birdies and never scored worse than a bogey on the weekend.

Junior Meredith Swanson carded a 2-over 74 on Sunday to earn the first top-10 finish of her career as she tied for 10th place with a score of 214 (-2). Swanson struggled to a 4-over 39 on the front nine but she settled down and closed out the round in strong fashion, making two birdies and seven pars on the back nine to finish the round at 2-over.

Junior Amanda Strang and sophomore Samantha Swinehart each shot a 4-over 76. Strang finished in a tie for 33rd with a score of 223 (+7), while Swinehart tied for 85th with a total of 237 (+21). Sophomore Katie Rose Higgins turned in an 81 (+9) and finished in a tie for 66th with a score of 231 (+15).

Freshman Justine Dreher, who played as an individual, posted an 80 (+8) to finish in a tie for 75th.

Cougar Classic Recap

The South Carolina women's golf team put together its best round of the Cougar Classic, posting a final-round 294 (+6) at Yearnans Hall Club.

The Gamecocks wrapped up the event with a three-round total of 899 (+35) as they moved six spots up the leaderboard to finish in 16th place.

After shooting only one round of par or better the first two days, Carolina finished strong, recording two rounds of even par and narrowly missing on a third 72. Freshman Sarah Schmelzel helped lead the way with her second straight 72. Junior Samantha Swinehart also carded a 72, and sophomore Justine Dreher turned in a 1-over 73.

Schmelzel proved to be the Gamecocks' most steady player at the event, shooting rounds of 75-72-72=219 (+3). She climbed 12 spots up the leaderboard to finish in a tie for 30th. For the third straight day, Schmelzel did not make worse than a bogey as she produced four birdies, four bogeys and 10 pars.

Swinehart bounced back from consecutive rounds of 77 with a 72 on the final day. A native of Lancaster, Ohio, Swinehart tied for 65th with a total of 226 (+10). After recording just one birdie in the first two rounds, she tallied five in the final round to go along with five bogeys and eight pars.

Dreher finished in a tie for 78th with a score of 228 (+12), recording three birdies, four bogeys and 11 pars for her round

Junior Suzie Lee and senior Meredith Swanson each carded a 5-over 77. Lee tied for 71st with a total of 227 (+11), and Swanson concluded the tournament in a tie for 100th with a score of 232 (+16).

Among the Elite

South Carolina head coach Kalen Harris has built a force to be reckoned with in both the SEC and on a national level. Under her guidance, the Gamecocks have won two NCAA East Regional titles and advanced to four NCAA Championships. Last season Carolina finished fifth at the NCAA Championship, which is the best ever by a Gamecock squad at the event.

Busy Summer

The Gamecocks had yet another successful summer in 2012 with several golfers performing at a high level in events across the country. Senior Meredith Swanson and junior Samantha Swinehart teamed up to take second place at the Pure Silk Collegiate Team Championship. Swinehart and freshman Sarah Schmelzel played at the U.S. Amateur, and Swinehart advanced to the match play portion. Sophomore Justine Dreher advanced to match play at the British Ladies' Amateur Championship.
