GAMECOCKS SET FOR NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Five individuals will represent South Carolina this week at the 2013 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships. The meet runs Thursday through Saturday at the IU Natatorium in Indianapolis, Ind. Preliminaries will begin each day at 11 a.m., and finals will be contested each night at 7. Junior Michael Flach will swim in three individual events for the Gamecocks (200 freestyle, 500 freestyle, 200 butterfly), while juniors Gerard Rodriguez, Alex Fitton, Jay Warner and freshman Marwan El Kamash will join Flach to swim the relay events.

HISTORY AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

This is the 29th year South Carolina will have at least one student-athlete compete at the NCAA Men's Championships. The Gamecocks last appearance at the meet came in 2011 when then-sophomore Michael Flach swam the 200 freestyle, 500 freestyle and 200 butterfly. South Carolina has 12 top-25 finishes all-time at the NCAA Championships, with the last being a 20th-place showing in 2004. The Gamecocks' best finish was a 10th-place showing in 1987 after winning the Metro Conference Championship. During that year's championships, South Carolina had All-America performances from nine individuals and two relays. The Gamecocks have never had an individual national champion.

LAST TIME AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS - 2011

Then-sophomore Michael Flach earned his first career All-America honor as he swam to a 15th-place finish in the 500 freestyle with a time of 4:21.66 at the 2011 NCAA Championships in Minneapolis, Minn. Flach, who was the lone Gamecock swimmer at the meet, led South Carolina to a 36th-place finish. He also swam in the 200 freestyle (37th) and 200 butterfly (31st).

FLACH IS BACK

Junior Michael Flach has had a stellar return to collegiate swimming after redshirting last season to focus on the U.S. Olympic Trials. A native of Annandale, Va., Flach recorded a team-high 12 first place finishes during the regular season. He won silver in the 500 freestyle at the SEC Championships with a school-record time of 4:15.32 and finished fourth in both the 200 freestyle and 200 butterfly. On the national scene, he currently has the seventh fastest time in the country in the 500 freestyle (4:15.32) and the 10th fastest time in the 200 butterfly (1:43.42). Flach put together a performance to remember at the Virginia Tech Invitational in November, posting the then-nation's fastest marks in the 500 freestyle (4:18.38) and the 200 butterfly (1:45.51) on his way to earning Counsilman Hunsaker National Swimmer Of The Week and SEC Male Swimmer of the Week honors.

WORKING TOGETHER

Until this year, the Gamecocks haven't had a relay team invited to the NCAA Championships since the 800 freestyle relay team qualified in 2007. That team finished 11th in the event to earn All-America honors. This year's 800 freestyle relay team of Gerard Rodriguez, Michael Flach, Marwan El Kamash and Alex Fitton enters the meet with the 19th fastest time in the country of 6:23.99, which is a school record. The Gamecocks are also eligible to swim the 200 freestyle, 200 medley and 400 medley relays.

2013 SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS RECAP

The Gamecocks had a solid week at the 2013 SEC Championships, finishing eighth on the men's side and 11th on the women's. On the week Carolina won two medals, broke six school records and swam two NCAA automatic qualifying

times. Junior Michael Flach made it to the championship final in three events (500 freestyle, 200 freestyle, 200 butterfly). He won silver in the 500 freestyle with a school-record and NCAA A cut time of 4:15.32. Flach finished fourth in both the 200 freestyle and 200 butterfly. Sophomore Patricia Kranz earned her first career medal at the SEC Championships as she won bronze on the one-meter springboard with a score of 307.25. Junior Jay Warner made the championship final of the 100 backstroke and broke his own school record with a time of 47.26 to finish fifth. The Gamecock men's relay teams in the 800 freestyle relay, 200 medley relay, 200 freestyle relay and 400 medley relay also set school records. On top of setting the school record, the 800 freestyle relay team of Gerard Rodriguez, Flach, Marwan El Kamash and Alex Fitton posted a NCAA automatic qualifying time of 6:23.99.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

The Gamecock women's victory over Alabama on Feb. 2 gave South Carolina head coach McGee Moody his 100th career victory (men and women combined). Moody, who is in his sixth season in Columbia, has compiled 62 wins with the Gamecocks. Prior to South Carolina, he led William & Mary to 38 wins in three seasons. Overall, Moody has a 100-96-1 record.

GAMECOCK WOMEN DEFEAT ALABAMA TO GIVE MOODY 100 CAREER WINS

The Gamecocks wrapped up the regular season on Feb. 2 against Alabama and Georgia in Tuscaloosa, Ala. Carolina went 1-3 on the day, with the lone win being a 162-148 victory over the Alabama women's team. The win gave head coach McGee Moody his 100th career victory. The meet came down to the final two races, as the Gamecocks outscored the Crimson Tide 26-10 in the those races to secure Moody's milestone win. The Gamecock women lost to Georgia 203-96. On the men's side, Carolina fell to both Alabama (157-143) and Georgia (209-85). On the day, South Carolina won five individual events. Sophomore diver Cole Miller swept the men's boards as he ran away on the one-meter board to win by 56.05 points with a score of 338.00. He also claimed the three-meter competition with a score of 337.05. Senior Matea Peteh won the women's 100 freestyle in 49.77, which is a PR and the fourth fastest time in school history. Freshman Alicia Cheripka posted a PR in the 200 backstroke to win with a time of 2:00.98, the eighth best time in school history. Junior Amanda Rutqvist captured the 200 breaststroke with a NCAA B cut of 2:15.37. With the split, the South Carolina women wrapped up the regular season at 6-7 overall and 1-4 in the SEC. On the men's side, the Gamecocks finished the year with a 6-6 overall record and a 1-3 mark in the conference.

CAROLINA SWEEPS COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON, QUEENS, WINGATE IN HOME FINALE

The Gamecocks swept College of Charleston, Queens and Wingate in a two-session meet last weekend to close out their home schedule. South Carolina sent its 13 seniors out with a win, as the Gamecock men defeated Wingate 269-59, Queens 221-107 and College of Charleston 281-53. The Carolina women completed the sweep by cruising past the Bulldogs 277-55, the Royals 282-46 and the Cougars 283.5-49.5. The Gamecocks recorded first-place finishes in 24 events on the weekend. Senior diver Rylan Ridenour won two of those events and set a school record along the way. Ridenour finished first on the three-meter springboard with a school-record score of 446.95. He also won the one-meter competition with a career-high 395.90. Sophomore Patricia Kranz won both boards for the Gamecock women, and junior Gerard Rodriguez, freshman Ellen Johnson and junior Matt Navata also tallied two wins apiece in the swimming events for South Carolina.

GAMECOCK MEN FALL TO FSU; WOMEN SWEEP BY NOLES, ARKANSAS

With three nationally-ranked teams in town, South Carolina had a chance to pick up a signature win. However, the Gamecocks were unable to pull off an upset of the 13th-ranked Florida State men, the 21st-ranked Florida State women and the 18th-ranked Arkansas women. On the men's side, the Gamecocks dropped a 180.5-117.5 decision to the Seminoles. In the women's action, South Carolina fell to the Seminoles, 190-109, and lost to the Razorbacks, 223-77.

On the night, the Gamecocks won five events with a different winner in each event. Senior Brooks Ross took first in the 1,000 freestyle in a season-best time of 9:22.58. Junior Michael Flach tied for first in the 200 freestyle in 1:39.74. Junior Jay Warner recorded his first win of the season by touching first in the 100 backstroke with a mark of 50.34. Gerard Rodriguez posted a first-place finish for the Gamecocks with a win in the 500 freestyle in 4:34.08. The Gamecock women managed just one first-place finish, as junior Amanda Rutqvist posted a NCAA B cut of 2:14.19 to win the 200 breaststroke.

GAMECOCKS OPEN 2013 WITH SWEEP OF DUKE

South Carolina started the New Year in strong fashion with a road sweep of Duke. The Gamecock women cruised to a 184-115 victory to improve to 2-4 on the season, and the Carolina men edged the Blue Devils 159-141 to move to 3-3 overall. The victory was the fourth straight over Duke for the Gamecock men and the second straight for the women's team. On the day South Carolina finished first in 18 of the 32 events and swept the top three places in five events. Senior Brooks Ross and juniors Michael Flach, Matt Navata and Rachael Schaffer led the way with two wins apiece.

On the boards, the Gamecocks faced their toughest test of the season in Olympic medal winners Nick McCrory and Abby Johnston. Duke won three of the four events, but sophomore Patricia Kranz prevented the sweep by claiming first on the three-meter springboard with a mark of 332.55. Kranz (302.47) fell 7.36 points shy of knocking off Johnston in the one-meter event. For the Carolina men, senior Rylan Ridenour finished second on the one-meter board with a score of 377.55, which was just 1.95 points behind McCrory.

CAROLINA MEN, WOMEN FINISH SECOND AT VIRGINIA TECH INVITE

Both the Gamecock men's and women's teams finished in second place at the Virginia Tech Invitational to wrap up the fall schedule in November. For the week, South Carolina posted 12 NCAA B cuts and won 10 races in the championship finals. Junior Michael Flach led the way by posting the nation's fastest times at the time in the 500 freestyle (4:18.38) and

the 200 butterfly (1:45.51). Freshman Marwan El Kamash also posted NCAA B cuts in the 500 freestyle and the 1,650 freestyle. Junior Amanda Rutqvist recorded provisional qualifying times in the 100 and 200 breaststroke, while junior Rachael Schaffer turned in a B cut in the 400 IM.

CAROLINA CRUISES TO SWEEP OF COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

The Gamecock men defeated the Cougars, 178-115, while the Carolina women captured its first win of the season with a 169-126 victory. The meet was an opportunity for some of the younger swimmers to compete, and they stepped up with a stellar effort, as Carolina finished first in 23 of the 28 events in the pool and swept the boards. Junior Narayan Naik (100 backstroke, 200 backstroke, 400 IM), senior Brooks Ross (800 freestyle, 400 freestyle) and junior Michael Covert (200 butterfly, 100 butterfly) each had multiple wins to lead the Gamecock men in the 25-meter short course. On the women's side, juniors Abby Galbreath (800 freestyle, 400 freestyle) and Rachael Schaffer (200 butterfly, 400 IM) recorded two wins apiece to lead the way.

Sophomores Cole Miller and Patricia Kranz were named the SEC Male and Female Divers of the Week for their performances against the Cougars. Miller won the three-meter springboard and finished second on the one-meter, while Kranz won both boards for the Carolina women.

GAMECOCKS FALL AT VIRGINIA

The South Carolina swimming and diving teams fell in a dual meet at Virginia on Saturday at the Aquatic and Fitness Center. The Gamecock men dropped a 160-126 decision, while the Carolina women lost to the 14th-ranked Cavaliers, 161-124. The diving corps gave the Gamecocks a solid start to the day, winning three of the four boards. The teams squared off on Friday night on the three-meter springboard. Senior Rylan Ridenour, the reigning SEC Diver of the Week, ran away with the men's competition with a score of 395.85. In the women's event, sophomore Patricia Kranz set a Virginia pool record with a score of 323.63 to win. Ridenour pulled away to win the men's one-meter springboard with a score of 352.06, while Malvasio (269.63) and Kranz (264.60) finished second and third, respectively in the women's competition.

GAMECOCKS SWEEP BY FLORIDA; DIVING DEFEATS CLEMSON

The Gamecock men fell to the top-ranked Gators, 166-128, to drop to 1-2 on the season and 1-1 in the conference. In the women's competition, South Carolina lost 176-119 and is now 0-3 overall and 0-2 in SEC action. The Gamecock women's diving team also squared off with rival Clemson in a first-ever diving only matchup. South Carolina dominated the meet, winning 26-12. The Gamecock divers were solid once again as they swept both the men's and women's competitions. On the women's one-meter springboard, sophomore Patricia Kranz won the event with a career-best 315.70, which is a NCAA Zone qualifying score. Freshman Lauren Lamendola claimed second with a personal record of 253.40. Kranz also won the three-meter competition with a score of 292.80, while Lamendola placed fourth with a score of 257.95. In his first action of the season, senior Rylan Ridenour won both boards as he posted a score of 359.35 on the one-meter and a mark of 396.60 on the three-meter. Sophomore Cole Miller took second in both events, scoring 322.45 on the one-meter and 367.80 on the three-meter.

CAROLINA MEN TOP TEXAS A&M, FALL TO UNC; WOMEN SWEEP

The Gamecocks are 1-1 overall and 1-0 in the SEC after defeating Texas A&M and falling to North Carolina to open the season. On the women's side, South Carolina lost to both teams to start the year at 0-2 and 0-1 in the conference.

The Gamecocks put up several nationally ranked times in the opening meet including three by junior Michael Flach. A native of Annandale, Va., Flach is ranked No. 6 in the 200-yard freestyle (1:38.56), ninth in the 200-yard butterfly (1:48.69) and 12th in the 200-yard IM (1:50.95). Freshman Marwan El Kamash (ninth-1000 freestyle, 15th-500 freestyle) and juniors Matt Navata (11th-200 breaststroke, 15th-200 IM) and Gerard Rodriguez (10th-200 freestyle) have also recorded ranked times. Junior Amanda Rutqvist led the women with the 10th fastest time in the country in the 200-yard breaststroke with a mark of 2:14.87.

NO REST FOR THE WEARY

South Carolina's swimmers and divers faced one of the toughest schedules in school history in 2012-13. The schedule featured six teams that finished 16th or better at last year's NCAA Championships on the men's side and five teams that finished in the top 20 at the women's NCAA Championships.

On the men's side, Texas A&M (13th), North Carolina (14th), Florida (eighth), Virginia (15th), Florida State (16th) and Georgia (11th) were on the schedule. The Gamecock women faced North Carolina (19th), Texas A&M (sixth), Florida (10th), Virginia (17th) and Georgia (second).

SWIMMING THE SUMMER AWAY

Junior Michael Flach didn't have much time to relax during his summer of 2012. Flach, who took an Olympic redshirt last season to focus his efforts on training for the London Olympics, made a splash on the national scene by finishing eighth in the 200-meter butterfly at the 2012 U.S. Olympic Trials in June, becoming the first Gamecock to make the finals since 1988. Flach's stellar summer continued into August when he was named to the U.S. roster for the 2013 World University Games, which will be held July 6-17 in Kazan, Russia. Flach earned his spot on the team with a second-place finish in the 200 butterfly at the U.S. Open, which was held in Indianapolis, Ind. After sneaking into the championship final with the eighth fastest time in the preliminaries (2:00.75), Flach shaved more than two seconds off his time in the finals to touch second in 1:58.40, securing his spot on the team.

Flach wasn't the only Gamecock competing during the summer, as teammates Matt Navata, Alex Vance, Jay Warner, Matt Columbus, Brooks Ross, Rachael Schaffer, Abby Galbreath, Annika Jonsson and Whitney Avers competed at the U.S. Olympic Trials. Divers Rylan Ridenour and Courtney Forcucci had strong showings at the U.S. Olympic Diving Trials, while Cole Miller performed well at the Canadian Olympic Diving Trials.





McGee Moody

Head Swimming Coach Sixth Year at South Carolina

A proven leader in the coaching profession, McGee Moody is in his sixth season as the head swimming coach at the University of South Carolina. He and his staff continue to build the South Carolina program and strive toward the elite level of the sport through effective training methods and tireless recruiting efforts.

In his five previous seasons at the helm, Moody has overseen a successful stretch for the Carolina swimming and diving program. Last season the Gamecock women went 7-3, which was one of the best records in program history. The winning season gave Carolina back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1994-95. On the men's side, the Gamecocks went 5-4 to achieve back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1993-94.

Individually, Carolina had an extremely successful 2011-12 led by diver Courtney Forcucci. Forcucci earned All-America honors on both the one and three-meter springboards at the NCAA Championships. She won gold on the three-meter board at the SEC Championships, setting a SEC and school record. Forcucci also claimed bronze on the one-meter board. Amanda Rutqvist captured silver in the 200 breaststroke at the SEC Championships and earned All-America honors in the event at the NCAA Championships. Michael Flach, who took an Olympic redshirt, made the 200 butterfly finals at the U.S. Olympic Trials and finished eighth overall. Flach was the first Gamecock to make the finals at the U.S. Trials since 1988.

During the 2010-11 season, the Gamecock men equaled the school record for wins in a single season, finishing with a 10-1 dual-meet record. The Carolina women also finished with a winning record for the first time since 2002, posting a 7-6 dual-meet mark.

His first three seasons saw gradual improvements. The 2009-10 season was a bit of a rebuilding year, but highlights included freshman Michael Flach's bronze-medal performance in the 500 freestyle at the SEC Championships.

In 2008-09, the Gamecock women finished with a .500 dual meet record for the first time since 2005 and won five meets for the first time since 2002. The women also earned their highest SEC Championships finish in three years. The Carolina men, meanwhile, sent two swimmers - Nick Walkotten and Kyle Cormier - to the NCAA Championships and earned a 29th-place national finish, the best for a Carolina squad since 2005. Combined, the Carolina men and women turned in 23 NCAA provisional qualifying times and broke 14 school records.

It wasn't an easy beginning for the East Carolina

graduate, but Moody made great strides with the South Carolina program in his initial season on the Horse-shoe. Despite arriving on campus only a month before the start of the 2007-08 season, Moody oversaw a successful transition as Carolina sent three swimmers to the NCAA Championships. Walkotten and Dominique Lendjel represented the Gamecock men while Christy Williams swam for the women.

Aside from NCAA competition, Moody saw even more success as nine Gamecock swimmers competed in the Olympic Trials. One swimmer, then-sophomore Shantelle McLean, represented her home country of Trinidad & Tobago in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing. In addition, then-rising senior Nicholas Walkotten competed at the Short Course World Championships.

Moody spent three years at William & Mary, where his teams achieved 559 lifetime best swims, 301 all-time Tribe top-10 performances, 46 school records and 18 gold medals at the Colonial Athletic Association Championships. The Tribe swimming program also excelled academically. The women received Academic All-America honors in each semester under Moody's tutelage.

In 2007, Moody earned the conference's Coach of the Year honor after leading his women's team (8-4, 6-2 CAA) to the first Colonial Athletic Association Championship in the program's 80-year history with a record-tying 12 gold medals. In doing so, the squad swept the conference awards by winning Performer of the Meet, Swimmer of the Year and Rookie of the Year. The men's program finished with a winning record (6-3-1, 5-2-1 CAA) for the first time since 1998-99, and finished fourth at the conference meet behind a pair of runner-up performances and a host of bronze medals.

In 2005-06, the Tribe women's team improved upon its fourth-place conference finish in 2005 by taking second, passing George Mason on the final day of the CAA Championships. During the season, the women were even more impressive, posting a 10-4 ledger (8-1 CAA), to set the school record for conference wins in a season. In the conference, their only blemish was against eventual champion UNC Wilmington. The men also experienced improvement, achieving five dual-meet wins for the first time since 1999 and posting a .500 mark (4-4) in the conference. They also improved on their result at the conference championship, riding a bevy of personal records in the last two days to a fifth-place finish.

Moody spent four seasons as an assistant men's swimming coach at the United States Naval Academy. During his tenure at Navy, Moody coached the Midshipmen's first NCAA automatic qualifier since 1996 in addition to guiding numerous NCAA, Senior National and Olympic Trial qualifiers. His 200 and 400 freestyle relay teams finished the season ranked in the top 25 of the world. Moody also made an impact in the Navy record book, with his athletes setting all of the top-10 fastest times in school history in both the 50 and 100 freestyles. Building his athletes into academic success stories as well, Navy's men's swimming team was awarded Academic All-America honors all three seasons from 2001-2004 under Moody's direction.

Moody got his coaching start at his alma mater, East Carolina University. He was the top assistant swim coach for both men and women for the Pirates from 1996-2000. While working in nearly every facet of the program at East Carolina, Moody coached over 25 varsity record holders.

A 1998 graduate of East Carolina, Moody swam on the Pirates' varsity squad for four seasons, setting several freshman records and captaining the team his junior and senior years. Moody was also an Olympic Trials qualifier in the 200 freestyle in 1992.

Moody, who earned both a bachelor's degree in psychology and master's in sports administration from ECU, is an active professional in the swimming community. He also served in the United States Navy, attaining the rank of Lieutenant. A member of both the American Swimming Coaches Association and the College Swimming Coaches Association of America, he has served as the chair of the latter's Media Relations Committee since 2001. He and his wife, Monica, have four daughters: Sydney, Olivia, Lily and Whitney.

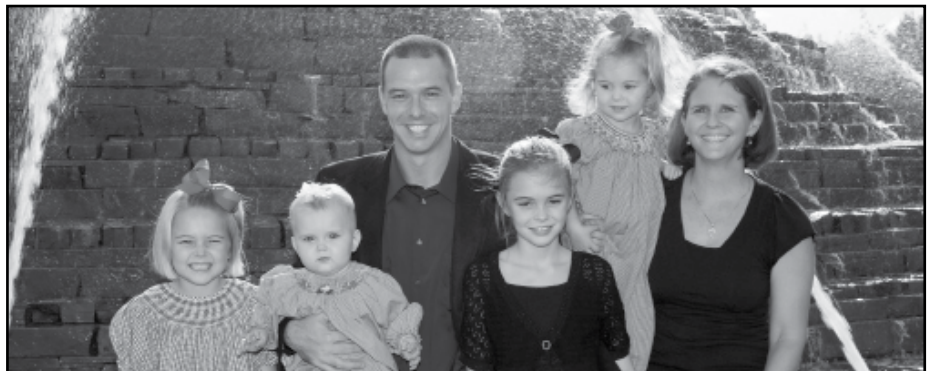

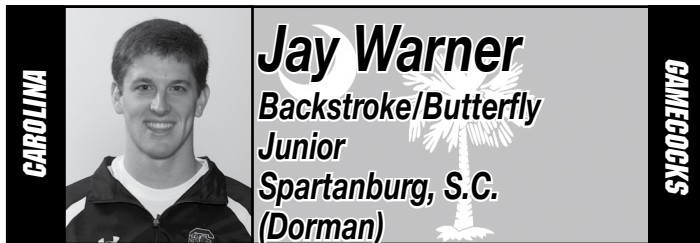
