## Gamecocks Ready to “Be the Change”

South Carolina has won 25 games in each of the last two seasons, despite the expectations of many outside the Gamecock faithful. Finishing both seasons in the top 25, the program has the nation’s attention and is primed to establish itself as a perennial powerhouse. To do that, head coach Dawn Staley has decided to turn her team’s attention on others as much as on itself, challenging the program and its fans to commit 50,000 random acts of kindness this season to “Be the Change” in the world around them. The Naismith Hall of Fame inductee believes the mentality will help the Gamecocks make their next move up the polls and in the postseason.

With just two starters returning, the Gamecocks will surely face questions about “rebuilding” again this season, despite last season’s dismissal of similar doubt after the departure of four starters who were the cornerstones of the 2012 NCAA Sweet 16 run. The key to Staley’s steady climb up the women’s basketball ladder has been in relying on her best players while continually developing the next class of elite competitors. The 2013-14 season will be no different.

The two returning starters are last year’s leading scorer, Aleighsa Welch, and do-it-all guard Tiffany Mitchell.

Welch exploded into her second season, never entertaining the idea of a sophomore slump, to score 12.0 points per game and reel in 7.7 rebounds per game en route to Second-Team All-SEC honors. Through just two seasons, the six-foot forward is already 10th in school history in offensive rebounds and is one of just three Gamecocks all-time to have multiple seasons with at least 100 offensive boards. With Welch’s statistical reliability night-in and night-out, Staley looks for her to assume a leadership role this season as well.

Mitchell charged out of the gates for the Gamecocks and survived a late-season slump to finish with 9.2 points and 5.1 rebounds per game, earning her SEC All-Freshman honors. With a season of conditioning and playing in the physical SEC under her belt, the 5-foot-9 guard should be able to sustain her contributions throughout this season.

Sophomore point guard Khadijah Sessions is ready to step out of the shadows and into the spotlight this season. Selected by her teammates as a team captain

(with Welch and Elem Ibiam), the Myrtle Beach, S.C., product sacrificed for the benefit of the team last season by coming off the bench, but has taken great strides on the court and in her command of the team in the offseason.

The Gamecocks will welcome the return of guards Tina Roy and Tiffany Davis from knee surgeries that kept them out all or most of last season. Roy will provide pop from the 3-point line, and both could see time at the point throughout the season. Sophomore Asia Dozier will shake off a slow-shooting freshman campaign to impact South Carolina this season along with a trio of incoming guards. JUCO Player of the Year Olivia Gaines will bring experience and explosiveness on both sides of the ball, while freshman India Farmer and redshirt sophomore LeAnna Morrison will battle as well.

Joining Welch in the frontcourt will be a pair of centers in junior Elem Ibiam and freshman Alaina Coates, both of whom stand 6-foot-4.

Ibiam was dominant late in the season for the Gamecocks, scoring in double digits in three of the four postseason games while averaging 8.5 rebounds during the stretch to come in as the team’s second-leading scorer and third-best rebounder across the SEC and NCAA Tournaments.

Coates is the third-straight Gatorade South Carolina Player of the Year to sign with the Gamecocks, and expectations for the Irmo, S.C., native are sky high. Her dedication over the summer has shown Staley that Coates is up for the challenge.

The team’s lone senior, Wilka Montout, showed flashes of the shooting and mobility that attracted Staley to the JUCO transfer last season. Her versatility will give opponents another element to plan for with the other more physical frontcourt players.

South Carolina’s 2013-14 schedule includes 14 teams that competed in the 2013 postseason, accounting for 17 of the 29 regular-season contests. Nearly half of the 26 teams on the Gamecocks’ slate recorded at least 20 wins last season, including four that reached the NCAA Elite Eight, one NCAA Sweet 16 team and a WNIT semifinalist.

All of which adds up to a 2013-14 season that is all about change – inside and out.
