

CAROLINA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

South Carolina is playing in its fourth consecutive tournament and fifth overall, holding an all-time record of 2-3-1 in NCAA Tournament games. The first bid came in a 2-0 loss at Charlotte in 1998. The current streak began in 2007, Carolina earned an at-large bid with a 14-6-2 record when the Gamecocks played Duke to a 1-1 draw at Athens, Ga. Duke advanced with a 4-1 edge in penalty kicks. In 2008, South Carolina dropped a 3-2 overtime decision to William & Mary at Durham, N.C. South Carolina advanced to the Round of 16 in 2009 with victories against Davidson (4-0) and Rutgers (1-0) before losing to Wake Forest (1-0) on a last-second stunner when the Demon Deacons scored off a corner kick at 89:59.

SCOUTING UNC GREENSBORO

UNC Greensboro enters the tournament at 19-1-1 riding a 16-match winning streak. The lone blemishes came on an early season trip to Los Angeles with a 0-0 draw against Southern California and a 2-0 loss at Cal State Fullerton. Six Spartans have double-digit points this season with three over the 20-point plateau. Sophomore Tabitha Padgett leads the charge with 10 goals and five assists for 25 points, and freshman Kristen Schmidbauer follows with nine goals and six assists for 24 points. Junior Cat Barnekow is among the nation's leaders with 14 assists. Junior Kelsey Kearney holds a 0.48 goals against average with 56 saves and 12 shutouts.

GROUP OF DEATH

The Virginia pod may very well likely be this year's "Group of Death". Only two pods in the entire tournament feature three ranked teams - the Virginia pod (#8 Virginia, #10 UNC Greensboro, #20 South Carolina) and the Notre Dame pod (#7 Notre Dame, #13 Illinois, #22 Southern California). South Carolina-UNCG and Illinois-Southern California are the only matchups of ranked teams in the first round of the tournament.

EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

For the fifth consecutive year Shelley Smith's squad exceeded preseason expectations by finishing strong in SEC play. Picked by the coaches to finish last in 2006, the Gamecocks earned fifth in the Eastern division. Picked to finish last in the East in the 2007 SEC Preseason poll, the Gamecocks tied a program record for wins en route to a fourth place division finish. Carolina was picked fourth in the 2008 preseason poll and again improved in the standings with a third place finish in the Eastern division. Coach Smith's team was again picked fourth in 2009 and responded with an SEC East runner-up finish that earned her SEC Coach of the Year honors. The coaches selected her team 3rd in the East in 2010, and the team finished as the overall SEC runner-up.

MOLLIE PATTON'S COUNTDOWN TO 33

Heading into the NCAA Tournament, senior goalkeeper **Mollie Patton** has 31 career solo shutouts at South Carolina. Her 31 shutouts are two shy of tying the SEC record of 33, held by Megan Rivera of Auburn (2001-04). She already holds the SEC records for consecutive shutouts (7) and single-season shutouts (15), and was already the South Carolina all-time record holder before the season began. Patton played 45 minutes in the 7-0 win against Mississippi State, a combined shutout that does not count towards the record.

GRIMSLEY NAMED OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR TO LEAD FOUR ALL-SEC HONORS

Junior forward **Kayla Grimsley** was named the SEC Offensive Player of the Year and four Gamecocks earned All-SEC honors to cap the most successful SEC season in program history.

It is the first SEC Offensive Player of the Year honor in South Carolina history and just the third overall Player of the Year selection (2009: Blakely Mattern, Defensive; 2004: Ashley Kirk, Freshman). Grimsley led the SEC in goals (11), points (31) and game-winning goals (5) while coming in third in assists (9). The Gamecocks recorded a program-best second place finish in the SEC and came within one game of winning the overall title.

Grimsley and senior defender **Brittany Rhoades** were selected to the First Team All-SEC list, and junior defender **Ellen Fahey** was selected to the Second Team. Midfielder **Danielle Au** was picked for the SEC All-Freshman Team, as voted on by league coaches.

THE 10-10-30 CLUB

Junior **Kayla Grimsley's** assist against Kentucky makes her the first Gamecock to join the 10-10-30 club. Grimsley has 12 goals and 10 assists for 34 points this season, numbers that had her at the top of the SEC list in goals, points and game winning goals (5) at the end of the regular season. In just her third season, Grimsley is already No. 2 in the South Carolina record books for career goals (33), assists (23) and points (89).

GETTING THE RECORD

Junior **Kayla Grimsley** scored a goal against LSU in the semifinal round to give her 34 points on the year, tying the record set by Gamecock legend Jennie Ondo in 1996 (14 goals, 6 assists). One more point will give Grimsley the all-time record for single-season points (12 goals, 10 assists).

...AND ANOTHER

Senior **Brittany Rhoades** set the South Carolina career record for games played at 93 following the SEC Championship match at Florida. With 91 career games started, she will tie former All-American **Blakely Mattern** at 92 with a start against UNC Greensboro Friday night.

THE NATION'S STINGIEST DEFENSE?

South Carolina's backline has now limited 13 of their last 15 opponents to four shots on goal or less, a streak that included eight road games, five home games and 10 of 11 SEC opponents. All 11 teams were also limited to 10 total shots or less with the streak dating back to the road victory at then-No. 22 Wake Forest. All-SEC defenders Brittany Rhoades (1st Team) and Ellen Fahey (2nd Team) lead the charge.

NEW-LOOK GRIMSLEY

Junior **Kayla Grimsley**, an All-American candidate at forward, has been called upon to play many roles for the youthful Gamecocks in 2010. Already one of the most prolific scorers in Gamecock history, Grimsley has added to her M.O. as a distributionist as well. With 10 assists already on the season - three coming on game-winning goals - Grimsley moves to No. 2 on the South Carolina all-time list with 23 in her career, behind the 24 put up by Mindy Sanders from 1996-99. Already in the Carolina top two in nearly every offensive category (including goals, assists and points), Grimsley now holds the freshman (6), sophomore (7) and junior (10) records for single-season assists. She's currently No. 22 in the NCAA this year in assists.

SENIOR CLASS SETS THE RECORD

The 2009 senior class left Columbia as the winningest senior class in program history, but the 2010 class took over that distinction after the win against Tennessee. The Class of '09 held a 55-23-14 (.674) record, but the Class of '10 currently claims a career record of 58-22-13 (.694) and is the first class to advance to the NCAA Tournament all four years.

ALL-AROUND PRODUCTION

In South Carolina's 14 wins, nine different players have hit the game-winning goal. Junior **Kayla Grimsley** leads the team and SEC with five GWG's, and freshman **Danielle Au** is the only other player with more than one after notching two game-winners. Seven other players have each scored the deciding goal for South Carolina, a mix of four defenders and three midfielders.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior **Kayla Grimsley** was named the National Player of the Week three weeks ago after her four-goal performance against Alabama and Auburn pushed Carolina to the top of the SEC ladder. She is the third Gamecock to earn National Player of the Week honors behind Lindsay Thorstenson (2007) and Blakely Mattern (2009).

PATTON AT THE TOP OF THE NATION

Heading into the weekend, senior **Mollie Patton** sits 15th in the nation with nine solo shutouts. A Lowe's Senior CLASS Award nominee, Patton's 31 career shutouts leaves her two shy of tying the all-time SEC record of 33 set by Auburn's Megan Rivera (2002-04). She is tied for No. 2 on the list of active goalkeepers with 31 career shutouts behind West Virginia's Kerri Butler (39).

BARR'S UP

Freshman Kelsey Barr has been a tenacious presence at center mid and has been one of the most solid freshmen to step on the field for the Gamecocks. A top reserve, Barr has seen her minutes steadily increase throughout the season and has turned into one of the most reliable players in the midfield at controlling pace and winning knockdowns.

NATIONAL GAMECOCKS

Two Gamecocks find themselves among the nation's top 25 in various statistics as we hit the start of the postseason. Junior **Kayla Grimsley** has proven to be one of the top distributionists in the country at No. 20 (10 assists) in the NCAA in assists. Grimsley is also 12th in the NCAA in points at 34 and No. 22 in goals at 12. Senior goalkeeper **Mollie Patton** sits No. 15 in the nation in shutouts at 9 despite not earning a solo shutout in a 7-0 win against Mississippi State that saw three goalkeepers play. Patton is also 23rd in the nation in goals against average (0.64).

AU SO GOOD!

Freshman **Danielle Au** had an impact weekend at the Carolina's Cup with two goals, including the game-winner against Furman in overtime. She became the first Gamecock freshman (and second ever!) to score a golden goal since **Lexi Tourtellotte** (the only other to achieve the feat) did it against Evansville (Oct. 16, 1995) - a span of 15 seasons and 56 overtime games. For her efforts, Au was named the tournament MVP and picked up SEC Freshman of the Week and CollegeSoccer360.com Primetime Performer of the Week honors.

MORE ON AU

Freshman **Danielle Au** has scored 10 points in South Carolina's last 12 games, including hitting the game-winning goals against Furman and Wake Forest. Au's game-winner against Wake Forest continued her record trend as she became just the second Gamecock freshman to ever hit a game-winning goal to defeat a ranked opponent. The only other was **Mindy Sanders** who score the game-winner in a 3-2 win against No. 9 Clemson (Sept. 18, 1996), the first game against a ranked opponent in South Carolina history.

SINCLAIR STARTS

Freshman midfielder **Elizabeth Sinclair** is a Gamecock to keep your eyes on. She immediately impressed with her work ethic and skills, taking her all of two games to crack the starting 11 in the spot vacated by the graduation of All-SEC performer **Kim Miller**. Sinclair brings the same all-around presence to the field that Miller gave the Gamecocks as a four-year starter.

JACOBS HITS THE HAT TRICK

Senior forward **Brooke Jacobs** notched her first career hat trick with three goals in a 14-minute span against Mississippi State. The hat trick was the sixth in South Carolina history and the first against an SEC opponent. The last hat trick was performed by Erin Sullivan against The Citadel in 2006.

IN THE POLLS AND RPI

South Carolina remains ranked No. 20 by the NSCAA in this week's poll. The Gamecocks jumped to No. 13 in the Soccer Times poll and finished the year with an RPI of 32.

KAYLA GRIMSLEY: MAC HERMANN TROPHY AWARD WATCH LIST

Junior forward **Kayla Grimsley** has been named as one of 45 players selected to the 2010 Watch List for the MAC Hermann Trophy, the top individual award presented in collegiate soccer. Grimsley's appearance marks the first time a Gamecock has been selected as a candidate for the prestigious award. She is a three-time postseason All-SEC selection, a TopDrawerSoccer Team of the Season selection and the 2010 SEC Player of the Year.

GAMECOCKS ON TV

The SEC Championship match against Florida marked the sixth time in 2010 that the Gamecocks appeared on television, with four of those games occurring on national TV. South Carolina finished the season 4-2 on TV, including the 3-0 win against Ole Miss (FSC), 7-0 win against Mississippi State (CSS), 2-1 win against Tennessee (ESPNU) and 1-0 win against LSU (ESPNU). The team fell to Florida by identical 1-0 scores on SUN Sports and ESPNU.

SUNDAY MADNESS

South Carolina has performed at a perfect level on Sunday afternoon matches, traditionally the toughest day of the week after playing a Friday game. The Gamecocks, 9-1-1 in Sunday matches this year, have outscored opponents 25-5 on Sundays with the lone loss coming against Florida in the SEC Championship match. Carolina has scored 17 goals in SEC Sunday matches this year. For the record, that means 25 of Carolina's 40 goals have come on Sundays.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

After struggling to put the ball in the net for much of the non-conference season, South Carolina emerged as an offensive threat in SEC play with 15 unanswered goals in a three-game stretch. Since Kentucky went ahead 1-0 in that match, South Carolina went on a roll with five straight against the Wildcats, three goals against Ole Miss (3-0) and seven goals against Mississippi State (7-0). Carolina possesses the SEC's No. 2 offense and No. 1 defense overall.

WATTS ADJUSTS EASILY

Sophomore **Christine Watts** played as Carolina's first person off the bench last season as a backup midfielder. This season, Watts has been asked to play a new role as the team's starting right back, and the transition has been seamless. She has already earned six assists from her new position with two of those assists coming on game-winning goals. Watts also hit the game-winning goal against Mississippi State.

HENRY FILLS IN ADMIRABLY

Sophomore defender **Dani Henry** took upon one of the most high-profile jobs this year when she was called to fill in the centerback spot vacated by the graduation of consensus All-American **Blakely Mattern**. Henry, a top 150 recruit coming out of high school, has played nearly every minute of the season in the spot beside **Ellen Fahey**.

MOLLIE PATTON: LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Senior goalkeeper **Mollie Patton** has been selected as one of 30 candidates for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for women's soccer. Candidates are chosen based on their dedication and achievement in four areas: Classroom, Character, Community and Competition.

GILBERT GOES FOR GOLD

Freshman defender **Gabrielle Gilbert** had a strong opening week for the Gamecocks in her collegiate debut. The Canadian national earned starts against Boston and Northeastern at right back and hit the game-winning goal against the Terriers to become the first true freshman to score a game-winning goal on the season opening weekend since Melinda Carter scored the GWG against Davidson on Sept. 1, 1998.

RETURNING CATEGORY LEADERS

Carolina returns six starters from last season's NCAA Tournament team. South Carolina will enter 2010 with a new look and new faces, but talent and depth will be available after Coach Shelley Smith signed 11 freshmen and added another standout during preseason training.



**Shelley Smith
10th Season**

Shelley Smith enters her tenth season at the helm of the USC women's soccer program after turning the Gamecocks into conference and national title contenders with three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Smith moved Carolina into the upper echelon of programs after guiding the Gamecocks in 2009 to the program's first SEC title and a berth in the NCAA Round of 16, earning her SEC Coach of the Year and NSCAA South Region Coach of the Year honors. South Carolina was a No. 2 national seed in the tournament and finished with a 19-4-2 record, the best in school history. The team's 7-3-1 conference record was also a program best, and four players earned All-SEC honors.

The Gamecocks finished as one of the top defensive teams in the nation with a school record 15 shutouts, led by Mattern on the backline who was a consensus first team All-American in her final season. Grimsley finished the year with 33 points and was named an honorable mention All-American by Top Drawer Soccer. The team finished eighth in the nation in average attendance.

Carolina's success in the classroom also continued last season as her squad earned two Academic All-District honors in Mattern and Mollie Patton for the second consecutive year. Mattern was also named to the Academic All-America first team, making South Carolina one of only four teams in the nation - and the only in the SEC - to have an Academic All-American selected each of the past five seasons. Her team was also honored with its eighth NSCAA Team Academic Award. Smith has coached 131 SEC Academic Honor Roll recipients since coming to USC in 2001.

Smith has coached several top student-athletes at Carolina including Ashley Kirk, USC's first four-time All-SEC honoree, Carolina's first All-American in four-time All-SEC selection Blakely Mattern and two-time All-SEC performers Melinda Carter, Jessica Julin, Kayla Grimsley and Sarah Lentz. Julin is currently the captain of the Finland National Team and Carter played in the WUSA. The Gamecocks have earned 24 All-SEC honors in the last nine years.

In her first season as head coach at Carolina (2001), the Gamecocks were the third most improved team in the nation with an 8-7-3 overall record. Carolina also had one of the school's best home records, going 5-3 at Stone Stadium, allowing opponents to score only four goals in eight matches.

The success continued for USC in 2002 with 13 wins in Smith's second season. The year was highlighted with USC's first ever victories against Florida and Kentucky. Smith also led her team to ties against 2002 SEC champion Auburn and Eastern Division champion Tennessee.

Smith led the Gamecocks to another successful season in 2003 with 10 wins including a USC record eight-game unbeaten streak as well as a 6-2-1 record at home in Stone Stadium.

The 2004 season featured a win over No. 7 Clemson, the Gamecocks' first win over a ranked opponent since 1998, as well as a 6-3 mark in non-conference action. Ashley Kirk also became the first freshman soccer player in school history to be named SEC Freshman of the Year. In addition, Carolina set a school record for a home game-winning streak with six consecutive wins.

Following an injury filled 2005 season, the program took a big step forward in 2006 as USC went undefeated at home for the first time in school history with an 8-0-3 mark at Stone Stadium. The season culminated with the Gamecocks advancing to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the first time in Carolina history, as Blakely Mattern became the team's first Freshman All-American selection since 1998.

The 2007 season marked the official turning point of the program, tying the school record with 14 victories and advancing to the NCAA Tournament for only the second time in program history. Carolina posted a 14-6-3 overall record including a 5-4-2 mark in the SEC after beginning the season by becoming the first team ever to knock off defending national champion and top-ranked North Carolina in a season opening game at Fetzer Field in Chapel Hill. The Gamecocks ran to a 7-0-0 start to the season and peaked at No. 7 in the national polls. For the second consecutive season South Carolina advanced to the SEC Tournament semifinals after knocking off Tennessee for the first time in program history and earned the school's first bid to the NCAA Tournament since 1998. Blakely Mattern became the first sophomore to ever earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year honors in addition to becoming the first All-American in South Carolina history.

Smith cemented Carolina's position as a conference title contender and player on the national stage after guiding the Gamecocks in 2008 to their second consecutive NCAA Tournament bid and third consecutive SEC Tournament bid. The Gamecocks went 11-7-4 overall and earned five SEC wins for the third year in a row with only one senior on the roster. Respected as a top defensive team, the Gamecocks finished the regular season second in the SEC with eight shutouts and ranked in the top two in every major defensive category including goals allowed, points allowed, shots allowed and shots on goal allowed.

Besides her collegiate coaching, Smith was a member of the Region III ODP staff for the past five years, as well as an assistant for the '90 Regional Team. Smith also was a member of the 2003 U-14 National Camp staff for U.S. Soccer.

With a background in both semi-professional and collegiate soccer, Smith previously served as head coach at Rhode Island from 1997-2000. The 2000 NSCAA Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Smith rebuilt the URI women's soccer program,

compiling a 41-35-2 overall record. Smith took a program that was 2-16 her first year to 12-7-1 in her second season, marking the eighth-most improved won-lost record for a team in NCAA history. In 2000, Smith coached URI to its best record ever of 15-4-1, while reaching the Atlantic 10 Semifinals, a first in URI history.

Smith was nominated for the 2000 and 2009 National Coach of the Year. The New England Women's Soccer Intercollegiate Soccer Association (NEWISA) also named her its Division I Coach of the Year in 2000. She was the 1998 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year as well.

In addition to her experience as a coach, Smith brings experience from the semi-professional level. From 1996-2000, Smith played for the Boston Renegades in the W-1 League. Smith was captain in 2000 as she led Boston to the semifinals in the W-1 Championship. The Renegades reached the finals in 1998. Smith also had the opportunity to play overseas in 1994 as a member of the Sheffield United Women's Football Club in England.

Smith, a 1993 graduate of the University of Vermont with a degree in nutritional science, received her teacher's certificate from the same institution in 1995. Smith started all four years for the Catamounts. Her primary positions were center midfielder and central defender. She was a regional All-American in both 1992 and '93 in addition to being named First Team All-North Atlantic Conference each year from 1991-93. During her freshman year, the squad won the ECAC Tournament. Smith was named to Vermont's Athletic Hall of Fame in the summer of 2004.

Smith worked as an assistant coach at Dartmouth College from 1995-97. The Big Green made the NCAA Tournament in her second season with the program.

Smith is married to USC associate head coach Jamie Smith, a 1994 graduate of Providence College. They are the proud parents of two sons, Braden James, born on Nov. 25, 2003 and Evan Addison born on Jan. 6, 2006. The family resides in Columbia, S.C.

Smith has her USSF B license and the NCAA Advanced National Diploma. She is currently a member of the USYSA Regional Olympic Development Staff.
