#### Gamecocks Wrap Up Fall at Wendy's Kiawah Classic

The South Carolina men's golf team will play in its final tournament of the fall this week at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic. The 54-hole event runs Sunday through Tuesday at the par-72, 7,100-yard Turtle Point Golf Club in Kiawah Island, S.C.

#### The Lineup

South Carolina head coach Bill McDonald is sticking with the same lineup that brought home the Badger Invitational title. Junior Caleb Sturgeon will occupy the No. 1 position after winning medalist honors at the Badger Invitational and will be joined by sophomore Matt NeSmith, sophomore Will Starke, junior Will Murphy and freshman Ben Dietrich. Senior Alan King will be making his Gamecock debut as an individual.

#### What They've Done So Far

- Sophomore Matt NeSmith: Runner-up at the Badger Invitational with a total of 212 (-4), the fourth top-five finish of his career...Has placed in the top 10 in six of last seven regular-season events dating back to last spring...Finished tied for fourth at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 45th at the Carpet Capital Collegiate to open the season...Second on the team with a stroke average of 72.78.
- Junior Will Murphy: Wrapped up Badger Invitational in a tie for 25th...Tied for sixth at the Rees Jones Invitational... Finished in a tie for 48th at the Carpet Capital Collegiate...Ranks fourth on the team with a stroke average of 74.33.
- Junior Caleb Sturgeon: Won second career tournament title, claiming medalist honors at the Badger Invitational with a total of 206 (-10)...Has four career top-five finishes and 12 top-20 showings...Tied for 14th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Tied for 41st at the Carpet Capital Collegiate to open the season...Leads the team with a stroke average of 72.44...Career average of 73.07 currently ranks fourth all-time at South Carolina.
- Sophomore Will Starke: Posted fourth top-20 finish of career and his second this season, tying for 18th at the Badger Invitational...Tied for 37th at the Rees Jones Invitational...Posted a 2-under 214 to finish in a tie for fifth at the season-opening Carpet Capital Collegiate...Ranks third on the team with a stroke average of 74.11.
- Freshman Ben Dietrich: Tied for 44th at the Badger Invitational...Made collegiate debut at the Rees Jones Invitational as an individual...Finished tied for 33rd...Has a stroke average of 76.17.

#### History at Turtle Point

The Gamecocks have played in four previous regular-season tournaments hosted by Charleston Southern at Turtle Point, including last year's Kiawah Classic. South Carolina ran away with a 20-stroke victory a year ago, with Caleb Sturgeon claiming medalist honors to lead the way. The Gamecocks finished seventh (2010), tied for 13th (2002) and tied for 11th (2003) in their other three appearances at Turtle Point. South Carolina also played in four Metro Conference Championships at Turtle Point, winning the 1991 championship.

#### Breaking Down the Field

South Carolina will be competing against its largest field of the fall, with a total of 18 teams slated to tee off on Sunday. The

Gamecocks are the lone team ranked in the Golfstat Top 50 at No. 33, but Missouri (53), Winthrop (57) and Minnesota (59) sit just outside the top 50. South Carolina will also compete against host Charleston Southern, Campbell, Creighton, Elon, George Washington, Jacksonville State, Marquette, Presbyterian, Radford, Richmond, Towson, Western Kentucky, Wisconsin and USC Upstate.

**Last Time at the Kiawah Classic - 2012**

The Gamecocks won their first tournament title since 2009 as they cruised to a 20-stroke victory at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic a year ago. Caleb Sturgeon claimed his first career tournament title to lead the way, finishing with a total of 210 (-3). Will Starke (2nd), Matt NeSmith (T-6th) and Dykes Harbin (17th) all finished in the top 20 for the Gamecocks.

**Going for Two Straight**

The Gamecocks will be playing for their second-straight tournament title at the Kiawah Classic. South Carolina has not won back-to-back tournament title since winning the Turtle Bay Intercollegiate and the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship back-to-back during the 2003-04 season. Junior Caleb Sturgeon is also looking to become the first Gamecock to claim medalist honors in consecutive events since Carl Paulson won the PING Intercollegiate and the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate back-to-back in 1993.

**2013-14 Tournament Recaps**

**Badger Invitational**

The South Carolina men's golf team posted a final-round 291 (+3) to cruise to a 24-stroke victory at the Badger Invitational on Tuesday at University Ridge Golf Course.

The Gamecocks led wire-to-wire and wrapped up the week with a 54-hole total of 856 (-8) to pull away from the field for the win. Junior Caleb Sturgeon also captured medalist honors for the second time in his career after firing a 3-under 69 in the final round. He posted a total of 206 (-10) to become the 11th golfer in school history to win multiple tournament titles.

A native of Laurens, S.C., Sturgeon now has four career top-five finishes, just one shy of breaking into the top-10 in school history. Sturgeon's closest competitor was also wearing Garnet and Black, as NeSmith carded a 73 (+1) to finish runner-up with a total of 212 (-4). NeSmith also has four top-five finishes for his career and has placed in the top 10 in six of the last seven regular-season tournaments dating back to last spring.

Sophomore Will Starke recorded his fourth career top-20 finish as he shot a final-round 72 (E) to tie for 18th with a total of 222 (+6), while junior Will Murphy finished just outside the top 20 in a tie for 25th with a total of 224 (+8) after shooting an 81 (+9) on Tuesday. Rounding out the lineup, freshman Ben Dietrich turned in a 77 (+5) to tie for 44th with a total of 228 (+12).

Kansas finished runner-up with a total of 880 (+16), followed by Illinois State (883), USC Upstate (+22) and Austin Peay (+27).

**Rees Jones Invitational**

The South Carolina men's golf team came up short of claiming its third Rees Jones Invitational title as it shot a final-round 299 (+11) to finish in a tie for second at Haig Point Club. The Gamecocks, who have never placed worse than third at the event, finished tied with South Florida with a three-round total of 887 (+23) to fall two shots shy of tournament champion Kennesaw State. The Owls captured their third Rees Jones Invitational trophy with a total of 885 (+21).

The final day proved to be the toughest, as the average score rose to 78.16 with winds gusting as high as 20 miles per hour. South Carolina fought through the conditions to place three golfers in the top 15. Sophomore Matt NeSmith was the highest Gamecock on the leaderboard as he finished in a tie for fourth with a total of 218 (+2) after shooting a 74 (+2) on Tuesday.

Junior Will Murphy carded the lowest round of the day for the Gamecocks, shooting a 1-over 73 to finish in a tie for sixth with a total of 219 (+3). Junior Caleb Sturgeon posted a final-round 77 (+5) to record his second-straight top-15 finish at Haig Point with a total of 222 (+6). Sophomore Will Starke tied for 33rd with a total of 231 (+15) after turning in a 75 (+3) in the final round, while junior Blaine Woodruff shot an 80 (+8) to tie for 48th with a total of 235 (+19). Playing as an individual in his first collegiate event, freshman Ben Dietrich finished in a tie for 33rd with a total of 229 (+13) after carding an 81 (+9).

**Carpet Capital Collegiate**

The South Carolina men's golf team shot a final-round 297 (+9) at The Farm Golf Club to finish in 10th place at the Carpet Capital Collegiate. The Gamecocks wrapped up the weekend with a three-round total of 888 (+24).

Continuing his solid play from the first two rounds, sophomore Will Starke recorded his second career top-five finish as he fired a 2-under 70 to conclude the tournament in a tie for fifth with a total of 214 (-2). A native of Chapin, S.C., Starke carded a team-best seven birdies to go with three bogeys and a double bogey. After shooting 1-over 37 on the front side, he bogeyed the 10th hole to start the back nine before playing the final eight holes at 4-under.

Junior Caleb Sturgeon, who posted a 76 (+4) on Sunday, was the next Gamecock on the leaderboard as he concluded the tournament in a tie for 41st with a total of 224 (+8). He recorded a pair of birdies, three bogeys and a triple bogey on the afternoon.

Sophomore Matt NeSmith turned in a 78 (+6) on Sunday to tie for 45th with a total of 225 (+9), while junior Will Murphy tied for 48th with a total of 226 (+10) after shooting a final-round 74 (+2). Rounding out the lineup, junior Blaine Woodruff shot a 77 (+5) to tie for 62nd with a total of 230 (+14).

#### **Be on the Lookout**

Sophomore Matt NeSmith, a PING Honorable Mention All-American last season, was listed among Golf World's top 50 male golfers to watch during the 2013-14 season. NeSmith recorded seven top-10 finishes a year ago.
