With expectations surrounding this season, Staley believed it was important for her team to focus on the collective instead of any individual, knowing that to thrive in pressure situations, each student-athlete may have to sacrifice a piece of herself to become one team.















South Carolina Notables

- The Gamecocks are in their 41st season of women's basketball. It is the program's 24th season in the SEC and the seventh under head coach Dawn Staley. South Carolina has played in the last three NCAA Tournaments, including two trips to the Sweet 16 (2012, 2014).
- South Carolina has ramped up its defensive pressure recently, forcing 21.0 turnovers and swiping 13.0 steals per game over the last two outings (vs. LSU and Vanderbilt). In total, the Gamecocks have forced 20 or more turnovers in a game eight times, including three SEC outings (LSU, Vanderbilt, Alabama).
- The Gamecocks' 3-point shooting has been especially efficient lately as they have shot 45.8 percent (27-of-59) over the last five games. Their 58.3 percent (7-of-12) from long range against LSU was a season high and this season's fourth game shooting over 50.0 percent. In addition to the season-long proficiency of junior Tiffany Mitchell, hitting 47.5 percent from outside the arc, junior Tina Roy has lifted her 3-point percentage to 41.7 percent on the season, including a team-best 47.2 percent in SEC action.
- South Carolina has seen increased offensive production from its primary point guards in the last 10 games as junior Khadijah Sessions and freshman Bianca Cuevas combine to average 14.0 points over the stretch, compared to their combined 8.7 scoring average prior to the Jan. 11 game against Kentucky. The duo has combined for double-digit scoring eight times in the last 10 games compared to just five times in the first 15.
- South Carolina has shown its versatility throughout games this season with six different Gamecocks leading the offense in at least one game – three guards (Tiffany Mitchell, Bianca Cuevas, Asia Dozier) and three post players (A'ja Wilson, Alaina Coates, Aleighsa Welch).
- Guard/forward A'ja Wilson became the first freshman to post consecutive 20-point games in SEC play in program history with her 26 vs. LSU and 20 against Vanderbilt. The last Gamecock freshman to record back-to-back 20-point games was Kelsey Bone in November 2009 in non-conference action.
- Senior forward Aleighsa Welch has been steadily increasing her rebounding average since the start of SEC play, during which she averages 7.1 per game to rank in the top 10 in the league. Her production has especially skyrocketed in the last four outings, during which her 10.8 rebounds per game have lifted her season average nearly a full rebound per game – 5.5 rpg after Ole Miss (Feb. 1) to its current average of 6.3. She needs just four rebounds to move into the Gamecocks' all-time top five in total boards. She is already second in school history in career offensive rebounds.

A South Carolina Win Would...

- Ensure the Gamecocks' fourth-straight 25-win season after the program reached the plateau just three times in the 37 previous seasons.
- Give South Carolina 13 SEC victories for just the second time in school history, but the second time in as many seasons.
- Be the Gamecocks' seventh SEC road victory, topping last season's record of six.
- Be the Gamecocks' fifth straight over Arkansas and their third straight over the Razorbacks at Bud Walton Arena.

By the Numbers

- 1 Game this season in which South Carolina has attempted fewer than 10 free throws (vs. Central Michigan, Dec. 20)
- 2 Women who have both played for and coached the nation's No. 1 team as South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley joined Baylor's Kim Mulkey in the category this season
- 4 Rebounded needed by senior Aleighsa Welch to move into the program's all-time top five in career boards

- 15 Games in which South Carolina's bench has tied or out-scored its starters, including 10 SEC contests
- 17.7 Point per game more in the paint scored by the Gamecocks than their opponents (40.1-22.4)
- 24 Times this season a Gamecock has played 30 or more minutes in a game, compared to 71 times last season
- 77.1 Percent free throw shooting by the Gamecocks in the last five minutes of games with a margin of 10 or fewer points

Arkansas Series History

The Razorbacks lead the series 17-12, but the Gamecocks have won five of the last six, including a current four-game win streak. South Carolina swept the home-and-home series last season, eking out a 55-51 victory in Fayetteville (Jan. 2) before storming past the Razorbacks 67-49 in Columbia (Feb. 9).

Bud Walton Arena has proved to be a challenging venue for South Carolina, despite their 3-2 record there in the Staley era. Four of the five games in Fayetteville were decided by five points or less, including one overtime affair.

Staley Status Update

While leading the Gamecocks to one of the best seasons in program history, South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has continued to carve out her place as one of the top coaches in the game.

With the Gamecocks' rise to No. 1 in the Associated Press poll this season, Staley joined Baylor's Kim Mulkey as the only women to have played on and coached a No. 1-ranked team. Staley's Virginia team was ranked No. 1 for a total of 24 weeks spanning her junior and senior seasons. She has led the Gamecocks to 12 weeks in the top spot in the Associated Press poll so far.

Staley also earned an extension from USA Basketball last week as she was named to an assistant coach to the U.S. Women's National Team through the 2016 Olympic Games. Her USA Basketball coaching resume already includes gold medals at the 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship (head coach), 2014 FIBA World Championship (assistant coach), 2008 Beijing Olympics (asst. coach) and 2007 FIBA Americas Championship (asst. coach).

Road Warriors

The Gamecocks are 8-1 on the road this season, including six SEC wins in enemy territory.

Overall, South Carolina is 211-241 (.467) in road games, including a 44-32 (.579) record during the Dawn Staley era. After a difficult start as the Gamecocks' mentor, Staley has guided her team to two of the program's top five road records in program history, including last season's school-record winning percentage of .833 (10-2). Her 2012-13 team posted a 7-3 (.700) record on the road for the fourth-best in program history.

Poll Prominence

South Carolina is No. 2 in both polls this week, closing out a 12-week run as the No. 1 team in the Associated Press Poll. It was the third-longest stretch by a team in the last five seasons (beginning 2010-11). Only four teams have held the top spot in the AP poll during that time – Baylor (39 weeks), Connecticut (35 weeks) and Stanford (6 weeks).

In the last 10 seasons (beginning 2005-06), eight teams have occupied the AP Poll's No. 1 position. South Carolina's 12 weeks in the spot is the fifth-most among that group – UConn (85), Baylor (39), Tennessee (16) and Duke (14).

The AP's No. 1 ranking on Nov. 24 was a South Carolina program first, besting the No. 2 spot the Gamecocks held for five times in their history – Nov. 17, 2014; Preseason 2014-15; Jan. 2, 1982; Dec. 27, 1981; and Dec. 20, 1981.

SEC Stories

Head coach Dawn Staley has steadily lifted the Gamecocks' national profile by building the Gamecocks into a consistent SEC contender, shirking decades of difficulty in the nation's best women's basketball conference.

In her seventh season at the helm, Staley boasts a 64-42 (.604) SEC regular-season record and has finished outside the league's top five just twice – an unprecedented achievement for a program that had finished INSIDE the top five just twice in the previous 17 seasons. Staley's 64 wins include now four seasons of double-digit league victories – 10-6 in 2012, 11-5 in 2013, an SEC-best 14-2 in 2014 and this season's current 12-0 mark.

Staley's SEC regular-season record includes a 35-18 (.660) mark at home and a 29-24 (.547) slate on the road.

Crunch Time

South Carolina has won all five of its games this season when the margin is under 10 points in the last five minutes, and the Gamecocks have done so with their primary strengths – Tiffany Mitchell and rebounding.

In those five games – Southern Cal, vs. #22/22 Syracuse, at #9/8 Duke, #10/11 Kentucky and at Missouri – Staley trusts in Mitchell's competitive spirit, giving her the ball in late-game situations.

The junior has answered the bell, averaging 3.6 points per final five minutes of those games – double the next Gamecock on the list. Behind her fearless attacking of the rim, a majority of her points have come at the free throw line, where she has hit 12-of-14 attempts during those close-game situations. In a show of determination, the Gamecocks have also dominated the glass at crunch time, out-rebounding their opponents 6.2 to 4.4 per final five minutes, with Alaina Coates, A'ja Wilson and Aleighsa Welch grabbing the bulk of the boards.

As a team, South Carolina is shooting 40.0 percent from the field and the same percentage from 3-point range in the last five minutes of close games, while the defense has held those opponents to just 21.2 percent shooting and 18.2 percent from outside the arc in that time span. Equally impressive is the Gamecocks' 77.1 percent (27-of-35) free throw shooting at crunch time, as South Carolina is shooting just 66.5 percent (349-of-525) otherwise.

Win Any Way

As the Gamecocks' baseball coach a few years ago, South Carolina athletics director Ray Tanner frequently used the phrase "Win Anyway." Women's basketball has put its own twist on the quote. The Gamecocks have lost just one game this season, but the end has not always come by the same means.

Dawn Staley's team has won with both a high-flying offense – posting records of 4-0 when scoring 90+ points, 7-0 when scoring 80-89 points – and a more methodical one, 7-0 when scoring 70-79 points, 7-1 with scoring fewer than 70.

The Gamecocks have won both inside – 10-0 when shooting less than 33.3 percent from 3-point range, 9-1 when at least half of points come in the paint – and outside – 14-1 when shooting 33.3 percent or better from 3-point range, 15-0 when less than half of points come in the paint.

South Carolina has seen its top scorer come from both the starting lineup (9-1) and the bench (13-0) – with two games in which a starter and reserve tied for the team high (win vs. Auburn – Welch, Wilson; win vs. Vanderbilt – Mitchell, Wilson).

Diehard Defenders

While the offense has fluctuated in source and volume, the one standard for the Gamecocks – both this season and throughout head coach Dawn Staley's career – has been their defense. South Carolina is seventh in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 52.3 points per game with just one opponent scoring more than 63 points (87 by UConn, Feb. 9). In fact, South Carolina has held an opponent under 50 points 12 times in 25 games this season.

In SEC play, South Carolina yields a league-best 54.1 points per game and has limited some of the conference's highest scoring teams well beneath their

averages. Kentucky (2nd in the SEC in scoring) has scored 75.3 points per game in their 11 games against other SEC teams but netted just 60 against the Gamecocks. Ranked fifth in the conference in scoring, LSU's 64.8 average in 10 other league games is well above the 56.5 it averaged against South Carolina. In all, five teams failed to reach their average against other league schools while playing the Gamecocks – Missouri (59.5 - 49), Florida (58.9 - 42) and Georgia (57.7 - 35).

Controlled Caroms

The Gamecocks have also built their success on the glass – an area, like defense, that head coach Dawn Staley preaches as a measure of effort as much as talent. South Carolina ranks eighth in the nation in rebounding margin, out-boarding its opponents by 11.2 per game. The Gamecocks have out-paced their opponent by double-digit rebounds 12 times this season, including six SEC outings. The rebounding margin has been at least 20 four times – Clemson (+22), Savannah State (+35), at Hampton (+27) and Vanderbilt (+20). Only two teams – #22/22 Syracuse (Nov. 28) and #9/8 Duke (Dec. 7) – have out-rebounded South Carolina this season.

Bench Marks

While every competitor wants to be a starter, the Gamecocks have shown that the bench can be just as productive a position. The South Carolina bench has tied or out-scored its starting teammates 15 times this season, including 10 SEC contests, and has out-scored the entire opposing team five times – Clemson (Nov. 20), San Diego State (Nov. 23), NC Central (Dec. 1) and Florida (Jan. 19). In all, the bench has accounted for 49.2 percent of the Gamecocks' points this season, including 52.7

percent of the offense in SEC games.

Of the 92 double-figure games turned in this season, 46 of them have come from the bench – A'ja Wilson (21), Alaina Coates (13), Bianca Cuevas (7), Tina Roy (2), Jatarie White (2) and Asia Dozier (1).

Diversified Assets

South Carolina is often lauded for the depth of its talent, and the Gamecocks' improved offensive numbers certainly bear out those accolades – 11th in the nation at 78.2 points per game and fifth in the nation in field goal percentage (.483).

The embarrassment of riches has not upset South Carolina's chemistry but instead has strengthened it as each Gamecock plays for the good of the team instead of herself – a message head coach Dawn Staley often equates with USA Basketball's utopian camaraderie and ultimate success.

Two stats that best exemplify the all-for-one mentality of the team are in the assist numbers – 15th in the nation at 17.3 per game – and that only one Gamecock is averaging more than 10.0 shots per game. In fact, on one of the nation's most efficient offensive teams, which features all five of its top scorers shooting over 50.0 percent, just one Gamecock has made the minimum field goals required for individual ranking in field goal

Zone Buster

Since the emergence of Elem Ibiam and the arrival of Alaina Coates in 2013-14, South Carolina has been a team feared for its inside presence. That perception got a boost with the addition of Jatarie White and A'ja Wilson this season, and teams have packed into a zone early and often against the Gamecocks.

This season, South Carolina's guards have been effective at capitalizing on what opposing teams are willing to cede in that defensive alignment – the 3-point shot. The Gamecocks lead the SEC and rank 26th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, hitting 36.4 percent from outside the arc. The percentage is not dramatically above last season's (.347), but after closing 2013-14 averaging 3.9 made 3s per game, South Carolina is third in the SEC with a 5.1 average this season.

Junior Tiffany Mitchell has been the primary long-range shooter, ranking third in the SEC with 1.9 made 3s per game while shooting 48.4 percent from outside the arc. But juniors Tina Roy and Khadijah Sessions have lifted their long-range production in SEC action as well. Roy is shooting a team-best 47.2 percent in league games, including 6-of-9 (.667) over the last two games, while Sessions has lifted her accuracy to 36.8 percent after going 5-of-7 over the last three games.

SWAT Team

South Carolina leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the nation with 6.0 blocked shots per game. The effort is a continuation of last season, during which the Gamecocks shattered the school record for blocks in a season by 41, recording 240 over 34 games for a 7.1 average.

Four Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 15 blockers, led by sophomore Alaina Coates in third at 1.6 per game. Freshman A'ja Wilson is just behind in fifth at 1.5 per game this season. Seniors Aleighsa Welch and Elem Ibiam are next in line with Welch swatting 1.2 per game for ninth and Ibiam rejecting 0.9 per game for 15th place.

SEC Title Talk

In 2013-14, South Carolina became the seventh program to win the SEC regular-season title, and the Gamecocks and were predicted by the league's coaches and media to the repeat the feat

this season. If Staley's group brings that forecast to fruition, it would be just the fourth team to repeat as the regular-season champion, joining Tennessee (multiple times), Georgia (1996, 1997) and LSU (2005, 2006).

More on Muffin

Senior forward Aleighsa Welch – nicknamed Muffin at birth by her mother – continues to be at the foundation of the Gamecocks' success. The South Carolina high school standout who first took a chance on head coach Dawn Staley's vision has done everything asked to power the Gamecocks to the lofty heights achieved during her career. Always willing to do the "dirty work" that doesn't show up in the box score, Welch's energy and constant communication are what drive the Gamecocks and what has prompted her teammates to vote her a team captain each of the last three seasons.

Welch's consistent effort has her ranked among the program's career top 10 in eight different categories, including three rebounding totals, while also among the top-20 scorers. Among the Gamecocks' 30 1,000-point scorers, she is one of just nine to amass at least 800 career rebounds as well. She is currently just four rebounds away from entering the program's top five in career boards. Her current career .581 field goal percentage is second in school history behind only Jocelyn Penn's school-record .593.

The expansion of the Gamecocks' frontline have brought her overall rebounding numbers down slightly (6.3 rpg this season vs. 7.2 average previous three seasons), but she has been especially tenacious on the glass against ranked opponents, averaging 9.3 boards over six games against ranked foes compared to 4.9 in the Gamecocks' other 19 outings. Welch also continues to provide consistency on the offensive end, shooting 56.6 percent from the field and handing out 1.8 assists per game.

Trademark TM

After elevating her game last season, junior guard Tiffany Mitchell continues to insert herself in national player of the year talk, but the only thing constant about her game is its versatility.

Last season, Mitchell was the only player to appear in the rankings for scoring, rebounding, assists and steals in SEC action. The one weapon she frequently kept in check was her 3-point shooting.

This season, the junior has established herself as one of the most accurate 3-point shooters in the country, hitting 47.5 percent. Her heightened accuracy was on full display against San Diego State (Nov. 23) when her 6-of-6 effort from 3 was the best perfect game in program history. She went on to match her career high with six 3s at Hampton as well, those coming on eight attempts.

While Mitchell is third in the SEC with 1.9 made 3s per game, her emergence in that role has not thwarted development in the rest of her game as she ranks in the top five in both field goal percentage (1st, .524) and free throw percentage (4th, .829).

Double Trouble

One of sophomore Alaina Coates' goals this season focuses around posting double-doubles, taking to

heart her head coach's quip that the 6-foot-4 center is a "walking double-double." Ranking 32nd in the nation with an SEC-best 10 this season, the Irmo, S.C., native has 20 career double-doubles through 58 games, tying her for 10th in school history in the category.

Four of this season's 10 have come in SEC action, which is two shy of the program record of six set by Marsha Williams in 1991-92. Her nine career SEC

double-doubles is third in program history and two shy of Williams' career record of 11.

Bang off the Bench

The Class of 2014's No. 1 recruit, A'ja Wilson drew the start in her collegiate debut, but the 6-foot-5 Heathwood Hall product has thrived off the bench ever since. Overall on the season, Wilson is second on the team in scoring, ranking ninth in the SEC in at 13.9 ppg, and has been the Gamecocks' top scorer a team-high 12 times. She is the only freshman to rank among the SEC's top 20 scorers and rebounders – standing ninth in both categories. Only Mississippi State's Victoria Vivian (15.0 ppg) out-scores Wilson among SEC freshmen. Wilson also adds a top-five blocked shots average (1.5) to her resume.

Wilson is the only freshman on either the Wooden Award Late-Season Top 20 or the Naismith Midseason Top 30. She has earned SEC Freshman of the Week five times, tying the league record, and was the USBWA's first ever Freshman of the Week (games Dec. 1-7).

B Aggressive

A 5-foot-6, lightning-quick, ultra-creative college point guard can earn a lot of clever nicknames. South Carolina simply calls its version "B," as in Bianca Cuevas.

The freshman from the Bronx, N.Y., has found the controls of her fast-paced, high risk/high reward style, and the Gamecocks are reaping the rewards as she grasps the balance head coach Dawn Staley wants her point guard to have between creating her own shot and doing the same for others.

In South Carolina's 12 non-conference games, Cuevas averaged 4.5 points and 1.8 assists in 14.2 minutes per game, shooting 35.9 percent from the

field and 22.6 percent from 3-point range. In SEC action, she averages to 8.5 points and 2.0 assists in 18.0 minutes and is shooting 41.0 percent, including 28.0 percent from outside the arc. A bulk of those numbers were established in a five-game stretch from Jan. 19-Feb. 5, during which Cuevas thrived with 11.6 points and 2.4 assists in 20.2 minutes per game on 51.2 percent shooting with 38.5 percent accuracy from 3-point range.

It's Elem-entary

Senior center Elem Ibiam is making a charge at the school record for career blocks this season after setting the single-season mark with 83 in 2013-14. The Fayetteville, Ga., native is currently second with 153 in her career, trailing the Gamecocks' career record of 177 of set by Lakesha Tolliver (2004-07).

DAWN STALEY

**7th Season at South Carolina
Virginia, 1992**

When three-time Olympic gold medalist Dawn Staley took the reins of the University of South Carolina women's basketball program on May 10, 2008, the Gamecocks' stature immediately rose not just in the Southeastern Conference but on the national stage as well. Building on a foundation of hard work, defensive effort and a "team first" mentality, South Carolina began to realize those expectations in 2011-12. Three consecutive 25-win seasons were capped with the 2013-14 squad's 29-win effort that included the program's first SEC regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as well as the Gamecocks' second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in three seasons. In 2014-15, Staley became just the second woman in college basketball history to both play and coach for a No. 1-ranked team, joining Baylor's Kim Mulkey in the elite category. Staley's Virginia team was ranked No. 1 for a total of 24 weeks spanning her junior and senior seasons. She has led the Gamecocks to 12 weeks in the top spot in the Associated Press poll so far.

In her 14 seasons as a head coach, Staley has amassed a 317-152 record, including her 145-72 slate in six seasons at South Carolina. She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons, a total of 11 postseason appearances (two WNIT), highlighted by the Gamecocks' pair of Sweet 16 appearances and 14 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including four in the top five. The future continues to brighten as the nation's top recruits make Columbia, S.C., a highly coveted destination. Consistently signing the top players in the state, Staley's 2014 group illustrated the seeds her staff had been sowing since its arrival as the No. 1 recruit in the class joined two other top-35 entries among the five-member class that was ranked No. 2 in the nation.

While her coaching career is blossoming, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified her legacy with her enshrinement into the Hall as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012 and was one of the final nominees for induction to the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame the same year. In the summer of 2011, the WNBA recognized her as one of the league's "Top 15," honoring the most influential players in the league's history.

At the helm of the Gamecocks over the last six seasons, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year (2014, Basketball Times), Naismith National Coach of the Year Finalist (2014), SEC Coach of the Year (2014, Coaches and AP) and BCA Female Coach of the Year (2012). She has coached an All-American, 12 All-SEC selections, five SEC All-Freshman team selections, an SEC Player of the Year, an SEC Sixth Player of the Year, an SEC Defensive Player of the Year and two SEC Freshmen of the Year. South Carolina's 29 wins in 2013-14 were one shy of the overall school record, breaking the best mark since joining the SEC of 25 set in 2011-12 and tied in 2012-13. The Gamecocks have won more SEC games than the season before in each of Staley's last five seasons, and her 52 SEC victories are more than any other Gamecock coach and account for 44.8 percent of the program's total 116 league wins. She has helped the Gamecocks to three of the program's four top-four finishes in the SEC, including the first regular-season championship in 2013-14. Her 97 overall wins in the last four seasons marks the most successful four-year stretch in program history.
