Men's Swimming - 2008-09 In Review

A 29th-place finish at the NCAA Championships, a strong performance at the SEC Championships and three dual meet victories highlighted a 2008-09 season for South Carolina men's swimming that was full of encouraging signs for the future development of the program. Although the Gamecocks continued to play catch-up with the rest of the Southeastern Conference, the gap is closing as South Carolina continues to strive toward the level of the elite swimming programs in the SEC and in the nation.

The season started at the Carolina Natatorium with a pair of difficult dual meets against ACC foes North Carolina and Virginia, both of whom were ranked in the CSCAA Top 25. While the Tar Heels left with a 184-115 victory and the Cavaliers won by a 165-124 margin, there were signs of improvement throughout the Carolina ranks. Nick Walkotten got a win in the 100 fly in both meets, while Andy Atzhorn won the 200 IM against UNC and set personal-best marks in two events against UVA.

Clemson came to town on Halloween night for the annual Palmetto State showdown, and the home crowd left happy as the Gamecocks dominated the Tigers, 178-119, to pick up their first win over Clemson since 2005. The Gamecocks got event wins in the 200 free (Kyle Cormier), 100 back (James Crawford), 100 breast (Armin Hornikel), 200 fly (Walkotten), 100 free (Cormier), 200 back (Crawford), 200 breast (Hornikel), 100 fly (Walkotten) and 200 IM (Crawford) while sweeping the relays to take down their rivals from the Upstate for the 33rd time.

Things were a little tougher the next week at No. 5 Florida with the Gators taking a 167-126 win. However, Cormier and Walkotten got wins in the 100 and 200 free, as well as the 100 fly.

Carolina would turn in a strong perfor-

mance two weeks later as they hosted the Gamecock Invitational, finishing second in the six-team field. Walkotten earned his first NCAA 'B' cut of the season in the 200 fly, while Cormier picked up provisional times in the 200 IM and 200 free.

After the holiday break, the Gamecocks headed north to Durham, N.C., for a tri-meet with Davidson and Duke. While Carolina easily handled Davidson, 157-116, the match with Duke came down to the final race. The Gamecocks needed to take first and second in the 400 FR to force a tie; however, Duke took second to take a 153-145 win.

Cross-state rival College of Charleston visited Columbia for Senior Day and the final home meet for Kyle Cormier, Keith Dawley, Christian Kata, Steven Luckie, Nick Walkotten, Todd Weyandt. The team sent out the seniors in style with a 159-126 victory over the Cougars.

The following week saw a trip to Tuscaloosa for a tri-meet with SEC foes Alabama and Georgia. The Gamecocks dropped both meets - 167-131 to Alabama; 197-103 to Georgia - with Cormier's win in the 200 IM highlighting the meet for the Gamecocks.


In late February, South Carolina headed to Auburn for the SEC Championships and put together its best collection of swims in several years. Five individuals scored points for Carolina in 10 different events, and Kyle Cormier took the medal stand with a third-place finish in the 200 free. Meanwhile, Carolina swimmers earned eight NCAA 'B' cut times in individual events and in four of five relays, and six school records fell in the four days at the Martin Aquatic Center. Carolina finished in eighth place, but continued to narrow the gap between itself and the rest of the SEC.

Walkotten and Cormier earned invites to the NCAA Championships, making it the third trip for both athletes. Cormier swam the 200 IM, 100 free and 100 fly but did not

score. Walkotten, meanwhile, turned in a 15th-place finish in the 100 fly then scored big points for Carolina in the 100 fly, finishing sixth. Walkotten's combined 15 points gave South Carolina a 29th-place finish, its best since 2005.
